#BYTHENUMBERS

Drew Swift has been one of the elite freshmen in the country in the small sample size to date, posting a .354 on-base percentage thanks to his 18 walks - just outside the Pac-12 top-10.. His biggest impact, however, has come from his much-needed defensive prowess at shortstop. Swift is second in the Pac-12 with 108 defensive assists this season. The frosh has helped to turn 22 double plays this season, tied for third in the Pac-12 and helping the Sun Devils sit second in Pac-12 with 28 total double plays this season.

Spencer Torkelson has 18 home runs in 36 games this season, a total that leads the nation and is nine more than any other freshman. He has advanced baserunners a team-best 36 times on 78 chances (.468) and has provided plenty of productive outs as well leading the way with 19 runners advanced with an out, nine more than any other Sun Devil. Torkelson's 13 twoout RBI also pace the squad and are six more than any other player on the roster. Torkelson needs 5 home runs to move in ASU's single-season Top-3 all-time.

Alika Williams and Lyle Lin each find themselves becoming increasingly difficult to strike out, currently ranked 6th and 8th in the Pac-12 - respectively - in averaging just one strikeout per every 10 at-bats. Williams has struck out just 11 times on 115 at-bats this season with Lin not far behind him with just 14 strikeouts in 151 at-bats. Williams has been impressive at the plate of late, notching a hit in 19 of his last 22 games with a .305 average in those games while he was at it.

Alec Marsh leads, the team with a 2.79 ERA in 9 appearances. His ERA is good for 11th in the Pac-12 while opponent's .204 batting average against Marsh is the 8thlowest in the Pac-12. Opponents have just 8 extra base hits in 42.0 innings pitched. His four doubles allowed are the lowest total in the Pac-12 among starting pitchers and he has allowed just 31 total hits - good for sixth in the league. Marsh enters the weekend with two consecutive quality starts since being named the Friday night starter

During games, credentials must be worn in plain view throughout the game while on the field and all photographers must adhere to painted lines and instructions given by security personnel and/or Arizona State staff members at all times. Shooting areas are designated camera wells on the far side of both the visitor's and home team's dugouts. Contact Jeremy Hawkes for any details regarding shooting game action.

Media Highlights Policy

Highlights include Pac-12 Networks/ESPN/FOX broadcasts and all home hosted non-televised competitions, including those that are live streamed. ESPN networks (i.e., ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU) will also televise all NCAA College World Series games from Saturday, June 17, through Wednesday, June 28. No other broadcast network or Internet entity, other than ESPN, may air these games, nor show highlights of these games until the ESPN broadcast is off the air. Broadcast networks / television stations may use up to three (3) minutes (per newscast) of video footage from any one game or five (5) minutes total of video footage from all games played on that particular day of competition for up to 72 hours following the game / broadcast. No media entity (commercial or noncommercial) is allowed to display any game video on its website. If a commercial broadcast entity wishes to license video footage beyond the previously described time period (72 hours), all requests to obtain clips or copies of NCAA championships / events (e.g., game / program records, melt / highlight tapes) need to go through the NCAA / T3 Media online footage request system, which can be found at the following website: http://www.t3licensing.com/video/home/ncaa.do.

2018 Media Coverage

Every single one of the Sun Devils' 35 home games will be available to fans via the Pac-12 Networks or the Pac-12 Live Stream online and a total of 13 games overall are scheduled to be televised live through the Pac-12 Networks.

The Sun Devil Sports Radio Network is scheduled to broadcast 35 Sun Devil Baseball games this season between NBC Sports Radio AM 1060. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on the radio or via the Tuneln app on thesundevils.com. Links to the streaming audio can be found on the online baseball schedule.

Tim Healey is set to serve his 20th season as the "Voice of the Sun Devils" on baseball broadcasts and will be joined for the second-straight season by color analyst Max Rossiter, who was an all-conference catcher for the Devils from 2012-13.

