THE GAME - Sun Devil Football will wrap up the 2018 home slate this weekend at Sun Devil Stadium, taking on the UCLA Bruins on Saturday, Nov. 10. The game is scheduled for a 12 p.m. kickoff Arizona time and will be broadcast live on the Pac-12 Networks. On the call will be J.B. Long, Anthony Herron and Lewis Johnson. The game will be broadcast over the airwaves on ESPN 620 AM with the Voice of the Sun Devils, Tim Healey, on the call alongside analyst Jeff Van Raaphorst and sideline reporter Jordan Simone

ASU VS. UCLA - UCLA owns the all-time lead in the series, leading 20-13-1. However, 9 of those wins came before 1992 and ASU was just 1-9-1 against the Bruins in the first 11 games of the series history. Things have evened out dramatically since then, with the series sitting at 12-11 in ASU's favor since then. ASU has won 3 of the last 5 games in the series and 2 of the last 3. The Sun Devils will be looking to early a win over both Los Angeles schools for just the 5th time in program history (1986, 1996, 1999 and 2013).

SENIOR DAY - The Sun Devils will celebrate Senior Day in Tempe this weekend, and honor the team's outscoring seniors in their final games at Sun Devil Stadium. ASU has been largely successful in recent years in the final home game of the season, posting an 11-4 record overall in the last 15 years.

ASU will honor the following group of 16 Seniors prior to kickoff: OL Quinn Bailey, LB Koron Crump, LB Ochuko Duke, DB Cody French, DB Jalen Harvey, LB Jordan Hoyt, WR Ryan Jenkins, DB Demonte King, PK John O'Brien, H Josh Pokraka, OL Tyson Rising, DL Doug Subtly, DB Dasmond Tautalatasi, OL Casey Tucker, QB Manny Wilkins and DL Renell Wren.

AN ASU VICTORY WOULD...

- Give ASU 3 straight wins for the first time this season and the first time since opening the season 4-0 in 2016.
- Give ASU its third win over USC in the last four seasons and 4th win in the last 6.
- Be just the 5th time in program history that ASU beat both USC and UCLA in the same season.

No ASU running back has **lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 780 consecutive carries**, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 28 consecutive games. That includes 205 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only RBs on rushing plays and does not include receptions). The fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back. If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1,119 carries over 40 games (since 2015).

Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 130 straight games. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 73 of those games (56.2 percent). The Sun Devils are 30-8 at home since 2013 and are one of just 17 teams in the FBS to win 30 home games in that time frame.

At 1,113 rushing yards this year, Eno Benjamin is well on pace to have the best single season during the Pac-12 era for a Sun Devil running back, already within 116 yards of Ryan Torain's Pac-12-era school record of 1,229 yards for a season (2006). The Sun Devil school record is 1,565 yards - set by Woody Green in 1972. In the Pac-12 era, no ASU running back has finished in the Top-10 nationally in single-season rushing yards. Benjamin is currently 5th nationally at 1,113 yards. Darryl Clack (1984) and Mario Bates (1993) both finished 18th nationally - the highest for a Sun Devil Running back in the Pac-12 era.

N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 34 games of his career at Arizona State, tied for the 10th-longest active streak among all current FBS players. Harry is now in 3rd place in program history with 195 receptions. Harry is currently 6th in school history with 2,629 career receiving yards, within 100 yards of the top four all-time. With 22 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is tied for 5th in ASU school history in that category as well and needs just two more to move into fourth. Harry has at least one touchdown reception in 10 of last 14 games. He has 14 touchdown receptions in those 14 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career.

The Devils have 5 games this year without allowing a sack (UTSA, UW, OSU and USC). Since AT LEAST 2000, ASU had never had more than 2 games in a SEASON where it didn't allow a sack. ASU hasn't finished in Top-100 in fewest sacks allowed per game since 2011 (74th). In fact, since 2003 (as far back as easily accessible team rankings go), ASU has finished in the top-100 just 3 times, and never better than 70th. ASU is currently t-14th in FBS with 1.11 allowed per game. ASU's 10 sacks allowed this season are 15th nationally. A year ago, ASU finished 124th in the nation with 41 sacks allowed and 119th in 2016 with 41 sacks allowed as well.

