SUN DEVIL REWIND

A slow start and Harvard's second-ranked powerplay ruined the Sun Devils' first game as a ranked team, as the Crimson won their first game at home, 4-1, last Friday night.

The Sun Devils bounced back on Saturday night, scoring a shorthanded goal to tie the game in the third period before killing a penalty to start overtime and followed it up with a goal, as sophomore forward Johnny Walker tipped a shot from freshman defenseman Josh Maniscalco for the game-winner in 2:45 into overtime.

Despite trailing for nearly half of the game and being shorthanded for a fourth of the game, the Sun Devils overcame adversity for the 3-2 victory over the Crimson thanks to fantastic performance by junior goaltender Joey Daccord and his 40 saves between the pipes.

ASU earned their fourth road win of the season, a figure that is twice as many as they had last season. The program captured its second consecutive split on an East Coast road trip after previously winning one of two against #6 Penn State (Nov. 2-3).

WE MEET AGAIN

For the second time this season, the Sun Devils will match up with Nebraska Omaha out of the NCHC. The first time the two sides matched up was a two-game series taking place Oct. 26-27 at Oceanside Ice Arena. On the weekend, ASU outscored the Mavericks, 13-5, to pick up their third series sweep of the season.

The wins against Omaha were also ASU's first-ever wins against an NCHC opponent. Sophomore forward JOHNNY WALKER compiled five points during the weekend, featuring a four-goal performance in game two Saturday night - his first collegiate hat trick. For his efforts, Walker was recognized as the third star as part of the NCAA's Three Stars of Week Four and ESPN's Best Player in the World of the Week in hockey.

Walker reached the eight-goal mark in the second game of the weekend, a feat he did not accomplish until Jan. 19 of last season on his way to a 17-goal freshman campaign. Senior forwards DYLAN HOLLMAN and ANTHONY CROSTON each contributed two goals during the high-scoring weekend.

1. This is the second meeting this season and fourth overall between @SunDevilHockey and @OmahaHKY.
2. @TheSunDevils rank in the top-20 in goals per game, goals against per game, shots per game, power play and penalty kill.
3. ASU's penalty kill continues to kill at an alarming rate, ranking second in the country at 89.6%.
4. Over the last 25 games dating back to last season, @jwalks96 has tallied 24 goals -- the most of any NCAA player in that stretch.

The Sun Devils captured their 10th win on Saturday night against Harvard, thus matching a program high for wins in a season which was accomplished in 2016-17.

PROGRAM FIRSTS

- Through the first six weeks of the season, ASU has continued to check off program firsts seemingly every week.
- In week one, the Sun Devils captured their first-ever home sweep with back-to-back wins over Alaska Fairbanks for their best start to a season at 2-0. ASU got scoring from 13 different players in the first two weekends, including points from five of six starting freshmen.
- In week two, ASU played a team ranked No. 1 for the first time, and both nights they pushed the top-ranked Buckeyes to the brink. Game one featured a 3-2 loss, while game two was a 3-0 loss that included a penalty shot goal and an empty-net goal for the Buckeyes.
- In week three, the Sun Devils hit the road to Alabama-Huntsville for the first time, and swept the Chargers for the first road sweep since December of 2016 -- and second ever.
- The two wins and best-ever start at the time at 4-2 earned Coach Powers and the Devils their first-ever vote in the USCHO top-20 poll in week three.
- Week four featured another series sweep -- the Sun Devils third of the short season -- against Nebraska Omaha, in which ASU outscored the Mavericks 13-5. Over the program's last three seasons, ASU totaled just two series' sweeps.
- The wins against Omaha were also ASU's first-ever wins against an NCHC opponent. They had three ties and six losses up until last weekend.
- In week five, the Sun Devils defeated a top-10 team for the first time in program history with a 4-3 overtime win over then-No. 6 Penn State. ASU had tied two top-10 teams two seasons ago, but never earned a true victory.
- In week six, the Sun Devils cracked the USCHO top-20 poll for the first time in program history at No. 18. It also represented their first-ever sweep of a Big Ten team.

KEEP ON WALKING

- After being held scoreless last weekend versus Michigan State, sophomore forward JOHNNY WALKER found his back into the score sheet, scoring the game winner in Saturday night's 3-2 overtime victory over Harvard.
- WALKER has six multi-point games and three multi-goal performances. In the last seven games, the Phoenix native has tallied eight goals. His 12 goals this season are three more than the next highest total in the country.
- In the first meeting between these two teams, WALKER was named ESPN's Best Player in the World of the Week in hockey after his five-point weekend -- and four-goal game -- in a 7-2 victory on Saturday night.
- WALKER returns this season after a record-breaking 2017-18 season for the Sun Devils in which he tallied a new school record with 17 goals. That was also good enough for second in the country among freshmen goal scorers.
- WALKER finished the season on a five-game goal streak with eight goals and an assist during that stretch, which he carried over into this season. He scored in each of the first three games this season to extend his streak to eight games.
- Over the last 27 games dating back to last season, WALKER has scored 25 goals.

