THE GAME - Sun Devil Football opens Pac-12 action on the road this weekend with a Top-25 matchup against No. 10/12 Washington in Seattle on Saturday, September 22. The game, scheduled for a 7:30 p.m. PT kickoff, will be broadcast live on the ESPN with Bob Wischusen, Brock Huard and Allison Williams on the call. The game will be broadcast over the airwaves on ESPN 620 AM with the Voice of the Sun Devils, Tim Healey, joined by Jeff Van Raaphorst and Jordan Simone.

PAC-12 OPENERS- ASU is 16-22-2 all-time in the first Pac-12 game of the season and 16-23-1 in the first Pac-12 road game of the season. ASU doesn't open on the road quite as often, playing the first league game of the season on the road just 18 times since 1978 compared to opening conference action at home 22 times. ASU has only opened Pac-12 play on the road twice since 2007 (2013 and 2014).

VS. WASHINGTON - ASU was won 11 of its last 12 games against Washington (since 2002), a streak rivaled only by Oregon's 12-4 record over the Huskies in that time. Washington has been ranked three times in the past five contests between the two teams with ASU going 2-1 in those games (wins in 2013 and 2017 and a loss in 2016). That 2016 loss in Seattle has been the lone setback for ASU in the series since 2002.

ASU has been largely successful in recent years with its ability to limit potent Washington QB Jake Browning, who will finish in the UW record books at the top of just about every major category respective at his position.

However, in 42 career games for Browning, the senior has just 13 games where he had an NFL QB rating under 82.0 Three of those games have come in his career matchups against ASU (61.9 in 2015, 81.4 in 2016 and 68.6 in 2017). He has thrown 5 interceptions in games against ASU out of his paltry 28 career interceptions and has been sacked nine times (out of 79 career sacks over 42 games, 3.0 per game against ASU compared to just 1.8 per game against other opponents).

AN ASU VICTORY WOULD...

- » Give the Sun Devils three straight wins in Pac-12 openers for the first time in conference history (since 1978).
- » Hand ASU its 12th win in the last 13 games against UW (since 2002). Only Oregon (12) has won more games ver UW than ASU's current 11 in that time.
- » Move ASU to 17-22-2 all-time in Pac-12 openers and 17-23-1 in Pac-12 road openers.
- » Improve ASU to 6-11-1 when the first conference game of the season occurs on the road.

No ASU running back has put the ball on the ground in 593 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 22 consecutive games. That includes 58 running back carries this season. The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers. ASU has just one turnover this season - tied for second nationally - and is one of just 15 teams not to lose a fumble on the year.

Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of **124 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points**. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 70 of those games (56.5 percent). Conversely, ASU is 12th in the country among teams that have played at least three games with just 5 touchdowns allowed this season.

N'Keal Harry has a catch in each of his 28 games as a Sun Devil - tied for the eighth-longest active streak in the nation. Harry has a TD reception in each of his last 5 games dating back to last season and at least one in 7 of last 8 games. He has 9 TD receptions in those 8 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career. He is tied with Stanford's JJ Arcega-Whiteside and UMass' Andy Isabella for the most in the country in that span. Harry has a 137.4 NFL QB rating when targetted this season, 27th nationally and third among receivers that have logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets.

Eno Benjamin has forced 18 missed tackles this season (11 rushing, 7 receiving) - leading the Pac-12 running backs and tied for third nationally. He has posted a for a 94.1 elusive rating according to Pro Football Focus, fourth in the league. Benjamin has forced a missed tackle 31.6% of the time - eighth nationally. 30.2% of Benjamin's rushing attempts this season have resulted in a first down or touchdown - a total good for the 25th-highest percentage nationally. Benjamin is fifth among the nation's running backs with 14 catches this season and his 19 total targets are fourth nationally.

Manny Wilkins as made **7 "big-time throws" this season, according to PFF (the organization's highest graded pass, usually on deep throws or into tight windows)**, good for 12th nationally. He has made just one single "turnover-worthy" throw - the 6th-lowest total in the nation. Wilkins has a 145.6 NFL passer rating when facing blitzing plays this season - the second-best total in the country and over 50 points higher than the national average of 90.7. Wilkins has been pressured on 31.5% of his dropbacks this season (20th nationally) but has just a 12.2 sack % that sits as the 18th-lowest total in the nation.

