SUN DEVIL REWIND

This past weekend, senior forward **JOHNNY WALKER** reached his 100th career point with an assist on senior forward **JAMES SANCHEZ**'s goal in the first period of Sunday's game. Since his return, **WALKER** has scored in three consecutive games, totaling seven points (3G-4A). With four goals on the weekend, freshman forward **MATTHEW KOPPERUD** leads the nation in goals scored (12) and is tied for second in points (18).

On Sunday afternoon, sophomore netminder **JUSTIN ROBBINS** got his first collegiate start and win with 26 saves for the Sun Devils. Before suffering a season-ending injury in 2019-20, **ROBBINS**' last appearance came in relief on Oct. 12, 2019 at Minnesota State.

ASU's special teams has shown massive improvement over the course of the season. The Sun Devil penalty killing unit has negated 10-straight penalties dating back to the last game against Ohio State. After starting the season 3-for-36 through the first 11 games, the Sun Devil power play has displayed its offensive capabilities with at least one goal in five consecutive games, three of which included multiple goals. **KOPPERUD** continued his man-advantage streak with two power-play goals in each game against the Irish.

WE MEET AGAIN

The Badgers (6-6-0) made headlines last weekend as they were the first and only team to have handed the Golden Gophers a loss this season. They went on to split the series, but managed to get three goals against the No. 1 ranked team, a feat which has only been done once before this season when the Sun Devils netted four goals the week prior.

Sophomore forward Cole Caufield, the 2019 15th-overall pick, leads Wisconsin offensively with 14 points (7G-7A). ASU is currently the only team to hold Caufield to zero points in a series, as he has recorded at least one point in every other game this season. The Badgers will have 2020 14th-overall pick Dylan Holloway back in their lineup after missing eight games while World Junior camp with Team Canada. Holloway has only played four games this season tallying two points (0G-2A).

Netminder Robbie Boudoun, a Michigan Tech graduate transfer, has held most of the time in the back end for the Badgers with 11 starts out of 12 games, played posting a .904 save percentage and 3.34 goals against average.

SUN DEVIL TWEETABLES

1. @SunDevilHockey is one of the least penalized teams in the country this year, averaging just 2.94 penalties per game for the third-lowest in the NCAA.
2. @SunDevilHockey has killed 10-straight penalties dating back to the Ohio State series.
3. Since the Michigan series, @SunDevilHockey ranks 2nd in scoring (4.00 g/gp) among all teams who have played at least eight games or more.
4. After ranking near the bottom early in the season, the power play now ranks 21st at 21.6% and the 2nd-best since the last time ASU and Wisconsin met.
5. After being one of the least experienced teams in college hockey in recent years, ASU is T7th for most upperclassmen and T4th for most seniors.

RETURN OF WALKER

- Senior forward **JOHNNY WALKER**, who entered the 2020-21 season as the active leader in goals scored in the NCAA, finally returned to the lineup at Minnesota after missing 10-straight games with an injury suffered in game two of the season at Michigan.
- After limited minutes in game one against the Gophers, **WALKER** returned to the top line and wasted no time making his presence felt with a highlight-reel, lacrosse-style goal -- made famous by Mike Legg at Michigan and Andrei Svechnikov of the Carolina Hurricanes -- to put the Sun Devils up 3-2 in the 2nd period. The play made for SportsCenter’s top play of the day on Monday. The goal was **WALKER**’s first of the season, and he managed several additional scoring chances on Monday night.
- Since his return, **WALKER** has tallied seven points over the last three games.

MAKING EARLY IMPACT

- Since the start of the season, four of the Sun Devils’ six freshmen have seen significant playing time. Goaltender **COLE BRADY**, who recently departed the team due to non-COVID related sickness, has also seen nearly half the starts before his departure.
- Two of the Sun Devils’ top three in points are freshman, including **KOPPERUD** at the top with 18 points and Detroit Red Wings’ draft pick **RYAN O’REILLY** with 10 points. They rank 1st and T-11th in total points among NCAA freshmen.
- With 12 games to go, **KOPPERUD** is six points shy of the Sun Devil record for points by a freshman (24 set by **JOHNNY WALKER** in 2017-18).