Cohl Cabral is one of just 22 Power Five centers to **not allow a sack on the year** and is the 24th-highest graded center as a pass blocker in all of the FBS according to Pro Football Focus (81.7) and 33rd-highest graded center overall (70.0). Quinn Bailey is one of just 24 offensive tackles (that's played at least 50 percent of a team's snaps) on a Power Five team **to not allow a quarterback sack this season** and one of just 8 tackles in the Pac-12 to lay claim to such a feat.

1. @NkealHarry15 notes: First Sun Devil WR to catch 3 TD passes in a game since Devin Lucien vs. Cal in 2015; 22 TD receptions in career - tied for 5th in program history; 195 career receptions - 3rd in history; 2,629 receiving yards - 6th in history
2. Only 2 Pac-12 programs have a QB/RB/WR combination ranked in the Top-50 overall highest-graded @PFF_College Pac-12 Offensive Players: ASU (WR Harry/3rd; RB Benjamin/15th; QB Wilkins/16th) and WSU (QB Minshew/2nd; RB Williams/18th; WRs Winston/19th and Patman/23rd)
3. 1,119 carries | 40 games | 3+ years. That's how long it's been since a Sun Devil running back has lost a fumble on a conventional running play (not including Sparky formation or passing plays).
4. Among all freshmen (true or redshirt) playing in the Power Five this season, none have made more defensive stops this seasons than @Merlin_2 (27) - a total that's also good for 15th overall in the Pac-12.

6. Quinn Bailey is one of just 24 offensive tackles on a Power-5 team to not allow a QB sack this season. His 8 pressures allowed are 17th-fewest among Power-5 tackles and he's PFF's 45th-highest graded pass-blocking tackle among ALL tackles in the FBS this season (82.2).
7. ASU hasn't finished in Top 100 in fewest sacks allowed per game since '11 (74th). In fact, since '03 (as far back as easily accessible team rankings go), ASU finished in the top-100 just 3 times, never better than 70th. Currently t-14th in FBS with 1.11 allowed per game

FOCUSING ON FOOTBALL

- » Manny Wilkins is the 16th-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 (78.0), regardless of position and the third-highest quarterback in the league.
- » N'Keal Harry ranks in the Top-20 nationally in receiving touchdowns (9/8th), receiving yards (828/18th), receiving yards per game (92.0/19th) and total touchdowns (11/17th).
- » Eno Benjamin in the 15th-highest graded offense player in the Pac-12 - regardless of position - with a 79.3 score that leads all running backs in the league.
- » Cohl Cabral is one of just 22 Power Five centers to not allow a sack on the year and is the 24th-highest graded center as a pass blocker in all of the FBS according to Pro Football Focus (81.7) and 33rd-highest graded center overall (70.0).
- » Chase Lucas is the 24th-highest graded pass rushing corner in the FBS, scoring a 63.9 score as a pass rusher this year. He has five quarterback pressures this season, 3rd among FBS cornerbacks.
- » Darien Butler is the 35th-highest graded pass rushing linebacker in the country, logging a 68.6 score from Pro Football Focus.
- » Only 2 Pac-12 programs have a QB/RB/WR combination ranked in the Top-50 overall highest-graded Pro Football Focus Pac-12 Offensive Players: Arizona State (WR Harry/3rd; RB Benjamin/15th; QB Wilkins/16th) and Washington State (QB Minshew/2nd; RB Williams/18th; WRs Winston/19th and Patman/23rd).

DON'T CROSS THAT LINE

- » ASU is currently 12th nationally and first in the Pac-12 in averaging 7.98 tackles for loss per game this season.
- » The Sun Devils are 29th in the nation and third in the Pac-12 in sacks per game, averaging 2.67 per game thus far.
- » 21 players have logged a tackle for loss this season for ASU, making the Sun Devils one of just one of 14 teams nationally to lay such a claim. 12 different players have scored a sack.
- » ASU entered the season ranked fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU was sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.
- » ASU recorded nine sacks against UTSA, the most since the Sun Devils sacked the UCLA Bruins the same amount of times on Nov. 23, 2013. ASU recorded 15 tackles for a loss, the most since the Sun Devils recorded that same amount against Washington State on Oct. 30, 2010.

