Meet Minutes

- After a 10-day rest, the West Virginia University gymnastics team gears up for a tri meet at No. 21 Arizona State, with No. 14 BYU, on Wednesday, March 13, at 9:30 p.m. EST, at Wells Fargo Arena in Tempe, Arizona.
 WVU opens the meet on uneven bars for the fourth time this season. WVU is 5-3 when starting on uneven bars. The Mountaineers' complete rotation order is: uneven bars, balance beam, floor exercise, vault.
- WVU is 7-3 in tri meets this season.
- WVU reached double-digit wins in just six meets, the fastest under eighth year coach Jason Butts, and the quickest since earning 10 victories in five meets in 2010.
- The Mountaineers' current win total of 16 is the team's top win mark since earning 21 in 2012, coach Jason Butts' first season.
- After re-entering the national rankings at No. 24 on Feb. 25, the Mountaineers sit at No. 28 in the Road to Nationals Rankings this week with a National Qualifying Score (NQS) of 195.635.
- Two Mountaineers own a combined three national rankings. Kirah Koshinski ranks No. 10 on vault (9.905 NQS) and No. 17 on floor exercise (9.915 NQS), and Jaquie Tun ranks No. 39 on floor (9.89 NQS).
- Fourteen Mountaineers have competed in at least one meet. Senior Kirah Koshinski is the most experienced Mountaineer, having competed in 49 career meets.
- Currently, a freshman or sophomore is featured in 12 of the Mountaineers' 24 lineup positions.
- WVU has hit 24-of-24 routines five times this season (Jan. 12, Feb. 2, Feb. 10, Feb. 22, Mar. 2).
- Nine of the 14 Mountaineers who have competed this season have reached the podium. Kirah Koshinski paces WVU with 20 podium finishes and 12 event wins, while Jaquie Tun shows 13 podium finishes (six wins), and Abby Kaufman shows 11 (two wins).

WVU vs. Arizona State

- WVU is 2-2 all-time against the Sun Devils.
- Last season, No. 16 WVU dropped a 196.475 195.875 decision to No. 14 ASU at the WVU Coliseum on Jan. 14.
- The teams also competed at the 2018 NCAA University Park Regional Championships on April 7, in University Park, Pennsylvania. ASU finished third (195.75), and WVU placed sixth (194.4).
- WVU has competed in Tempe just once before, falling to the Sun Devils, 195.875 190.6 in 1998.

WVU vs. BYU

• WVU is 0-1 all-time against the Cougars, losing 185.2 - 184.05, in a six-team meet at Georgia in 1990.

A Look at the Field

- The Sun Devils are coming off a third place, 194.825 showing at No. 6 Denver on March 10. The mark was a season low for ASU, who lost to the Pioneers (197.675) and No. 18 Nebraska (196.225) and defeated Pitt (194.2). Sophomore Cairo Leonard-Baker finished fourth in the all-around with a 39.05 score.
- Associate head coach Jessica Santos (Bartgis) competed for WVU from 2001-05. She scored a 10.0 on vault in 2004, the last Mountaineer gymnast to achieve the perfect mark.
- BYU topped No. 11 Boise State, 197.0 196.325, on March 7 in Boise, Idaho. The 197.0 score was the Cougars' first since 2004. Junior Shannon Evans won the all-around with a career-best 39.575 and is the reigning Mountain Rim Gymnastics Conference (MRGC) Gymnast of the Week.

The Mountaineers are 12-3 on the road this season and 0-4 against ranked teams ... coach Jason Butts earned his 100th career victory at Penn on Feb. 10 and boasts a career coaching record of 107-72-1 ... Kirah Koshinski paces WVU with 1,413.225 career points and needs 5.55 points to break onto the WVU Career Points Top 20 List and 86.775 to reach the 1,500 career-point plateau ... Abby Kaufman ranks No. 2 on the team with 893.35 career points, and Jaquie Tun follows with 876.975 points ... Julia Merwin shows 457.625 career points and needs 42.375 points to reach the 500 career-point plateau ... McKenna Linnen shows 370.05 career points and needs 129.95 points to reach the 500 career-point plateau ... Koshinski ranks No. 2 in program history with 43 career scores of 9.9 or better ... she needs five more scores to match TeShawne Jackson's (2000-03) program record of 48 ... Koshinski is tied with TeShawne Jackson (2000-03) at No. 1 in program history with 23 career vault scores of 9.9 or better and needs one more to establish a program record ... she has scored 9.9 or better 20 times on floor and ranks alone at No. 2 ... Koshinski needs one more floor score of 9.9 or better to match TeShawne Jackson's (2000-03) school record of 21 ... Koshinski paces WVU with 44 career wins.

2019 Meet Recaps

Meet 1: WVU at the Cancun Classic (1/4) WVU opened the 2019 season with a third place, 194.15 showing at the Cancun Classic in Cancun, Mexico. No. 9 Michigan won the meet (196.05), Iowa State finished second (194.275) and Rutgers placed fourth (189.8).

WVU won balance beam (48.775) and floor exercise (49.05) and finished third on vault (48.8) and uneven bars (47.525). Kirah Koshinski earned WVU's lone event victory, scoring 9.925 on floor. She also paced the team on vault (9.8) and finished sixth overall. Esperanza Abarca and Rachel Hornung paced on bars and beam, respectively, with 9.8 scores.

Meet 2: No. 22 WVU at Pitt with Utah State and Eastern Michigan (1/12)

WVU swept the competition at Pitt, scoring 195.5 and finishing first on floor (49.275), vault (49.2) and uneven bars (48.775). WVU placed third on balance beam (48.25). Pitt finished second (194.75), Utah State placed third (194.6) and Eastern Michigan finished fourth (192.7).