Scouting the Utes

- ASU is 38-11 all-time against the Utes.
- Utah leads the Pac-12 with 30 double plays and ranks third with 360 assists and fifth in fielding percentage (.976).
- The Utes are fourth with 29 stolen bases and tied for fourth with eight triples.
- Utah pitchers are tied for first in the Pac-12 with 13 pickoffs.
- DaShawn Keirsey, Jr., ranks in the top 10 in the league in several categories including leading the league in doubles (14) and ranking second in slugging percentage (.389). He is ninth in the NCAA in doubles per game (0.48). Keirsey is also third in the Pac-12 in hits per game (1.52).
- Oliver Dunn ranks third in the league in assists and is tied for second with 24
- double plays. Matt Richardson is tied for fifth in the league with 22 double plays and
 is fifth in assists (86). Wade Gulden ranks tied for fourth in the Pac-12 with three
 triples.
- Trenton Stoltz is third in the Pac-12 with 20 appearances and is tied for eighth in the league with four saves. Brett Brocoff is one of three pitchers in the Pac-12 this year who has not given up a home run.

Eli's Coming

- Eli Lingos leads the team this year with five quality starts in his eight starts to date. Of note on that, however, is that he went 5.2 innings in two other starts while allowing fewer than 3 runs, meaning he is just 2 outs away from having seven quality starts in his nine starts to date.
- Lingos led the Sun Devils with six quality starts last season. No other Sun Devil had more than one quality start on the year.
- Lingos has picked off a Pac-12-leading four runners thus far this season.
- Lingos is second in the Pac-12 with 59.1 innings pitched this season and is tied for second with five victories.
- Lingos has 55 strikeouts this year, good for a tie for second in the Pac-12. He is already within 11 strikeouts of his previous career season best of 66 set last season.

- Lingos opened Pac-12 action with career bests in innings pitched in three straight gaesm as he went 7.2 innings against Oregon, 8.0 innings against #16 UCLA and 9.0 innings in a complete game shutout of Washington State.

- of the Oregon and USC games, a period of four starts.
- Lingos has showed a veteran presence when he gets ahead in counts, striking out 33 batters on 0-2 or 1-2 counts with opponents batting just 8-of-64 in the process (.125).
- Lingos is throwing a strike 65.8 percent of a the time, a total that leads all Sun Devil pitchers. He has only fallen behind 2-0 in the count 25 times on 253 batters faced this season and has faced just 13 3-0 counts in the process.

12-Gage

- Gage Canning was named to the Golden Spikes National Player of the Year Award's Midseason Watch List and is currently fourth in the Pac-12 with a .379 average this season.
- Canning has reached base in 35 of 36 games this season and has a hit in 32 of those.
- Canning has seven games this season with 3 or more hits four more than any other player on the Sun Devil roster. Last
 season, he became the first player to reach double digits in the
 category (10) since Jason Kipnis had 13 in 2009.
- He has multiple hits in 16 games to date.
- The junior became the first Devil since before 1998 at least (as early as easily accessibly game-by-game records go) to start a season on a 16-game hitting streak.
- He is first in the Pac-12 with 58 hits this season and first in the nation in triples with nine.
- Canning was a consensus National Player of the Week following ASU's sweep of Oregon and the Pac-12 Player of the Week as well. On the weekend, the junior went 10-for-13 from the plate (.769) with two home runs (one inside-the-park), two triples, eight runs scored, seven RBIs, three walks, a 1.615 slugging percentage and a .813 on-base percentage in the series.
- Canning leads the team with a .429 average with runners in scoring position on 11-of-26 chances.

