Sun Devils Open 2017 at Iowa State Friday, Home vs Cal Poly Sunday

TEMPE, Ariz.—The Sun Devils open 2017 at Iowa State Friday at 5:30 pm MT before returning home for the first time in almost two months to host Cal Poly on Sunday in the Pac-12 opener (2 pm MT). This weekend starts the Devils' dual schedule in earnest after several tournaments over the last two months.

Fans are encouraged to wear GOLD, one of ASU's primary colors, as Sunday's match has been designated a "Gold Out".

SUCCESS AT MIDLANDS

The Sun Devils continued their comeback into national prominence with a third place finish at the 54th Annual Ken Kraft Midlands Championships, their best finish as a team since winning the tournament in 1989.

Zahid Valencia (174), who is still undefeated on his career, and Tanner Hall (HWT) won individual weight class titles, marking the first time since 1996 the Devils have had multiple champions, just the fourth time in program history. Hall and Valencia became the 13th and 14th all-time individual winners for ASU, and the first since Eric Larkin in 2001.

Additionally, Anthony Valencia and Josh Shields each finished third, the first time

Green Match Facts/Figures

PURPOSE

To promote Sun Devil athletics' green initiatives while driving fan awareness of sustainability and its best practices. Arizona State University was the first school in the country to offer a degree in sustainability and the University prides itself on being a national leader in the sector. Sun Devil Athletics green games will leverage the high-profile platform of athletics events to inform our fan base and highlight sustainable practices.

SUSTAINABILITY INITIATIVE AT ASU

Sustainability is one of the pillars of Arizona State University, and Sun Devil Athletics prides itself with aligning the department to minimize its carbon footprint. Athletics provides a unique opportunity to promote sustainability at our University, and Sun Devil Athletics has fully embraced the opportunity to advance sustainable practices as an institution and with our fans.

In June of 2016, USG and NACDA named Arizona State the most sustainable athletics department for its innovative and creative sustainable practices. Basketball's Weatherup Center has the distinction of being named the first athletic practice facility in the nation to become LEED-certified. Wells Fargo Arena became the first installed and operational LED-lit Power Five athletic facility, increasing lighting by 25 percent and increasing energy consumption by 75 percent. Additional, ASU boasts the most solar panels out of any university in the country to harness the Valley's 300-plus days of sunshine.

ZERO WASTE

Help Sun Devil Athletics achieve Zero Waste by composting and recycling your waste at events. By recycling and composting, Arizona State is not sending trash to the landfill but reusing and repurposing materials to help the environment. Look for the BLUE and GREEN bins to help participate in ASU's Zero Waste program. Use #ZeroWasteASU and #GreenGameASU to help bring awareness to the issue.

SUSTAINABILITY FACTS

- The average American uses 700 lbs. of paper a year. That's equal to approximately 465 trees per person.
- Plastic takes 450 years just to BEGIN to decompose. Every single piece of plastic ever created has not even started to decompose.
- Did you know you can recycle bottles into clothes? It only takes 25 recycled plastic bottles to make one fleece jacket.
- For every ton of paper that is recycled, 17 trees are saved.
- An aluminum can can be recycled and back on the shelf in 6 weeks.
- It takes between 200-500 years for an aluminum can to decompose in a landfill.
- An American uses an average of 159 gallons of water a day, or three bathtubs full. The rest of the world averages 25 gallons of water a day.

ZERO WASTE INITIATIVES AT ASU

- Arizona State harnesses energy from 81,424 solar panels, the most of any university in the country. In FY16, ASU generated 41,305,722 kWh of energy from the sun, enough to power over 3,100 Arizona homes for the entire year (40% of Tempe campus during peak demand). Softball stadium solar panels generate energy and provide shade to spectators, using Phoenix's 300-plus days of sunshine (local resource) to create energy.
- Every ticketed sport hosts a green game to put promotion behind the zero waste initiative. Have seen diversion results (waste from event thrown into recycle/compost instead of trash) in the 90% range when events are publicized.
- Participated in Pac-12 Game Day Challenge, where teams take snapshots of their Zero Waste success and compete against other Pac-12 schools for most sustainable school in the conference. This year ASU placed first in the Pac-12 for the school that creates the least waste per fan.
- ASU has the largest solar portfolio in the country.
- Wells Fargo Arena was the first operational LED-lit Power Five athletic facility in the nation, increasing lighting levels by 25% and reducing energy consumption by 75%. Exceeds the 125-vertical foot candle measurement needed for NCAA broadcast standards, and will factor into championship selections for ASU. The total 10-year savings with the new lighting is \$357,000.
- LEED Certification of Weatherup Practice Facility (Basketball)/Sun Devil Stadium: Weatherup is the first athletic practice facility in the nation to become LEED-certified (v2+ Gold), solar panels provide 45% of energy, and the facility is made with renewable wood flooring and recycled/locally manufactured products.
- Sun Devil athletics worked with concessionaire Sodexo on sustainable practices and since February 2013, the majority of products sold by SDA are recyclable and compostable.

