THE GAME - Sun Devil Football will head south this weekend to take on in-state rival Arizona in the annual Territorial Cup matchup on Friday, Dec. 11 at 5 p.m. AZT in Tucson.

The game will be nationally televised on ESPN with Jason Benetti, Andre Ware and Stormy Buonanotony on the call while the airwaves will carry the game on Arizona Sports 98.7 FM with Tim Healey, Jeff van Raaphorst, Jordan Simone and Jeff Munn.

THE BRUINS/HOME OPENERS - - This will be the 94th Duel in the Desert, with Arizona leading the all-time series 49-43-1. The vast majority of those Wildcat wins came prior to 1950, however. Since 1949, ASU holds a 42-29-1 record in the series.

The winner of the game will receive (or retain) the Territorial Cup Trophy, and the game is recognized by the NCAA as the nation's oldest rivalry trophy game.

The Sun Devils have won three straight in the series and 7 of the last 10 contests. The three game streak is just the third three-game winning streak for either team since 1990 (Arizona won from 1993-95, ASU from 2005-07). The Sun Devils are looking for the first four-game winning streak in the series since Arizona won five straight from 1982-1986.

KICKING OFF

- » Against UCLA, Chip Trayanum became the first true freshman to rush for 100 yards in a game since Demario Richard in 2014 (14 for 116 vs. Utah - the 8th game of the year). In doing so in just his second game as a Sun Devil, he became the fastest freshman to have a 100-yard game since Keegan Herring rushed for 134 yards on 12 carries in his debut in the season opener for ASU vs. Temple in 2005.
- » Among Pac-12 running backs with at least 65 snaps, Chip Trayanum is the highest-graded halfback in the league with his offensive score of 86.4 while teammate Rachaad White has the fourth highest score in the league at 79.6.
- » Tyler Johnson (4.5 tackles for loss, 3 sacks) became the first Sun Devil with four tackles for loss since Tashon Smallwood against New Mexico State in Aug. 31, 2017 and the first Sun Devil with three sacks in a game since Koron Crump vs. Washington State on Oct. 22, 2016.
- » ASU has shut out its opponents in the third quarter of each of the first two games.
- » ASU has 17 tackles for loss and 8 sacks in the first two games this year, including 10 TFL and 5 sacks against UCLA. If you include the Florida State contest last season, it is 27 tackles for loss and 12 sacks in its last three games.
- » Michael Turk immediately picked up where he left off from a punting this season and leads the nation in averaging 49.5 yards per punt this year.

AN ASU VICTORY WOULD...

- Give ASU 8 wins over Arizona in the last 11 matchups.
- Be the fourth straight victory over the Wildcats, the longest streak in the series since Arizona won five straight from 1982-86.
- Improve ASU to 16-9 in the series since the 1996 season.
- Help ASU avoid an (asterisk-filled) 0-3 start to start a season for the first time since 1976.

The Sun Devils have the seventh-youngest team in the nation in terms of underclassmen percentage with 68.1 percent of the roster with 77 total underclassmen (49 freshmen/28 sophomores) on a roster of 113. The Sun Devils began the season as the only team in the country with a travel roster that featured zero starts or carries at the FBS level among the running backs on the roster. ASU's 30 combined starts along the offensive line to start the season were the sixth fewest in the country.

Michael Turk immediately picked up where he left off from a punting this season and leads the nation in averaging 49.5 yards per punt this year. He has pinned five punts inside the 20 and has three punts over 50 yards. His average hangtime of 4.39 seconds against USC also led the Pac-12 for that week and was tied for third among all FBS punters for the weekend. A semifinalist for the Ray Guy Award last season, Michael Turk's 46.0 yards per punt average on 59 punts were 11th in the FBS and led the Pac-12.

ASU's defensive line has generated 45 total QB pressures through just two games (22.5 per game). Chip Trayanum leads the Pac-12 running backs in averaging a first down or touchdown on 39.3 percent of his rushing touchdowns this season - 29th in the FBS. His 7.3 yards per carry is fourth in the league among those with at least 25 touches. He is eighth among Pac-12 running backs in averaging 3.9 yards after contact per rush this year. Among Pac-12 running backs with at least 65 snaps, Chip Trayanum is the highest-graded halfback in the league with his offensive score of 86.4, which is good for the 21st-best score in the country and sixth-best score among any offensive true freshmen.