Gage Gets Triples

- Canning is the NCAA's active leader in career triples with 23
 so far in his career and nine this season a total that also leads
 the NCAA and is three more than any other player.
- The NCAA career record for triples is 32 (set by Indiana State's Bob Zeihen over a four-year career from 1985-88) and the NCAA single season record is 17 (set by New Mexico's Keith Hagman in 1980). At Canning's current clip, he could be on pace to challenge both of those by the end of the season.
- The ASU career record for triples is 26 by Alan Bannister and Ed Irvine back in the 1970s.
- The junior also gets plenty of doubles second the Pac-12 with 11 so far this season and adding five home runs for a .714 slugging percentage that is 15th nationally and fourth in the Pac-12.

#LINSANITY2018

- Lyle Lin had his 15 game-hitting streak to start the season come to an end in the finale against UNCW. He and Canning had become the only Sun Devils since at least 1998 to start a season on a 15-game hitting streak.
- Lin enters this weekend batting .325 on the season, good for 11th in the Pac-12 while his 49 total hits are third in the league.
- Lin has multiple hits in 15 games this season, good for second on the team.
- The sophomore leads the team with 17 hits this season with two outs and is batting .362 (17-of-47) in the process.
- His 12 hits with runners in scoring position are second on the team.
- Lin is the eighth-toughest player in the Pac-12 to strikeout this season, doing so just once every 10.1 at bats this season.
- Lin is fourth in the Pac-12 with nine runners caught stealing this season.

Fear the Tork

- Spencer Torkelson was named to the Golden Spikes National Player of the Year Award's Midseason Watch List.
- The freshman has 18 home runs in 36 games this season, a total that is alone for first in the nation and leads all freshmen nine more than any other freshman in the country.
- In NCAA history, no freshman has ever led the country in home runs at the end of the season. Torkelson also will have a shot at the NCAA freshman record of 26, current held by Todd Greene of Georgia Southern back in 1990.
- He needs 5 home runs over the final 19 games to move into ASU's all-time Top-3 in the category as he looks to tie Jeff Larish, Oddibe McDowell and Barry Bonds at 23.
- Against Washington State, he surpassed the previous Sun Devil freshman record of 11 home runs set by Barry Bonds in 1983.
- The freshman was named the Pac-12 Player of the Week following Long Beach State and Oklahoma State.
- Torkelson has a .311 average, with 26 of his 42 hits this season going for extra bases as he has slugged .770 on the year good for 6th nationally.
- Torkelson is sixth in the Pac-12 with 35 RBIs, surpassing the team leader for the entirety of last season.
- Torkelson leads the team in having reached base in 20 consecutive games.

#TorksUp

- He has advanced baserunners a team-best 36 times on 77 chances (.468) and has provided plenty of productive outs as well leading the way with 19 runners advanced with an out, nine more than any other Sun Devil.
- Torkelson's 13 two-out RBI also pace the squad and are six more than any other player on the roster.
- Torkelson has 10 games this season with multiple RBIs, two

- more than any other Sun Devil.
- The freshman also leads the team with 21 walks this season and tied for 11th in the Pac-12.
- More superlative love for the frosh includes his prowess leading off an inning, where he is 17-of-29 (.586) with five home runs and three doubles. He has 28 hits when the bases are empty this season and leads the team with a .412 average in the process.
- Torkelson is the only freshman in the nation represented on the Golden Spikes Award midseason watch list. Since the Golden Spikes Award began releasing a midseason watch list in 2012, Torkelson is just the 13th freshman out of 400 overall selections to be honored and is the first since the 2016 season.

A Swift Start

- Drew Swift has been one of the top freshmen in the conference, posting a .354 on-base percentage thanks to his 18 walks.
 His biggest impact, however, has come from his much-needed defensive prowess at shortstop.
- Swift is second in the Pac-12 with 108 defensive assists this season.
- The frosh has helped to turn 22 double plays this season, tied for fifth in the Pac-12 and helping the Sun Devils sit second Pac-12 with 28 total double plays this season.
- The freshman has produced many productive at-bats, second on the team in advancing runners 30 times on 64 attempts thus far this season (.469).

