#BYTHENUMBERS

Lyle Lin has 11 multi-game hits in 23 games this season. That total is notable as he is the ONLY Sun Devil freshman since AT LEAST 2000 to have multi- hit games in 11 of their first 22 games as Sun Devils. In fact, his 11 multi-hit games through 23 games is tied for eighth since the 2000 season with Brett Wallace, Jason Kipnis and Colby Woodmansee. No other Sun Devil on this year's team has more than six multi game hits and through 23 games last season, the team lead was 10 while no Sun Devil freshman had more than

The Sun Devil bull pen has made big strides in recent weeks. Jake Godfey is current second on the team with 11 inherited runners this season and has been exception in getting out of jams, stranding 10 of those. In two of his last three appearances, Godfrey has gone exactly 3.2 innings without a run allowed. Meanwhile, No. 11 Connor Higgins has come on strong as well. After giving up four earned runs in 1.1 innings in three appearances to start the year, Higgins hasn't allowed an earned run in 8.1 innings pitched over his last four games with a win and a save.

Eli Lingos has been exceptional in six starts this season, going 3-1 with four quality starts. Lingos has gone over 6.0 IP in five of his six appearances this season after neving having consecutive games over 6.0 IP in his career prior. The junior has allowed no earned runs in two of his four starts this season. something he had done in a start just once in his career. His three wins match his 2016 total while he has issued no walks in two of four starts this season, something he had accomplished in just two starts prior to 2017.

In the first 13 games of the season, the Sun Devil bullpen struggled mightily to the tune of a 7.80 ERA. Since then, the group has turned things around with a 3.83 ERA in the team's last 10 games. In those first 13 games, Chaz Montoya made eight appearances and struggled with a 14.29 ERA and an 0-1 record. In his last 10 games Montoya has a 0.00 ERA and a 2-0 record, striking out 14 and walking three with just six hits allowed in 11.1 innings pitched. He also earned his first career start in a 7-0 victory

Interview Policy

Arizona State will typically host weekly media availability every Tuesday and Wednesday at Phoenix Municipal Stadium prior to practice at approximately 1 p.m. On weeks of a Tuesday midweek game at home, the Tuesday postgame press conference will serve as the week's availability. Media planning to attend must contact Jeremy Hawkes ahead of time and inform him of their plans. Throughout the season's schedule, ASU will host postgame interviews in the Omaha Room located in the home locker room following after coach's postgame talk with the team. Media members must request players at the beginning of the ninth inning (or earlier in games that look to be blowouts). Please contact Jeremy Hawkes or a member of the media relations staff in the press box to coordinate those interviews. Media members who wish to schedule an interview outside of practice must contact Jeremy Hawkes.

Photography/Videoography

Accomodations for B-Roll purposes at practice can be made through Jeremy Hawkes (jdhawkes@asu.edu). During games, credentials must be worn in plain view throughout the game while on the field and all photographers must adhere to painted lines and instructions given by security personnel and/or Arizona State staff members at all times. Shooting areas are designated camera wells on the far side of both the visitor's and home team's dugouts. Contact Jeremy Hawkes for any details regarding shooting game action.

Media Highlights Policy

Highlights include Pac-12 Networks/ESPN/FOX broadcasts and all home hosted non-televised competitions, including those that are live streamed. ESPN networks (i.e., ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU) will also televise all NCAA College World Series games from Saturday, June 17, through Wednesday, June 28. No other broadcast network or Internet entity, other than ESPN, may air these games, nor show highlights of these games until the ESPN broadcast is off the air. Broadcast networks / television stations may use up to three (3) minutes (per newscast) of video footage from any one game or five (5) minutes total of video footage from all games played on that particular day of competition for up to 72 hours following the game / broadcast. No media entity (commercial or noncommercial) is allowed to display any game video on its website. If a commercial broadcast entity wishes to license video footage beyond the previously described time period (72 hours), all requests to obtain clips or copies of NCAA championships / events (e.g., game / program records, melt / highlight tapes) need to go through the NCAA / T3 Media online footage request system, which can be found at the following website: http://www.t3licensing.com/video/home/ncaa.do.

