His 0.77 ERA is second in the Pac-12 and 17th nationally. His 34 strikeouts are third in the league. Marsh dominates when getting ahead of the count, holding batters to 1-15 hitting (.067) with balls in play on 0-2 counts and 1-of-121hitting (.048) on

> Hunter Bishop is tied for the national lead with 12 home runs this season - four more than any other player in the Pac-12. His 1.039 slugging percentage leads the nation as well while his .552 on-base percentage is third in the country. Bishop has scored 34 runs this season, first in the league and second nationally. The junior is also third in the country and leads the league with 33 RBIs already this season. His .442 batting average is second in the Pac-12 and ranks in the Top-15 nationally. He leads ASU with an active 12-game hitting streak.

Chaz Montoya has not allowed an earned run since the second game of the season - a streak of nine consecutive appearances. Additionally, Montoya has not walked a batter in his last 8 pitching apperances. Montoya has inherited 13 runners this season, allowing just one of them to scoreln his 11 appearances, Montoya has retired the first batter he has seen on 9 occasions. Media planning to attend must contact Jeremy Hawkes (520-403-0121/jdhawkes@asu.edu) ahead of time and inform him of their plans. Throughout the season's schedule, ASU will host postgame interviews in the Omaha Room located in the home locker room following coach's postgame talk with the team. Media members should request players at the beginning of the ninth inning. Please contact Jeremy Hawkes or a member of the media relations staff in the press box to coordinate those interviews. Media members who wish to schedule an interview outside of practice must contact Jeremy Hawkes.

Photography/Videoography

Accomodations for B-Roll purposes at practice can be made through Jeremy Hawkes (jdhawkes@asu.edu). During games, credentials must be worn in plain view throughout the game while on the field and all photographers must adhere to painted lines and instructions given by security personnel and/or Arizona State staff members at all times. Shooting areas are designated camera wells on the far side of both the visitor's and home team's dugouts. At no point during game action should a member of the media be on the field of play. Contact Jeremy Hawkes for any details regarding shooting game action.

Media Highlights Policy

Highlights include Pac-12 Networks/ESPN/FOX broadcasts and all home hosted nontelevised competitions, including those that are live streamed. ESPN networks (i.e., ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU) will also televise all NCAA College World Series games from Saturday, June 17, through Wednesday, June 28. No other broadcast network or Internet entity, other than ESPN, may air these games, nor show highlights of these games until the ESPN broadcast is off the air. Broadcast networks / television stations may use up to three (3) minutes (per newscast) of video footage from any one game or five (5) minutes total of video footage from all games played on that particular day of competition for up to 72 hours following the game / broadcast. No media entity (commercial or noncommercial) is allowed to display any game video on its website. If a commercial broadcast entity wishes to license video footage beyond the previously described time period (72 hours), all requests to obtain clips or copies of NCAA championships / events (e.g., game / program records, melt / highlight tapes) need to go through the NCAA / T3 Media online footage request system, which can be found at the following website: http://www.t3licensing.com/video/home/ncaa.do.

2019 Media Coverage

The vast majority the Sun Devils' 34 home games will be available to fans via the Pac-12 Network or the Pac-12 Live Stream online and a total of 15 games overall are scheduled to be televised live through the Pac-12 Networks.

The Sun Devil Sports Radio Network is scheduled to broadcast 32 Sun Devil Baseball games this season between NBC Sports Radio AM 1060. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on the radio or via the Tuneln app on the sundevils.com. Links to the streaming audio can be found on the online baseball schedule.

Tim Healey is set to serve his 21st season as the "Voice of the Sun Devils" on baseball broadcasts and will be joined for the third-straight season by color analyst Max Rossiter, who was an all-conference catcher for the Devils from 2012-13.

Head Coach Tracy Smith's weekly radio show, "Dugout Chatter," will debut in March on NBC Sports Radio AM 1060. The 30-minute show will run mainly on Wednesday's at 7 p.m. for nine weeks and is hosted by the Tim Healey.

PHOENIX -- Sun Devil Baseball continues Pac-12 play this weekend with its first conference road series, heading to the Pacific Northwest for a three-game series against Oregon. The series is scheduled to begin Friday, March 22 in at PK Park in Eugene Oregon. First pitch is scheduled for 6 p.m. Saturday's game is slated to get underway at 4 p.m. with the finale taking place at 12 p.m. on Sunday. Each game of the series will be streamed live through the Pac-12 Network Oregon Live Steam.

- Each game will be streamed live online through the Pac-12 Oregon Live Stream.
- Fans are encouraged to follow along in-game content throughout the weekend on the Sun Devil Baseball account (@ASU_Baseball).