The Sun Devils have forced 25 turnovers in the last nine games dating back to last season. No team in the country has forced more than 23 over its latest nine-game stretch. ASU recorded 10 takeaways in its last three games including the 2019 Tony the Tiger Sun Bowl. ASU had a takeaway in eight straight games dating back to last season broke against UCLA and had multiple turnovers in seven of those (3+ in four of them). ASU (11th in 2018) was one of just four teams nationally to rank in the Top-25 in turnover margin in each of the last two seasons.

Chase Lucas is the second-highest graded cornerback in the Pac-12 with an overall defensive score of 79.9 (11th among all defensive players in the league). He holds the highest score in coverage among league corners at 82.7. His coverage score is the 14th-highest among corners in the nation. Lucas has been targetted just nine times on 99 snaps in coverage and only allowed six catches in that span. His 10.7 snap to target ratio is good for 17th in the nation among FBS corners.

- Among defensive interior players with at least 40 snaps this season, Jermaine Loe leads the league with a run-stop percentage of 13.0 percent -- good for sixth nationally.
- Kellen Dlesch remains the sixth-highest graded player in the Pac-12 on offense regardless of position this season, posting an 82.8 overall score according to PFF. The 82.8 grade is tied for 29th among all tackles in the FBS this season.

- » Kellen Diesch remains the sixth-highest graded player in the Pac-12 on offense regardless of position this season, posting an 82.8 overall score according to Pro Football Focus. The 82.8 grade is tied for 29th among all tackles in the FBS this season.
- » He has posted an 87.4 score as a run-blocker this season, leading all players in the Pac-12 and the 17th-highest score among tackles in the FBS.
- » Among Pac-12 guards, Dohnovan West has the highest score in the Pac-12 on offense with a grade of 75.6. Nationally, that ranks him at the 35th-highest graded guard in the entire FBS.
- » Among Pac-12 running backs with at least 65 snaps, Chip Trayanum is the highest-graded halfback in the league with his offensive score of 86.4 while teammate Rachaad White has the fourth highest score in the league at 79.6.
- » For Trayanum, that is the 21st-best score among all running backs in the FBS and fourth among true freshman tailbacks in the nation and the sixth-highest score among any offensive true freshman in the country - and tops among Pac-12 true freshmen.

IN A RUSH

- » Among Pac-12 running backs with at least 65 snaps, Chip Trayanum is the highest-graded halfback in the league with his offensive score of 86.4 while teammate Rachaad White has the fourth highest score in the league at 79.6.
- » For Trayanum, that is the 21st-best score among all running backs in the FBS and fourth among true freshman tailbacks in the nation and the sixth-highest score among any offensive true freshman in the country - and tops among Pac-12 true freshmen.
- » Trayanum leads the Pac-12 running backs in averaging a first down or touchdown on 39.3 percent of his rushing touchdowns this season - 29th in the FBS. His 7.3 yards per carry is fourth in the league among those with at least 25 touches. He is eighth among Pac-12 running backs in averaging 3.9 yards after contact per rush this year.
- » Trayanum became the first player with two rushing touchdowns in his Sun Devil debut since Marion Grice in 2012 vs. NAU (3). He is the first freshman to have multiple rushing touchdowns in his Sun Devil debut since George Montgomery against Baylor in 1990.
- » ASU ran for over 250+ yards in the first game of the season against USC after not reaching the mark last season.
- » Against UCLA, Chip Trayanum became the first true freshman to rush for 100 yards in a game since Demario Richard in 2014 (14 for 116 vs. Utah - the 8th game of the year). In doing so in just his second game as a Sun Devil, he became the fastest freshman to have a 100-yard game since Keegan Herring rushed for 134 yards on 12 carries in his debut in the season opener for ASU vs. Tempe in 2005.
- » Out of Rachaad White's 129 rushing yards this season, 106 have come after first contact. Trayanum has 110 yards after contact this year.
- » Jayden Daniels' 111 rushing yards against USC were the fourth-most by a quarterback in Sun Devil history.
- » ASU had three players rush for over 75 yards against USC (Jayden Daniels 111, Chip Trayanum 84, Rachaad White 76). It was the first time ASU had three players go over the 75-yard mark in the ground since Nov. 15, 1997 against Oregon when Michael Martin (158), J.R. Redmond (127) and Marlon Farlow (85) accomplished the feat.

