



Age requirement

Children ages 2 and under will be admitted free to football games with a paid adult. Please note free admittance is only valid for a seat in an adult's lap. There is no required pass or ticket for this admittance.

Accessible tickets

All accessible tickets in Sun Devil Stadium are marked and individually ticketed by the Sun Devil Ticket Office. Please make sure to indicate your accommodation needs when purchasing your ticket so the ticket office may provide you with the best and most appropriate seating available. Accessible seating is provided for individuals with specific needs and up to three (3) companion seats will be sold for every one (1) accessible seat sold.

In-person: The Sun Devil Ticket Office is located at the South end of Sun Devil Stadium. Office hours are Monday – Friday from 9am – 5pm. On game days, the ticket office will open five hours prior to kickoff and remain open until the end of the third quarter. The Sun Devil Ticket Office accepts Visa, MasterCard and American Express.





Mobile Ticket Instruction



Rideshare locations

The convenient rideshare pickup and drop-off zones are located at Lot 10, on the corner of Rural Rd. and Rio Salado, or Lot 50, in front of San Pablo Residence Hall off of Veterans Way. Enjoy, and Go Devils!

Entering the stadium

Sun Devil Athletics continues to place a high priority on safety. Enhanced security measures including the clear bag policy, use of magnetometers and no reentry policy will be in effect at Sun Devil Stadium for 2021. We encourage you to arrive early and be patient with these procedures. Please visit thesundevils.com/findmyseat to determine the best point of entry based on your seat location.

Accessible event day parking

There are disabled parking spaces available during football games at Sun Devil Stadium. These reserved spaces, located in the Disabled Lot outside the northeast stadium gates can be accessed from either the north or south end of Packard Drive.

A state issued disabled plate or placard must be presented with the appropriate ASU parking pass to enter this reserved lot. Any spaces remaining beyond those held by season pass holders will be made available on a first-come, first-served paid basis to those guests with the state issued plate or placard. Once the lot is full guests will be directed to the nearest pay lot. Disabled parking is also available on game day on the first floor of the south Packard Drive Structure with a state issued disabled plate or placard.

Passenger drop-off

Guests without parking passes, with extenuating circumstances (i.e. mobility impairments) may be dropped off just inside the reserved Disabled Lot.

Pre-game and post-game guest shuttle

On game days, Sun Devil Athletics provides shuttle service to guests from the Disabled Lot and first floor of the Packard Structure to the northwest, northeast and southeast stadium gates pre-game. Post-game, shuttles will be available from the northwest, northeast and southeast stadium gates to shuttle guests to the disabled parking lots. This service will end approximately 30 minutes after the game concludes. Please refer to the A-Z guide on our website for additional information on shuttles.

Traffic and Parking

Important parking note: Due to classes being in session, spaces in reserved parking lots are not guaranteed for weeknight games except personalized North reserved spaces west of the light tower. Reserved parking pass holders will be directed to any open spot in their designated lot. Visit thesundevils.com/parkingcentral for detailed parking lot and traffic flow information.

Banners/signs/flags

Signs cannot be hung over any existing signage, block the view of another guest, or contain any advertisements or profanities. Signs larger than 3' X 2', whiteboards, and poles of any kind or size are not allowed into Sun Devil Stadium. Sun Devil Event Management reserves the right to confiscate any sign/whiteboard.

Ejection policy

Threats, actual violence, or impeding competition WILL result in immediate ejection from Sun Devil Stadium. No warning is necessary for any of these actions.

Gate opening

Gates open 90 minutes prior to kickoff. The Club areas including Founders', Legends', Coach's, the San Tan Ford East Sideline Club and MidFirst Bank Stadium Club open two hours prior to kickoff. Fans holding tickets in all other areas of the stadium can enter beginning 90 minutes prior to kickoff.

Guest assistance centers

There are Guest Assistance Centers located inside Sun Devil Stadium. They are located just inside the Southwest gate, and on the main concourse level on the west and east sides. Guest relations representatives are available to assist with directions, seating issues and any other questions or comments you may have.

Merchandise

ASU merchandise can be purchased at various locations throughout Sun Devil Stadium on game day. Sparky's Stadium Shop, located at the southeast gate, is open from 9 am to 2 hours prior to kickoff for both non-ticketed and ticketed guests on game days, then reopens 90 minutes prior to kickoff to ticketed guests only. Merchandise can also be purchased at various locations on all levels throughout Sun Devil Stadium. All locations will remain open through the entire game. Sparky's Stadium.