POPULAR DESTINATION

- The Sun Devils have fallen fortunate to transfers since the program transitioned to Division I, including players like Dylan Hollman, Robbie Baillargeon, Wade Murphy and David Norris.
- In 2019-20, forwards **JAMES SANCHEZ** (Michigan) and **WILLIE KNIERIM** (Miami) made immediate impacts in their junior seasons. **SANCHEZ** led the entire team and became the first player in program history to reach 40 points in a season, while **KNIERIM** contributed 15 goals and was 5th in scoring for the Devils.
- While **CHRIS GRANDO** (Boston College) came in a season ago and had to sit out during the 2019-20 season due to transfer rules, he joins **SEAN DHOOGHE** (Wisconsin) and **TANNER HICKEY** (Alabama-Huntsville) -- all of which were key contributors to their respective programs before transferring -- as the 2020-21 transfers hoping to contribute to the Maroon & Gold transfer reputation.

DEVILS IN THE PROS

- Former netminder Joey Daccord, who helped catapult the program to its first NCAA Tournament berth, recently signed a three-year, two-way extension with the Ottawa Senators. Daccord was not only the first Sun Devil to sign an NHL contract, but play in the NHL as he made his debut on April 4, 2019. He was also the first Sun Devil committed to the program when getting drafted.
- This past season, senior defenseman Brinson Pasichnuk became the program’s second player to sign an NHL contract and first to sign a free agent deal. Pasichnuk signed with the San Jose Sharks for two years back in June.
- Most recently in August, rising junior Josh Maniscalco signed a three-year free agent deal with the Pittsburgh Penguins and has recently received an invite to training camp. Maniscalco recorded 11 goals and 21 assists last year and was ranked 6th among national defensemen in scoring.

WE GOT THE POWER(S)

Coach Powers enters his sixth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2020-21, and his 13th overall at the helm at ASU. The two-time finalist for the Spencer Penrose National Coach of the Year led the program to its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2018-19 and were on track for a repeat appearance in 2019-20 before COVID-19 ended the season. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their first-ever ACHA Division I National Championship. He holds a 240-127-29 career record at ASU.

Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers’ four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.

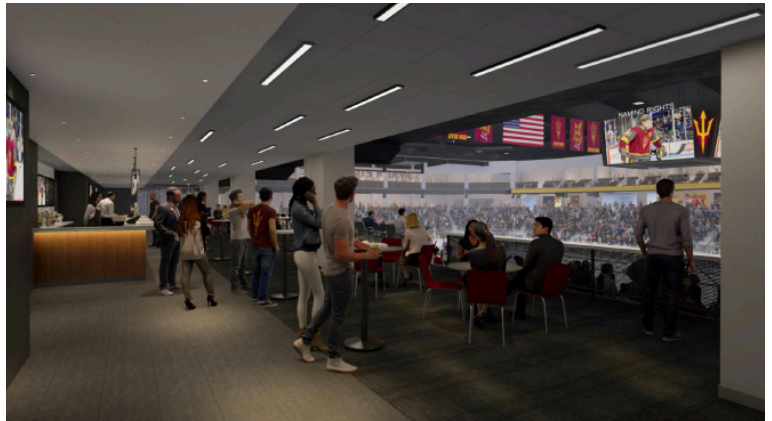

BREAKING GROUND

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received for the commencement of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve as the future home for Sun Devil men's ice hockey, wrestling and women's gymnastics. This project continues the development of the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado Parkway on the east side of Packard Drive, immediately north of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction is scheduled to begin in January 2021, with full completion projected for December 2022.
- The 5,000-seat venue will be managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for the Multi-Purpose Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- A 942-seat student section will occupy the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the north side of the arena. Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
