### TERRIERS SET FOR DESERT HOCKEY CLASSIC

- The No. 6 Boston University men's ice hockey team will open 2023 with a trip to Tempe as the Terriers take part in the Desert Hockey Classic at Arizona State on Friday and Saturday.
- BU will face Air Force on Friday at 3:30 p.m. local time (5:30 ET) and then face the winner of the Arizona State-Michigan Tech game on Saturday at either 3:30 or 7 p.m. local time.
- Arizona State will be playing at 7 p.m. on both days regardless of result.

### NOT OUR FIRST TRIP TO ARIZONA

- This will be the Terriers' second trip to Arizona State, as BU traveled to Tempe in Jan. 2018.
- The Terriers swept the Sun Devils, earning an 8-0 win and a 4-3 win that weekend.
- BU will be playing in its third rink in Arizona, as the Terriers faced ASU at both the Gila River Arena, then the home of the NHL's Arizona Coyotes, as well as Oceanside Ice Arena.
- This weekend's games will take place at the brand new Mullett Arena, home to both Arizona State and the Covotes.

### HISTORY WITH AIR FORCE

- BU and Michigan Tech have met 14 times but this will be the first time the two schools have faced off since Nov. 26, 1988, when the Terriers earned a 6-4 win at Walter Brown Arena.
- Michigan Tech leads the all-time series at 9-5-0, including a 6-0-0 record at neutral sites.

### **SCOUTING THE HUSKIES**

- No. 16 Michigan Tech enters the weekend at 12-6-3 overall after finishing third at the Great Lakes Invitational.
- The Huskies defeated then-No. 11 Michigan State, 3-2, in overtime after an 8-1 loss to then-No. 18 Western Michigan the previous day.
- Junior Ryland Mosley leads Michigan Tech in goals (9), assists (12) and points (21).
- Freshman Kyle Kukkonen is second on the squad with 14 points on seven goals and seven assists.
- Senior goaltender Blake Pietila has started 19 of the Huskies' 21 games, posting a 2.19 goals-against average and a .922 save percentage.

### HISTORY WITH ARIZONA STATE

### RECAPPING A THRILLER AT WALLY B

- Senior captain Domenick Fensore scored with 31.8 seconds to play in overtime to lift BU past No. 9 Harvard, 2-1, on Dec. 30 at Walter Brown Arena.
- Playing in front of a sold-out crowd at Walter Brown for the first time since Jan. 2, 2005, the Terriers never trailed, as freshman Quinn Hutson opened the scoring just 2:02 into the proceedings.
- Seniors Wilmer Skoog and Matt Brown assisted on Fensore's winner, with Brown's backcheck to deny a Harvard breakaway setting the stage for the winning rush.
- Freshmen Devin Kaplan and Ryan Greene assisted on Hutson's seventh goal of the season.
- Junior goaltender Drew Commesso was outstanding for the Terriers, turning aside 33 shots, including nine on the penalty kill.

### ANOTHER RANKED FOE ON DECK?

- The Terriers' tough schedule will continue this weekend, as they have a chance to face a ranked opponent for the 13th time this season if they face No. 16 Michigan Tech.
- BU improved to 5-1-0 against top-10 opponents this season with its 2-1 win over then-No. 9 Harvard on Dec. 30.
- It was the Terriers' second straight win over a top-10 foe, as they bested then-No. 8 UConn, 3-2, on Dec. 11 in their final game before the holiday break.
- The Terriers enter Friday with a 9-3 record against ranked teams this season.

### **ENDING THE YEAR ON A HIGH NOTE**

- Not including the 2020-21 season, which started in January, BU has closed out the calendar year with a win in each of the last eight seasons beginning with the 2014-15 campaign.
- The Terriers have outscored their opponents, 40-13, in those eight victories, including their 2-1 overtime win over Harvard on Dec. 30.

