SCOUTING THE SERIES

For the first time in program history, the Arizona State ice hockey team (1-4-1) is goin' up north to face the Northern Michigan Wildcats on the shores of Lake Superior. The Sun Devils drop the puck against the Wildcats on Oct. 25 at 4 p.m. AZT/7 p.m. ET and on Oct. 26 at 3 p.m. AZT/6 p.m. ET. Both games are available on Midco Sports Plus and on the airwaves on Fox Sports 910.

ASU competes in its second-straight road game after suffering a series sweep at No. 14 Providence. After an off-week over Halloweekend, the Sun Devils once again return to mountain heights at Colorado College for ASU's first conference games in program history.

The Sun Devils look to make a strong presence on the road with the Pairwise rankings in mind, especially since the Pairwise system looks at road wins favorably when deciding the NCAA Tournament field.

Key offensive players make their return to the lineup this weekend as Artem Shlaine and Charlie Schoen after experiencing injuries at in the off-season.

SERIES HISTORY

The Wildcats and Sun Devils have faced off three times in the last ten years. This weekend is ASU's first-ever trip to Marquette and the Berry Events Center. Last season, Northern Michigan traveled to Mullett Arena in October. Then, ASU came away with the series sweep in two 3-2 and 5-1 wins. The first time the two programs met was in Las Vegas for the Ice Vegas Invitational in 2017-18. ASU beat Northern Michigan 7-3 on the opening night of the tournament to reach the championship game. ASU eventually defeated Michigan Tech, 3-2, to secure it's first holiday tournament win in program history.

- -- Former Northern Michigan captain Artem Shlaine makes his return to the UP this weekend. The center missed the first six games of ASU's season due to an off-seaason injury. For the Wildcats he notched 21 goals and 34 assists for a total 55 points through 65 games. Before Northern Michigan, Shlaine played at UCONN for two seasons.
- -- College hockey's leading point scorer Noah Beck is a 1.50 point per game player with one goal and eight assists through six games.
- -- Top draft prospect Cullen Potter continued to impress in his introductory games to college hockey with four points (2G, 2A), including the game-tying goal against No. 10 Michigan with only 44 seconds left in regulation. Potter went on to score the sole goal in the shootout after ASU finished with a 3-3 tie against the Wolverines last Saturday night.

SUN DEVIL NOTES

BACK IN THE LINEUP

After missing the first six games of the season, forwards Artem Shlaine and Charlie Schoen return to the lineup for the first time this season at Northern Michigan. Schoen looks to bring more speed and skill to the offense while Shlaine should serve as a faceoff specialist for the Sun Devils and compete as a top two-way center. Former Sun Devil Matthew Romer transferred to Northern Michigan this off-season and was named an alternate captain for the Wildcats under their first-year head coach.

FAMILIAR TERRITORY

Artem Shlaine returns to his former Wildcat territory after transferring from Northern Michigan following two seasons with the Wildcats. Shaline wore the 'A' in his junior year in Marquette and was upgraded to a captain for his senior year in 2023-24. Shlaine played in 65 games for the Wildcats and tallied 21 goals and 34 assists for a total 55 points.

WIZARDING WORLD OF CULLEN POTTER

Six games into his college hockey career, Potter is already scoring highlight reel goals and actively assisting teammates on the scoresheet. He completed his first collegiate two-point night versus No. 10 Michigan on Saturday with one goal and one assist. His goal that gave ASU the shootout victory does not count towards his NCAA record. Can he reach the point-scoring prestige of the likes of ASU greats Josh Doan and Johnny Walker from their rookie vears? Doan set the ASU program record for points by as a freshman with 37 in 2021-22. Walker previously held the record with 24 points in his first year during the 2017-18 season. The highly touted ASU rookie is the second-youngest player in the NCAA. The U.S. National Development Program product is 17 years old and turns 18 on Jan. 10, 2025. He's only seven days older than the youngest player in college hockey (Sascha Boumedienne, Boston University).

MOST WINS IN PROGRAM HISTORY With the NCAA Tournament and Pairwise chase off of the table for the 2023-24 season, the team set its sights on accomplishing a new goal: the most wins in a single season in program history. With the final game of the season marked as a 5-2 win for the Sun Devils, ASU completed the year with 24 wins, the most in ASU history. The previous record was held by the 2019-20 squad who accomplished a 22-win season

before the season was ultimately cut short due to Covid-19.