Head Coach Zeke Jones



The seventh coach in ASU wrestling history, Zeke Jones was hired in April 2014 and had his contract renewed in October 2016. In his first season with the Sun Devils, Jones led ASU to a second-place finish at the Pac-12 Championships, the best finish since 2006, and coached six wrestlers to the 2015 NCAA Wrestling Championships, including All-American Blake Stauffer (184 pounds). In 2015-16, the Sun Devils again returned six individuals to the NCAA championships.

An Olympic silver medalist for the United States, Jones was the 1991 World Champion at 52kg, a four-time World-Cup Champion, and coached United States' Olympians in the 1996, 2000, 2004, and 2012 Olympic Games.

A member of ASU's 1988 NCAA Wrestling Championship team, Jones was a three-time All-American and Pac-10 Champion for the Sun Devils. A national runner-up at 118, Jones sits at No. 4 in ASU's career record book in both overall victories (134) and dual victories (59). He also holds the school record for dual match victories in a season with 22 during the 1989-90 campaign.

As Olympic head coach, Jones' athletes earned two gold medals and one bronze at the London Games in 2012. His athletes in the 2004 Athens Games, where he was the freestyle coach, earned a gold and two silvers.

In the four World Championships during Jones' tenure, USA placed third in the 2011 World Championships, fifth in 2013, and seventh in 2009. He also led USA to five individual World Champion medals, including two-time World champion Jordan Burroughs.

The United States competed in three Freestyle World Cups during the Jones era, placing third in 2012 and 2013, and sixth in 2010. During the Jones staff era, USA won eight Junior World medals, five University World medals and four Cadet World medals.

Jones came to USA Wrestling after coaching at the University of Pennsylvania from 2005-07, where he amassed a record of 33-17-1. Following the 2006 campaign that saw an NCAA Champion, two All-Americans, two Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association (EIWA) champions, and a third-place finish at the EIWA Championships, Amateur Wrestling News named Jones the Rookie Head Coach of the Year.

Prior to coaching at Penn he served on the coaching staffs at West Virginia, Arizona State, and Bloomsburg University. Jones coached teams that have finished in the NCAA Final Four twice, in the top-10 four times and won six conference team championships. Individually his wrestlers have won six NCAA titles, eight NCAA finalists, 36 individual conference champions, 29 All Americans, 74 NCAA Qualifiers, and 11 wrestlers have competed in the NWCA All Star Meet.

Originally from Ann Arbor, Mich., Jones is a Distinguished Member of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame, member of the Arizona State University Hall of Fame, and Michigan Wrestling Hall of Fame.

Arizona State University President Michael Crow on Zeke Jones: "I said to Ray, either we're going to have a wrestling team that's going to compete for national championships or we're not going to have a wrestling team. So you need to find the best person in the world to be our coach. Zeke Jones is our coach. Multi-time world champion in wrestling, NCAA champion, ASU graduate; and at the time that Ray hired him, sitting Olympic coach for the United States Olympic Team in wrestling, former coach at the University of Pennsylvania. That is the person; the personage, the kind of character that we are looking for."

ASU Vice President for University Athletics and Athletics Director Ray Anderson on Zeke Jones: "It is important we retain our high-caliber coaching hires and, without a doubt, Coach Jones has made a huge impact in his three years at Arizona State. He consistently demands high academic commitment and athletic dedication from our student-athletes and he and his staff worked tirelessly to recruit one of the top-rated recruiting classes in college wrestling history."



