## Opponents Outlook

### No. 13 Auburn

- In 2019, the Tigers made it to the 2019 NCAA Baton Rouge Regional Final against LSU, where their season ended.

- Derrian GoBourne, a sophomore this season, advanced to the NCAA championships as an individual in the all-around. She won Auburn gymnastics' first ever national championship after scoring a 9.950 on vault to tie for the title.

- ASU last saw Auburn at the 2019 NCAA Baton Rouge Regional, where the Sun Devils took third in the session and the Tigers took second.

### No. 7 Denver

- Last season, the Pioneers advanced to the 2019 NCAA Championships and made it to the team final, where they took fourth place.

- Returner Lynzee Brown shared the national championship on floor with a 9.950. She was Denver's second national champion in program history.

- The Sun Devils last saw the Pioneers in 2019 in Denver for a tri-meet with Pittsburgh. Denver took first and ASU took third in that meet.

### No. 25 Penn State

- The Nittany Lions made it to the 2019 NCAA Ann Arbor Regional, where they took third in the second round, falling short of the regional final.

- Penn State sent two individuals to the NCAA championships in 2019, including returner Jessie Bastardi who competed on beam.

- Arizona State traveled to Penn State last season for a quad meet. Though the Nittany Lions took first, the Sun Devils earned their highest road score to that point to earn second place.

## Last Season

Jay and Jessica Santos led the Gym Devils to a successful season in 2019, the first since 2014 to have a winning record (11-10) in the regular season. The team was ranked in the top-25 on Road to Nationals all year, finishing at No. 25, and earned four wins over top-25 teams throughout the season. They scored a 196.000 or better six times and had a team RQS (Regional Qualifying Score) of 196.320 at the end of the year, the second season in a row with an RQS over 196.000.

To start off the postseason, the Sun Devils took fifth at the Pac-12 Gymnastics Championships, the best team finish since 2006. At NCAA Regionals, the team finished in seventh, but Cairo Leonard-Baker won the regional bar title with a 9.925, automatically qualifying her for nationals as an individual. At the NCAA Championships, she scored a 9.900, earning Second Team All-America honors in that event.

### Cairo: 2x All-American & History-Maker

In 2019, Cairo Leonard-Baker earned Second Team All-America honors on bars after scoring a 9.900 at the NCAA Championships. She was also named a WCGA Regular Season All-American for the second-straight season, this time on bars. She garnered regular season All-America Second Team honors in 2018 in the all-around from the National

Association of College Gymnastics Coaches (NACGC). She was the first Gym Devil to earn regular season honors since they started in 2013.

She was also named to the 2019 All-Pac-12 First Team in both the all-around and on bars. She is the first Gym Devil to receive both of those awards in back-to-back seasons since Ashley Kelly from 2003-04.

## More Than An Athlete

The Gym Devils continued their tradition of incredible work in and out of the classroom. Tying last year's record, nine student-athletes were placed on Pac-12 All-Academic Teams.

There were six on the first team, which is a program record. The six on the first team are Corinne Belkoff, Jessica Ginn, Anne Kuhm, Kaitlyn Szafranski, Ashley Szafranski and Heather Udowitch. On the second team, the Gym Devils represented are Morgan Hart and Morgan Wilson. Justine Callis is the Sun Devil receiving an honorable mention.

## In the Rankings

ASU was ranked No. 21 in the Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association (WCGA) preseason poll. The Sun Devils' highest ranking in 2019 was No. 13 in week two. They were in the top 20 in seven weeks of the regular season and in the top 25 all season.

## Returners

The Sun Devils return seven gymnasts who have played key roles for ASU in past seasons. The team is led by junior Leonard-Baker, who has earned All-America honors in each of her two seasons in Tempe. She has been a staple in the all-around for Arizona State in the last two years. Other returners who have made key contributions are Morgan Wilson, Jessica Ginn Morgan Hart and Ashley Szafranski. Jasmine Gutierrez and Graycee Zaugg have also made appearances in lineups during their time here.

Three returners have earned 9.900s or better during their time at ASU. Hart scored a 9.900 on bars last year, Szafranski has earned 9.900s on bars and beam in her career and Wilson won a vault title with one of her two 9.900s in 2019. Leonard-Baker has the most 9.900s or better, earning 12 between bars and floor just last season. She also won 12 event titles last year, seven on bars and five on floor.

## Newcomers

Arizona State has seven new faces on the team: six freshmen and a transfer sophomore. The Sun Devils will rely on some key underclassmen to show up big for the team in 2020. At the Maroon and Gold Scrimmage in early December, freshmen Juliette Boyer, Hannah Scharf and Gracie Reeves all competed in the all-around, with Boyer taking second behind Leonard-Baker.

Vice President for University Athletics and Athletics Director Ray Anderson named Jay Santos the head women's gymnastics coach on May 27, 2016.

Boasting arguably one of the most substantial turnarounds in recent collegiate gymnastics history, Santos' 2018 squad improved 18 spots from their 2017 national finish of 41, capping the season ranked at No. 23 nationally (highest finish since 2007). Ranking in the top-20 of the national standings for 12 consecutive weeks, Arizona State made its first team NCAA regional appearance since 2014 while sending individual all-around qualifier and regular season All-American Cairo Leonard-Baker to nationals. Courtesy of his efforts at the helm of the program, Santos was named the 2018 Pac-12 Coach of the Year.

In his first season as head coach in 2017, Santos quickly elevated the program. The Gym Devils scored 195 in four separate meets, the first time that has happened since the 2014 season. The Gym Devils also bested then-No. 23 Arizona for the program's first Pac-12 win since 2014 and the coveted Territorial Cup series point. At the Pac-12 Championship, the Gym Devils completed the season with a 195.600, their second highest team score of the season. It was the second highest team total for the program at a championship meet since 2004 when they scored a 196.775.

Santos coached Eastern Michigan to the 2016 Mid-American Conference Championship, the program's first-ever NCAA Regional appearance, and finished the season ranked 17th in the nation – the highest national ranking in the history of the program. He earned NCAA Central Regional Head Coach of the Year honors.

Prior to leading Eastern Michigan, Santos coached at the University of Illinois-Champaign where he served as assistant coach, then associate head coach in his four-year tenure. At Illinois, Santos coached the team to three NCAA Championship appearances in 2011, 2013, and 2014, finishing 11th in the nation each year. Santos also coached eight Illini gymnasts to All-American honors.

Santos was assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Iowa State from 2006-10, and also spent time as an assistant at Ohio State. Santos also spent eight years coaching at Somersault Gymnastics Center in Stoughton, Mass., serving as the women's team director and head coach for his last four years. At Somersault Gymnastics, he was responsible for all facets of the women's program and produced several Junior Olympic national and regional qualifiers, and many state champions.

Santos served as a nationally-rated men's gymnastics judge from 1997-2001, working numerous college dual meets as well as Junior Olympic state and regional championships.

Santos earned a bachelor's degree in Business Administration in Operations Management from the University of Massachusetts at Amherst in 1995, and was a member of the Minutemen's gymnastics team from 1990-95. At Amherst, he was a three-time co-captain and founding member of the department's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC).

Santos' wife, Jessica Santos, serves as the Sun Devil Gymnastics program's associate head coach. They have two sons, Mason and Cooper.