2017 Media Coverage

There will be no shortage of ways to follow the Sun Devils throughout the 2017 campaign as a record 43 of ASU's 55 total games this season will be broadcast on television or via live stream. Every single one of the Sun Devils' 33 home games will be available to fans via the Pac-12 Networks or the Pac-12 Live Stream online and a total of 17 games overall are scheduled to be televised live through the Pac-12 Networks.

The Sun Devil Sports Radio Network is scheduled to broadcast 35 Sun Devil Baseball games this season between NBC Sports Radio AM 1060 and 100.7 KSLXHD. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on the radio or via the Tuneln app on thesundevils.com. Links to the streaming audio can be found on the online baseball schedule.

Tim Healey is set to serve his 19th season as the "Voice of the Sun Devils" on baseball broadcasts and will be joined for the second-straight season by color analyst Max Rossiter, who was an all-conference catcher for the Devils from 2012-13.

Head Coach Tracy Smith's weekly radio show, "Dugout Chatter," will debut on March 29 on NBC Sports Radio AM 1060. The 30-minute show will run each Wednesday at 8 p.m. for nine weeks and is hosted by the Tim Healey.

Scouting the Bruins

- UCLA is 11-11 overall on the season and are currently riding a 5-game winning streak.
- Griffin Canning has twice tied a career-high with 12 strikeouts this season. He has 49 total punch outs in seven starts, good for 23rd in NCAA. He leads the Pac-12 in strikeouts looking at 24 and ranks inside the top-10 in the conference in strikeouts, opposing batting average and innings pitched.
- Sean Bouchard is second in the Pac-12 with five home runs and ranks inside the top-10 in the conference in slugging percentage, RBIs and total bases.
- Kyle Cuellar is tops in Pac-12 only games in hits with 12 and also ranks in the top-five in batting average, on-base percentage, RBIs, doubles and total bases.
- The Bruins pitching staff ranks 38th in the NCAA in hits allowed per nine innings at 7.83, and 62nd in WHIP at 1.33, 66th in strikeouts per nine innings at 8.8 and 67th in ERA at 3.78.

- ASU leads the all-time series against UCLA, 119-71.
- Since 2000, the Sun Devils are 12-5 in series played against the Bruins with three sweeps.
- ASU took two out of three against the Bruins last season in Los Angeles.

Eli's Coming

- Eli Lingos, who earned first team Pac-12 All-Academic honors in 2016, has quickly solidified himself as the team's ace this season after entering the year as the Friday Night Starter.
- Lingos has opened the 2017 season with a bang, going 3-1 with four quality starts in his first six appearances of the season. No other Sun Devil has more than one quality start this season.
- Among those wins were an upset over then-No. 1
 TCU and a career-best 7.2 IP outing against LMU in
 which he allowed no runs.
- Lingos went over 6.0 IP in his first five appearances this season after neving having consecutive games over 6.0 IP in his career prior to this season.
- The junior lefty has allowed no earned runs in two of his six starts this season, something he had done in a start just once in his career prior.
- His three wins this season match his 2016 total while he has issued no walks in two of three starts this season, something he had accomplished in just two starts prior to 2017.
- He is fourth in the league with 38.1 innings pitched this season and ninth in the conference with 32 strikeouts.

Mr. Friday Night

- Lingos is the sixth pitcher since 2014 to assume the Friday Night role, joining Ryan Burr, Brett Lilek, Seth Martinez, Ryan Kellogg and Hever Bueno.
- ASU used four pitchers in the Friday night role in six seasons between 2008 and 2013 with Mike Leake ('08, '09), Seth Blair ('10), Brady Rodgers ('11, '12) and Trevor Williams ('13).
- Lingos joins a long and illustrious line of Mr. Friday Night's at ASU that includes nine Major Leaguers and numerous ASU Hall of Famers, including Eddie

Bane, Floyd Bannister, Kendall Carter, Mike Esposito, Larry Gura, Gary Gentry, Mike Leake, Trevor Williams and Brady Rodgers.

