@ASUSwimDive Heads East to Sunshine State for First Full-Squad Meet

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – The new-look No. 14 Sun Devil men's swimming and diving team looks to make their season debut in a dual meet with Florida State alongside the Arizona State women's squad this Friday in Tallahassee.

The trip out west marks the first as a full squad, as only women's swimming made the trek up to the Pacific Northwest to face conference foe Oregon State three weeks ago.

The Sun Devil men come into their 2018-19 campaign complemented by 25 new faces, including seven first-year transfers, to go along with the returning athletes that include World University Games qualifier Grant House and four additional 2018 NCAA qualifiers in Zach Poti, Danny Comforti, Cameron Craig and Youssef Selim.

The incoming class – named the fifth-best in the nation by Swim Swam Magazine – is full of a diverse set of talent that includes 18 freshman and seven transfers from some of the top swimming programs in the country.

Diving is set for their first taste of competition on the season this weekend as well, adding two new men – freshmen Brandon Spencer and Caleb Ives – and one woman, Hannah Sanders.

"Florida State has two very good male and female divers, so it'll pose a very good early challenge for us," head diving coach Mark Bradshaw said. "It'll give our divers an idea of where their competitors are in terms of their training and skill level."

Spencer was a three-time Wisconsin state champion in high school, while Ives was a three-time All-American out of Colorado. Although Sanders' high school didn't have a diving program, the Portland native was a six-time national qualifier and regional and zone champion.

"All three of them are about the same level skill-wise coming in and they're all very solid with a lot of room to improve," Bradshaw said. "This weekend will be a test for them because it'll give them a chance to test where they are against divers of Florida State's level."

The three add to an already robust diving squad comprised of 2018 Pac-12 1M Champion Selim and David Hoffer, who redshirted in 2017-18 but looks to provide invaluable leadership as the only senior between both the men's and women's diving programs. On the women's side, All-American Frida Kaellgren and NCAA qualifier Ashley McCool look to build upon their successful 2017-18 campaigns.

"David's a fifth-year senior, so he's been around for a while and has had pretty much all of the experience you can have in terms of competing in dual meets, conference meets, zone meets and then NAAs," Bradshaw said. "He's a pretty calm guy, so he'll lead in that way when it comes to not only this meet, but throughout the season."

Despite the turnover on the men's side, the women brought back most of last year's team and added just one transfer in Cierra Runge and also earned votes in this week's CSCAA Poll.

After a solid 153-96 victory last time out that included victories in every single event and sweeping finishes in five, the women set their sights on their first ranked opponent, as the Seminoles men and women both check in at No. 21 this week.

Last season's meeting between the two programs marked the first in program history, and the Sun Devils notched victories on both the men and women's sides.

HEAD DIVE COACH MARK BRADSHAW



Completing his 20th season at ASU in 2016-17, Mark Bradshaw has proven to be one of the most successful NCAA diving coaches in the country.

With Bradshaw at the helm of the diving program, ASU has produced some of the NCAA's finest divers, including four-time NCAA Champion Joona Puhakka and six-time All-Americans Micky Benedetti and Trisha Tumlinson. Under Bradshaw's

guidance, ASU has had nine divers earn four NCAA individual titles and 29 All-American honors. In addition, Bradshaw has been named NCAA Diving Coach of the Year twice, in 2003 and 2005.

With eight Pac-10 Men's Diving Coach of the Year and one Women's Diving Coach of the Year plaques on his wall, Bradshaw has earned more Pac-10 Diving Coach of the Year honors than any other coach in conference history and has been named Pac-10 Coach of the Year the most out of all ASU Head Coaches. His divers have earned a total of nine Pac-10 Diver of the Year awards and six Pac-10 Newcomer of the Year honors.

HEAD SWIM COACH BOB BOWMAN



Bob Bowman, mentor of the world's most decorated Olympian and two-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, was named Arizona State head men's and women's swimming coach prior to the 2015-16 season. He earned his third conference Coach of the Year honor in 2016-17, named Pac-12 Men's Swimming Coach of the Year.

A 2010 inductee into the American Swimming Coaches Association (ASCA) Hall of Fame, Bowman is a five-time ASCA Coach of the Year and is the most-honored coach in the 40-plus years of the award. He has earned USA Swimming Coach of the Year honors six times, the USA Swimming Foundation's Golden Goggle Award four times, and was the 2002 USA Swimming Developmental Coach of the Year.

In addition to Phelps, Bowman guided Allison Schmitt to five medals, including three gold, at the 2012 Olympics, and coached 13-time international medalist Conor Dwyer.