A Hot Start

- The Sun Devils are the lone remaining undefeated team in the country, entering the weekend at 20-0.
- ASU's 20-0 start is the longest winning streak for the Sun Devils (and longest streak to start the season) since ASU went 24-0 to start the 2010 campaign. It is the third-longest winning streak to start a season in school history behind 2010 and 1961 (21-0).
- The Sun Devil offense has put up monster numbers during the start, scoring 203 runs (third nationally).
 ASU is third in the country in scoring at 10.2 runs per game
- The Sun Devils have scored double digit runs in 10 of the team's 20 games this season. For perspective, ASU scored double digit runs just 8 times last season.
- ASU is third nationally in home runs (first in the league) with 34, second nationally in batting average (.349), fourth in on-base percentage (.433) and second in slugging percentage (.566).
- While much ado has been made about the bats, it has been the Sun Devil pitching rotation that has
 quietly put up a 2.62 ERA that is currently 11th in the nation and third in the Pac-12 after several
 consecutive seasons above a 4.50 team ERA.

Fear the Tork

- All-American Spencer Torkelson now has mutiple hits in 31 of his 75 career starts (.413).
- Torkelson is batting .390 on the season on 32-of-82 hitting with three home runs, five doubles with 24 RBIs.
- His 32 hits are 4th in the league and 30th nationally while his 24 RBIs are also fourth in the conference and 44th in the country.
- Torkelson has multiple hits in a team-best 12 of ASU's 20 games this season and at least one RBI in 11 of those (multiple RBIs in 6).
- Torkelson is batting .433 with runners in scoring position with a team best 13 hits on 30 chances.
- He has been an extremely tough out to end the inning, currently 11-of-26 with two outs (.423) with a
 team-best 16 two-out RBI on his 24 total RBIs three of which coming on his 11th-inning walk-off home
 run against Michigan State.
- He is second on the team in advancing runners, doing so 35 times on 57 opportunities (.617).
- Spencer Torkelson was named the Pac-12 Player of the Week for the Opening Week of the 2019 season. It was the second time in his career earning the honor.
- Defensively, Torkelson has also made impressive strides. He has yet to post an error on 170 chances (3rd in the Pac-12) while he is tied for the league lead in helping to turn 18 double plays this season.

#TorksUp

- Torkelson led the country in 2018 with 25 home runs two more than any other player and just one shy
 of the NCAA freshman record while becoming first freshman in NCAA history to lead the nation in home
 runs.
- Became just the sixth player to reach 25 home runs since the BBCOR batting technology changes took
 effect in 2011 and the only freshman in the NCAA to reach the milestone in that time.
- Slugged a gaudy .743 on the season (25 homers, 12 doubles), the third-highest total for any freshman
 in the NCAA in the past two decades and the highest for a freshman in the BBCOR era (since 2011).
 Only Rickie Weeks (.849 in 2001) and Jeremy Baltz (.771, 2010) posted higher freshman slugging
 percentages in the past 20 years.
- Torkelson was a unanimous All-American, as every major baseball media outlet in the nation rewarded
 the freshman with at least one All-America accolade (Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, Baseball America,
 NCBWA, and Perfect Game).
- Honored with Perfect Game's National Freshman of the Year award.
- Named a Golden Spikes Award Semifinalist, an award honoring the best player in college baseball.
- National Collegiate Baseball Writers of America named him as a third-team All-America selection;
 Earned third-team recognition from Perfect Game; Placed on the Perfect Game Freshman All-America
 First Team; Named by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper as the National Co-Freshman of the Year and the NCBWA as the National Freshman Hitter of the Year.
- Just the seventh Sun Devil in school history to be named an All-American as a freshman, joining Mike Kelly (1989) and Casey Myers (1998) as the only two ASU position players to be named All-Americans as freshman
- The third Sun Devil to be named Pac-12 Freshman/Newcomer of the Year, joining lke Davis (2006) and Jason Kipnis (2008).

Hunting Party

- Hunter Bishop is tied for the national lead with 12 home runs this season four more than any other player in the Pac-12
- Bishop has more home runs this season than he has strikeouts (11). He has also walked 16 times.
- The junior is second in the Pac-12 with a .442 batting average on the season 14th nationally and leads the league with 33 RBIs (3rd in the nation).

- Bishop has scored 34 runs on the season, a total that leads the Pac-12 and is second in the country.
- Bishop's .552 on-base percentage is third in the league and 11th in the country.
- Bishop leads the team in successfully advancing baserunners, doing so .691 percent of the time on 38-of-55 chances.
- He is the only player that has reached base in each of ASU's 20 games this season and currently holds the team's longest active hitting streak at 12 games.
- He leads the team with 9 multi-RBI games (three more than any other player) and is second on the squad with 11 multi-hit games.