Lin-Sanity

- True freshman Lyle Lin continues to be the highlight of a young freshmen class, ranked seventh in the Pac-12 Conference with 32 hits this season.
- Lin has had three or more hits in three games on the year while registering multiple hits in 11 games on the season overall. No other Sun Devil has more than six such games.
- That number is especially notable as since AT LEAST the year 2000 (as far as pertinent records were available), no other freshman has had 11 multi-hit games in their first 23 games at Arizona State.
- In fact, the 11 multi-hit games at this point in the season are good for eighth among all players regardless of year since 2000, tied with Jason Kipnis, Brett Wallace and Colby Woodmansee.
- Lin has started every game this season, one of just three players to do so with a team-leading .351 average and 13 RBI in the process, the latter good for 11th in the Pac-12.

Re-LYLE-able

- Lyle Lin has an approach at the plate that is tough to find in many freshman. The youngster lead's the team's starters with a .419 average this season with two outs on the board on 13-of-31 hitting.
- Lin leads the team with six two-out RBIs and also holds a team-leading 13 hits with runners in scoring position on 28 at bats (.464), five more than the next closest Devil.
- Lin has reached base in all but one game this season.
- Should Lin reach in Friday's opener against UCLA, he would have two separate 10-game reached base streaks this season while only one other Sun Devil (Andrew Shaps at 13 earlier this season) has reached double digits once and no other player has one longer than seven.

#BISHETE

- Another pair of freshman have come up with the hot bats of late as well in outfielder/DH Hunter Bishop and infielder Carter Aldrete.
- Bishop is currently third on the team with a .302 average while slugging .422 and a perfect 3-for-3 on stolen base attempts on the year.
- He's been a great asset when it comes to getting the big hit when you need it, going a perfect 1-for-1 with the bases loaded and 3-for-3 with a runner on third and less than two outs.
- Aldrete is one of just three Sun Devils to start every game this season (Lyle Lin and Gage Canning being the others) and has appeared at three positions along the infield. He is currently second on the team in three categories with 12 RBIs, five doubles and two home runs.
- Bishop and Aldrete had history before coming to Arizona State. Both hail for Northern California and played in the 2015 Under Armour All-American games and selected to play for the Oakland Athletics' Area Code team in 2015.

Zach Cer-Bomb

- One of the most pleasant surprises of the early 2017
 has been the emergence of senior catcher Zach
 Cerbo, a four-year veteran who is seeing his most
 significant action as a Sun Devil this season.
- Cerbo has responded with a .333 average in his 15 appearances, also leading the way with a teamleading .465 on base percentage with his eight walks and also leading the team in slugging at .485 on the year.
- Cerbo has advanced runners on base on 11-of-16 chances this season (.688) - nearly 100 percentage points higher than the next closest teammate (Tyler Williams at .593).
- The senior helped lead the charge in the team's sweep of Long Beach State, knocking his first career home run in the second game of the series and knocking in four RBIs over the course of the weekend.

12-**G**age

- Gage Canning holds the Devils second longest hitting streak this season at seven games. Canning had a team-best 13-game hitting streak as a freshman in 2016.
- Canning is tied for the team lead with three games this season with three or more hits.
- Canning has spent time at the leadoff spot and turning the order back around in the nine-hole this year and done exactly what's expected of him in that role, stealing two bases, leading the team with 16 runs scored and advancing runners on 21-of-45 opportunities (.467).
- Canning also leads the Devils with six doubles and four triples this season (tied for first in the Pac-12).

Shaps Blasts

- After missing the first five games of the season to suspension, junior Andrew Shaps matched the Sun Devil season lead with 13 consecutive games reaching base, a streak that was snapped in the finale against No. 2 Oregon State.
- The outfielder had a career-best 10-game hitting streak entering that OSU finale and is already second on the team with 13 runs scored this year.
- Despite missing five games, Shaps is third on the Devils with eight walks this season.

Big Willie Style

- Tyler Williams has provided some much needed pop in the lineup this season, leading the team with three home runs on the year after having none in his freshman campaign.
- The sophomore has picked up the game-winning RBIs in each of the last two Sun Devils victories, plating the first run in his team's 7-0 victory over USC (on a day where he had a career best three RBIs) while knocking the go-ahead two-run homer against UNLV to earn a 5-4 victory.
- Williams is slugging .458 on the year and is second on the team when it comes to advancing runners, doing so 16 times on 27 chances (.593).