Kobe Williams has allowed just five yards after the catch this season - leading Pac-12 corners and good for the seventh-lowest total nationally. He has been targetted just six times on the season - the third-lowest total in the country. Williams is allowing just 0.37 yards per play in which he is the primary man in coverage, good for third among Pac-12 corners. In general, Williams has allowed just 31 total yards when targetted - the third-lowest total in the Pac-12 and good for 14th nationally. Williams has only been targetted once every 13.8 passing plays this season - the fourth lowest total nationally.

#10THINGS (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

1. ASU's Kobe Williams has been targetted just six times on the season - the third-lowest total in the country. He's allowed just 31 total yards when targetted - good for 14th nationally.
2. ASU has 81 plays this season in which the opponent has gained zero or negative yardage (48 incomplete passes, 27 tackles for loss, 6 plays of no gain) on 225 total opponent plays (36.0 percent).
3. .@mjsleepdalton36 is tied for the national lead with 10 punts inside the 20 through three games. He is seventh nationally in net punting at 44.2 yards per punt.
4. Eno Benjamin is currently 5th among the nation's running backs with 14 catches and his 19 total targets are 4th nationally. He has an offensive success score of 36.8% as a receiver, according to PFF, good for 8th among RBs with at least 7 targets.
5. No ASU running back has coughed up the ball in 593 consecutive carries (22 straight games without a fumble).
6. .@eno_benjamin5 leads the Pac-12 with 18 missed tackles forced this season - a total that is also tied for third nationally. He's forced a missed tackle 31.6 percent of the time, good for 8th among the nation's running backs.
7. Shannon Forman is 12th nationally among 3-4 defensive ends in PFF's run-stop %, logging 6 tackles in rush defense that have all constituted as a stop - and a 10.0 stop % that leads the nation among players that have played over 50% of their snaps on running plays.
8. .@NkealHarry15 has a touchdown reception in each of his last 5 games and at least one in 7 of last 8 games. He has 9 touchdown receptions in those 8 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career.
9. N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 28 games of his career at Arizona State, the eighth-longest active streak of games for any returning player in the NCAA.
10. Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of 124 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points.



GOLD ZONE

- » ASU had its streak of 64 consecutive successful red zone scoring drives (excluding game-ending kneel-downs) come to a end during the second quarter against San Diego State - a streak that dated back to the first half of the team's contest at Washington in 2016.
- » ASU has scored on 9 of its 10 red zone trips this season.
- » ASU finished fifth nationally in converting on 96.23 percent of its red zone appearances last season (51-of-53). HOWEVER, the Devils took a knee in the red zone in the final seconds of the team's victories over fifth-ranked Washington and in the Territorial Cup contest against Arizona.
- » The Sun Devils scored on 43-of-47 trips to the red zone in 2016 (91.5 percent), a total that ranked 10th in the nation.
- » ASU is the only team in the country to be ranked in the Top 10 in red zone scoring in each of the past two seasons.

DON'T CROSS THAT LINE

- » ASU recorded nine sacks against UTSA, the most since the Sun Devils sacked the UCLA Bruins the same amount of times on Nov. 23, 2013. ASU recorded 15 tackles for a loss, the most since the Sun Devils recorded that same amount against Washington State on Oct. 30, 2010.
- » ASU is currently 16th nationally in averaging 9.00 tackles for loss per game (27 total) this season while the team's 131 yards lost on tackles for loss are good for fourth nationally.
- » The Sun Devils are fourth in the nation in sacks per game, averaging 4.00 per game thus far (12 total).
- » ASU entered the season ranked fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU was sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.
- » In 2018, ASU has 81 plays in which the opponent has gained zero or negative yardage (48 incomplete passes, 27 tackles for loss, 6 plays of no gain) on 225 total plays (36.0 percent)

DON'T CROSS THAT ONE, EITHER

- » Among team's that have played at least three games, ASU is 22nd nationally in scoring defense (16.0 points per game) and 22nd in total points allowed among teams with at least three games (48).
- » The Sun Devils have not allowed a single point in the first quarter of games this season, one of just 10 teams in the country to do so through the first three weekends of the year.
- » ASU is 12th in the country among team's with three games with just 5 touchdowns allowed this season.

HOLD ON TO THAT BALL

- » No ASU running back has put the ball on the ground in 593 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 22 consecutive games. That includes 58 running back carries this season.
- » The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers.
- » ASU has just one turnover this season - tied for second nationally - and is one of just 15 teams not to lose a fumble on the year.

