#### **UP NEXT**

The Sun Devil women's basketball team will make its first Pac-12 road trip of the season this weekend when it travels to Oregon for games at Oregon on Friday (8 p.m. MST/7 p.m. PST) and Oregon State on Sunday (1 p.m. MST/12 p.m. PST).

Despite having already played 15 games this season, the Sun Devils will be playing just their second and third true road games of the 2023-24 campaign. In fact, this will only be the third time this season ASU will be leaving the state of Arizona. Up to this point, ASU has played 10 games in Desert Financial Arena (its home arena), one away game at Grambling (Nov. 16) and four neutral site games: three at the Virgin Islands Paradise Jam (Nov. 23-25), the last time it played outside of its home state – and one game at Footprint Center in Phoenix.

Both the Sun Devils (8-7, 0-3 Pac-12) and Ducks (9-7, 0-3) will be in search of their first Pac-12 win on Friday. Washington State (11-5, 0-3) enters this weekend's games as the only other squad that has yet to claim a win in league play. Conversely, only three teams – No. 2 UCLA (14-0), No. 5 Colorado (13-1) and No. 8 Stanford – have won all three of their conference contests. With three other teams 2-1 (No. 9 USC, Cal, Arizona) and three more 1-2 (No. 19 Utah, Oregon State, Washington, the Sun Devils could quickly make up some ground in the Pac-12 standings with a pair of wins this weekend.

In last week's home losses to then-No. 15 Utah (58-41) and No. 5 Colorado, the Sun Devils displayed both the flashes of brilliance necessary for success in in the league and – with the team's health situation playing an increasingly bigger role in recent losses – the lulls on either side of the floor that can often make the difference between winning and losing.

ASU came through with an inspired defensive effort against Utah, holding the Utes (came into game No. 5 in the nation in scoring and No 1 in FG pct.) more than 33 points below their scoring average and nearly 16 points below their shooting percentage. ASU was not able to match Utah offensively as it scored in single digits in three of the four quarters. Jalyn Brown notched her fourth 20-point game of the season with a career-high 21 points while Adison Novosel came off the bench and knocked down a trio of 3-pointers.

In Sunday's loss to Colorado, Brown raised her game to a whole different level, scoring 35 points, the most by a Sun Devil in the 21st century and the highest single-game total by a player this season in a game contested between two Pac-12 teams. Although the Sun Devils outscored the Buffaloes 43-31 in the second half, they fell into too big of a hole earlier in the game (CU led by as many as 28 late in the first half) and dropped their third straight game.

In all of its recent losses, ASU has missed key personnel. Starting post Maggie Besselink has missed ASU's last four games and key offensive contributor Treasure Hunt has missed the last three; Jaddan Simmons did not start for the first time in her career (illness) vs. Santa Clara; starting guard Trayanna Crisp was injured less than five minutes into ASU's game vs. Utah.

#### SERIES NOTES VERSUS OREGON

- Oregon captured the both meetings last season 82-62 in Tempe and 77-48 in Eugene.
- Both of ASU's 2020-21 contests vs. Oregon were eventually canceled due to Covid-19 protocols. The first scheduled meeting of 2021-22 (Jan. 13, 2022) had to be postponed for the same reason.
- Nearly two years elapsed between meetings (Feb. 9, 2020 Feb. 1, 2022) when ASU and Oregon made up the initial postponement on Feb. 1, 2022 in Eugene, a game won by the Ducks 72-58. ASU evened the season series when it upset the No. 19 Ducks 55-49 on Feb. 6, 2022.
- On Jan. 10, 2020, the Sun Devils upset the second-ranked Ducks 72-66 in Tempe.

#### **RANKINGS OF NOTE (AS OF JAN. 11, 2024)**

- As a team, ASU leads the Pac-12 in FT attempts per game (20.13/50th in the nation) and is 2nd in FTs made per game (13.60), 4th in offensive rebounds per game (12.5) and turnover margin (+2.87), 5th in steals per game (8.5) and turnovers forced per game (16.67) and 6th in fewest turnovers per game (13.8).
- Jaddan Simmons is among the leaders in both the Pac-12 and the nation in free throws attempted (90/2nd in Pac-12/15th in the nation), free throws made (70/2nd in Pac-12/20th in the nation) and minutes per game (2nd in the Pac-12/35.41/35th in the nation). Simmons is also among the leaders in the Pac-12 in steals per game (7th/2.07) and FT pct. (14th/77.8) and 17th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.38).
- Jalyn Brown is 7th in the Pac-12 in scoring (16.0 ppg), 10th in FT pct (78.6) and 12th in FG pct. (44.6). In Pac-12 games, In Pac-12 games, Brown leads the league in scoring (25.0 ppg), is 3rd in FT pct. (94.1/16-17) and tied for 3rd in O-rebs (3.67 rpg).