GAME NOTES

Turning The Tides

- In the first 13 games of the season, the Sun Devil bullpen struggled mightily to the tune of a 7.80 ERA.
 Since then, the group has turned things around with a 3.83 ERA in the team's last 10 games.
- In those first 13 games, Chaz Montoya made eight appearances and struggled with a 14.29 ERA and an 0-1 record. In his last 10 games Montoya has a 0.00 ERA and a 2-0 record, striking out 14 and walking three with just six hits allowed in 11.1 innings pitched. He also earned his first career start in a 7-0 victory over USC.
- Connor Higgins was in even more dire straights in the first 13 games with a 27.00 ERA in three appearances with just 1.1 innings pitched. Since then, Higgins has a 0.00 ERA in four apperances with 10 strikeouts to two walks in 8.1 innings pitched while picking up his first career win and save as well.
- Eder Erives had a 9.00 ERA in three appearances and just 2.0 innings pitched, dropping that to 2.08 wtih a save and 10 strikeouts in 10 games since in addition to a solid start against current No. 1 Oregon State.
- Jake Godfrey had a 6.35 ERA early in the year that
 is now 2.70 in the last 10 games in four apperances.
 The junior college transfer has been solid in keeping
 his team out of trouble all season, inheriting a teamleading 11 baserunners on the year and stranding
 10 of those.

They Can Mash Too

• Six Sun Devils (Tyler Williams 3, Carter Aldrete 2, Andrew Shaps 2, Ryan Lillard 1, Zach Cerbo 1, Hunter Bishop 1) have combined for ASU's 10 home runs this season - an interesting note as those six combined entered the 2017 season with three career collegiate home runs between them (Shaps 2, Lillard 1).

Clutch Hitting

 The Sun Devils have lived and died by their clutch hitting this season, currently batting 39-of-124 (.315) with runners in scoring position in the team's

- wins but struggling to plate runners in the team's losses at just 21-of-102 (.206).
- On the flip side, ASU has struggled defensively to get out of some innings, allowing 54 two-out RBIs of the 117 total by the opposition this season while allowing opponents to bat .317 (89-of-281) with two outs.

Not Wasting Time

- Freshman Spencer Van Scoyoc became the first Sun Devil freshman to start a game in the Opening Weekend since Adam McCreery against Western Michigan in 2012.
- Van Scoyoc pitched a gem in his start against #1
 TCU, going 6.0 innings with four strikeouts and no
 earned runs allowed in his first career quality start.
- Van Scoyoc currently sits just outside the Top 10 in the Pac-12 with a team-leading 2.42 ERA.
- The lefty has been nigh impossible to steal a base off from this season, leading all Sun Devils with four caught stealings this season - a total good for fourth in the Pac-12 and first among all pitchers - to just two stolen bases against.
- Van Scoyoc was selected in the 19th round of the MLB Draft by the Toronto Blue Jays but elected to attend ASU instead.
- He was rated the #1 LHP and #1 overall player in lowa and the #8 overal LHP in the nation.

Baseball's in Their Blood

There are eight Sun Devils on the 2017 squad who have a history of baseball in their family: Ryan Hingst (father, David, UT El Paso), Andrew Snow (cousin, Dustin Pedroia, Boston Red Sox), Garvin Alston Jr. (father, Garvin, MiLB), Eli Lingos (brother, Angelos, UC Riverside), Jackson Willeford (brother, Guy, Palomar JC; brother, Alex, Palomar JC/SDSU), Hunter Bishop (brother, Braden, Seattle Mariners), Fitz Stadler (Brothers Sullivan and Walker, Indiana), Carter Aldrete (father, Rich, MiLB; uncle, Mike, New York Yankees), Andrew Shaps (father, Robert, Cleveland Indians).

Keeping It Interesting

- The Devils had a knack for success in close games last season and that continued this season
- Since 2016, the Devils are 7-2 in extra-inning games (1-1 in 2017), with six walk-off wins (two this season) and are 15-3 (3-2 this year) in one-run games including 5-2 in Pac-12 play. ASU has driven in the gamewinning run in the eighth inning or later 13 times (three times this year).
- Arizona State has notched nine wins since 2016 when trailing after six innings (three times this season).

