SUN DEVIL LACROSSE PREVIEW

Arizona State Lacrosse (3-1) returns to Tempe to host No. 6 Michigan (4-0) on Tuesday, February 27 at 3:00 p.m. MST. The game will be streamed via the ASU Live Stream, which will be available here, and tickets are available for purchase here. Tuesday marks the first time a ranked team will come to Tempe since April 22, 2022 when No. 17 USC was in town. The Sun Devils have not defeated a ranked opponent since May 5, 2022 in the 13-12 win over No. 16 USC.

Sun Devil Outlook:

The Sun Devils come off of a road loss to No. 11 Stony Brook where they faced just a one-goal deficit at the half, but ultimately fell 20-9 to the Seawolves in the team's first road game of the season.

The last time ASU faced Michigan was in 2022, when the Sun Devils traveled to Ann Arbor on February 18, 2022 and suffered a 9-11 defeat against the then-No. 11 team in the nation. The game was current junior goalkeeper Katie Vahle's first in the Maroon & Gold. Since then, Vahle has racked up over 300 saves and leads the program recordbooks in that category.

In day games, ASU is 2-1 this season and has not yet lost at home this season. The Sun Devils are also 3-0 when scoring the first goal of the game, and have just trailed for 92 seconds in the three games at home, all of which came with early 2-1 deficits.

Scouting the Opponent:

The Michigan Wolverines checked in at No. 6 on the polls after posting a 4-0 record in the first four games this season. Michigan holds the best scoring defense in the NCAA, allowing just three goals per game, and has the highest save percentage of 0.769.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS:

- Senior attacker Mina Scott is 6th all-time in goals with 59, and 7th all-time with 71 points. No other active player is in the top-10 for all time goals or assists.
- With 31 saves this season, Junior goalkeeper Katie Vahle has increased her program-leading career save mark with 344 passing Berkeley Bonneau's 310.
- With three wins in four games this season, Vahle is just two wins shy of tying Berkeley Bonneau's program-best 20 wins.

TEAM NOTABLES:

- The Sun Devils have spent just 92 seconds trailing their opponents this season. ASU faced 2-1 deficits against Xavier and Pittsburgh, but was able to even the game 2-2 44 and 48 seconds, respectively, after their opponents had taken the lead.
- ASU is facing their second ranked opponent in as many games. The Sun Devils have not defeated a ranked opponent since May 5, 2022 in the 13-12 win over No. 16 USC.
- The Sun Devils' 3-0 start to the season for the first time in program history, but was halted after a loss to Stony Brook last weekend.
- In the first half, the Sun Devils have outscored their opponents 44-20 through the first three games.

PLAYER NOTABLES:

- Zoe Mazur's 9.00 draw controls per game are the sixth-best individual mark in the NCAA and third best in the Pac-12.
- With her four scores against Pittsburgh, Shannon Urey leads ASU with 12 goals on the season.
- Anna Thornton's 16 points (7G-5A) have her at third most in the Pac-12.

Sun Devil Athletics hired Taryn VanThof as the new Lacrosse Head Coach, Vice President of University Athletics Ray Anderson announced on July 5, 2022

VanThof comes to Arizona State after an extremely successful six-year stint as the Assistant Coach at national power Florida. There she served as the Offensive Coordinator, Goalie Coach, Draw Specialist, and Recruiting Coordinator for the Gators.

“Thank you to Vice President for University Athletics Ray Anderson and Senior Associate AD/SWA Christina Wombacher for this opportunity to lead the Sun Devil Lacrosse program,” VanThof remarked. “I could not be more thrilled to coach at this extraordinary university.”

Under the direction of VanThof and Head Coach Amanda O’Leary, Florida has emerged as one of the nation’s premiere programs over the past six years. In 2022, the Gators made their fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament, earning a bid every year of VanThof’s tenure. She arrives in Tempe coming off two straight appearances in the NCAA Quarterfinal Round (Elite Eight) with Florida.

“Taryn VanThof is a tremendous addition to the Sun Devil Family.” Vice President of University Athletics Ray Anderson stated. “We identified her as the right person to lead this program on the rise because of her energy, passion, and desire to be at Arizona State.”

Prior to launching a budding career in coaching, VanThof was a standout All-American midfielder at Loyola Maryland from 2011-15. She competed at the professional level as recently as the 2021 season in the Athletes Unlimited League.

As the Offensive Coordinator, Goalie Coach, Draw Specialist, and Recruiting Coordinator, VanThof had an impact on all aspects of the program for the last six years. The Gators finished the season ranked in the Top-10 all but one of those seasons, proving to be one of the most consistent and well-coached teams in the country.

She began her coaching career at Rutgers in 2016, getting a taste of Big Ten action immediately following the completion of her collegiate career. During her only season in New Brunswick, she helped orchestrate a four-win improvement, with two Scarlet Knights named to the Big Ten All-Conference Team.
