The Arizona State Sun Devils (10-12; 3-6) travel to Oregon to face the No.13 Oregon Ducks on Thursday, Feb. 2, at 8 p.m. PT with Aaron Goldsmith and Casey Jacobsen on the Fox Sports 1 call and then head to Corvallis for a Saturday 3 p.m. PT tilt against the Oregon State Beavers, with Guy Haberman and Eldridge Recasner on the call for the Pac-12 Network. Tim Healey and Kyle Dodd have the call on the Sun Devil Sports Radio Network, presented by MidFirst (98.7 FM on Thursday). ASU makes its first trip to Oregon since Jan. 8-10, 2015, as the teams face each other only one time this year and last.

FINAL FOUR REMINDER: ASU and Glendale/Phoenix host the 2017 Final Four, the first Final Four held west of Texas since Seattle in 1995. It will be held at University of Phoenix Stadium, home of the Arizona Cardinals. The 2017 Final Four also marks the 25th anniversary of Bobby Hurley earning 1992 MOP.

NOTES VS. DUCKS: ASU is 7-7 against the Ducks in past 14 meetings...the Ducks and ASU split a pair in 2013-14, but Oregon swept the series in 2014-15 and then won the lone meeting last year 91-74 in Tempe... ASU is 8-10 against UO in past 10 years, going 3-6 in Eugene, 5-3 in Tempe and 0-1 in the Pac-10 Tournament.

NOTES VS. BEAVERS: ASU has won six of the past nine and 12 of the past 15 in the series...ASU and OSU meet for the 86th time with the Sun Devils holding a narrow 43-42 edge in the series...the teams split last year with ASU winning 86-68 in Tempe (Jan. 28) and Oregon State winning 75-66 in the Pac-12 Tournament (Mar. 9)...ASU shot .593 (32-of-54) in the win, 22-of-61 (.361) in the loss.

QUICK HITTERS: The 81.7 points per game posted by ASU is its best since the 1997-98 squad averaged 84.5, as ASU ranks second in the Pac-12 in scoring and third in free throw shooting (.748). ASU is averaging just 11.0 turnovers (third in the league) and 9.9 three-pointers made, second in the Pac-12.

SEASON RESET: ASU zig-zagged across North America three times (Orlando, Bahamas and New York City) and got solid road wins at San Diego State (Dec. 10) and Stanford (Dec. 30)...Sun Devils returned two starters (Tra Holder and Obi Oleka) and four total lettermen from last year that posted eight wins against top-100 RPI teams in Bobby Hurley's first season...<u>four players average at least 13 ppg...five players average at least 28 minutes...Obi Oleka is one of four Pac-12 players averaging a double-double (13.1 ppg./10.6 rpg.)...Obi leads the league in double-figure rebounding games with 15 and is averaging 14.2 points and 11.5 rebounds in the past 13 games.</u>

2,162 POINTS IN BACKCOURT: Junior Tra Holder moved past the 1,000-point mark at UCLA on Jan. 19 with 22 points as he is the 36th member of the Sun Devil 1,000-point club. <u>ASU now has a backcourt with two 1,000-point scorers</u>, as Shannon Evans has 1,093 career points, 754 of them coming in 62 games at Buffalo.

FREE THROW THREE-DOT DATA: The Sun Devils are making free throws at a rate that is third-best in school history (345-of-461/.748) from the charity stripe. ASU shot .756 in 1977-78 and .754 in 1954-55 for its best seasons...ASU went 12-of-12 in the second half of a tight road win at San Diego State on Dec. 10 and was 16-of-18 for the game...junior Tra Holder is 331-of-448 (.739) from the charity stripe in his 86 games... Shannon Evans II made his first 20 free throws to start the season. He 259-of-317 (.817) from the free throw line in his career...Obi Oleka is 145-of-196 (.740) from the free throw line in his career.