### THREE BOSTON RINKS, THREE OT WINS

- All three of the Terriers' overtime wins this season have been in Boston, though they've been in three different rinks.
- BU earned a 2-1 OT win over then-No. 18 UMass Lowell at Agganis Arena on Oct. 29, then secured a 4-3 overtime victory at then-No. 18/16 Northeastern on Nov. 19.
- The Terriers most recently bested then-No. 9 Harvard, 2-1, in overtime on Dec. 30 at Walter Brown Arena.
- All three overtime goals were scored by defensemen, as freshman Lane Hutson tallied the winners against Lowell and Northeastern while senior Domenick Fensore potted the winner against Harvard.

### FENSORE NAMED DEFENDER OF THE MONTH

- Senior captain Domenick Fensore was named Hockey East Defender of the Month on Wednesday.
- Fensore was the best defenseman in the league and perhaps the entire country last month as he led the Terriers to a 4-1-0 December record.
- He led all league blue liners in goals (4) and points (7) and tallied a league-best three game-winning goals, with two of the three winners coming in the third period or overtime, including a goal in OT to push BU past No. 9 Harvard on Dec. 30.
- Fensore generated a league-high 26 shots on goal and was the only Hockey East player to average over five shots on goal per game (5.20).
- He ended the month on a seven game point streak (6g, 4a), scoring a goal in five of those seven contests.
- For the season, Fensore has scored a career-high seven goals and added nine assists for 16 points. He played in his 100th career game as a Terrier on Dec. 9 and enters this weekend having totaled 17 goals and 54 assists for 71 points.
- This is the third straight month that a Terrier has been named Hockey East Defender of the Month, as freshman Lane Hutson earned that honor in October and November.

### FENSORE ALSO EARNS WEEKLY HONOR

- In addition to his Defender of the Month award, Fensore was tabbed as the league's Defender of the Week on Monday.
- In Friday's 2-1 OT win over then-No. 9 Harvard, Fensore scored the game-winning goal during his third shift of the OT period on one of his team-high seven SOG.
- Fensore also led BU with three blocked shots in a complete 60-minute performance.

### **QUINNING TIME**

- Freshman Quinn Hutson scored his seventh goal of the season in the Terriers' 2-1 overtime win over then-No. 9 Harvard.
- He is now tied for second on the squad in goals and fifth on the team in points, having tallied seven goals and six assists for 13 points.
- Five of Hutson's points (4g, 1a) came in December as he helped BU go 4-1-0.
- Four of his seven goals have either tied the game or given BU the lead.

### **HUSTON SKATING AT WORLD JUNIORS**

- Freshman Lane Hutson (North Barrington, Ill.) was named to the U.S. Junior National Team that is currently at the 2023 World Junior Championship in Moncton, New Brunswick, and Halifax, Nova Scotia.
- Hutson enters Thursday's bronze medal game against Sweden having tallied one goal and two assists for three points.
- He is also a plus-3.
- The two-time Hockey East Defender of the Month is third among NCAA defensemen with an average of 1.13 points per game.
- He is also tied for sixth among all blue liners and first among NCAA rookie defensemen with 18 points on seven goals and 11 assists.
- Hutson leads all Hockey East defensemen in goals and points and is first among all league rookies in assists and points.
- He has a pair of three-assist games to his credit and leads BU with three gamewinning goals, including two in overtime.

### **BROWN KEEPS ROLLING**

- Senior Matt Brown leads BU in goals (8), assists (16) and points (24) after assisting on the overtime-winning goal last Friday against then-No. 9 Harvard.
- He finished the first semester with a five-point weekend, including a one-goal, three-assist effort at BC on Dec. 9.
- Brown also had the primary assist on Wilmer Skoog's game-winning goal at then-No. 8 UConn on Dec. 11.
- Brown tallied seven goals and 10 assists for 17 points all of last season.
- Dec. 9 was the second time this season that Brown has tallied four points in a game, as he scored two goals and added two assists in a 5-2 triumph over UConn on Oct. 22.
- Brown ranks fifth nationally and first in Hockey East with an average of 1.41 points per game.
- His 24 total points is second in Hockey East.
- He has notched 11 points (3g, 8a) over the last seven games.
- Brown became the first Terrier to reach double digits in points when he assisted on Hutson's tying goal on Oct. 29 against UMass Lowell.