#### WHAT TO LOOK FOR

- With a win on Friday, ASU would eclipse its win total from 2022-23 (8-20).
- ASU has had 5 players lead/tie for team lead in scoring: Jaddan Simmons (5x), Kadidia Toure (4x), Trayanna Crisp (4x), Jalyn Brown (4x), Treasure Hunt (1x).Brown's career-high 35 points vs. No. 5 Colorado on Jan. 7, represent the highest single-game point total by a Sun Devil this season.
- In the rebounding department, 8 Sun Devils have led/tied for the team lead: Journey Thompson (5x), Maggie Besselink (4x), Toure (3x), Simmons (3x), Mallory Miller (1x), Sandra Magolico (2x), Brown (2x), Hunt (1x) and Isadora Souza (1x). Toure's 14-rebound game vs. San Francisco (Nov. 13) represents the best rebounding game by a Sun Devil this season.
- On Dec. 20, Simmons (now with 1024 points) became the 25th Sun Devil to score more than 1000 points. In ASU's win over Fresno State (Dec. 20), Simmons had a career-high 8 assists with zero turnovers.
- In ASU's last 8 games, Brown (currently ASU's leading scorer/16.0 ppg) is averaging 19.9 ppg and is shooting 47.3 pct (62-131) from the floor and 86.2 percent from the line (25-29).
- Crisp scored a then-career high 17 points 2x in ASU's first seven games. She surpassed that with 18 points vs. GCU (Dec. 8). Crisp has scored in double figures in all but 3 games averaged 14.0 ppg in 4 games prior to Utah game in which she left early due to injury. During that stretch: led team in assists (2.75 apg) and was tied with J. Simmons for lead in steals (2.5 spg).
- ASU has allowed 13 or fewer points in a quarter 22x, including 7x in single digits.
- ASU scored a double-digit point total in each of the first 20 quarters of the season. Overall, it has scored in double figures in 48 of 60 quarters.



#### **ASU WITHOUT ALL-PAC-12 STANDOUT TYI SKINNER IN 2023-24**

Although the Sun Devil women's basketball team's overall health is a 180-degree difference from last season, the squad was dealt a tremendous blow when Natasha Adair announced Oct. 4, 2023 that senior guard Tyi Skinner would miss the 2023-24 season due to a knee injury.

Skinner, who last season earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention honors from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 recognition from media who cover the league, quickly established herself as one of top scorers in the Pac-12 and one of the most exciting players in the nation to watch in her first season in Tempe.

In 2022-23, Skinner scored 20 or more points 15 times, including a career-high 29 points on two occasions. A starter in all 28 games, Skinner went on to average 19.3 points per game, the most by a Sun Devil since the 1988-89 season. She concluded her first campaign in the Maroon and Gold among the leaders in the Pac-12 in points per game (19.3/2nd/27th in the nation), 3-pointers per game (2.43 per game/2nd), minutes per game (36.59/3rd/29th in the nation), free throws made (79/3rd) and attempted (91/4th), steals per game (1.71/5th), 3-point FG percentage (34.7/6th) and free throw percentage (78.1/8th).

#### IN CASE YOU ARE JUST JOINING US

- ASU has had a pair of season-best three-game winning streaks in 2023-24. It started 3-0 after home wins over UTSA (70-55/Nov. 6), Montana State (75-62/Nov. 10) & San Francisco (77-69/Nov. 13). In the first half of its first three wins, ASU averaged 45.3 points & hit 49.5 pct of its shots. In the win vs. UTSA, ASU tied last season's highest point total in a half on its way to a 49-23 halftime lead. Against Montana State (Nov. 30), ASU scored 30 points in the first quarter, representing the third time it has scored 30 or more points in a quarter under head coach Natasha Adair.
- In its first loss at Grambling State (Nov. 16), ASU scored 32 points and shot 38 pct. in the first half while allowing the Tigers to score 45 points. Down by as many as 17, ASU tied the game at 67-67 before the Tigers hit game-winning 3-pointer in final seconds.
- ASU responded with a 72-40 win over Idaho State. The Bengals' final point total represented the fewest given up by ASU since a 49-40 win over VCU on November 27, 2020.
- After dropping an 84-42 decision to Texas in its first game at the Virgin Islands Paradise Jam (Nov. 23), ASU once again rebounded with a 3-game winning streak. Less than 24 hours after the setback to Texas, ASU had to face a South Florida squad (Nov. 24) that entered the game among the Top 50 teams in the nation in rebounding margin (+10.8). ASU rose to the challenge and outrebounded the Bulls 38-32 in its 66-49 win. In its 77-69 win over High Point (Nov. 25), ASU shot 50 percent for the game, the first time it shot 50 percent or higher since a win at San Diego on Dec. 18, 2021. Brown had her first 20-point game, while Hunt just missed a double-double with season highs in points (19) and rebounds (game-high 8 boards).
- ASU made it three straight wins after a 76-66 triumph over Pacific (Dec. 1). Simmons scored 17 of her career-high 26 points in the 2nd half, including 8 points in the final 94 seconds while Brown contributed a career high-tying 20 points for the second straight game.
- The Sun Devils nearly came back from 14 down in the 4th quarter (got within 4 points 2x) before falling to Grand Canyon, 66-59 on Dec. 8. Simmons (20 points), Crisp (18 points) and Brown (16 points) scored all but five of ASU's points. ASU was without Hunt (illness) in the loss.
- ASU dropped consecutive games for the first time this season after falling to Arizona 91-52 in the Pac-12 opener for both teams. The Wildcats got off to a fast start that eventually enabled them to take a 52-24 lead at the half.
- ASU got back on the winning track scoring a season high in an 80-76 win over Fresno State as part of the Jerry Colangelo Hall of Fame Series

