HITTING THE ROAD

Trading the Grand Canyon state for the Aloha State, Sun Devil Water Polo heads to Hawaii for their first road games of the 2025 season. After hosting the ASU Invitational, the Sun Devils will face off against Biola, LMU, and Hawaii in the four-team Hawaii Invitational at Duke Kahanamoku Aquatic Complex. This is the program's first trip to Hawaii to compete in the Hawaii Tournament since 2019.

The Sun Devils recorded five plus assists in every game and 10 plus goals this past weekend. The team currently boasts a 90 point cumulative total compared to their oponents who sit at 53.

For the tournament, there is one game Friday and two more on Saturday. The games will have live stats on FOSH and there will be live updates on the Sun Devil Water Polo X/Twitter @sundevilwp.

BY THE NUMBERS

The team consists of 11 newcomers, coming from three different countries other than the United States. (Hungary, Australia, and Spain)

Seven Sun Devils tallied their first collegiate goals at the ASU Invitational, Itziar Almeda, Karly Frangieh, Ani Pamp, Layla Smith, Keri Glad, Leila Meraz, and Hannah McClaskey.

The Sun Devils have opened their season with a 4-0 start in the 2025 and 2024 seasons.

All four goaltenders for the Sun Devils saw action last weekend with freshman Keri Glad and Junior Sanne Keijzer each recording 24 saves.

THE RUNDOWN

- The Sun Devils return 11 from the previous season with Millie Quin leading the way in scoring with a career high 69 goals in 2024.
- Arizona State finished the 2024 season with a win after defeating Indiana in last seasons' MPSF Conference tournament.
- With 11 returners, the Sun Devils also boast 11 newcomers, including transfer Molly Glad who spent two seasons at USC before joining the Maroon and Gold.

LAST WEEKEND

 On Saturday, the team defeated Cal Lutheran 19-6 in the first game and outscored No. 23 San Diego State 19-13 in the second match of the day. The Maroon and Gold then remained undefeated by finishing off the ASU Invitational with victories against No. 15 UC Davis and Cal Baptist. ASU captured the first game on Sunday against the Aggies 10-8, then pulled away against the Lancers 16-10.

IT'S A FAMILY MATTER

 The 2025 roster boasts two sets of sisters, junior Zoe Frangieh and freshman Karly
 Frangieh as well as redshirt junior Molly Glad and freshman Keri Glad.

WATER POLO HISTORY

- Origionally established in 2002, the Maroon & Gold have an all-time record of 373-277.
- ASU boasts 30 All-Americans and have had at least one all-american in 18 straight seasons.

AROUND THE GLOBE

- The team has talent from all over the world, coming from six different countries totaling ten athletes. The countries are the Netherlands, Hungary, New Zealand, Spain, Canada, and Australia.
- Two freshmen represented their respective countries at the World Aquatics Women's U18 World Championships this past fall. Itziar Almeda took home gold, notching 16 goals throughout the tournament to help solidify the win for Spain. Keri Glad represented the United States and finished in fourth.

LOCAL TALENT

Ashley Byron is from Chandler, Arizona and attended Corona Del Sol High School, seven miles from Tempe. She is the first Arizona native to rep the Maroon and Gold in program history.

MILESTONE MOMENTS

 Millie Quin finished the weekend with twelve goals and four assists, officially surpassing 150 career points. Sophie Shorter-Robinson surpassed 100 career points, scoring fourteen goals between the four matches.
 She leads the team in goals scored.

FRESHMAN PHENOM

Spaniard Itziar Almeda immediately made a splash this past weekend. She played in all four games, notching at least one goal and one assist in every game. In the Saturday slate, she had three goals and four assists versus Cal Lutheran while she secured another two goals and three assists against No. 23 SDSU. On Sunday, she earned four goals and four assists against UC Davis and Cal Baptist. She scored nine goals and 11 assists for a total of 20 points for the weekend.

2025 LOOK AHEAD

- Arizona State will host 12 home matches in Tempe along with a three-game home stand in March against fellow conference foes before two road MPSF matches.
- The Sun Devils will take part in five tournaments this year, two in Tempe, two in California, and one in the state of Hawaii.
- The postseason begins April 25-April 27 at the MPSF Tournament in Los Angeles, California.

BIO BLAST:

Petra Pardi was announced as head coach of Sun Devil Water Polo on May 18. 2022 and is an alumnae of the program and a two-time Arizona State graduate. Pardi ranks among the top of the

Sun Devil record books, for goals scored (157), assists (71), and points (228). Pardi is one of 30 All-Americans in program history and served as team captain in her senior season. In August of 2018 she was promoted as assistant coach under Todd Clapper after earning her master's degree in Higher Edcucation Administration and being a graduate assistant upon returning to ASU in 2016. Pardi was part of the 2014 NCAA tournament team, and was an assistant for the team that finished in third at the 2021 NCAA tournament. She played for the Hungarian national team and the youth, junior and senior levels before coming to Tempe.
