MAKIN' A SPLASH

- The Sun Devils cruised to a 157-105 in the season opener against Washington State on Oct. 16, showing a dangerous balance of veteran leadership and young talent. In their collegiate debuts, Elli Straume, Charli Brown, Riley Lexvold, Hana Edwards, Iza Adame and Emma Gehlert all earned top-three finishes in their respective races. Redshirt seniors Emma Nording and Erica Laning also tallied wins in the 1000 and 200 freestyles, respectively.
- Adame and Brown, two highly-touted high school recruits, have made immediate impacts upon their arrival to Tempe, with each already owning top times in the 100 breast and 400 IM, respectively.
- The benefits from redshirting the entire roster last season are becoming more and more apparent, as the redshirt freshmen class, making their Sun Devil debuts this season, shined in the opener against Washington State. Riley Lexvold and Elli Straume looked polished and poised, with the former owning the school's top times this season in the 50, 100 and 200 back.
- Redshirt senior Emma Nordin, who was named to the 2021-22 USA National Swimming Team in the offseason, made it look easy against the Cougars, winning her two races in the 1000 and 500. Nordin owned the nation's fastest time in the 500 free in 2020.
- The win against the Cougars marked the Sun Devils' first regular season win since a 181-103 pummeling of the Arizona Wildcats on Feb. 8, 2020.
- With the 157-105 win at Washington State on Oct. 16 to open the regular season, the Sun Devils are now 5-0 in season openers under head coach Bob Bowman. The last time the Sun Devils opened a season 2-0 came in 2017-18.

Scouting the Opposition

UCLA

- The Bruins opened conference play last weekend with a decisive 169-91 win over Washington State to move to 2-0. They won 11 of 14 events, with eight different swimmers earning wins. The Bruins' youth movement helped lead the way, as freshmen Paige MacEachern, Mia Chang and Eva Carlson all tallied wins.
- The Bruins are fresh off one of their best seasons in more than a decade, as their third-place finish at last season's Pac-12 Championships was the school's highest placing since a runner-up effort in 2006.
- All nine Bruins who traveled to the NCAA Championships last spring are back in the Blue & Gold for UCLA this season.
- It's been two years since these two schools last met, when the Bruins narrowly pulled out a 156-142 win in Tempe on Nov. 2, 2019.

No. 17 USC

- The No. 17 Trojans cruised to a season-opening 161-93 win over Washington State on Oct. 29. Freshman Marlene Kahler won both the 500 and 1000 yard free.
- The 2021-22 Trojans received a boost with the return of Laticia Transom, the 2020 Pac-12 100 and 200 yard free champion, who was sidelined all of last season due to an injury.
- Sophomores Anicka Delgado and Marlene Kahler, who hail from Ecuador and Austria, respectively, both competed in this summer's Tokyo Olympics.
- After a fifth-place finish at last season's Pac-12 Championships, the Trojans returned all but three for this year, including the defending two-time Pac-12 breaststroke champion Kaitlyn Dobler.

New Kids On The Block

Thirteen of the 27 on the roster had yet to compete at the collegiate level entering this season. Five were true freshmen who debuted against Washington State on Oct. 16.

Olympic Trial Experience

The Sun Devils were more represented at this summer's Olympic Trials than ever before under head coach Bob Bowman, as Ruby Martin, Nora Deleske, Lindsay Looney, Erica Laning and Emma Nordin all participated in the events.

Worldwide Devils

The Sun Devils continued to be represented by countries all around the world.

On the roster, there are seven international student-athletes. Charli Brown and Molly Batchelor are from Australia, Hana Edwards and Pilar McCann are from Canada, Marte Lovberg is from Norway, Natalia Fryckowska is from Poland and Jane Brown is from Great Britain.

Last Time We Saw Them

The last time the Sun Devils were in action -- prior to the 2021-22 season -- was in March 2020 at the Pac-12 Championships in Washington.

The remainder of the 2020 season was cancelled soon thereafter, and the coaching staff opted to redshirt the entire roster for the 2020-21 season. It had been 616 days in between regular season meets for the Sun Devils.

Preseason Honors

The Sun Devils were ranked No. 22 in the College Swimming and Diving Coaches Association of America's preseason rankings. Four teams from the Pac-12 Conference rounded out the list, as the Sun Devils were joined by No. 2 Stanford, No. 6 California and No. 17 Southern California.

The Sun Devils will welcome the Trojans to Tempe on Nov. 6 for a top-25 showdown.

Career Leaders

Emma Nordin owns the top times in program history in each of the 200 and 500 freestyles. She's also second in the 1650 free and third in the 1000 free.

Lindsay Looney owns the school's top three times in the 200 butterfly. She earned the program record on Feb. 8, 2020, with a 1:55.39 finish against Arizona.

Tempe's Flyest

Redshirt sophomores Jade Foelske and Lindsay Looney are teaming up to be quite the one-two punch in the butterfly races. They earned top-two finishes in each of the 100 and 200 fly events and were separated by less than one second in each.

Good grief, Charli Brown!

The Australian true freshman Charli Brown was fantastic for the Sun Devils in the season-opening win over Washington State.

En route to racking up the fifth-most points across both schools, Brown won the 400 yard IM (4:24.38), finished first in the 400 medley relay and added a second-place finish in the 200 yard freestyle race.

Home, Sweet Home

When the Sun Devils welcome the UCLA Bruins and USC Trojans to the Mona Plummer Aquatic Center on Nov. 5-6, it will serve as the first home meet in 636 days.

The last time fans saw Bowman's Sun Devils in action came on Feb. 8, 2020, when they toppled the Arizona Wildcats, 181-103.