WELL ROUNDED

- While Walker is all the commotion with his on-ice antics and offensive prowess, the Sun Devils have been well balanced offensively with nine additional players recording two or more goals so far this season. All but four players have scored a goal thus far, two of which being defensemen with the other two playing three games or less this season.
- Redshirt senior DYLAN HOLLMAN is one of those making a big impact in a short span, as he sits second on the team in goals scored with seven -- the most he's ever recorded in a single season and he's only 14 games in. His three-goal weekend against then-No. 6 Penn State extended his goal streak to five-straight games with all six coming in those contests. After ending his goal streak versus Michigan State, Hollman bounced back with a goal and an assist in the Sun Devils 3-2 overtime win on Saturday at Harvard.
- 11 different players have seven or more points so far through 13 games.
- JORDAN SANDHU ranks tied for 12th in the country in points among freshmen with nine, while PJ MARROCCO ranks tied for 19th with eight, and DEMETRIOS KOUMONTZIS is tied for 26th with seven. MARROCCO is tied for 9th in goals with four -- two shy of the lead -- while JORDAN SANDHU sits tied for fourth in assists (8) and KOUMONTZIS is tied for 15th (6).

RETURN OF THE DESERT HOCKEY CLASSIC

- After a year removed, the Desert Hockey Classic, presented by Raymond James, returns with one of the best tournament fields in the country, including 2018 NCAA Frozen Four champion Minnesota Duluth, WCHA powerhouse Minnesota State, and 2018 tournament team Clarkson.
- Duluth and Minnesota State will square off in a rematch of last year's regional semifinal in game one on Friday, Oct. 28 at 4:30 p.m. ASU will take on Clarkson in game two at 7:30 p.m. on Pac-12 Network. ASU will play in the later game on Saturday no matter the result on the Pac-12 Networks as well.
- The tournament returns to Gila River Arena after being hosted in Prescott back in 2016-17.
- The last two tournament champions have included Michigan Tech in 2015-16 and UCONN in 2016-17.

EXTRA SPECIAL

- Special teams for the Sun Devils have been a contributing factor in their early success so far this season.
- The penalty kill had been nearly perfect until Friday night where they gave up multiple powerplay goals for the first time since game one against then-No. 1 Ohio State. They now rank 2nd in the country with a 89.8% kill rate.
- On the other side of special teams, the Sun Devil man advantage has capitalized on 14 of their 70 attempts. The 70 attempts are the second most in the country, while the 14 power play goals is tied for 6th nationally.

RECORD BREAKING YEAR

- Junior defenseman BRINSON PASICHNUK's 26 points outdid teammate ANTHONY CROSTON's 21 point performance in 2016-17. Former graduate transfer ROBBIE BAILLARGEON also recorded 21 points that season as well.
- Junior forward BRETT GRUBER's 20 assists also set a new bar for apples in a season, as he finished his sophomore campaign with 25 points overall -- good for second on the team.

MORE FIREPOWER

- For the second-straight season, head coach GREG POWERS and the Sun Devils' coaching staff brought in a top-20 recruiting class.
- The 2018-19 class features another NHL draft pick in Calgary Flames' 2018 fourth-rounder DEMETRIOS KOUMONTZIS from Edina, Minn. The 18-year-old grew up in Phoenix and even played for the Phoenix Jr. Coyotes here in the Valley before moving to Minnesota for his senior year of high school at Edina High. KOUMONTZIS completed one of the best seasons the Minnesota High School Elite League has ever seen from a statistical standpoint with a league-leading 49 points in 21 games. The included tying for the league lead in goals as well (16).
- The rest of the class features the Sun Devils' first player from the U.S. National Team Development Program in two-way defenseman JOSH MANISCALCO, speedsters JORDAN SANDHU and PJ MARROCCO, shut-down d-men JARROD GOURLEY and CONNOR STUART, and technical goaltender EVAN DeBROUWER.
- This year also includes the debut of redshirt freshman AUSTIN LEMIEUX, who will suit up in the maroon and gold for the first time after leading the USPHL in scoring two seasons ago.

FAMILIAR FACES

- ASU's JOSH MANISCALCO shared the ice with Omaha's Nathan Knoepke and Tyler Weiss with the USNTDP Juniors and U.S. National U18 Team in 2016-17, as well as with Knoepke the previous year with the U.S. National U17 Team in 2015-16.
- MANISCALCO also played with Maverick Chayse Primeau in Dubuque (USHL) last season.
- Way back in 2014-15, MANISCALCO and ASU's GAGE MACKIE played with Omaha senior defenseman Jordan Klehr at prestigious Shattuck St. Mary's High School.
- For part of the 2013-14 season and the entirety of the 2014-15 season, ASU senior LOUIE ROWE and Maverick senior Steven Spinner played together in Omaha for the Lancers (USHL).

POWERING UP

Coach Powers enters his fourth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2018-19, and his 11th overall at the helm at ASU. The 2017-18 campaign finished at 8-21-5 against the nation's 24th-toughest schedule, but what the record doesn't show is the progression made with the young program. The Devils had nine losses occurring either in overtime, by one goal or featured an empty-net goal against in the final minutes. Not to mention a program-high five ties. During the 2016-17 campaign, Powers led the Devils to double-digit victories at 10-19-3, doubling his victories year-to-year. In the inaugural NCAA season, ASU finished 10-23-5 in 2015 and 5-22-2 in NCAA play under Powers. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their first-ever ACHA Division I National Championship. He holds a 201-98-23 career record at ASU.

Along with assistant coaches Alex Hicks and Mike Field, the Sun Devils welcomed their second straight top-20 recruiting class in just their fourth season as an NCAA program.

Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.