Taylor Made

- Taylor Lane has been ASU's top hitter in Pac-12 games this season, leading the way with a .395 average in conference games, a total the would lead the Pac-12 if not for Lane coming just shy of the league minimum requirements for at-bats.
- Lane's .439 on-base percentage in Pac-12 games also leads the team and would be good for 11th in the Pac-12.

A Lot to Alika

- Alika Williams posted just one hit in the first two weekends of action and was batting .205 up until March 10 against UNCW.
- Since that UNCW game, Williams has a hit in 19 of the last 22 games (multiple hits in five of those) with a .305 average
- Williams has been among ASU's top players with two outs, leading the team with a .400 average on 16-of-40 hitting and is second on the team with seven two-out RBIs.
- Williams is the sixth toughest player to strike out in the Pac-12, doing so just once every 10.5 at bats this season.

Marshing to the Beat

- Alec Marsh has been exceptional for the Sun Devils this season, leading the team with a 2.79 ERA in 9 appearancs.
- His ERA is good for 11th in the Pac-12 while opponent's .204 batting average against Marsh is the 8th-lowest in the Pac-12.
- Opponents have just 8 extra base hits in 42.0 innings pitched.

- His four doubles allowed are the lowest total in the Pac-12 among starting pitchers and he has allowed just 31 total hits good for sixth in the league.
- Marsh went 8.1 innings before allowing a run against USC in his first-ever Friday Night start, earning the victory. He followed that up with his second consecutive quality start against No. 2 Stanford the following weekend.

Putting in that Work(man)

- Gage Workman has continued to improve through the season and finds himself a staple at the year.
- Workman is batting .348 in Pac-12 conference games this season, second on the team and is third on the team in such games with 9 RBI.
- The .348 average in league games is good for 11th in the Pac-

Movin' On Up

As has become commonplace at Arizona State, five Sun Devils heard their names called in the MLB Draft following the 2016 season. The Sun Devils have had five or more players drafted in 46 of the 53 MLB Drafts held since 1956 and five or more players have gotten the call in 13 of the last 15 seasons.

Keeping the Tradition Alive

- Four Sun Devils made their debuts in the MLB during the 2016 season, bringing ASU's total to 108 all-time the most among all NCAA schools since 1959. Jake Barrett (Diamondbacks) and Tony Barnette (Rangers) each saw their first Big League action in the opening month of the MLB season last year while Brady Rodgers (Astros) and Trevor Williams (Pirates) bookended things, appearing in the final month of the season.
- The Sun Devils have now had at least one major league player on their varsity roster each year from 1961 through 2013, which is the longest current streak in the nation. Thirty-three ASU baseball players have made their MLB debuts since 2002.



TRACY SMITH - HEAD COACH - THIRD SEASON (21st OVERALL)

OVERVIEW

- · 2013 National Coach of the Year
- 75 of his players have been selected in the MLB Draft, including 68 draftees since 2000 and 32 in the first 10 rounds
- Coached the fourth overall pick in the 2014 Major League Baseball June Amateur Draft (Kyle Schwarber) and three first-round selections in the 2009 MLB June Draft (Eric Arnett, Josh Phegley, Matt Bashore)
- One of five active coaches and one of eight all-time to bring three different Div. I schools to NCAA Regional play when he guided the Sun Devils to a No. 2 seed in the Fullerton Regional in 2015
- Has amassed a 698-535-1 career record in 21 seasons as a head coach at three different schools, including nine seasons at both Miami (Ohio) and Indiana, and three years at Arizona State
- His 698 victories rank in the Top-40 among active coaches in the NCAA, and his 21 seasons represent the fourth-fewest number of years on that list to be ranked within the Top-40

ARIZONA STATE (2014-p)

- Hired as the fifth head baseball coach in program history on June 24, 2014
- Enters his fourth season at the helm of the Sun Devil baseball program
- Has seen 22 players earn Pac-12 All-Conference honors
- · Coached three players to All-American honors in 2015 (Seth Martinez, David Greer and Colby Woodmansee)
- 24 players have earned Pac-12 All-Academic honors in Smith's first three seasons (ASU's 10 selections in Smith's first season led the Pac-12)



