THIS WEEK: As temperatures cool in Seattle, the Huskies escape to the desert this week looking to get hot again after seeing a seven-match win streak snapped in their last match. 15th-ranked Washington will have a big challenge in store in the Arizona schools, both of which served notice last week with road sweeps at the Oregon schools. The Huskies, Wildcats, and Sun Devils all go into this third week of Pac-12 play with 3-1 conference records, looking to keep positioned at the top of the pack.

The Huskies (11-3, 3-1 Pac-12) will visit No. 21 Arizona first on Friday, Oct. 5, for a 6 p.m. match airing on Pac-12 Networks WA/AZ. Then it will be on to Tempe to meet the Sun Devils on Sunday, Oct. 7, for a 12 noon first serve. Sunday's match will be live stream only on Arizona State's website.

The first RPI numbers were crunched by the NCAA this week, with the Huskies coming in at No. 7, second in the Pac-12 behind No. 1 Stanford. Two of UW's three losses were to teams ranked in the top-six: No. 3 Illinois and No. 6 Pitt. Washington's highest wins at the moment based on RPI came over No. 17 Washington State and No. 28 Dayton.

Through the first two weeks of Pac-12 play, only Stanford sits without a loss at 4-0. The Huskies had a chance to join the Cardinal but lost in four sets to Utah at home on Sunday. Arizona's only loss in conference play thus far came to Stanford in four sets in Palo Alto, while ASU lost to Arizona in the conference opener, but has since beaten Cal, Oregon State, and then-No. 12 Oregon. Arizona also upset Oregon last week, in five sets.

The Wildcats are 14-2 overall, their only loss aside from Stanford coming in five sets to New Mexico State. Arizona is hitting .257 on the year and holding opponents to just .171. Arizona's senior outside hitter Kendra Dahlke was named Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week this week after the two wins at Oregon. Dahlke leads the Pac-12 with 5.18 kills per set on the season. Junior setter Julia Patterson is third in the league with 11.45 assists per set while junior middle Devyn Cross is fifth in attack percentage at .359 and eighth in blocks per set at 1.23. Cross has upped that to .397 in Pac-12 matches. The Huskies have won 13 straight in the series but did not visit Tucson last year.

KEEGAN COOK



Keegan Cook's first three seasons as Head Coach of Husky Volleyball continued the tremendous success UW had enjoyed in his previous two years as assistant coach ... three seasons as Head Coach have resulted in two Pac-12 Championships and two trips to the Elite Eight, with seven different Huskies earning

AVCA All-America honors covering every position on the court, and a Pac-12 Player of the Year award for Courtney Schwan ... the Huskies are 85-16 over Cook's first three years with a league record of 48-12 ... the first time Head Coach **guided Washington to a 31-3 record, a Pac-12 Championship, and a trip to the Elite Eight in 2015**, and he was named AVCA Pacific North Region Coach of the Year ... despite graduating six seniors from the 2015 team, **the 2016 squad won the Pac-12 title again with a 29-5 overall record** and a second straight Elite Eight appearance ... 2017 was complicated by multiple injuries throughout the year that caused the Huskies to use 17 different starting lineups, and yet the Dawgs battled through the adversity to still tie for second in the Pac-12 with a 14-6 record, earning the No. 8 overall seed in the NCAA tournament but falling in a five set battle in the second round to Illinois ... coached the U.S. Junior National Team to gold at the 2018 NORCECA Championships and in the summer of 2016, was head coach of the USA Collegiate National Team on a tour of China ... officially took the reins as the Head Coach of Husky Volleyball in January of 2015, following two of the best years in Washington history as an assistant ... in a whirlwind **first year on staff as an assistant coach**, Cook helped the Huskies advance to the 2013 Final Four indoors and then was named Head Coach of the new Beach Volleyball program which played its inaugural matches in April of 2014 ... **Cook's second season as an assistant in 2014** saw the Huskies roll to a 25-0 record to start the season, the longest win streak in program history. The Huskies went 31-3 and made the NCAA round of 16 ... got his start in collegiate coaching at St. Mary's, going from a volunteer assistant up to the top assistant coach ... over Cook's final five years at St. Mary's, the Gaels advanced to the NCAA Championships three times, including a trip to the second round in his last season in 2012 ... helped lead the Gaels to their first West Coast Conference title in program history in 2009 ... Cook's teams have consistently been among the best serving teams in the nation. Washington led the Pac-12 in aces per set in 2013, 2014, 2016 and 2017, and the Gaels led the WCC at the service line every year from 2009-12.