Game times

Sun Devil Football start times vary because of our affiliation with the Pac-12 Conference and partnerships with ABC, the ESPN Family of Networks, FOX, Fox Sports 1 and CBS. Scoreboard messages

Commemorate a special occasion by displaying a message on the Sun Devil Stadium video board during an Arizona State football game. Scoreboard messages can be purchased for \$250 for all non season ticket holders and \$200 for season ticket holders. Messages can be up to 75 characters, including spaces and punctuation, and will be reviewed for content by Sun Devil Athletics, Messages deemed to be obscene, controversial or offensive include foul language or refer negatively to ASU, our opponent, or any subject matter will not be accepted. The message cannot be used for commercial purposes and are subject to NCAA legislation. Payment must be made prior to announcement. Payment can be made by check or cash only. There are a limited number of messages available each game. Space is limited, so reserve your space early. Reservations and payment must be made by 5pm MST the Tuesday prior to a Saturday game. 




Sun Devil Stadium Parking Map

NCAA compliance rules

Arizona State University athletics compliance

Integrity is a core principle of Sun Devil Athletics. Essential to that principle is a commitment to athletics compliance – following the rules of the NCAA and Pac-12. Rules compliance is a responsibility shared among all Sun Devil Athletics stakeholders, including SDA coaches, student-athletes, prospective student-athletes, and representatives of ASU's athletics interests (more commonly referred to as "boosters").

As a Sun Devil football fan, you are likely to be considered a booster under NCAA legislation, and your actions could therefore have an impact on SDA's sports programs. Remember that once you become an SDA booster, you remain one indefinitely. We ask that you please read and familiarize yourself with the following summary of NCAA booster legislation so you can help us prevent activities that might jeopardize SDA's interests and those of our student-athletes. While the information does not contain all applicable rules, it should serve as a guide regarding whether an activity is permissible.

Summary of NCAA booster rules

Booster rule #1

You cannot recruit prospects, either directly or through prospects' friends or families.

Impermissible recruiting:

- Contacting (e.g., phone, text, in person) prospects or their relatives, coaches, or high school administrators.
- Having face-to-face conversations with prospects (or their relatives) during prospects' visits to campus including game days and practices.

Booster rule #2

You cannot give anything to studentathletes (prospective or current) or their friends or families that is not authorized under NCAA rules.

Impermissible benefits to student-athletes and prospects

- Allowing the use of your personal property (e.g., boats, homes, cars).
- Providing or co-signing for loans.
- Providing cash, gift cards, free or reduced-cost lodging, entertainment, services, or products.
- Promising employment, money, gifts, or anything else of value after college graduation.

NCAA compliance rules

So what are you permitted to do?

The answer depends on whether a student is a prospective or a current studentathlete. An individual becomes a Sun Devil prospect when they begin the ninth grade. A prospect then becomes a student-athlete after beginning team practice or attending class at ASU. The following lists provide examples of activities permitted under NCAA legislation for prospects and student-athletes.

Prospects – Permissible activities

- Attending high school, community college, and public events in which prospects are participating. But you may not attempt to contact or recruit those prospects.
- Continuing established family relationships with prospects and relatives as long as contacts and communications remain unrelated to recruiting.
- Accepting calls from a prospect as long as they are not arranged by coaches or staff members and are unrelated to athletics. You should direct a prospect to an SDA coach or the Compliance Office staff if he or she has questions about athletics.

Student-athletes -

Permissible activities

- Speaking with student-athletes at games, events, banquets, etc. To determine the best way to communicate, ask the student-athlete or coach - generally email is the preferred method.
- Hosting an occasional meal for a studentathlete or an entire team at your home or on ASU's campus. You must obtain prior approval by the Compliance Office.
- Employing a student-athlete, as long as you pay the going rate for work actually and already performed and have documentation of the payments.
- Using a student-athlete to promote your business, so long as ASU's NIL activity policy is followed. NIL activities must not be used to compensate studentathletes for athletics performance or recruit prospective student-athletes to ASU. Please visit our NIL website at sundevilcompliance.com/nil for more information relating to ASU's NIL policy.