Toure scored 12 of her career high-tying 22 points in the second half while Brown continued her streak of scoring in double figures in games she has started (eight) with 20 points. Crisp scored 12 points while Simmons and Thompson (careerhigh four steals) scored 10 points each. ASU shot 49 percent for the game, its second-highest mark of the season. Simmons, who went over 1,000 career points in the fourth quarter of the win, set a career high with eight assists and hit a pair of free throws with six seconds remaining to help clinch the win.

- The short-handed Sun Devils nearly came back from a double-digit deficit but in the end did not have enough to get over the hump in 65-55 loss to Santa Clara (Dec. 30). Crisp and (12 points), Simmons (11 points) and Toure (10 points) led the way for the Sun Devils (8-5), who were without key contributors Maggie Besselink and Treasure Hunt. The Sun Devils trailed by as many as 12 in the first half before transforming their defense into a riddle Santa Clara had no answers for during the latter stages of the first half and for the entire third quarter. The net result was a game tied at 44-44 entering the fourth quarter. Santa Clara outscored ASU 21-11 in the 4th Q.
- ASU came through with one of its most inspired defensive efforts of the season in holding one of the most prolific offenses in the country more than 30 points below its scoring average. Unfortunately, ASU was not able to do enough on the offensive end in a 58-41 loss to No. 15 Utah on Friday night.
- Brown scored 35 points, the most by a Sun Devil in the 21st century and the highest single-game total by a player this season in a game contested between two Pac-12 teams, in ASU's 81-68 loss to No. 5 Colorado on Jan. 7.

- Missed games vs. San Francisco (Nov. 13) & at Grambling State (Nov. 16) before returning in reserve role vs. Idaho State (Nov. 19).

- Has not played since ASU's contest vs. High Point (Nov. 25).

#### #44 • Isadora Sousa • G • 6-0 • Grad. • Sao Paulo, Brazil

- Has played in 34 games with 10 starts in her three seasons with the Sun Devils.
- Has worked hard to come back from injury each of her three seasons and has proven to be an effective performer when on the floor.
- Made her 2023-24 debut vs. Arizona (Dec. 17) and played 9 minutes. Did not play vs. Fresno State (Dec. 20) but started ASU's game vs. Santa Clara (Dec. 30) and scored 7 points and had 3 rebounds in 19 minutes.
- Posted career highs in points (10) and steals (3) vs. No. 5 Colorado (Jan. 7).
- In 2022-23, scored a career high-tying points in consecutive games (at Stanford/Dec. 31 and at Cal/Jan 2) and had the second highest field goal percentage on the team, shooting 44.8%.
- Missed first 10 games due to injury before playing in first game of 2023-24 vs. Arizona (Dec. 17).

#### **RECAPPING THE 2022-23 SEASON**

- Even with all its injuries, ASU nearly pulled off three Top 25 upsets in the season's final five games: vs. No. 21 Colorado (62-70), vs. No. 4 Utah (69-74) and vs. No. 19 UCLA (70-81-OT) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. After trailing the Bruins by as many as 19 points in the third quarter, the Sun Devils staged a furious rally to take a two-point lead in regulation before falling in overtime. The win would have been ASU's biggest comeback in school history.

- In their 75-73 win at Oregon State, the Sun Devils overcame their second-largest deficit in school history (17 points). The victory was also No. 175 of Adair's career.
- Individually, Sun Devil guards Jaddan Simmons (Pac-12 All-Defense honorable mention) and Tyi Skinner (All-Pac-12 honorable mention) comprised one of the most talented backcourts in the country. Both players earned Pac-12 honors as voted on by the league's head coaches. Skinner, who finished second in the Pac-12 and 27th in the nation in scoring (19.2 ppg), was also named to the media's 15-member All-Pac-12 team.