LAST TIME OUT

The ASU women's swim squad travelled to Corvallis to take on Oregon State almost three weekends ago, notching a convincing 153-96 to open the 2018-19 competition season.

ASU started strong off the block from the beginning and never looked back, commencing the evening with a 1-3 finish in the 400 medley relay. The Sun Devils followed with sweeping finishes in five of the 12 individual events (excluding events in which ASU exhibited all swimmers), including in the 1000FR, 200FR, 200FL, 50FR and 100FR, and a top finish in all 14 events.

As a testament to the diverse talent on the squad, eight different swimmers posted top finishes in the meet, while Chloe Isleta (100BK, 200BK) and Silja Kansakoski (100BR, 200BR) marked the only two to officially touch first in multiple events.

ON THE WORLD STAGE

Freshman **Ashley McCool** represented her country in her native Calgary at the 2018 Canada Cup Grand Prix, earning silver in the 3M synchro ahead of the United States, Cuba and Germany.

McCool added another medal to her collection at the Summer Speedo Nationals, putting up a score of 283.10 in the finals to place third in the event and earn a bronze medal.

Frida Kaellgren competed again in the 1M dive for her country at the Swedish National Championships, racking up her second-straight gold medal in the event to become a Swedish National Champion in the event. Kaellgren notched a gold medal in the same event in 2017 and a silver in the 3M dive as well.

HOMECOMING

The Sun Devils added a new coach to the staff in the offseason -- #SunDevil4Life **Herbie Behm**.

Behm returns to Tempe after serving as the assistant sprints coach at the University of Utah for two seasons. During his tenure in Salt Lake, Behm led a group of more than 20 student-athletes in their daily training programs while assisting and working with each individual's technique, training strategies and post-race analysis. Under Behm's tutelage, 20 student-athletes set school records in just two seasons.

At Utah, Behm also coached a 2018 Pac-12 Champion and an All-American in the 200 medley relay. One of his student-athletes also swam the fastest 50-yard backstroke in the nation in the 2017-18 season.

Behm swam at Arizona State from 2010-13. Excelling in the classroom as well, Behm was a three-time Scholar-Athlete Award winner and graduated with his degree in Psychology while minoring in Communications. As a Sun Devil, Behm was a part of the foursome that set the school record in the 400 medley relay.

MEN NAMED NO. 5 INCOMING CLASS IN NATION

Boasting yet another exceptional recruiting class, the Sun Devil men's swimming program's 2018 haul was chosen as the No. 5 class in the nation, according to Swim Swam magazine's annual evaluation of NCAA Division I swimming classes.

The highly-touted Sun Devil class features 16 freshman and seven four-year university transfers spanning 12 states including Missouri, Ohio, Arizona, Virginia, Texas, Alabama, California, Colorado, Florida, Pennsylvania, Michigan, New York and one international student from Australia.

Swim Swam recognized freshmen **Cody Bybee, Noah Henry, Khalil Fonder** and transfers **Jack Kucharczyk** (Indiana) and **Carter Swift** (Eastern Michigan) as top-tier additions to the class.

The class, recognized as one of the nation's largest signing groups, rose quickly through the rankings, as only one of the class' prospects broke the magazine's top-20 list in the summer of 2017. After huge senior campaigns, that number tripled to three.

The class boasts nine swimmers with 100 free times of 44.9 or better, five with 50 free bests of 20.3 or better and six with 200 free bests at 1:36.6 or better. This adds to an already strong crop of Sun Devil freestylers that includes **Cameron Craig**, who owns all 10 of the top-10 200 free times in ASU history and **Grant House**, who put up the No. 24 time in the world during the 2017-18 season in the 200 free over the summer.

POWERHOUSE SCHEDULE

During the dual season, the men's and women's teams also face seven top-25 teams to finish last season, including the top-ranked team for each. The men face No. 1 Stanford, No. 2 Cal, No. 3 Indiana, No. 6 Texas, No. 9 USC, No. 18 Arizona while the women face those teams plus No. 21 UCLA.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

The Sun Devils earned CSCAA Scholar All-America honors as a team, marking the 10th-consecutive semester dating back to Fall 2013 that both Sun Devil squads have earned a place in the team, while the ASU men have achieved upward improvement for the past three seasons. 17 individual Sun Devil swimmers and divers were also named Scholar All-Americans.

Rounding out the selections were **Sarah Bathe, Camryn Curry, Kendall Dawson, Emma Nordin, Fanny Teijonsalo, Cameron Smith, Heikki Makikallio, Youssef Selim** and **Jack Dalmolin**.