HOLD ON TO YOUR SEATS

- » Arizona State has played in 11 total games decided by four points or less in the Herm Edwards era, which is tied for third in the FBS in that time behind Kansas State and North Carolina (13).
- » ASU has seven wins in games decided by four points or less (7-4 record), tied second behind Nevada (8) for the most wins by four points or fewer since 2018
- » The Sun Devils have now played in 19 games decided by a touchdown or less in the last two-plus years, going 9-10 in that time. The 19 games are second behind Texas (21) for the most in the country during that time. The 9 wins in such game are tied for 5th in the FBS in that time.
- » ASU played eight games last season decided by a touchdown or less - six of which decided by four points or less.

HOLD ON TO THAT BALL, ALSO

- » The Devils turned the ball over just 14 times last season - the 20th-lowest total in the FBS. ASU was 6th nationally in turnover margin on the season (1.08).
- » ASU forced a turnover on 17.5 percent of opponent possessions last season, good for 4th nationally.
- » ASU (11th in 2018) is one of just four teams nationally to rank in the Top-25 in turnover margin in each of the last two seasons (Georgia Southern, Syracuse, LSU) and only ASU and Syracuse have been in the Top-15 in the last two seasons.
- » ASU's four interceptions thrown last year were tied for the 4th-lowest total nationally. ASU was one of just five non-triple option offenses to rank in the Top-25 in fewest interceptions in the last two seasons - joining Auburn as the only other one of those to do so with a different primary quarterback in each of those seasons.

WE'LL TAKE THAT

- » ASU has forced 25 turnovers in its last nine games dating back to last season, good for the most in the nation.
- » ASU had a streak of a takeaway in eight straight games dating back to last season ended against UCLA. It had multiple turnovers in seven of those (3+ in four of them).
- » ASU collected 15 fumble recoveries last season, the third-most in the nation and the most since finishing the 2014 season with 13. ASU had 17 fumble recoveries during the 2011 season. It had one against Oregon State, the first fumble lost by the Beavers all season in its first 10 games.
- » ASU has outscored opponents 765-386 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 64.5 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (129 of 200) while finding the end zone 94 times in that span (47.0 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 48.1 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (65 of 135) with 50 touchdowns (37.0 percent).

LOCKING IT DOWN

- » The Sun Devils gave up just three plays over 50 yards last season, tied for the 8th-fewest nationally. ASU was also tied for 9th nationally in allowing just 3 plays of over 50 yards in 2018 after sitting in the bottom 10 nationally in the previous four years. ASU has allowed just on 50-yard play this season.
- » ASU's 10 plays allowed over 40 yards last season were 25th nationally. In 2018, ASU was tied for 11th nationally in allowing just 8 plays over 40 yards, an area the Devils had struggled in in previous seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively). Only one 40-yard play has been allowed this season.
- » ASU allowed just 17 plays over 30 yards last season, a total tied for 7th nationally. In 2018, The Devils gave up just 22 plays over 30 yards, tied for 34th-fewest nationally. In the previous four years, ASU had given up 38, 44, 40, 40 such plays, ranked 116th, 124th, 117th and 119th. ASU has allowed just three such players this year.
- » ASU's run defense was especially efficient, finishing 17th in the country with only 47 rushing plays allowed over 10 yards last season. With just 8 rushing plays over 20 yards allowed last season, ASU was 8th in the country.
- » In the last two-plus seasons combined, the Sun Devil secondary has allowed just 15 total passing plays over 40 yards. For perspective, it had 12 alone in 2017, 22 in 2016 and 24 in 2015 - the latter two ranked second to last and last, respectively, in the nation.
- » ASU's defense did its part to limit opponents on short-field drives (drives beginning less than 60 yards for the end zone) last season, holding teams to 2.83 points per drive in such situations (28th in the country).