DON'T CROSS THAT ONE, EITHER

- » The Sun Devils have allowed just 22.4 points per game this season, good for 36th nationally and fourth in the Pac-12.
- » ASU did not allow more than 30 points in the first 7 games of the season, one of just 11 teams in the nation to do so in 2018. ASU has held opponents to 30 or less points in 8 of 9 games this season.
- » This was just the fifth season in the Pac-12 era that ASU has opened the year with seven consecutive games not allowing 30 points, joining the 1982, 1986, 1991 and 1997 campaigns
- » The Sun Devils defense did not allow a single point in the first quarter of games against non-conference opponents and haven't allowed one in six of nine games this year. ASU has allowed just 3.9 points per first quarters this season, good for 29th nationally. Last season, ASU allowed 6.7 first quarter points per game - the 82nd worst tally nationally.
- » The tough scoring defense has kept ASU in every game this season, with six games this year being decide by one possession - tied for the second-most in the FBS this year. Unfortunately, ASU has been on the wrong end of four of those games - one of just five teams in the nation to have lost at least four games by a touchdown or less this year (Eastern Michigan, Western Kentucky, Nebraska, Air Force).

HOLD ON TO THAT BALL

- » No ASU running back has lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 780 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 28 consecutive games. That includes 205 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only running backs on rushing plays and does not include running backs on receptions).

- » Of note on the above stat, the fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back (Kalen Ballage against UCLA in 2016). If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1,119 carries over 40 games, dating back to Utah in 2015.
- » ASU ranks tied for fourth nationally with only 7 turnovers this season. ASU is outscoring opponents 35-13 in points off turnovers this season.
- » The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers.

HE'S THE MANNY

- » Manny Wilkins is the 16th-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 (78.0), regardless of position and the third-highest quarterback in the league.
- » Wilkins currently sits at 7,849 career passing yards, good for fifth in Sun Devil football history. Wilkins will have a chance as moving into the Top 3 in ASU history (8,827 yards by Jake Plummer).
- » His 636 career completions are good for fourth in program lore while his 47 career touchdown passes are tied for 7th in program history.
- » Wilkins has 16 rushing touchdowns in his career, good for second among all ASU quarterbacks in school history behind only Mark Malone (21). He had seven touchdowns on the ground last season, becoming one of just 10 quarterbacks in the FBS last season to pass for at least 20 touchdowns with at least 7 rushing touchdowns as well.
- » Wilkins has accounted for 63 career touchdowns (47 passing and 16 rushing).
- » Wilkins holds a 103.3 NFL QB rating this season, according to Pro Football Focus, the 10th-best total among QBs with at least 300 dropbacks in the FBS.
- » The Sun Devil offense has scored a successful play (as graded by Pro Football Focus) on 39.1 percent of Wilkins' passing attempts this season - the 29th-best total among all quarterbacks in the FBS with 350+ snaps.
- » Wilkins has a 124.4 NFL passer rating when facing blitzing plays this season - the 5th-best total in the country.
- » Wilkins has just an 10.0 sack percentage (percentage of time sacked when under pressure) that sits as the 17th-lowest total in the nation.
- » Wilkins is 20th nationally in adjusted completion percentage (74.8 percent), which excludes QB spikes, throwaways, dropped passes and passes thrown while being hit.
- » Wilkins is one of just six quarterbacks in ASU history to win a game at the Los Angeles Coliseum and just the second one since 2000 (joining Mike Bercovici).

DIRTY HARRY

- » N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 34 games of his career at Arizona State, tied for the 10th-longest active streak among all current FBS players.
- » Harry is now in 3rd place in program history with 195 receptions.
- » Harry is currently 6th in school history with 2,629 career receiving yards, within 100 yards of the top four all-time.
- » At 5.74 receptions per game in his career, Harry is third among the NCAA's active career leaders in the category. His 77.3 career receiving yards per game are sixth among all active players.
- » With 22 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is tied for 5th in ASU school history in that category as well and needs just two more to move into fourth.
- » Harry has at least one touchdown reception in 10 of last 14 games. He has 14 touchdown receptions in those 14 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career.
- » Harry has a 146.6 NFL QB rating when targetted this season, good for third nationally among receivers that have logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets.
- » Harry has forced 14 missed tackles this season, which is good for 13th-most among all FBS receivers.
- » Harry posts an 84.4 overall grade from Pro Football Focus, the fourth-highest grade among Pac-12 offense regardless of position and 8th among all wide receivers nationally.