NHL DEVILS

Joey Daccord signed a five-year, \$25 million contract with the Seattle Kraken on Wednesday. It has an average annual value of \$5 million and begins next season. The 28-year-old goalie could have been an unrestricted free agent after this season. He's in his second full season in the NHL after going 19-18-11 with a 2.46 goalsagainst average, .916 save percentage and three shutouts in 50 games (46 starts) for Seattle in 2023-24.

Former Sun Devil Hockey captain Josh Doan made the NHL opening day roster for the Utah Hockey Club's inaugural season in Salt Lake City. Doan spent one season with the AHL Tucson Roadrunners and made his NHL debut for the Arizona Coyotes at Mullett Arena on March 27, 2024. Forty-eight skaters from the NCHC made NHL rosters. Along with those 48, another 12 alumni of NCHC teams, who didn't play in the NCHC (two of which are Daccord and Doan), landed a spot on opening-night rosters. In all, a total of 60 alumni from NCHC teams will begin the 2024-25 season on NHL rosters.

CONTENDING IN THE CONFERENCE Despite the slump in goal scoring, ASU leads the conference in shots on net through six games with 186. Sun Devil netminders have also had to make the most saves in the NCHC at 176 between Gibson Homer and Luke Pavicich.

Noah Beck is tied for the conference lead in points with nine. Bennett Schimek's eight points through six games is tied for second in the NCHC. Schimek also leads the conference in goals scored with four.

Cullen Potter leads the NCHC in shots followed by teammates Ryan Kirwan, Bennett Schimek,, and Noah Beck who own the second, sixth and 12th spots in the conference, respectively.

HEAD COACH GREG POWERS

Coach Powers enters his tenth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2024-25, and his 17th overall at the helm at ASU. He was a finalist for the 2019 and 2020 Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the Division I Coach of the Year. Coach Powers was also named the 2018-19 Frank Kush Sun Devil Coach of the Year, as voted on by the 26 head coaches at Arizona State. On July 7, 2022, Arizona State University and Greg Powers agreed to a five-year contract extension through the 2026-27 season. In 2023-24, Powers led the Sun Devils to a program record 24 wins on the season. Matthew Kopperud finished as an NCAA statistical leader with 17 power play goals. A true Sun Devil coached by Powers all four years of his NCAA career, Kopperud completed his time at ASU as the fourth-best career power play scorer in NCAA history with 41 through his four years in college. Lukas Sillinger also topped the charts in 2023-24 as he set the ASU program record in single season points (48). In the final year of Oceanside Arena, Powers coached ASU to five-straight wins versus USCHO.com Top-20 opponents for the first time in program history (the previous record for consecutive wins against ranked opponents was three-straight games). In 2021-22, the team boasted three of the top-10 scorers in the nation in Colin Theisen, Matthew Kopperud and Josh Doan. ASU scored 116 goals in 35 games for a 3.31 goals per game average, ranked No. 10 in the country. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their first-ever ACHA Division I National Championship. Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter

Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.



A HOME IN THE DESERT

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, 2020, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received for the
 commencement of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve as the future home for Sun
 Devil men's ice hockey and wrestling. This project continues the development of the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado
 Parkway on the east side of Packard Drive, immediately north of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction began in January 2021 and recieved its certificate of occupancy on Friday, September 30, 2022.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the north side of the arena.
 Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
- On February 14, 2022, ASU and the NHL's Arizona Coyotes formed the first agreement of its kind between a college and NHL team in 100 years. The last time an NCAA college team and an NHL team shared an arena was the Boston Bruins and Boston University from 1924-28 at Boston Arena, now known as Matthews Arena. Other improvements will now be made, at the Coyotes' expense, to prepare the arena to temporarily house Coyotes home games. These improvements include constructing coaches' rooms, equipment rooms, technology and other aspects of the new ASU arena according to NHL standards. The added cost is up to \$30 million, which will be paid in advance by the Coyotes.
- The 5,000-seat venue is managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for Mullett Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- · A 942-seat student section occupies the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.

This partnership with FOX 10 will bring our fans into new and exciting moments throughout the year. 