HE'S THE MANNY

- » Manny Wilkins is currently eight in program history with 6,557 career passing yards and he needs just 355 to move into the top five in program history.
- » His 534 career completions are good for sixth in program history.
- » Wilkins has 13 rushing touchdown in his career, moving into a tie among all ASU quarterbacks for third in school history with Taylor Kelly (Mark Malone, 32; Danny White, 14). He had seven touchdowns on the ground last season, becoming one of

just 10 quarterbacks in the FBS last season to pass for at least 20 touchdowns with at least 7 rushing touchdowns as well.

- » Wilkins broke the school record for most consecutive pass attempts without an interception last season at 192 between the end of the 2016 season and the first half of last year, breaking Rudy Carpenter's previous school record of 149 from the end of 2005 to 2006.
- » With his passing touchdown to Brandon Aiyuk in the first quarter against SDSU, Manny Wilkins notched his 50th career touchdown accounted for (38 passing, 12 rushing). Wilkins added a rushing TD and one more passing TD in the fourth quarter now giving him 52 career touchdowns (39 passing and 13 rushing).
- » Wilkins holds a 103.2 NFL QB rating this season, according to Pro Football Focus, the 20th best total in the country (and 13th among QBs with at least 100 dropbacks).
- » Wilkins is currently the nation's 12th-highest graded QB among Power Five quarterbacks through three games this season, logging a 80.9 grade according to PFF - good for third among Pac-12 quarterbacks.
- » Wilkins as made 7 "big-time throws" this season, according to PFF (the organization's highest graded pass, usually on deep throws or into tight windows), good for 12th nationally. Conversely, he has made just one single "turnover-worthy" throw (coming on his lone interception this season), according to the outlet - the sixth-lowest total in the nation.
- » The Sun Devil offense has scored a successful play (as graded by Pro Football Focus) on 42.2 percent of Wilkins' passing attempts this season - the 18th-best total among all quarterbacks in the FBS.
- » Wilkins has a 145.6 NFL passer rating when facing blitzing plays this season - the second-best total in the country and over 50 points higher than the national average of 90.7. Wilkins has been pressured on 31.5 percent of his dropbacks this season (20th nationally) but has just a 12.2 sack percentage that sits as the 18th-lowest total in the nation.
- » Wilkins is 23rd nationally in adjusted completion percentage (72.2 percent), which excludes QB spikes, throwaways, dropped passes and passes thrown while being hit.

DIRTY HARRY

- » N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 28 games of his career at Arizona State, tied for the eighth-longest active streak among all current FBS players.
- » His 161 career receptions are good for sixth in Sun Devil school history and he is just seven away from moving into a tie for fourth.
- » Harry is currently 10th in school history with 2,116 career receiving yards.
- » At 5.75 receptions for game in his career, Harry is currently the NCAA's active career leader in the category. His 75.6 career receiving yards per game are second among all active players.
- » With 17 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is tied for 10th in ASU school history in that category as well and needs just one more to move him into ninth.
- » He was named to PFF's Offensive Team of the Week, finishing with a 90.7 grade and accounted for 114 yards after the catch on his 140 total receiving yards.
- » Harry has a touchdown reception in each of his last 5 games dating back to last season and at least one in 7 of last 8 games. He has 9 touchdown receptions in those 8 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career. He is tied with Stanford's JJ Arcega-Whiteside and UMass' Andy Isabella for the most in the country in that span.
- » Harry has a 137.4 NFL QB rating when targetted this season, good for 27th nationally and third among receivers that have logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets.
- » Harry has forced 8 missed tackles this season, which is good for seventh-most among all FBS receivers.



GOLD RUSH

- » ASU has 27 rushing TDs last year as it reached 25 rushing touchdowns for the fourth time in the last six seasons. Those four times are notable as the Devils had just three previous seasons with at least 25 rushing touchdowns from 1980-2011 (1985, 1986 and 1996).
- » The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards five times in the last six seasons seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011 and only eight times total over 30 years from 1981-2011.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, the Sun Devils had the 27th-highest graded rushing attack last season after having the 41st worst-graded attack in 2016.
- » During Week One, the Sun Devils averaged 8.1 yards per attempt on the ground - good for 15th nationally. The offensive line played a big role in that, as ASU led the FBS this week in yards gained before contact at 3.9 yards per carry.

KEEPING MOMENTUM

- » Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of 124 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 70 of those games (57.0 percent).
- » The Sun Devils have won at least seven games in four of the last six seasons, marking the first time ASU has done so in a six-year gap since doing it four straight times from 2004-07.
- » Prior to that, the last time ASU accomplished the feat was 1978-82, winning at least seven games four times in that five-year spread.