# **HEAD COACH NATASHA ADAIR**



- •On March 27, 2022, Natasha Adair was introduced as the new head coach of Sun Devil Women's Basketball.
- •Adair, who brought 10 seasons of head coaching experience to ASU, came to Tempe after five seasons at Delaware where she compiled a 95-58 record, including a 48-13 record in her final two seasons.
- •In 2021-22, Adair's final season at Delaware, the Blue Hens captured the program's third Colonial Athletic Association tournament title and earned their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in nearly a decade.
- •In 2021, Adair was named the CAA's Coach of the Year for a season in which she guided Delaware to its first regular season conference championship since 2013.
- Prior to her five seasons at Delaware, Adair also had successful head coaching stints at College of Charleston (two seasons) and Georgetown (three seasons).
- Despite a spate of unlucky injuries to key personnel, the Sun Devils had several noteworthy accomplishments during Adair's inaugural season in Tempe, including: Starting 5-0 for the first time since 2002-03; Finishing the season No. 2 in the Pac-12 and 10th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (12.3/only ASU's 2017-18 squad averaged fewer turnovers per game (11.7) in a season; Even with all its injuries, ASU nearly pulled off three Top 25 upsets in the season's final five games: vs. No. 21 Colorado (62-70), vs. No. 4 Utah (69-74) and vs. No. 19 UCLA (70-81-OT) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament; After trailing the Bruins by as many as 19 points in the third quarter, the Sun Devils staged a furious rally to take a two-point lead in

Skinner, who finished second in the Pac-12 and 27th in the nation in scoring (19.2 ppg), was also named to the media's 15-member All-Pac-12 team.

- •In addition to the 2021-22 team (NCAA Tournament), Adair's leadership while at Delaware was instrumental in the 2017-18 (WNIT) and 2020-21 (WNIT) squads earning postseason appearances. Playing a big role in Delaware's success in Adair's final two seasons as head coach was the Blue Hens' resiliency on the offensive glass as they finished among the top three teams in the nation in offensive rebounding in 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- •Under Adair's tutelage, three Delaware student-athletes earned Player of the Year honors, two were named Rookie of the Year and multiple players collected All- Conference honors.
- •In recent years, Adair has taken on an increasingly prominent role within USA Basketball. In 2017, she was appointed as the U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach. In 2018, Adair was a speaker at USA Basketball's Las Vegas Coach Academy. In 2018 and 2019, Adair earned gold medals while serving as an assistant coach for the USA teams that won the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.
- •Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned a four-win Hoyas program into a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, Georgetown finished the 2016-17 campaign with 17 wins, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12 and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.
- •In only her second season at Georgetown, Adair helped the Hoyas experience a 180-degree turnaround as they finished 16-14 the third-best NCAA DI turnaround in 2015-16 and made the program's first postseason appearance since 2012.
- •While at Georgetown, Adair coached a Big EAST Rookie of the Year, two players who were named to the league's All- Rookie team and pair of All-Conference standouts.
- •Adair's first head coaching job was at College of Charleston, where (35-31 overall in two seasons). She was the first coach to lead the program to consecutive postseason appearances.





# **HEAD COACH NATASHA ADAIR**

- •In 2013-14, Adair's second season and the Cougars' first in the Colonial Athletic Association, Adair guided College of Charleston to a record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.
- •In her first season at College of Charleston, Adair led the Cougars to 16 wins and a WBI postseason bid. Her first squad broke 22 school records along the way.
- While leading the College of Charleston, Adair coached two all-conference players and an all-rookie team performer who would go on to be named a three-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year.
- •Adair previously spent 14 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with eight years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor five WNBA draft picks and several players who went on to play professionally overseas.
- A founding member of the Black Coaches United, Adair has been recognized by the organization, as well as Advancement of Blacks in Sports (ABIS), as one of the top women's basketball coaches in the country. Adair prides herself on being known as a game-changer as it



relates to social justice and creating a safe space for athletes to find and use their voice; where she was a guest on ESPNW's "Around the Rim" with LaChina Robinson and Delaware's UD Winning Women in Athletics: Trailblazers and Changemakers Webinar Series.

- •Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990- 92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994.
- Coach Adair has two children, a son Aaron M. Adair (26), graduated magna cum laude from Johnson C. Smith University. A four-year member of the university's President's Council for his academic achievement, he also earned four letters playing for the men's basketball team. Daughter Allyssa M. Adair (18) is a freshman at Texas State University and a middle blocker on the volleyball team.