- » The junior ranks in the Top-20 nationally in receiving touchdowns (9/8th), receiving yards (828/18th), receiving yards per game (92.0/19th) and total touchdowns (11/17th).
- » Harry has played 606 snaps this season - 10th-most among all Power Five receivers.

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

- » Benjamin has forced 59 missed tackles this season (49 rushing, 10 receiving) - second among all FBS players in the category.
- » He has posted a for a 95.3 elusive rating from Pro Football Focus, good for 15th nationally.
- » Benjamin has forced a missed tackle 26.2 percent of the time - good for 12th nationally.
- » 37.8 percent of Benjamin's rushes this season have resulted in a "win" for the Sun Devil offense, the 21st-highest total among FBS running backs. 31.6 percent of his rushes have resulted in a first down or touchdown, the 18th-highest percentage in the FBS.
- » Benjamin's 24 explosive runs this season (runs for over 15 yards) are second nationally and his explosive run percentage of 12.2 percent is 5th in the FBS.
- » Benjamin is averaging 3.6 yards after contact per rush this season, the 19th-highest total nationally.
- » At 1,113 rushing yards this year, Eno Benjamin is well on pace to have the best single season during the Pac-12 era for a Sun Devil running back, already within 116 yards of Ryan Torain's Pac-12-era school record of 1,229 yards for a season (2006).
- » The Sun Devil school record is 1,565 yards - set by Woody Green in 1972 - a mark that will be worth keeping an eye on through the remainder of the season.
- » Mario Bates (1993) and J.R. Redmond (1999) are the only other running backs since 1978 to average over 100 yards per game in a single season. Benjamin is currently at 123.7 yards per game.
- » In the Pac-12 era, no ASU running back has finished in the Top-10 nationally in single-season rushing yards. Benjamin is currently 5th nationally at 1,113 yards. Darryl Clack (1984) and Mario Bates (1993) both finished 18th nationally - the highest for a Sun Devil Running back in the Pac-12 era.

NEVER ENO-OUGH

- » Eno Benjamin in the 15th-highest graded offense player in the Pac-12 - regardless of position - with a 79.3 score that leads all running backs in the league.
- » Benjamin set a single-game school rushing record with 312 yards against Oregon State, placing him eighth all-time on the Pac-12 conference single-game rushing list.
- » With his 47-yard rushing touchdown in the second quarter, Eno Benjamin set the school record for rushing yards in one half (185).
- » Benjamin's 312 yard performance was the most in the NCAA Division I FBS this season. Coming into the contest, Benjamin had only recorded 283 rushing yards this season and 425 rushing yards in his career.
- » His 339 all-purpose yards (312 RUSH, 27 REC), are the second-most in school history, falling just short of J.R. Redmond's 350 all-purpose yards in 1998 vs. USC (214 RUSH, 34 REC, 17 PR, 85, KOR).
- » Benjamin forced or avoided 20 missed tackles on carries against Oregon State, tying the Pro Football Focus single-game record for most missed tackles forced on runs by a running back. He had 177 yards after contact in the contest, averaging 5.9 yards after contact per play.

THE CHASE IS ON

- » Chase Lucas has made his presence felt all over the field and has been especially efficient in run defense, where he has made 18 solo tackles this season - tied for 7th among all FBS corners.
- » Lucas is the 24th-highest graded pass rushing corner in the FBS, scoring a 63.9 score as a pass rusher this year. He has five quarterback pressures this season, 3rd among FBS cornerbacks.
- » Lucas was named a freshman first-team all-American last season by the FWAA and second-team by USA Today.
- » Lucas earned Pac-12 Second Team honors at defensive back and was the only freshman to be named to either the Pac-12 First or Second teams last season and became the first

freshman to earn First or Second team honors on offense or defense since Oregon running back Royce Freeman earned Second Team offense honors in 2014 .He was the first Pac-12 freshman defensive back to make the First or Second teams since Brandon Browner did so for Oregon State back in 2003.

- » Despite being targeted more than any of the 23 Pac-12 corners that played at least 60 percent of snaps in the regular season (once every 4.6 passing plays), Lucas allowed the fifth-lowest completion percentage of any corner in the conference - regardless of year.

MAKE 'EM PAY

- » ASU has outscored opponents 622-341 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 67.1 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (104 of 155) while finding the end zone 79 times in that span (51.0 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 51.8 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (58 of 112) with 44 touchdowns (39.3 percent).