Kirah Koshinski and Jaquie Tun tied for first on floor with 9.9 scores. Koshinski also won vault with a 9.925. Esperanza Abarca paced WVU on uneven bars and finished second with a 9.8, while Rachel Hornung finished fourth on beam with a 9.7. Abby Kaufman placed second in the all-around with a 38.925 total

Meet 3: WVU at Air Force with Cortland (1/19)

WVU swept its second meet of the season with a first place, 194.75 score. Air Force finished second (193.675), and Cortland placed third (180 475) WVU finished first on yault (48 85) uneven bars (48.425) and floor exercise (48.85), and second on balance beam (48.625).

Kirah Koshinski matched her career-best vault score of 9.95 for the win and also tied Falcon Tyler Davis for the floor win with a 9.85. Esperanza Abarca scored 9.8 on uneven bars and earned her first career victory, while Rachel Hornung took the balance beam crown with a career-best 9.825. Abby Kaufman again finished second in the all-around (38.7).

Meet 4: WVU vs. George Washington and Kent State (1/27)

WVU earned its third consecutive sweep with a 194.925 showing in its home season opener at the WVU Coliseum. WVU finished first on floor (49.25) and vault (48.875). The Mountaineers also finished second on balance beam (48.275) and third on uneven bars (48.525).

Kirah Koshinski scored 9.9 on vault and floor for the event wins. Jaquie Tun matched the floor score and also tied Esperanza Abarca on bars with a winning 9.8 score. Carly Galpin tied for first on balance beam with a season-best 9.8, and Abby Kaufman finished second in the all-around with a 38.775 total.

Meet 5: WVU vs. No. 7 Denver and Iowa State (2/2)

WVU tallied a season-best 196.125 in a third-place finish, as the Pioneers placed first (197.45) and Iowa State finished second (196.7). WVU's final total was aided by a 49.375 on floor exercise, the 13th-best mark in program history. WVU also earned 48.975 on uneven bars and 48.85 on balance beam, as well as

Kirah Koshinski earned her fifth consecutive floor win with a 9.925. She also placed second on vault with a 9.9 and third on beam with a career-best 9.875. Kendra Combs paced WVU on bars with a career-best 9.85 and finished fifth. Abby Kaufman placed sixth in the all-around (38.925).

Meet 6: WVU at Penn with Temple and Bridgeport (2/10) WVU earned its fourth sweep of the season with a 195.25 score at The Palestra in Philadelphia. Bridgeport finished second (194.775), Penn placed third (193.825) and Temple finished fourth (193.575).

A WVU gymnast earned a share of three event victories. Abby Kaufman and McKenna Linnen earned their first career wins on vault (9.75) and balance beam (9.85), respectively.

Jaquie Tun scored a career-high 9.925 on floor for the victory, and Julia Merwin paced on uneven bars with a career-high 9.825. Kaufman finished second in the all-around (38.825).

Meet 7: WVU vs. Pitt, Utah State and Cornell (2/17)

The Mountaineers tallied 195.575 in a second-place finish at the WVU Coliseum. Utah State finished first (196.075), Pitt placed third (195.1) and Cornell finished fourth (193.075). WVU won floor and uneven bars with season-high scores of 49.5 and 49.175, respectively. The floor score matched the fifth-best mark in program history. The Mountaineers also scored 48.925 on vault and 47.975 on balance beam.

Kirah Koshinski scored a career-high 9.975 on floor for the win and also placed third on vault (9.825). Jaquie Tun won uneven bars with a career-high matching 9.875, and McKenna Linnen and Esperanza Abarca placed fourth on balance beam with 9.75s. Abby Kaufman finished second in the all-around with a career-high 39.225.

Meet 8: WVU at Pitt with Ball State (2/22)

WVU overcame an early deficit to earn its fifth meet sweep of the season and third victory over Pitt with a 195.65 score inside Fitzgerald Field House. The Mountaineers opened with a third place, 48,625 on balance beam before taking the wins on floor exercise (49.0), vault (49.075) and uneven bars (48.95).

Kirah Koshinski earned wins on vault (9.95) and floor (9.9). Koshinski's vault score matched her career high. Jaquie Tun tied for the win on uneven bars with a 9.85, and Taylor Sell paced on balance beam and finished fourth overall with a career-high 9.775. Abby Kaufman earned her first career all-around victory

Meet 9: WVU vs. No. 1 Oklahoma (2/24)

In its lone dual meet of the season, WVU dropped a 197.15 - 195.35 decision to the top-ranked Sooners inside the WVU Coliseum. The Mountaineers finished second on every event. scoring 49.1 on floor exercise, 48.925 on uneven bars, 48.75 on balance beam and 48.575 on vault.

Kirah Koshinski earned the team's lone event win with a 9.925 on floor. She also tied Jaquie Tun for seventh place on vault (9.75). Tun paced WVU on bars and finished fourth (9.85), a placement matched by Esperanza Abarca on balance beam (9.825). Abby Kaufman finished third in the all-around (38.875).

Meet 10: No. 24 WVU at No. 23 Ohio State with Temple (3/2) A season high on balance beam and a season-best road score on uneven bars helped push the Mountaineers to a second place, 196.1 showing at St. John Arena in Columbus, Ohio. The Buckeyes finished first (196.85), and Temple finished third (194.0). WVU tied for first on vault (49.05) and finished second on uneven bars (48.975), balance beam (48.975) and floor exercise (49.1).

Kirah Koshinski tallied a career-high 39.35 and finished second in the all-around, while Abby Kaufman finished fourth with a 39.175. Koshinski also finished a team-best second on vault (9.85) and floor exercise (9.875). She and Kaufman, along with Taylor Sell, paced WVU on balance beam and finished fifth overall with 9.825s, and Jaquie Tun finished fourth on uneven bars with a