- Freshman Ryan Greene is fifth among Hockey East rookies with 15 points, tied for seventh among league freshmen with six goals and tied for fifth among first-year skaters with nine assists.
- Greene is one of just four league rookies to average at least one point per game.
- A native of Paradise, Newfoundland and Labrador, Greene has been named both Hockey East Rookie of the Week (Oct. 3) and Hockey East Player of the Week (Nov. 14).
- He was instrumental in a November sweep of then-No. 11/10 UMass, recording five points (2g, 3a) in a 7-2 road win before opening the scoring in a 5-1 home victory to complete a six-point weekend.
- Greene also tallied two assists in a 6-3 win at New Hampshire this past weekend and scored the goal that forced overtime in a 4-3 victory at then-No. 18/16 Northeastern on Nov. 19.

### **POLL POSITION**

- BU enters Friday ranked sixth in both national polls, matching their highest ranking of the season.
- BU was also No. 6 in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll on Dec. 5.
- The Terriers have faced six schools that are currently in the top 20 of both polls, including three currently in the top 10 of
- BU will face (or in the case of Michigan Tech, potentially face) an additional four teams that are currently ranked.
- BU has faced or will face every team ranked No. 7-11 in this week's polls.
- Seven preseason top-20 teams in total will visit either Agganis or Walter Brown Arena this season and BU will play 29 games against teams receiving at least one vote in either preseason national poll.

### **GOALS FROM EVERYWHERE**

- Through 17 games this season, 17 different Terriers have scored a goal and 18 different Terriers have recorded at least one point.
- All 18 of those Terriers have notched at least two points.

### **RECENT SUCCESS AT AGGANIS**

- BU is 13-4-2 in its last 19 games at Agganis Arena, with three of the four losses coming in overtime.
- In fact, Northeastern was the first team since UMass Lowell on Oct. 29, 2021 to earn a regulation win at Agganis when the Huskies earned a 2-0 victory on Nov. 18.
- BU will be on an extended break from its home rink, however, as the Terriers don't play at Agganis again until they begin a five-game homestand on Jan. 11.

### **SCORING IN BUNCHES**

- The Terriers average 3.82 goals per game, which is tops in Hockey East and fourth-most in the NCAA.
- The Terriers averaged 4.1 goals per game over the final two months of the year en route to an 8-2-0 record in November and December.
- BU has scored at least two goals in all but two games this season and have notched five or more goals on seven different occasions, including 8-2 and 7-2 victories.

### **SHOOTING GALLERY**

- BU averages 36.2 shots on goal per game, which ranks second in the country and first in Hockey East.

### PANDOLFO ERA UNDERWAY

- The Terriers' season-opening win over Bentley on Oct. 1 was Jay Pandolfo's first game as the Terriers' head coach.
- Pandolfo was hired in May as the program's 13th head coach after spending this past season as the team's associate head coach.
- Prior to returning to BU, Pandolfo spent five years as an assistant coach with the Boston Bruins and helped them reach the second round of the Stanley Cup playoffs in four straight seasons.
- A two-time Stanley Cup champion with New Jersey (2000, 2003), Pandolfo played 899 NHL games with the Devils, the New York Islanders and Boston, totaling 226 points (100q, 126a).
- A member of the 1995 national title squad, Pandolfo is the first Division I men's ice hockey coach to have won an NCAA championship and two Stanley Cups as a player.
- At BU, he totaled 169 points (79g, 90a) and was runner-up for the 1996 Hobey Baker Award as a senior after recording 67 points (38g, 29a).
- He helped lead BU to four straight Frozen Fours, two Beanpot titles and two Hockey East championships during his playing career.
- A 1996 First-Team All-American, Pandolfo was a first-ballot inductee into the BU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2001.