THE CHASE IS ON

- » Chase Lucas has made his presence felt all over the field and has been especially efficient in run defense, where he has made 8 tackles this season - tied for seventh among all FBS corners. His 5.6 run-stop percentage is tied for 16th nationally among all corners.
- » Lucas was named a freshman first-team all-American last season by the FWAA and second-team by USA Today.
- » Lucas earned Pac-12 Second Team honors at defensive back and was the only freshman to be named to either the Pac-12 First or Second teams last season and became the first freshman to earn First or Second team honors on offense or defense since Oregon running back Royce Freeman earned Second Team offense honors in 2014. He was the first Pac-12 freshman defensive back to make the First or Second teams since Brandon Browner did so for Oregon State back in 2003.
- » Despite being targeted more than any of the 23 Pac-12 corners that played at least 60 percent of snaps in the regular season (once every 4.6 passing plays), Lucas allowed the fifth-lowest completion percentage of any corner in the conference - regardless of year.

MAKE 'EM PAY

- » ASU has outscored opponents 601-328 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 67.8 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (101 of 149) while finding the end zone 77 times in that span (51.7 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 51.8 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (55 of 106) with 43 touchdowns (40.6 percent).

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

- » Eno Benjamin has forced 18 missed tackles this season (11 rushing, 7 receiving) - leading the Pac-12 running backs and tied for third nationally.
- » He has posted a 94.1 elusive rating according to Pro Football Focus, fourth in the league.
- » Benjamin has forced a missed tackle 31.6 percent of the time - eighth nationally.
- » 30.2 percent of Benjamin's rushing attempts this season have resulted in a first

down or touchdown - a total good for the 25th-highest percentage nationally.

- » Benjamin has been equally impressive in the passing game, currently fifth among the nation's running backs with 14 catches this season and his 19 total targets are fourth nationally.
- » He has an offensive success score of 36.8 percent as a receiver, according to PFF, a total that is good for eighth among running backs with at least 7 targets this season.

A HAND IN THE COOKIE JAR

- » ASU has 17 interception returns for touchdowns in the last seven seasons, good for third in the nation behind only Alabama (19) and Ohio State (17) in that time.
- » The Sun Devils have 94 interceptions in the last six seasons, ranked in the Top 10 nationally.
- » ASU has added four fumble return touchdowns as well for 21 defensive touchdowns since the 2012 season, good for fourth in the country in that time span behind Ohio State (27), Alabama (25) and Boise State (24).

ON THE DEFENSE

- » Jalen Bates is tied for third among 3-4 defensive ends with 6 QB pressures this season for a 10.5 pass rush productivity score that is good for second nationally. Teammate Doug Subtyl is tied for second among ends with five QB pressures this season.
- » Kobe Williams has allowed just five yards after the catch this season - leading Pac-12 corners and good for the seventh-lowest total nationally. He has been targeted just six times on the season - the third-lowest total in the country.
- » Williams is allowing just 0.37 yards per play in which he is the primary man in coverage, good for third among Pac-12 corners. In general, Williams has allowed just 31 total yards when targeted - the third-lowest total in the Pac-12 and good for 14th nationally.
- » Dasmond Tautalatasi and Demonte King have combined to allow just 6 receptions on a combined 174 plays in coverage from the safety position this season (3.4 percent).
- » Jalen Harvey leads the Pac-12's safeties and is seventh in the nation in run stop percentage, recording a Pac-12 leading 6 "stops" and a 10.3 run-stop percentage. All 6 of those stops came within 8 yards of the line of scrimmage - a total that is two more than any safety in the conference. His 12 tackles on running plays are 17th among the nation's safeties and second in the Pac-12.
- » Shannon Forman is currently 12th nationally among 3-4 defensive ends in Pro Football Focus' run-stop percentage, logging six tackles in rush defense - all of which constituting as a stop - and a 10.0 stop percentage that actually leads the nation among players that have played over percent of their snaps on running plays.
- » ASU is one of just 7 teams this season to not give up a play of over 40 yards, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively).

RUIZ'S PIECES

- » Brandon Ruiz connected on all three of his field goal attempts (49, 24, 28), including the game-winning kick from 28 yards as time expired in ASU's 16-13 upset of then-No. 15 Michigan State to earn Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week Honors for the third time in his career.
- » Ruiz is 13th nationally with a 80.0 percent touchback percentage this season (12 of 15).

DON'T SLEEP ON HIM

- » Michael Sleep-Dalton is tied for third in the nation this season with 10 punts downed inside the 20 yard line.
- » He has had just one of his 3 punts against him returned for a grand total of 11 yards.
- » He is currently 16th nationally (first in Pac-12) in averaging 44.9 yards per punt and 7th nationally with his 44.2 net yards per punt as well.