- Tallied more than 40 wins in his final two seasons at IU and led the Hoosiers to consecutive Big Ten Conference Championships for the first time in school history
- Won the Big Ten regular season and B1G Tournament title in 2013, marking the school's first regular season conference championship since 1949 and the first outright crown since 1932, and advanced to the 2013 College World Series, which ended the Big Ten's 29-year CWS absence

<u>BEN GREENSPAN - ASSISTANT COACH/RECRUITING COORDINATOR</u>

-The 2017 campaign saw Gage Canning emerge as one of the elite players in the Pac-12 with Greenspan helping to oversee that growth. He was the only player in the Pac-12 to finish with a double-digit number of doubles while also posting at least six home runs and six triples.

-Greenspan also helped oversee the emergence of Hunter Bishop as one of the exciting young freshmen in the country on the year. Bishop started 31 games in the outfield eason to become just the sixth ASU freshman in the pa<mark>st 15 years to start over 5</mark>0 percent of the season in the outfield.

-Catcher Brian Serven earned First Team All-Pac-12 recognition in 2016, as well as Pac-12 All-Academic honorable mention and was a semifinalist for the Johnny Bench Award, given to the nation's top catcher. His prowess on both sides of the plate was evident as he became just the fifth catcher in school history to lead the team in home runs and he caught 17 runners stealing, the most by a Sun Devil since 2009.

-Also excelling at the plate under Greenspan was first baseman David Greer, who also earned a First Team All-Conference selection as well as earning a spot on the Louisville Slugger All-America third team. The Arizona-native finished his junior campaign first in the conference in doubles and total bases, second in slugging percentage and third in runs

I-n his first season at ASU, Greenspan helped the Sun Devils excel both offensively and defensively. The Devils ranked in the top half of the Pac-12 in a number of offensive categories, including second in slugging percentage, third in both batting average and hits, and posted their best defensive numbers since 2010 as they finished fourth in the conference in both fielding percentage and errors.

-Excelling in his recruiting coordinator position, Greenspan assembled the No. 1 recruiting class in the nation in 2016 according to Collegiate Baseball Newspaper. Greenspan followed that up in playing a big part in another Top-5 Nationally ranked recruiting class in 2017, and the top recruiting class in the Pac-12 and the West. The 2017 Sun Devil class features six signees who participated in the 2015 Area Code Baseball Games, an invitation-only elite baseball event held annually in Long Beach, Calif., and one who played in the Tournament of the Stars - a showcase hosted by USA Baseball.

Greenspan spent six seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, including the past year as recruiting coordinator, and worked extensively with the team's catchers and hitters. The Hoosiers' offense ranked in the top 25 in the nation in batting average, slugging percentage, total hits and extra-base hits in 2014.


Greenspan mentored some of the most prolific hitters in IU program history, including two-time All-American catcher Kyle Schwarber, current Oakland Athletics catcher Josh Phegley, and 2010 Big Ten Player of the Year Alex Dickerson. He also played a large role in developing talent at IU as 11 of his position players were selected in the Major League Baseball First Year Player Draft, including five in the top five rounds. In the eight years Greenspan has served as a catching coach, his guidance has produced a First Team All-Conference player at that position in five of those seasons with two of them currently playing MLB (Schwarber and Phegley).

Greenspan's additional hitting protégés include 2012 Big Ten Freshman of the Year Sam Travis, two-time All-American Dustin DeMuth and current major leaguers Micah Johnson and Ethan Wilson.

Greenspan played for two seasons under coach Smith at IU, and was a Hoosier team captain and Academic All-Big Ten performer in 2007. He spent two years at the University of Connecticut as a catcher and first baseman before joining the IU program. He earned a bachelor's degree in Sport Marketing and Management and a master's degree in Sport Administration from Indiana University.