CURLEY CULP HONORED

Curley Culp, one of the best two-sport athletes Arizona State has ever seen, was an offensive and defensive lineman in football as well as 1967 NCAA heavyweight champion.

The five-time pro-bowler and 1975 NFL Defensive Player of the Year, Culp was enshrined in the 2013 Pro Football Hall of Fame as well as the 2013 Kansas City Chiefs Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Chiefs during their Super Bowl championship in Super Bowl IV.

Culp had a singlet hung in the Wells Fargo Arena rafters in his honor at halftime of ASU's match vs. Ohio State on Nov. 19.

ASU ADDS THREE FRESHMEN FOR 2017-18

Navonte Demison (Bakersfield, Calif.), Brandon Courtney (Goodyear, Ariz.), and Dakota Galt (Beresford, S.D.) join the ASU roster next season. Demison is a two-sport athlete and national champion, Courtney is a two-time state champion and two-time All-American, and Galt is a two-time team captain, three-time state champion, and All-American. Courtney and Demison are ranked in the top five in their weight classes by FloWrestling.

IMPRESSIVE TRANSFERS ADDED TO ASU ROSTER

Head coach Zeke Jones and his staff have recently added three impressive transfers to the roster in Ali Naser, Jason Tsirtsis, and Ryan Millhof.

Naser (133), a junior from Woodland Hills, Calif., is the only collegiate wrestler to defeat not one but two Olympians (Coleman Scott, Sam Hazewinkel), as well as US World Team member Obe Blanc.

Tsirtsis (149) transferred from Northwestern where he was the 2014 NCAA Champion as well as a two-time Big Ten champion and 2015 All-American.

Millhof most recently signed with the Sun Devils, moving to Tempe from the University of Oklahoma where he earned All-American honors in 2015-16 and was one of just four true freshmen to compete in OU's starting lineup in 2014-15.

ANTHONY ROBLES (ASU '11) RETURNS TO PAC-12 NETWORKS

Announced Wednesday, Nov. 16, Anthony Robles returns for his third season as an analyst for the Pac-12 Networks alongside Ken Chertow and play-by-play announcers Rich Burk and Jason Knapp.

Pac-12 Networks will air eight wrestling matches, four featuring the Sun Devils, this season, culminating in the Pac-12 championship finals at Stanford on Sunday, Feb. 26 at 6 p.m. PT.

The Sun Devils will appear on the Pac-12 Network four times this season, including three at home, with home matches on the conference network vs. Cal Poly (Jan. 8), North Carolina (Jan. 20), and CSU Bakersfield (Feb. 9) as well as at Oregon State (Feb. 5).

Robles, a three-time All-American and Pac-10 champion, went 36-0 his senior year and won the national championship at 125-pounds. He was named the NCAA Tournament's Most Outstanding Wrestler, defeating defending national champion Matt McDonough (Iowa). He concluded his wrestling career with a 122-23 record and ranks eighth for most match wins by a Sun Devil wrestler.

#SUNDEVIL4LIFE MARTORI RECEIVES ALUMNI AWARD

Sun Devil wrestling alum ('65) and long-time supporter of the program Art Martori received the 2016 Alumni Service Award at homecoming 2016 from the ASU Alumni Association.

He previously served as President of USA Wrestling (1992-94) during which the team won its first World team title in freestyle wrestling and as the U.S. Olympic Freestyle Wrestling Team Leader.

Martori is a member of the Arizona Sports Hall of Fame and was awarded the Gold Star by FILA, the international governing body of wrestling. In order to give back to up-and-coming young wrestlers, Martori started Sunkist Kids in 1976 to give opportunities, resources, and funding for U.S. Olympic hopefuls.

JONES SIGNS CONTRACT EXTENSION

Head coach Zeke Jones recently signed a five-year contract extension that would keep him at the helm of the Sun Devils until 2021. He was Ray Anderson's first coaching hire in a long line of highly touted coaching hires.

A former Sun Devil, Jones was a three-time All-American and national runner-up as a collegiate wrestler, as well as a member of the 1988 ASU national championship team. An Olympic silver medalist himself, Jones served as head coach of the United States Freestyle Wrestling Team, coaching U.S. Olympians in the 1996, 2000, 2004, 2012, and 2016 Olympic games.