#OccupyPHXMuni

- ASU drew more than 78,000 fans last season, finishing in the top 30 nationally in total attendance and attendance per game.
- The Sun Devils have had a pair of big attendance games this season, including 6,010 against Oregon State in the series opener the second largest crowd since moving back to Phoenix Muni as well as 4,107 fans against UNLV in the largest mid-week attendance since returning to Muni and fifth-largest overall since returning.
- The Devils are currently 20th nationally with 43,251 cumulative fans this season (first in the Pac-12) and 24th with 2,544 fans per game (second in the Pac-12).
- ASU ranked 13th in total attendance and was the only school west of Texas to draw more than 100,000 fans in 2015, and ranked 18th in average attendance with 3,082 fans per game. ASU's 107,010 fans were the program's most since 2010 and ranked as the fourth-highest regular-season attendance since 1988.
- ASU moved back to Phoenix Municipal Stadium in 2015 after playing 40 seasons at Packard Stadium from 1974-2014, winning their first contest in the team's on a walk-off home run in extra inning against No. 5 Oklahoma State on Feb. 13, 2015.
- The Devils played 137 games at Muni from 1964-74, and went 111-26 at the stadium, including 17-6 against Arizona. ASU's first game at Muni was April 10, 1964, and was a 5-3 win over Arizona. ASU's last game at Muni was March 18, 1974, and was 9-6 win over Colorado. ASU won District 7 titles in 1965

- and 1967 at Muni before going on to win National Championships in Omaha.
- Former Sun Devil and eventual Major League Baseball Hall of Famer Reggie Jackson was the first college player to hit a home run at Muni.

Erives On Fire

- Sun Devil Baseball senior RHP Eder Erives has been named to the preseason watch list for the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper of the Year Award, given to the top relief pitcher in NCAA Division I baseball, members of the association announced Monday.
- Erives is the first Sun Devil to be named to the preseason watch list for the award since Ryan Burr in 2014.
- Erives, a Pac-12 All-Conference Honorable Mention in 2016, notched a 6-2 record with a 2.95 ERA last season. His 10 saves trailed only Oregon State's Max Englebrekt, whose 11 saves top the list of returning relievers in in the Pac-12.
- Last season, Erives struck out 73 batters and walked 36 in 76.1 innings. The 76.1 innings pitched rank fourth among the 55 players named to the watch list while his 73 strikeouts are good for seventh. Erives held opponent batting average to .192, a career-low for the right-handed pitcher. He made 23 appearances with three starts and finished fourth in the conference in saves.
- Erives holds a 3.00 career ERA and a 9-4 record overall with 61 total appearances, three starts and 11 saves over 129 innings.

- ASU has the highest winning percentage among all Pac-12 schools and the fourth-highest winning percentage among all NCAA schools at .708 (2,524-1,037-4) behind Texas (.728), Florida State (.729) and Miami (FL) (.710). ASU only includes its modern era (1959-present) in its record books, while the NCAA record book goes back to 1907.
- ASU's 2,524 wins in the modern era are tied for 23rd among all NCAA schools, but its 58 seasons are 11 fewer than the next closest team in the top 25 (Florida State at 69). 21 of those top 25 teams have over 100 years to their credit.
- ASU has finished the season nationally ranked in 45 seasons, including 27 times in the top 10, 22 in the top 5 and five No. 1
- ASU has notched 54 consecutive 30-win seasons, which is the most in the NCAA, and have won at least 30 games in 56 of the
 program's 58-year history in the modern era. The streak started with the 1963 season when ASU went 34-13. Florida State is
 second with 51 consecutive.
- ASU has 30 40-win seasons, 18 50-win seasons and four 60-win seasons

- Four Sun Devils made their debuts in the MLB during the 2016 season, bringing ASU's total to 108 all-time the most among all NCAA schools since 1959. HEAD COACH TRACY SMITH



TRACY SMITH - HEAD COACH - THIRD SEASON (21st OVERALL)

Tracy Smith, the 2013 National Coach of the Year, was hired as the fifth head baseball coach in program history on June 24, 2014, and enters his third season at the helm of the Sun Devil baseball program.

Smith has established a reputation of evaluating and developing talent as more than 50 student-athletes since 2000 improved their stock in the Major League Baseball Draft under Smith's tutelage, including four who became first-round draft picks after going undrafted out of high school.