A HAND IN THE COOKIE JAR

- » ASU has 17 interception returns for touchdowns in the last seven seasons, good for third in the nation behind only Alabama (20) and Ohio State (17) in that time.
- » The Sun Devils have 94 interceptions in the last six seasons, ranked in the Top 10 nationally.
- » ASU has added four fumble return touchdowns as well for 21 defensive touchdowns since the 2012 season, good for fourth in the country in that time span behind Ohio State (27), Alabama (26) and Boise State (25).

KEEP THEM IN FRONT OF YOU

- » Renell Wren has scored a positive grade on 18.1 percent of his plays on running snaps, the 7th-highest percentage of all Pac-12 front-seven players this season. He is 34th nationally among all defensive interior linemen in the category.
- » Wren has the 7th-highest run defense score among Pac-12 interior defenders with a 76.6 grade from PFF.
- » Jalen Harvey has made 37 tackles within 8 yards of the line of scrimmage as a safety - the fourth-highest total among all safeties nationally.

LOCKING IT DOWN

- » ASU is tied for 11th nationally in allowing just 5 plays over 40 yards this season, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively). ASU is also tied for 3rd nationally in allowing just 1 play of over 50 yards on the year.
- » The Devils have given up just 12 plays over 30 yards, tied for 13th-fewest nationally. In the past four years ASU had given up 38, 44, 40, 40 such plays, ranked 116th, 124th, 117th and 119th.
- » ASU is tied for 8th nationally for fewest passing plays over 40 yards allowed this season, allowing just three. ASU was 90th in the category a year ago with 12 such plays allowed and 127th in 2016 with 22 passing plays over 40 yards allowed.

ON THE DEFENSE

- » The Sun Devils are third nationally in opponent starting field position (24.4 yard line) after ranking 91st nationally (29.6 yard line) a year ago.
- » ASU is 29th nationally in average opponent third-down distance (8.0 yards).
- » On those passing downs, opponents are averaging a marginal explosive tally of -0.16, according to Bill Connelly's advanced metrics, the 11th-best score nationally. ASU has recorded a sack 14.8 percent of the time on blitzing downs - the 15th-best total nationally.
- » A testament to ASU's ability to crack down on the big play, the Sun Devils are 26th nationally with a -0.06 defensive marginal explosiveness rating.
- » The defense has been exceptional in limiting scoring, logging in a 1.04 IsoPPP (points per play) score based on Connelly's metrics, the 20th-best total among FBS defenses. A year ago, ASU was 111th (1.17).
- » The Sun Devil defense causes havoc (tackles for loss, fumbles forced or passed defended/intercepted) 18.7 percent of the time - good for 26th nationally - and 2.5 points over the



nation average. ASU had just a 14.1% havoc rate last season (94th nationally).

- » ASU's defense has held opponents to just 2.50 points per possession on "short" field drives (drives that start with 60 or fewer yards to go to the end zone). That's the 13th-lowest total nationally. ASU was 64th a year ago in the category (3.35).

TAKING OFFENSE

- » ASU is sixth nationally in Offensive Ball Control Rate (drives that last 4 plays or more) - doing so 75.6 percent of the time.
- » The Devils are 18th nationally in Offensive First Down rate (drives that result in at least a single first down) with 79.3 percent of its drives resulting in at least one first down.
- » ASU has capitalized on short field position, scoring 4.45 points per drive when the possession STARTS within 60 yards of the opponent end zone - 17th nationally.
- » ASU's offense has been fairly successful when backed up against their own goal line, scoring a successful play 46.7 percent of the time - the 32nd-best total nationally.
- » ASU gets itself into manageable third-and-short situations 17.7 percent of the time (2nd nationally).
- » ASU only finds itself in third-and-long situations 39.5 percent of the time this season, good for the ninth-lowest total national. Its average third-down distance is 6.4 yards - the 11th best total in the country.