He has won four World Cup Gold medals and was selected The World's Most Technical Wrestler, one of only three Americans ever to receive the award, by United World Wrestling, the international governing body for the sport of wrestling.

Already building an impressive resume at the ASU helm, Jones' first full recruiting class, including heavyweight Tanner Hall and brothers Zahid and Anthony Valencia, was tabbed the No. 1 recruiting class by D1CollegeWrestling.Net, FloWrestling, InterMat, and WIN Magazine.

He continues to attract the nation's top student-athletes, adding for 2016-17 the likes of Ali Naser, who has defeated two Olympians, Jason Tsirtsis, the 2014 NCAA National Champion at Northwestern, and Ryan Millhof, an All-American and Big 12 champion from Oklahoma.

In just two and a half years, he has also signed five No. 1 recruits in their perspective weights and six that were ranked in the top 10 pound for pound. In addition, the Sun Devils have added eight cadet and junior world team members since Jones arrived.

Zahid Valencia competed in Macon, France at the Junior World Championships, an opportunity he earned by defeating 2016 NCAA runner-up Bo Nickal of Penn State in a best-of-three 84 kg finals at qualifiers in Irving, Texas in May 2016. Valencia won matches over Ukraine's Mark Markarian, a 2014 Cadet World Team member, and Georgia's Meki Simonia, both by tech fall.

STANFORD TO HOST 2017 PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIPS

After ASU hosted the Pac-12 championships last season, hosting responsibilities shifts to Stanford as the Cardinal hosts the conference championships on Feb. 26. As a team, the Sun Devils finished second in 2016 for the second straight season.

Last season, Dalton Brady, Blake Stauffer, and Josh Dasilveira (133, 184, 197) won Pac-12 titles while Robbie Mathers, Matt Kraus, and Tanner Hall (141, 149, HWT) also claimed automatic bids to the NCAA championships.



2017 NCAA WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2017 NCAA Wrestling Championships are set for March 16-18 in St. Louis, Mo.

In 2016, ASU qualified six wrestlers for the second straight season, including Dalton Brady (133), Robbie Mathers (141), Matt Kraus (149), Blake Stauffer (184), Josh Dasilveira (197), and Tanner Hall (HWT).

NO. 1 RECRUITING CLASS FINALLY DON ASU SINGLETS

After Arizona State's 2015 signing class was named No. 1 by D1CollegeWrestling, FloWrestling, Intermat, and WIN Magazine, many of the remaining members of the class will have the chance to see the mat this season. The class marked the Sun Devils' first top recruiting class, per AWN, since 1988.

As Tanner Hall was the only member of the class to see action as a true freshman, much of the remainder of the class including Anthony Valencia (St. John Bosco, Bellflower, Calif.), Zahid Valencia (St. John Bosco, Bellflower, Calif.), Josh Maruca (Franklin Regional HS, Murrysville, Pa.), Josh Shields (Franklin Regional HS, Murrysville, Pa.), and Nikko Villarreal (Gilroy, Gilroy, Calif.) will have the chance to compete for the Sun Devils in 2016-17.

Hall, an NCAA qualifier as a freshman, was named to the Amateur Wrestling News All-Rookie Team as well as to The Open Mat's All-Freshman Team.

THE STAFF

Joining head coach Zeke Jones on the 2016-17 coaching staff are fifth-year assistant coach Lee Pritts, third-year assistant coach Chris Pendleton, and volunteer assistant Haislan Garcia.

Pritts, considered one of the top recruiters in the country, previously worked at North Carolina State, Old Dominion, and Missouri. He was an All-American at Eastern Michigan and qualified for the 2000 Olympic trials.

Pendleton previously served as an assistant coach at Wyoming for four seasons, and specialized in training the team's upper weight classes. Pendleton was a two-time NCAA Champion and three-time All-American at Oklahoma State.

Garcia, a three-time Canadian Olympian, joined the staff as volunteer assistant coach this season and brings a wealth of experience as a nine-time Canadian National Champion and multiple-time Pan-American championship medalist.

Director of Operations Maddie Schossow (Iowa '15) and Student Assistant Director of Operations Madi Davies, daughter of All-American and national championship team captain Mike Davies, also join the staff to start the 2016-17 season. Recent alum Matt Kraus joins the staff as an undergraduate assistant coach.
