# **QUICK HITS**

## **Last Weekend**

For the final time this season, Sun Devil Volleyball is home to host Colorado on Friday in the Salute to Service game before taking on No. 16 Utah on Sunday for Senior Day, honoring Jamye Cox. The Sun Devils look to bounce back after dropping both matches against the Washington schools over the weekend.

## Iman Isanovic

Junior outside hitter Iman Isanovic had a career-high 28 kills while hitting a season-high clip of .426 in the matchup with WSU on Sunday. Isanovic is currently on a nine-match streak of reaching double digits in kills, and is second in the Pac-12 in kills.

## **No Sophomore Slump Here**

Being a factor on offense and defense, sophomore pin hitter Marta Levinska had her 10th double-double of the season on Sunday, finishing with 12 kills and 10 digs. Levinska also was the team leader in digs with 13 against Washington. Another sophomore, setter Ella Snyder notched her 10th match this season reaching 40 or more assists over the weekend. She has 882 assists this fall, good for third in the Pac-12 in overall assists.

## They Can Dig It

The libero duties this past weekend were split between junior Annika Larson and grad Jamye Cox. Larson remains second in the Pac-12 with digs where she has 361 on the season and has reached 20 or more digs in six matches. On Sunday, Cox had 10 digs and four assists, which was her third time reaching double figures in digs as a Sun Devil and matched her career high in assists.

## **Beware of Claire**

Sophomore middle blocker Claire Jeter leads the team in blocks this season with 99. She had seven along with five kills on Friday and three on Sunday. In addition to her high blocking numbers, she is third on the team in total kills with 227.

## Scouting the Opposition Colorado (13-9, 5-9 Pac-12)

- Over the weekend, the Buffaloes defeated USC in four sets on Friday but were swept by No. 13 UCLA on Sunday during a homestand.
- This season, the Buffs have two ranked wins, one coming against No. 16 Utah in conference play. One of the team leaders is libero Brynna DeLuzio; she is first in the Pac-12 in total digs with 397.
- Arizona State last played Colorado on Oct. 24 in Boulder where they won in four sets. Four Sun Devils reached double figures in kills and digs that match along with three Sun Devils earning double-doubles. The alltime series record is tied at 11-11.

## Utah (16-7, 9-5 Pac-12)

- Last weekend, Utah split its two matches hosted at home in Salt Lake City. The Utes dropped a five set match to No. 13 UCLA on Friday night but defeated USC in four sets on Sunday. This fall, Utah has five ranked wins this season, including a season sweep over a ranked Oregon team.
- Fifth year outside hitter Dani Drews leads the Utes in kills with 426 this season and leads the Pac-12 in kills with that number. She has been the Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week twice, as well as the national player of the week back in September.
- The Sun Devils upset the then-No. 18
   Utes on Oct. 22 on the road in four sets. It
   was the first career win over Utah for head
   coach Sanja Tomasevic and the second win
   over a ranked opponent at that point.

## Weekly Awards

Junior outside hitter Iman Isanovic was named Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 25, and on Oct. 26 she was the Sports Imports/AVCA Player of the Week. It was the first offensive player of the week nod for ASU since 2018 and the first national weekly award since 2015.

## **New Kids On The Block**

There are eight new faces on the roster: five freshmen and three transfers. Of the five freshmen, one is a libero, two are outside hitters, one is a setter and one is a middle blockers. The transfers include two middle blockers and one libero.

## **National Team Experience**

Over the summer, Sun Devil Volleyball pin hitters Iman Isanovic and Marta Levinska played for their national teams in their home countries of Bosnia-Herzegovina and Latvia, respectively. Isanovic helped her team earn a bid for the European Women's Volleyball Championship for the first time ever.

## **Worldwide Sun Devils**

The Sun Devils continued to be represented by countries all around the world. On the coaching staff, head coach Sanja Tomasevic is from Serbia and associate head coach Carlos Moreno is from Brazil.

On the roster, there are six international studentathletes. Jinna Zeng is from Canada, Ayyuce Altintas is from Turkey, Iman Isanovic is from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Marta Levinska is from Latvia, Roberta Rabelo is from Brazil and Beatrice Badini is from Italy.

## 2020-21 Recap

In the fourth season under head coach Sanja Tomasevic, the Sun Devils competed in 20 matches, all against Pac-12 opponents. The team went 6-14 on the year and finished in ninth place in the conference. The roster was made up of primarily underclassmen (82 percent), eight student-athletes making their Division I NCAA volleyball debut.

Arizona State earned two wins over ranked opponents in the 2020-21 season, beating Sweet Sixteen teams Washington and Oregon. The Sun Devils made history at Stanford this season, winning there for the first time since 1982.

## Pac-12 Honors in 2020-21

A few Sun Devils made a splash in conference play in the spring. Iman Isanovic was named to the All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention list last season. Marta Levinska made the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team after being named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week twice.

## **Career Leaders**

On this young squad, junior Iman Isanovic has the highest career numbers in multiple categories. She has 481 kills and 35 aces. Junior Annika Larson has 387 career digs and junior Shannon Shields has 558 career assists.

## **Tried and True**

The roster features 12 returning letterwinners, including the kill leaders (Isanovic and Levinska), digs leader (Annika Larson) and assists leader (Ella Snyder). Seven Sun Devils who started in a match last season are returning.

## Pac-12 Preseason Poll

The Sun Devils were picked to finish 11th in the Pac-12 preseason poll. ASU finished the 2020-21 season in 9th place. Washington was picked to win the conference.