General

The Sun Devil Athletics media relations staff understands the importance of assisting the media in providing coverage of the institution, its athletics programs, administrators, coaches and student-athletes. We pride ourselves in being able to disseminate information as widely, uniformly and fairly as possible using normally accepted media standards. To this end, the best attempt will be made to fill reasonable requests by recognized media outlets. Members of the media are encouraged to work with the Sun Devil Football media relations staff to assist in that endeavor. It is not permissible for media members to contact any athletics department administrator, associate, coach or student-athlete directly without working through the media relations department.

Practice Policies

Due to the nature of Arizona State game dates this season, practices schedules each week will vary dependent upon that week's game. The ASU media relations office will provide a practice schedule prior to each game week for the media.

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4. At the conclusion of Period 3, a member of the media relations staff will escort the media out of practice. The typical viewing period will last approximately 35-40 minutes.

No member of the media may shoot any portion of practice that includes team activities (anything 11-on-11) or that includes any play-calling signals and/or audio. Members of the media may only photograph and shoot individual or positions groups working separate of a team setting.

Viewing periods are always subject to the discretion of the Sun Devil Football coaching staff and may change suddenly. Following that open viewing period, the members of the media will be escorted out of the facility and reconvene at the Student-Athlete Facility on the north end of Sun Devil Stadium for post-practice interviews. Under no circumstances will Periscope technology be permitted.

Interview Policies

All interviews will be conducted post-practice at the new Student-Athlete Facility, located at the north end of Sun Devil Stadium. Due to high demand, several players and members of the coaching staff might only be available on a limited basis each week. A full availability schedule will be provided to the media each week.

All interviews must be arranged through the Media Relations office. Under no circumstances are members of the media allowed to contact a student-athlete or member of the coaching staff without first contacting a member of the Media Relations staff. All coaches and student-athletes have been encouraged to check in with the Media Relations staff and not indulge any interview requests that have not been arranged through the proper channels. Every possible attempt will be made to accommodate all media requests.

Following home contests, Arizona State will bring several student-athletes to the media room at the new Student-Athlete Facility in the North End Zone for a post-game press conference. Head Coach Herm Edwards will follow

the student-athletes.

Please note that there is a new NCAA rule in effect that states that every NCAA athletic team must take one day off per week from all team-related activities, including practice, weight training, conditioning, meetings, interviews, etc. This means that one day per week (typically Monday for Sun Devil football), no Sun Devil student-athlete may conduct an interview. As this is an NCAA rule and will be monitored by compliance personnel, there can be no exceptions made.

Weekly Press Conferences

Head coach Herm Edwards will host his weekly press conferences each Monday prior to game week. The press conference is tentatively scheduled for 12 p.m. (Noon) Arizona Time each week.

Photography/Videography

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4 and those wishing to document practice via photograph or video will be able to do so during this time, so long as said documentation does not record play-calling signals. On-camera interviews will be conducted at the end of each practice.

For home games, a photographer work area has been established inside the Carson Student-Athlete Center (first floor). Internet access to transmit files is available in the photography workroom. Credentials must be worn in plain view throughout the game while on the field and all photographers must adhere to painted lines and instructions given by security personnel and/or Arizona State staff members at all times.

The Pac-12 Football Coaches Weekly Media Teleconference Call will take place each Tuesday during the season. Coach Graham is scheduled to speak at 12:05 PT/1:05 MT each Tuesday. The Pac-12 will again provide access to Armed Forces Network for carriage of Pac-12 football games in 2017 for the benefit of the men and women in the military.

Randall McDaniel to be Inducted into Rose Bowl Hall of Fame

PASADENA, Calif. -- Former Arizona State offensive lineman Randall McDaniel will be inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2018. McDaniel will join Pop Warner, Vince Young and George Halas being honored at the Rose Bowl Kickoff Luncheon in Pasadena on December 31, 2018.

McDaniel will be the third Sun Devil to be inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame after teammate and quarterback Jeff Van Raaphorst and head coach John Cooper, who coached the team that included both McDaniel and Van Raaphorst to 1987 Rose Bowl Title.

McDaniel, from nearby Avondale, Ariz., was a four-year starter along the offensive line in Tempe and helped lead ASU to the 1987 Rose Bowl Title, defeating Michigan 22-15. The following year, he was awarded the 1987 Morris Trophy for Pac-10 offensive lineman of the year. He was also a two-time first-team all-American in 1986 and 1987.
