SCOUTING THE SUN DEVILS

The Arizona State men's hockey team (2-4-0) continues its four-game home stand at Mullett Arena against Colorado College (2-2-0) on Friday and Saturday, October 21-22. Puck drop for both games will be at 7 p.m. MST and both games of the second weekend in Tempe are free to stream on the Pac-12 Insider.

In last weekend's inaugural games at Mullett Arena, the Sun Devils split the two-game series against Colgate. In Friday's home opener, Scottsdale native and team captain Josh Doan scored the first-ever goal in Mullett Arena and junior forward Ryan Reilly had his first goal of the season in a 2-0 win over the Raiders.

Also in Friday's win, sophomore goaltender TJ Semptimphelter recorded his second career shutout after playing in just his fifth game as a Sun Devil. His 225 saves so far this season are the most in the NCAA through six games.

Doan and Lukas Sillinger lead the team with four points apiece with Robert Mastro Simone, Jack Jensen and Ethan Szmagaj each close behind with three points.

ASU faced Colorado College six times since the 2017-18 season and leads the series 3-2-1 and split last season's dual played in Colorado Springs back in December 2021. The Tigers came up short against St. Lawrence in Canton, N.Y. last weekend but opened the season at home with two wins over Alaska Anchorage. Last season, Colorado College went 4-13-2 on the road and they're on the road for the second time this season when they come to Tempe.

QUOTES

HEAD COACH GREG POWERS

- **On feeling like the building is “home”:** “It still has an almost too good to be true feel to it. It’s feeling more and more like our building every day. We know it’s our building, but it’s going to take awhile. We didn’t get a training camp in here, so it’s going to take some reps and getting used to this place, getting used to how we’re going to use it to our advantage, and most importantly we have to get used to having 5,000 people behind us. It was really cool and we’re disappointed that we didn’t give them much to cheer for on Saturday, so the guys are eager and really urging to go out and get these people excited on Friday night.”
- **On what the team can do to finish:** “Just what we did today. Simplify. Get more pucks to the net. Get bodies to the net. You get in the goalie’s eyes and that’s how you have to get some ugly ones to get going and we haven’t scored very many pretty goals yet. A lot of our goals are just pucks and bodies at the net. We’re averaging two goals a game, and that’s the biggest reason why the record is not flipped. We’re not putting the puck in the net enough. You can’t force goals. Guys are just going to grip their sticks even tighter when you come down on them for not really finishing and bearing down, so we just have to simplify getting more pucks and bodies to the net. That’s what we worked on today, and we’ll continue to preach all week.”

SOPHOMORE DEFENSEMAN TY MURCHISON

- **On the importance of this weekend versus Colorado College:** “It’s a big one. We definitely need to sweep this weekend. They’re a solid team but I think we definitely have the better team and that we can do it so hopefully it sets us off on a good trajectory and leads us to a better half of the season.”

POPULAR DESTINATION

- The Sun Devils have fallen fortunate to transfers since the program transitioned to Division I, including alumni players Colin Theisen, Sean Dhoooghe, Willie Knierim, James Sanchez, and Jack Becker.
- This year the ASU roster is completed with the addition of **TJ SEMPTIMPHELTER, ROBERT MASTROSIMONE, LUKAS SILLINGER, TY JACKSON, and DYLAN JACKSON.**
- The roster is supported by four upperclassmen transfers: **ROBERT MASTROSIMONE** (Boston University) achieved career highs during the 2021-22 season, **LUKAS SILLINGER** (Bemidji State) finished third in the Beavers point scoring last season, and **TY** and **DYLAN JACKSON** (Northeastern) played in a combined 78 games in two years for the Huskies.
- Up-and-coming netminder **TJ SEMPTIMPHELTER** adds elite skill to an area that needed depth in 2021-22. In his freshman season at Northeast, Semptimphelter ‘wowed’ between the pipes during the Beanpot.

DEVILS IN THE PROS

- Former student-athletes Colin Theisen and Jacob Wilson competed in the AHL following their collegiate careers in Spring 2022. Both were invited to their respective NHL training camps within the Arizona Coyotes and Boston Bruins organizations this fall.
- Former netminder Joey Daccord, who helped catapult the program to its first NCAA Tournament berth, was selected by the Seattle Kraken in the 2021 NHL Expansion Draft. Daccord was not only the first Sun Devil to sign an NHL contract (Ottawa Senators), but play in the NHL as he made his debut on April 4, 2019. He was also the first Sun Devil committed to the program when getting drafted.
- Defenseman Brinson Pasichnuk became the program’s second player to sign an NHL contract and first to sign a free agent deal. Pasichnuk signed with the San Jose Sharks for two years back in June 2020. He appeared in four NHL games with the Sharks and 32 games with AHL affiliate San Jose Barracuda, notching a goal and seven assists.
- In August 2020, Josh Maniscalco signed a three-year free agent deal with the Pittsburgh Penguins and is immediately considered a top-10 prospect within the organization. Maniscalco recorded 11 goals and 21 assists last year and was ranked 6th among national defensemen in scoring.

WE GOT THE POWER(S)

Coach Powers enters his eighth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2022-23, and his 15th overall at the helm at ASU. He was a finalist for the 2019 and 2020 Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the Division I Coach of the Year. Coach Powers was also named the 2018-19 Frank Kush Sun Devil Coach of the Year, as voted on by the 26 head coaches at Arizona State. On July 7, 2022, Arizona State University and Greg Powers agreed to a five-year contract extension through the 2026-27 season. In 2021-22, Powers led ASU to five-straight wins versus USCHO.com Top-20 opponents in 2021-22 for the first time in program history (the previous record for consecutive wins against ranked opponents was three-straight games). In 2021-22, the team boasted three of the top-10 scorers in the nation in Colin Theisen, Matthew Kopperud and Josh Doan. ASU scored 116 goals in 35 games for a 3.31 goals per game average, ranked No. 10 in the country. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their first-ever ACHA Division I National Championship. Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers’ four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.

ASU'S FIRST WIN IN MULLETT VS. COLGATE



BREAKING GROUND

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received for the commencement of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve as the future home for Sun Devil men's ice hockey and wrestling. This project continues the development of the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado Parkway on the east side of Packard Drive, immediately north of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction began in January 2021 and received its certificate of occupancy on Friday, September 30, 2022.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the north side of the arena. Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
- On February 14, 2022, ASU and the NHL's Arizona Coyotes formed the first agreement of its kind between a college and NHL team in 100 years. The last time an NCAA college team and an NHL team shared an arena was the Boston Bruins and Boston University from 1924-28 at Boston Arena, now known as Matthews Arena. Other improvements will now be made, at the Coyotes' expense, to prepare the arena to temporarily house Coyotes home games. These improvements include constructing coaches' rooms, equipment rooms, technology and other aspects of the new ASU arena according to NHL standards. The added cost is up to \$19.7 million, which will be paid in advance by the Coyotes.
- The 5,000-seat venue is managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for the Multi-Purpose Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- A 942-seat student section will occupy the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.
- ASU played its first game in Mullett Arena on Oct. 14, 2022 against Colgate in front of a 5,029 sold out crowd. ASU won 2-0.