Greenspan is originally from West Point, N.Y., and is married to his wife, Janine. The pair have two children, Grayson and Adalyn.





-Prior to his coaching career, Cather had a 10-year career as a professional pitcher with three seasons spent in Major League Baseball with the Atlanta Braves (1997-99). Cather did not allow an earned run in his first eight games in the MLB and helped the Braves to a spot in the National League Championship Series against the Florida Marlins in 1998.

-Among his professional assignments and developments through the years, Cather has worked with All-Stars Josh Beckett and Clay Buchholz, as well as the likes of Matt Wisler, Carl Edwards, Jr., Joe Ross and Daniel Bard.

-In 2014, Cather joined the Chicago Cubs organization as the pitching coach for the lowa Cubs at the Triple-A level and oversaw a pitching staff that led the Pacific Coast League in ERA, setting several club records in the process. He developed young and veteran players for the team's postseason run in 2015

-Cather joined the San Diego Padres organization in 2012 where he served as the Minor League Pitching Coordinator as well as the pitching coach for the El Paso Chihuahuas, the Padres' Triple-A affiliate. In El Paso, Cather worked under former Sun Devil Baseball head coach Pat Murphy. He also initiated and created the throwing program used for Dominican players at the overseas academy.

Cather began his career in the professional ranks with the Boston Red Sox organization in 2006. He joined the organization as the pitching coach for the Class A Wilmington Blue Rocks before being promoted to pitching coach for the Portland Sea Dogs, the Red Sox's Double-A affiliate, in 2007. In 2010, Cather was named as one of Boston's Major League advanced scouts, where he provided reports and insight to the organization's Major League staff.

-During his playing career with the Braves, Cather pitched two scoreless innings of relief in Game 2 against the Houston Astros in the 1998 National League Divisional series after helping the team to the NL Eastern Division title. In the National League Championship Series against the Marlins, Cather did not allow a run over four games.



MICHAEL EARLEY - VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH/HITTING COACH

-Earley will also serve as the team's outfield coach and helped pace one of the top outfields in the Pac-12 in 2017. On the year, first-team All-Pac-12 selection Gage Canning started in every single game for the Sun Devils and while providing stellar defense with zero errors on the season and leading the team in outfield assists

-Canning led the team in virtually every hitting category, including batting average (.332), runs (37), doubles (12), triples (8), home runs (6) and slugging percentage (.538). He was the only player in the Pac-12 to finish with a double-digit number of doubles while also posting at least six home runs and six triples.


-Earley also helped oversee the emergence of Hunter Bishop as one of the exciting young freshmen in the country on the year. The freshman earned All-Pac-12 honors and finished his 2017 campaign with an impressive .301 batting average, five doubles, four triples and five home runs. He ranked second on the team - behind only Canning - in batting average, runs scored (27), triples, home runs and slugging percentage (.484).

-During the 2017 pitching coach search, Earley was granted a waiver to recruit by the NCAA. Earley assisted in recruiting during the spring and summer of 2017. During that time Earley helped identify prospects and recruits for the 2017 through 2020 recruiting classes. The 2017 recruiting class was ranked fourth in the country andt tops in the Pac 12.

-Earley played under Smith at Indiana from 2008-10 before going on to a professional career with the Chicago White Sox organization. He played professional baseball for six seasons, including time with the team's Triple-A affiliate, the Charlotte Knights.


-The outfielder finished his playing days with the Southern Illinois Miners in the independent Frontier League in 2015. He finished his professional career with 559 hits, 117 doubles, 38 home runs and a .284 average. He was named to four All-Star teams in his professional career and was also named a member of the Southern Illinois All-Decade Team.

-Earley earned Third Team All-Big Ten recognition during his senior campaign at IU in 2010 after he tied for fourth in the conference in home runs with 13, and finished the season batting .352. Earley was the only player in the Big Ten with double digit homeruns and stolen bases during the 2010 season.