In 20 total years as a head coach, Smith has seen 68 of his players selected in the MLB Draft, including 61 draftees since 2000 and 31 in the first 10 rounds. He has mentored 36 Major League Baseball draft picks over the past eight seasons, including the fourth overall pick in the 2014 Major League Baseball June Amateur Draft (Kyle Schwarber) and three first-round selections in the 2009 MLB June Draft (Eric Arnett, Josh Phegley, Matt Bashore).

In 2016, Smith piloted the Sun Devils to a regional final for the time since 2013. The Sun Devils' 36 wins were the most in the past three years and they finished tied for third in the Pac-12. Five players were selected in the 2016 Major League Baseball Draft, marking 14 total players who have been taken in the draft during Smith's tenure.

Eight Devils earned All-Pac-12 honors on the season, including first team selections David Greer, Seth Martinez, Brian Serven and Colby Woodmansee.

All four players would go on to be selected in the MLB draft with Greer (third team), Martinez (second team) and Woodmansee (third team) earning Louisville Slugger All-America accolades.

Smith was instrumental in Sun Devil Baseball's signing of the nation's top recruiting class in 2016, which included eight players who had been drafted by the Major League out of high school.

In his first season at ASU, Smith led the Sun Devils to a postseason berth, a third-place finish in the Pac-12 and 30-plus wins.

He became one of five active coaches, and one of eight all-time, to bring three different Div. I schools to NCAA Regional play as he guided the Sun Devils to a No. 2 seed in the Fullerton Regional in 2015.

He has amassed a 675-503-1 career record in 20 seasons as a head coach at three different schools, including nine seasons at both Miami (Ohio) and Indiana, and one year at Arizona State. His 675 victories rank in the top 50 among active coaches in the NCAA, and his 20 seasons represent the sixth-shortest number of years on the list.

Smith instituted a change in culture at Arizona State and his demand for excellence both on and off the field was represented as the Devils led the Pac-12 in both all-conference and all-academic honorees in 2014.

Nineteen players have earned Pac-12 All-Academic honors in Smith's first two seasons, tied for the most in Sun Devil history for a two-year span. ASU's 10 selections in Smith's first season led the Pac-12.

His emphasis on defense became evident right away as ASU vastly improved its fielding percentage and lowered its number of errors committed in Smith's first season. The Devils finished fourth in the Pac-12 in both categories in 2015 after ranking near the bottom of the conference from 2010-14.

An accomplished fundraiser, Smith played a huge role in helping transition the Sun Devil Baseball program into Phoenix Municipal Stadium. His vision saw a renovated clubhouse, complete with an alumni locker room and an academics center, as well as an increased prominence on the program's historical accomplishments. Capital improvements included a state-of-the art video board, batting tunnel, a weight room and training room, creation of a grass berm and patio installations, and premium seating options.

Smith earned National Coach of the Year honors and was a unanimous choice for Big Ten Coach of the Year after he led IU to the school's only College World Series appearance in 2013. The following season in 2014, Smith led the Hoosiers to the No. 4 national seed in the NCAA Tournament, the first national seed in Big Ten baseball history.

Smith came to Tempe with 18 years of experience as a collegiate head coach, including nine at Miami University (Ohio) and nine at IU, where he was two-time Big Ten Coach of the Year. He led both programs to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances and more than 600 combined

He tallied more than 40 wins in each of the past two seasons at IU and led the Hoosiers to consecutive Big Ten Conference Championships for the first time in school history. IU won the Big Ten regular season and B1G Tournament title in 2013, marking the school's first regular season conference championship since 1949 and the first outright crown since 1932, and advanced to the 2013 College World Series, which ended the Big Ten's 29-year CWS absence.


Smith took an IU program that had finished 10th in the Big Ten six times in an eight-year stretch between 2000 and 2007, and led the Hoosiers to an NCAA Regional in 2009 and to the College World Series in 2013. IU notched a program-best 21 conference wins in 2014 and secured eight first team All-Big Ten selections to tie a conference mark for most first team honorees from one school.

He began his coaching career as head coach at Miami University-Middletown in 1990, served as an assistant coach at Miami (Ohio) from 1993-94 and was the pitching coach at IU from 1995-96.

A four-year letterwinner at Miami (Ohio), Smith was a pitcher and an infielder for the RedHawks, and played three minor league seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization. He also participated in 1992 Major League Scouting Bureau's Professional Scout School as a representative of the Cubs.

