# Scouting the Opposition Western Kentucky (3-0)

- The Lady Toppers are off to a perfect start as well, winning the Toledo Blue and Gold Tournament over the weekend.
- Two players, Paige Briggs and Lauren Matthews, totaled over 40 kills in the three matches, 44 and 42, respectively.
- This is the second meeting between these two schools, with WKU winning the first back in 2008.

### Tennessee Tech (0-3)

- The Golden Eagles struggled during their first weekend, getting swept in all three matches at the Michigan Invitational.
- Last season, they went 11-19, 5-11 in Ohio Valley Conference play.
- This is the first meeting between ASU and Tennessee Tech in program history.

### No. 24 Louisville (2-1)

- This is the second weekend in a row at home for the Cardinals after going 2-1 in the Cardinal Classic last weekend. Louisville's lone loss came at the hands of No. 10 Florida in three sets.
- The Cardinals are the only non-conference team on the Sun Devils' schedule that made it to the NCAA tournament last season, advancing to the second round.
- ASU trails in the all-time series history against Louisville, 2-1.

### Can You Dig It?

Senior libero Courtney Leffel is the 20th Sun Devil in program history to reach 1,000 career digs. All she needed was 39 and she totaled 83 over the three matches. Against LSU, she had 39 digs, good for ninth in a single match inthe record books at ASU, seventh in the rally-scoring era. Her stellar performance at the Flo Hyman Collegiate Cup earned her the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week nod.

### **All-Tournament Players**

Courtney Leffel and Andrea Mitrovic were named to the Flo Hyman Collegiate Cup All-Tournament Team. Leffel had 83 digs over three matches, while Mitrovic had 30 kills on a .369 clip.

### **Road Warriors**

For the first four weekends of the season, Arizona State will be on the road. ASU will play in four tournaments starting in Houston and ending in Las Vegas. This is the first time since 2016 with no home tournaments in the non-conference schedule. The first home

match will not be until September 26.

### **New Kids On The Block**

There are nine new faces on the 2019 roster: six freshmen and three transfers. Of the six freshmen, three are liberos, one is an outside hitter and the other is a middle blocker. The transfers include two outside hitters and one setter.

### Serbia Squad

Serbia is well-represented on the 2019 Sun Devil roster. In addition to head coach Sanja Tomasevic, three players have Serbian ties. Senior Ivana Jeremic and redshirt sophomore Danica Krstonošic are from Serbia while junior Andrea Mitrovic, Canada natvie, has a strong Serbian heritage and speaks Serbian.

### Oh, Canada

Canadians Andrea Mitrovic and Megan Beedie spent their summers with Canadian national teams. Mitrovic made the Canadian National Team and traveled to multiple tournaments this season, including the Olympic qualification tournament. Beedie was part of the NextGen squad and most recently competed in the 2019 Pan American Games.

### 2019 Outlook

After seeing improvement in 2018, the Sun Devils look to take an even bigger leap in 2019. Arizona State finished the season at 14-18, 5-15 Pac-12. Following a tough 2017 season, the Sun Devils improved immensely, earning four more wins in the season total and five more in conference play. This has been the biggest improvement from season to season for an ASU team since 2012 when the nine 2011 wins jumped to 20.

Last season, the Sun Devils were ranked in the AVCA Coaches Poll at No. 25 on Oct. 8, the first time being ranked since 2015 when they reached as high as No. 5. They also received votes on Oct. 1 and 15. They got recognition nationwide after three ranked wins, all top-15 teams.

### Pac-12 Preseason Poll

The Sun Devils were picked to finish 11th in the Pac-12 preseason poll, ahead of Oregon State. ASU finished the 2018 season 11th as well. Reigning national champion Stanford was picked to win the conference again.