THE YOUTH MOVEMENT

- » Only three Pac-12 TRUE freshmen have played at least 450 defensive snaps this season and all of them play for Arizona State (Merlin Robertson/592, Darien Butler/479, Aashari Crosswell/491).
- » Robertson's 592 snaps are 101 more than any other true freshman in the league and the third-most among any Power Five true freshman in the country.
- » Robertson was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week for his performance against #16 Utah, becoming the first freshman offensive or defensive player to accomplish the task since 2010.
- » Among all true or redshirt freshmen playing for Power Five team in the country, none have more defensive stops than Robertson (27), also good for 15th overall in the Pac-12.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, there are just 21 3-4 outside linebackers to not miss a tackle on a running play this season that play at least 100 snaps on rushing plays - with Merlin Robertson being one of those.
- » Darien Butler is the 35th-highest graded pass rushing linebackers in the country, logging a 68.6 score from Pro Football Focus.
- » Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have accounted for 31 percent of all of ASU's tackles this season (183 of 591) and 43.4 percent of the team's total tackles for loss (30.5 of 70).

IN THE TRENCHES

- » ASU has now twice gone consecutive games without allowing a sack (Washington/Oregon State and USC/Utah). The last time ASU had consecutive games doing so even once in a season was 2005 (LSU and Northwestern).
- » The Devils now have 5 such games this year (UTSA, UW, OSU, USC and Utah). Since AT LEAST 2000, ASU had never had more than 2 games in a SEASON where it didn't allow a sack.
- » ASU's 10 sacks allowed this season are 15th nationally. A year ago, ASU finished 124th in the nation with 41 sacks allowed and 119th in 2016 with 41 sacks allowed as well.
- » ASU hasn't finished in Top-100 in fewest sacks allowed per game since 2011 (74th). In fact, since 2003 (as far back as easily accessible team rankings go), ASU has finished in the top-100 just 3 times, and never better than 70th. ASU is currently 114th in FBS with 1.11 allowed per game.
- » Cohl Cabral is one of just 22 Power Five centers to not allow a sack on the year and is the 24th-highest graded center as a pass blocker in all of the FBS according to Pro Football Focus (81.7) and 33rd-highest graded center overall (70.0).
- » Cabral has scored a positive run-blocking grade on 11.0 percent of his rushing snaps this season - the 18th-best percentage among FBS centers in the country and 3rd in the Pac-12.

- » Quinn Bailey is one of just 24 offensive tackles (that's played at least 50 percent of a team's snaps) on a Power Five team to not allow a quarterback sack this season and one of just 8 tackles in the Pac-12 to lay claim to such a feat.
- » Bailey's 8 pressures allowed are tied for 5th-fewest among Pac-12 tackles and 17th-fewest among Power Five tackles. He is Pro Football Focus' 45th-highest graded pass-blocking tackle among all tackles in the FBS this season (82.2).
- » Getting it done on the outside has been important also, as wide receiver Kyle Williams is the 11th-highest graded receiver in the FBS this season as a run-blocker (79.0).
- » Following the non-conference slate, ASU's run game efficiency from PFF was ranked 85th nationally (8th in Pac-12) with a play success rate of 32.9. During the Pac-12 slate, ASU is ranked 26th nationally (3rd in Pac-12) with a success rate of 38.0 (4 points above national avg).

GOLD RUSH

- » ASU has had a 100-yard rusher in 10 of its last 14 games dating back to last year (Demario Richard with 4 and Eno Benjamin with 6).
- » The last time that occurred was across the 1997 and 1998 campaigns, where ASU had 10 such performances over a 13-game span (last 6 of '97, 4 of 7 to open '98).
- » ASU had 27 rushing TDs last year as it reached 25 rushing touchdowns for the fourth time in the last six seasons. Those four times are notable as the Devils had just three previous seasons with at least 25 rushing touchdowns from 1980-2011 (1985, 1986 and 1996).
- » The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards five times in the last six seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011 and only eight times total over 30 years from 1981-2011.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, the Sun Devils had the 27th-highest graded rushing attack last season after having the 41st worst-graded attack in 2016.
- » ASU currently has the 19th-highest graded rushing attack of 2018, according to Pro Football Focus.

KEEPING MOMENTUM

- » Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 130 straight games. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 73 of those games (56.2 percent).
- » The Sun Devils have won at least seven games in four of the last six seasons, marking the first time ASU has done so in a six-year gap since doing it four straight times from 2004-07.
- » Prior to that, the last time ASU accomplished the feat was 1978-82, winning at least seven games four times in that five-year spread.
- » The Sun Devils are 30-8 at home since 2013 and are one of just 17 teams in the FBS to win 30 home games in that time frame.