Born Feb. 14, 1966, Smith graduated with a bachelor's degree in Education from Miami (Ohio) in 1989 and completed a master's degree in Sport Organization from Miami (Ohio) in 1992.

A native of Kentland, Ind., Smith and his wife, Jaime, have three sons, Casey, Ty and Jack. Casey was a four-year letterwinner on the Hoosier baseball team while Ty was a member for the IU football team. Jack is currently a quarterback on the Sun Devil football team.




- BEN GREENSPAN ASSISTANT COACH/RECRUITING COORDINATOR

 Ben Greenspan enters his third season at Arizona State University as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator, and works primarily with the team's offense and catchers.
- Excelling in his recruiting coordinator position, Greenspan assembled the No. 1 recruiting class in the nation in 2016 according to Collegiate Baseball Newspaper. The class is headlined by Hunter Bishop, who was rated the 15th best outfielder in the nation by Perfect Game. Bishop is joined by Chaz Montoya, the No. 1 left-handed pitcher in Arizona, and Carter Aldrete, the 23rd best shortstop in the nation according to Perfect Game.
- Catcher Brian Serven earned First Team All-Pac-12 recognition in 2016, as well as Pac-12 All-Academic honorable mention and was a semifinalist for the Johnny Bench Award, given to the nation's top catcher. His prowess on both sides of the plate was evident as he became just the fifth catcher in school history to lead the team in home runs and he caught 17 runners stealing, the most by a Sun Devil since 2009. Serven was the first Devil to go in the 2016 MLB Draft, going in the fifth round to the Colorado Rockies.
- Also excelling at the plate under Greenspan was first baseman David Greer, who also earned a First Team All-Conference selection as well as earning a spot on the Louisville Slugger All-America third team. The Arizona-native finished his junior campaign first in the conference in doubles and total bases, second in slugging percentage and third in runs scored. Greer was taken in the 10th round of the 2016 MLB Draft by the Seattle Mariners.
- Greenspan mentored some of the most prolific hitters in IU program history, including two-time All-American catcher Kyle Schwarber, current Oakland Athletics catcher Josh Phegley, and 2010 Big Ten Player of the Year Alex Dickerson. He also played a large role in developing talent at IU as 11 of his position players were selected in the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft,


including five in the top five rounds. In the eight years Greenspan has served as a catching coach, his guidance has produced a First Team All-Conference player at that position in five of those seasons with two of them currently playing MLB (Schwarber and Phegley).

- Additional hitting protégés include 2012 Big Ten Freshman of the Year Sam Travis, two-time All-American Dustin DeMuth and current major leaguers Micah Johnson and Ethan Wilson.
- Played for two seasons under coach Smith at IU, and was a Hoosier team captain and Academic All-Big Ten performer in 2007. He spent two years at the University of Connecticut as a catcher and first baseman before joining the IU program. He earned a bachelor's degree in Sport Marketing and Management and a master's degree in Sport Administration from Indiana University.




FRED NORI - ASSISTANT COACH

- This marks Nori's fifth stint working with Coach Smith after he served as the volunteer assistant for Indiana University in 2014 and 2007, for Miami University in 2005 and for the Sun Devils in 2015.
- Nori has three conference tournament championships, three NCAA Regional berths and two regular season conference crowns in four seasons as a Div. I assistant coach.
- He was a member of the 2014 IU team that won the Big Ten Conference championship and tournament championship, and became the first program in Big Ten history to earn a national seed. The RedHawks finished first in the Mid-American Conference, won the MAC Tournament championship and were an NCAA Regional participant in 2005. Nori was also a member of the 2009 Xavier Baseball staff, where he helped the Musketeers win the Atlantic 10 Tournament title and advance to an NCAA Regional.
- Nori has a long history of excellence in Ohio high school baseball and owns more than 20 years of head coaching experience that includes a Class A State Championship.
- Nori went on to play professional baseball for three seasons after his playing days at IU ended and he hit .284 with five home runs and 55 RBI as a member of the New York Mets organization. He was a student-athlete at IU from 1961-65, and earned his IU degree in 1965 and a master's degree from Xavier in 1969.





- Spent time in 2016 as an associate scout for the New York Mets.




