## **QUICK HITS**

- The Sun Devils are currently on a three-match win streak, winning nine of their last sets in a row. ASU swept the season series over Cal for the first time since 2016.
- Leading the offense has been the pin hitter duo
  of sophomore Iman Isanovic and freshman Marta
  Levinska. They have the two highest kill totals with
  188 for Isanovic and 175 for Levinska, the only
  two on the team in triple digits.
- Sophomore middle blocker Kennedi Boyd has been a strong force at the net this season. She is currently ranked second in the conference and 30th in the nation for total blocks with 65.
- The setting duties have been split this season. Sophomore Shannon Shields has been the primary setter for the last three matches, leading the team to two of its top three hitting percentages of the season. She has 120 assists on the season. Freshman Ella Snyder leads the team with 362 assists this season.
- Sophomore libero Annika Larson has a team-high 221 digs on the year and has reached double figures in digs in all but two matches this season. She is second in the Pac-12 for total digs.
- The group of defensive specialists have split time throughout the season. Paige Denton and Alasia Urena have played in 40 and 27 sets, respectively. Emily Holbrook has appeared in 19 sets and Madi Berkholz has come in for 14 sets. Denton and Berkholz have also seen time at libero.

## **Scouting the Opposition** Stanford (1-5)

- The Cardinal has had a tough season due to COVID-related issues and precautions. With just six matches under their belt, their only win has come against Cal at home.
- Sophomore Kendall Kipp leads the team in kills with 84, notching double digits in all but one match so far. Fellow sophomore Selina Xu has been the primary setter 211 assists. On defense, freshman Elena Oglivie has 83 digs to lead the team.
- ASU is looking for its first win over Stanford since 2015 and first win at Stanford since 1982.

#### Player of the Week

Freshman Marta Levinska was named hte Pac-12 Freshman of the Week on 1/26 after helping ASU take down No. 8 Washington in the season opener on the road. She had 18 kills and 10 digs in the win. She also totaled 31 kills over the weekend.

#### **New Kids On The Block**

There are 10 new faces on the roster: seven freshmen and three transfers. Of the seven freshmen, two are liberos, two are outside hitters, one is a setter and two are middle blockers. The transfers include two outside hitters and one setter.

#### **Worldwide Sun Devils**

The Sun Devils continued to be represented by countries all around the world. On the coaching staff, head coach Sanja Tomasevic is from Serbia and associate head coach Carlos Moreno is from Brazil.

On the roster, there are six international student-athletes. Megan Beedie and Jinna Zeng are from Canada, Ayyuce Altintas is from Turkey, Iman Isanovic is from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Marta Levinska is from Latvia and Roberta Rabelo is from Brazil.

#### 2020-21 Outlook

Last season Sun Devil Volleyball set numerous records for the program and are looking to do the same in 2021. The Sun Devils improved to a 17-14 record, 9-11 in the Pac-12 in 2019, improving three wins in the regular season tally and four in conference play. This left the team at eighth place in the Pac-12, the highest finish since 2015.

Notable wins last season includes two victories against Washington State, who was ranked for both matches. ASU also beat Arizona in two Territorial Cup matches, and completed season sweeps against both Oregon and Oregon State.

#### **Career Leaders**

On this young squad, senior Megan Beedie has the highest career numbers in multiple categories. She has 375 kills, 149 blocks and 23 aces. Junior Noa Miller has the most assists with 777 and digs with 361.

#### **Young and Mighty**

The roster features just four upperclassmen with eight freshmen and six sophomores. With only four returning starters (Megan Beedie, Kennedi Boyd, Iman Isanovic and Noa Miller) the Sun Devils will look different this season.

#### Pac-12 Preseason Poll

The Sun Devils were picked to finish 9th in the Pac-12 preseason poll, ahead of Arizona, Cal and Oregon State. ASU finished the 2019 season in 8th place. Utah was picked to win the conference.

#### Oh, Canada

Canadian Megan Beedie spent summer 2019 a Canadian national team. Beedie was part of the NextGen squad and most recently competed in the 2019 Pan American Games.


