SUN DEVIL LACROSSE PREVIEW

Arizona State lacrosse (7-8, 2-3) wraps up the 2024 Pac-12 road slate with a matchup against the Oregon Ducks (7-5, 1-4) on Saturday, April 20. The game is slated to start at 12 p.m. MST and will be broadcast on Pac-12 Arizona.

Program History:

The two teams have faced off nine times in program history, with ASU holding the 6-3 edge. Two of the three ASU losses came in the first two meetings between the teams, though the most recent loss to the Ducks came last season in Eugene and halted the sixgame win streak by the Sun Devils.

Sun Devil Notes:

Last week, the Sun Devils had a pair of games in Colorado and dropped both contests. The team fell 20-10 to No. 20 Colorado and 21-11 at No. 13 Denver, despite trailing the Pioneers by just two goals at halftime. Seven of the eight losses this season have come to ranked opponents. ASU has not defeated a ranked team since May 5, 2022, when the Sun Devils took down then-No. 16 USC.

Sun Devil sophomore attacker Lydia Oldknow stayed hot with her eighth hat trick of the season against DU, which leads the team. She sits at 38 goals on the season and is the first Sun Devil with 50+ points this season.

Graduate defender Zoe Mazur still leads the program's single-season recordbooks with 126 draw controls after picking up 10 in the two games last weekend.

Scouting the Opponent:

Oregon has compiled a 7-5 record with first-year head coach Jessica Drummond this season. The Ducks have lost their last two games to No. 21 USC at home and unranked San Diego State on the road. All seven of Oregon's wins this season have come when the Ducks have scored 15+ goals. The five losses have come when the team scores 14 or fewer goals.

Anna Thornton had back-to-back three assist games last week and sits at 15 on the season which is tied for 9th all-time in the program's single-season record books.

Defender Gigi Gaspar scored her third goal in as many games against the Pioneers. Entering the game, she had two goals on two shots this season, both of which came against California.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS:

-Senior attacker Mina Scott is 5th all-time in program history with 82. She is 6th all-time with 102 points in the program's career recordbooks behind Kaylon Buckner's 137.

-Sophomore attacker Lydia Oldknow is also on the list with Scott sitting at 54 career goals, which is 6th place in the career recordbooks. Oldknow is 7th in all-time points with 75. Her 20 career assists is also 8th all-time behind Kylie Kroeger's 20.

-Zoe Mazur's 126 draw controls have her on the single-season leaderboard, sitting at first all-time passing Maura Cissel's 111 draw controls which came in 2021. Mazur also holds the program's career draw control record with 289, 60 more than the next closest player.

TEAM NOTABLES:

-ASU earned their first road win of the season against SDSU on March 17. The Sun Devils outscored the Aztecs 10-2 in the second half to secure the 17-9 win.

-ASU has held opponents to a 85.5% clear percentage allowing 183 clears in 214 attempts.

-The Sun Devils' 3-0 start to the season was the first time in program history, but was halted after a loss to Stony Brook in the team's first road game.

PLAYER NOTABLES:

-Zoe Mazur's 8.40 draw controls per game are the ninth-best individual mark in the NCAA and second best in the Pac-12.

-Attackers Mina Scott (34) and Lydia Oldknow (38) each have 30+ goals on the season.

-in the Pac-12 opener against SDSU, junior goalkeeper Katie Vahle hit the 400 career save mark and was the second active goalie in the Pac-12 with 400 career saves.

-Oldknow has eight hat tricks this season, which leads the team.

PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

-Katie Vahle earned the first weekly award for ASU this season after being named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the week on 3/19.

-Zoe Mazur was named Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week on 4/8/24 after recording 24 draw controls in two games. It was the first career Pac-12 honor for the graduate defender.

Sun Devil Athletics hired Taryn VanThof as the new Lacrosse Head Coach, Vice President of University Athletics Ray Anderson announced on July 5, 2022

VanThof comes to Arizona State after an extremely successful six-year stint as the Assistant Coach at national power Florida. There she served as the Offensive Coor dinator, Goalie Coach, Draw Specialist, and Recruiting Coordinator for the Gators.

"Thank you to Vice President for University Athletics Ray Anderson and Senior Associate AD/SWA Christina Wombacher for this opportunity to lead the Sun Devil Lacrosse program," VanThof remarked. "I could not be more thrilled to coach at this extraordinary university."

Under the direction of VanThof and Head Coach Amanda O'Leary, Florida has emerged as one of the nation's premiere programs over the past six years. In 2022, the Gators made their fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament, earning a bid every year of VanThof's tenure. She arrives in Tempe coming off two straight appearances in the NCAA Quarterfinal Round (Elite Eight) with Florida.