KEEP 'EM OFF THE BOARD

- » ASU has held opponents to less than 30 points in 19 of 28 games under Herm Edwards, notable as it DID allow 30+ in 32 of 43 previous games dating back in a span from 2013-17.
- » Last season, ASU was 35th in the country and fifth in the Pac-12 in allowing just 22.4 points per game. The Sun Devils allowed just 25.5 points per game in 2018, good for 53rd nationally. The totals are notable as ASU was 103rd nationally at 32.8 points per game allowed in 2017 and had finished 99th or worse in three consecutive seasons prior to the marked improvement the past two seasons.
- » ASU held six opponents under 20 points last year, its most since holding six under the mark in 2012.
- » ASU has not allowed an opponent to score in the third quarter of a game this season. That was a notable area of struggle just two seasons ago, when ASU was 92nd nationally in allowing 7.7 points per third quarter.
- » Slow starts hurt the Sun Devil defense in 2019, with ASU ranking 96th nationally in first quarter points per game allowed at 7.8. ASU has allowed just one touchdown through two first quarters this season.

THRILL OF THE CHASE

- » Chase Lucas played the most defensive snaps of any player in the country the USC weekend on 97 total snaps, (95 plays and two plays blown dead on penalties). It was the most snaps by a Pac-12 player in a regulation game since UCLA had three players with 101 snaps against - ironically - Arizona State in Pasadena in 2017.
- » Lucas played 63 snaps in coverage - also the most in the FBS in Week 10 - and recorded a Pac-12-best score of 85.8 on those plays - five points higher than any other Pac-12 defensive back for the week. It was the fourth-best grade in coverage for a Power Five defender in the country.
- » Chase Lucas is the second-highest graded cornerback in the Pac-12 with an overall defensive score of 79.9 (11th among all defensive players in the league). He holds the highest score in coverage among league corners at 82.7. His coverage score is the 14th-highest among corners in the nation.
- » Lucas has been targetted just nine times on 99 snaps in coverage and only allowed six catches in that span. His 10.7 snap to target ratio is good for 17th in the nation among FBS corners.
- » Lucas was credited with just one touchdown allowed in coverage last season, the lowest total in the Pac-12 and 5th-lowest total nationally - despite being targetted the 37th most times on an corner nationally (76).
- » Lucas trails only Oregon's Jordon Scott (41) and Arizona's Lorenzo Burns (39) in most defensive starts in the Pac-12 at 36. He will go down as one of the few Sun Devil secondary players to finish his career as a four-year starter.

- » ASU's defensive line has generated 45 total QB pressures through just two games (22.5 per game). USC's 17.8 and UCLA's 17.0 QB pressures per game are the only ones remotely close to ASU in the Pac-12. In fact, despite playing the fewest games, ASU has more TOTAL QB pressures along its defensive line than three other Pac-12 programs and are within 5 pressures of three others that have played more games.
- » ASU has 17 tackles for loss and 8 sacks in the first two games this year, including 10 TFL and 5 sacks against UCLA. If you include the Florida State contest last season, it is 27 tackles for loss and 12 sacks in its last three games.
- » Through two games, the ASU defense line has combined for 43 tackles, 14.0 tackles for loss and all 8.0 of ASU's sacks for the year
- » D.J. Davidson (19.7 percent) and Tyler Johnson (18.2 percent) have the fourth and sixth-highest win-percentages among Pac-12 lineman on pass-rushing players this season.
- » Tyler Johnson (4.5 tackles for loss, 3 sacks) became the first Sun Devil with four tackles for loss since Tashon Smallwood against New Mexico State in Aug. 31, 2017 and the first Sun Devil with three sacks in a game since Koron Crump vs. Washington State on Oct. 22, 2016.
- » Among defensive interior players with at least 40 snaps this season, Jermayne Lole leads the league with a run-stop percentage of 13.0 percent -- good for sixth nationally.
- » The entire defensive line has been credited with just three missed tackles this season.

HAVING A FIELD DAY

- » Evan Fields was the third-highest graded Pac-12 defender in Week 10, according to Pro Football Focus, recording a score of 80.4.
- » Fields is the 23rd-highest graded defensive player in the league on the season with his score of 74.5.
- » No player in the conference had more tackles during the USC weekend than Fields' 17. It was tied for the 13th-most by any player on the FBS this season.
- » The 17 tackles were the most by a Sun Devil since Christian Sam had 15 in a game in 2017 - also against USC.
- » Evan Fields had 23 total defensive "stops" last season, a total that was tied for second among safeties in the Pac-12.
- » On run defense last season, Fields recorded 17 total defensive "stops" to lead all Pac-12 safeties and 46th nationally.

LO-LEEEEE, LOLE, LOLE, LOLEEEE

- » Jermayne Lole was the 10th-highest graded defender in the league in Week 10 with a 75.9 grade. He recorded a 74.4 score on run defense, which was good for ninth in the Pac-12 and third among defensive interior players in the league.
- » Lole is currently the fifth-highest graded defensive interior player in the Pac-12 (73.8).
- » Among defensive interior players with at least 40 snaps this season, Jermayne Lole leads the league with a run-stop percentage of 13.0 percent -- good for sixth nationally.
- » Lole was a part of 19 "key" plays against USC, the second most of any Pac-12 defender.
- » In 2019, Lole checked in as the 20th-highest graded player in the Pac-12 with a score of 75.3 - the second-highest score among edge defenders in the league. His 81.9 score on running plays last season was in the Top-50 of all edge defenders on the year.
- » Lole recorded 72 tackles last season, the third most for a Sun Devil defensive lineman since 1990 behind only Shante Carver (79 in 1993) and Terrell Suggs (73 in 2002).
- » The sophomore had the 12th-highest positive run impact score in the country at 23.6 percent among players graded as interior linemen (percentage of run defense snaps where player earned a positive grade from Pro Football Focus).
- » Lole's 32 defensive stops on run plays last season were seventh among the nation's edge defenders. His 39 overall stops were 14th among edge defenders.
- » Lole was credited with just five missed tackle last season, tied for 35th among FBS edge defenders.

BIG PLAY FRANK

- » Frank Darby has caught 13 career touchdowns in his career with 11 of those coming against Pac-12 opponents.
- » Frank Darby earned Pac-12 honorable mention accolades in 2019.
- » He hauled in a touchdown pass in four straight games in the back half of the season and accounted for two touchdowns in three of those outings. He had seven touchdowns over the four-game span (UCLA-USC-Oregon State-Oregon). Prior to the UCLA game, he had five total receiving touchdowns in his previous 30 career games to that current four-game stretch.
- » In those four games, he has made 16 catches for 387 yards (24.2 yards per catch) and seven touchdowns
- » His 125-yard performance in the upset victory over No. 6 Oregon was the fifth 100+ yard game of his career
- » Darby's 19.87 yards per reception last season was 10th in the country and second among Pac-12 receivers
- » When targeted last season, Darby posted a 133.1 NFL quarterback rating (31 catches for 616 yards with eight touchdowns and no interceptions) -- good for the 21st-highest total among all wide receivers nationally and top-10 among those that return this season.
- » Frank Darby was the Pac-12's 10th-highest graded wide receiver (69.7) among players with 600 snaps, but also did his part off the ball in recording the third-highest score in the FBS among receivers as a run blocker (80.6).

NOBODY'S BUSINESS BUT THE TURKS

- » Michael Turk immediately picked up where he left off from a punting this season and leads the nation in averaging 49.5 yards per punt this year.
- » He has pinned five punts inside the 20 and has three punts over 50 yards.
- » His average hangtime of 4.39 seconds against USC also led the Pac-12 for that week and was tied for third among all FBS punters for the weekend.
- » A semifinalist for the Ray Guy Award last season, Michael Turk's 46.0 yards per punt average on 59 punts were 11th in the FBS and led the Pac-12.
- » He pinned 32 of those 59 punts inside the opponent 20-yard line (54.2 percent), a total that was second in the nation. Turk had 21 punts out of 59 (35.6 percent) punts over 50 yards last season, six more than any other player in the Pac-12.
- » The 63.0 yards per punt mark by Turk on Aug. 29 vs. Kent State broke an NCAA record. The previous record for highest average yards per punt in a game with minimum five attempts was Braden Mann of Texas A&M on Sept. 22, 2018, as he had a 60.8 yards per punt average vs. Alabama. Turk punted five times for 315 yards with boots of 64, 62, 65, 49 and 75 in his Sun Devil debut.

DAAAAMMNNNN DANIELS

- » Jayden Daniels had a streak of 203 consecutive pass attempts - the fourth-longest active streak in the nation - ended against UCLA. With two interceptions on 338 pass attempts last season, he set the ASU school record for fewest interceptions on 300 or more passes.
- » Daniels had the fourth-highest PFF grade as a passer in Week 14 vs. UCLA.
- » He had the fourth highest PFF rushing score among FBS quarterbacks during the USC week. His 125 yards gained (minus sacks) were the the sixth-most of any quarterback in the country for that week.
- » Last season, Daniels' 8.86 yards per pass attempt were 13th in the FBS and third in the league. Among quarterbacks with at least 200 attempts, he was tied for the fewest interceptions nationally with just two -- one of which coming on a half-ending Hail Mary attempt against Utah.
- » Daniels was eighth in the country last year with 15 pass completions over 40 yards last season and 12th in the FBS with 24 passes over 30 yards. His eight completions over 50 yards were 10th. Eleven of his 17 touchdowns passes went for at least 25 yards (64.7 percent).

ICE IN HIS VEINS

- » Daniels was exceptional on third downs last season, with his 744 passing yards on third downs good for 17th in the country (despite missing a game). His 160.13 passer rating on third down was 25th nationally.
- » Despite missing a game, Daniels accounted for 784 passing yards in the fourth quarter of games, good for 10th nationally while his 34 passing first downs were also 10th.
- » He recorded nine fourth quarter passing touchdowns (fourth nationally) to one interception. His 183.84 QB efficiency rating in the fourth quarter was 12th in the country.
- » Daniels completed 11 passes of 25+ yards in the fourth quarter of games (tied for 2nd nationally) and his 19 pass completions over 15 yards in the frame was tied for 11th.
- » While under pressure last season, he posted the sixth-highest NFL passer rating of any quarterback in the FBS at 97.2. For reference, the national average was 68.6.

THE KIDS WILL BE ALRIGHT

- » The Sun Devils have the seventh-youngest team in the nation in terms of underclassmen percentage with 68.1 percent of the roster with 77 total underclassmen (49 freshmen/28 sophomores) on a roster of 113.
- » The Sun Devils began the season as the only team in the country with a travel roster that featured zero starts or carries among the running backs on the travel roster.
- » ASU's 30 combined starts along the offensive line to start the season were the sixth fewest in the country.
- » All told, 32 true or redshirt freshmen played for the Sun Devils last year (21 true, 11 redshirt). That was tied for the third-highest total among FBS programs this season behind Clemson and Oklahoma.
- » Eight have started a game for ASU last year, tied for the second-highest total in the nation behind Alabama (9). ASU's 5 offensive true freshmen to start a game last season were the most of any team in the country.
- » The Sun Devils played 25 freshmen in the season opener (15 true, 10 redshirt) last year - the most ever in the modern era at ASU. That was the third-highest total in the country behind only Clemson (38 - 27/11) and Baylor (35 - 20/15).
- » In 2019 - for the first time in program history - a freshman was named a team captain after Herm Edwards dubbed true freshman quarterback/athlete Ethan Long as special teams captain before the season. Additionally, Darien Butler was the first true sophomore captain in program history after the linebacker was named captain for the team's defense.
- » The trend continues in 2020 with true sophomores Jayden Daniels and Case Catch earning the nod as captains.
- » Prior to the last two seasons, no player that had been with the program for less than three years had ever been named a team captain in ASU history.
- » Last season, Arizona State was the only team in the country starting two true freshmen on its offensive line.