Marshing to the Beat

- Alec Marsh has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 23 of his last 24 appearances dating back to his freshman season.
- Dating back to last season, Marsh has a posted a quality start in 9 of his last 13 starts since assuming the mantle of Mr. Friday Night midway through the 2018 campaign. Each of Marsh's previous two Friday starts have resulted in shutout victories for ASU.
- Marsh posted three consecutive quality starts to open 2019 and is 5-0 on the season - tied for first nationally in victories.
- His 0.77 ERA is currently 17th in the nation and second in the Pac-12. His 34 strikeouts are currently third in the league as well.
- Marsh is first among Pac-12 pitchers with 35.0 innings pitched this season.
- Marsh has been absolutely dominant when runners reach base against him, holding opponents to just 9-of-54 hitting (.167) with runners on the base path.
- The junior is not hesistant about pounding the strike zone, recording a first-pitch strike a team-best 67.4 percent of the time this season and has fallen into 2-0 counts just 15 times on 144 batters faced on the year.
- Marsh dominates when getting ahead of the count, holding batters to 1-15 hitting (.067) with balls in play on 0-2 counts and 1-of-21 hitting (.048) on 1-2 counts with 17 combined strikeouts between the two.
- Marsh struck out 10 batters on Opening Night, the first time an ASU player had reached double digits in a game since Seth Martinez in March of 2016. Marsh also became the first Sun Devil in at least 20 years to throw 10 strikeouts on Opening Night. Since at least 1998 (as far back as readily accessible records go), no Sun Devil had struck out more than eight batters on Opening Night until Marsh's performance.

#LINSANITY

- Lyle Lin has embraced his new role as the team's designated hitter this season, currently third the Pac-12 and 25th in the nation with 26 RBIs.
- Lins 26 RBIs through the opening month are an incredible tally considering the junior had just 18 RBIs total during the 2018 season, despite starting every game.
- He has multiple RBIs in 6 games this season, good for second on the team.
- Lin is 9-for-13 this season in bringing runners from third home with less than
 two outs, a notable area of struggle for the junior was was just 2-for-12 in the
 category last season.
- Lin is third on the team in advancing baserunners, doing so 32 times on 57 chances (.561).
- Lin recorded the game-winning RBI (the RBI that put ASU ahead for the remainder of the game) in all three of ASU's games against UC Davis.
- Lin became the first Sun Devil since 2014 to hit a grand slam with his roundtripper in the second game of the UC Davis series.
- Lin has started in all 130 games he has appeared in at Arizona State.

Put Me In, Coach

- The consummate team player, fans can expect to find Carter Aldrete all over the diamond this season. Aldrete has seen time in right field, second base, third base and on the mound this season
- Aldrete is currently 5th in the Pac-12 with 23 RBIs this season. Of those 20 RBIs, 14 have come with two outs.
- He has 11 hits with two outs this season, seonnd on the team and has a .379 average in the scenario on 11-of-29 hitting.
- Has four home runs on the season, already a career-high and tied for fifth in the Pac-12.
- Aldrete is second on the team in advancing runners home from third with less than two outs, doing so 6 times on 11 chances.
- Aldrete is tied for 8th in the Pac-12 in helping to turn 10 double plays this season.

 Had a monster game in Game 2 against Notre Dame, posting his first multihome run game of his career while adding a career-best six RBIs in the process.

Just Like He Drew It Up

- Despite missing three weeks to injury, Drew Swift returned to the lineup and shown he is one of ASU's most improved hitters.
- The sophomore was batting .406 with 5 doubles and 9 RBIs in the early going
 of the year. The five doubles are already a career high, despite missing several
 weeks of action and currently sit just outside the Top-10 in the Pac-12.
- Batting out of the nine-hole this season, Swift successfully turned the order around over 50 percent of the time with his .512 on-base percentage.
- Swift has been a part of 8 double plays this season, despite the time missed.
- Prior to missing games with injury, Swift's 24 assists through 8 games were tops in the Pac-12. He has just one error this season on 48 chances (.979).
- Became the first Sun Devil since Jake Peevyhouse in 2014 to have three doubles in a game, doing so against San Diego.

A Lot to Alika

- Alika Williams has quietly continued to put up impressive numbers as a sophomore is currently second on the team in batting .397 with 19 RBIs as well as his first career home run against Fullerton.
- Williams is currently sixth in the Pac-12 with a .506 on-base percentage
- Williams leads the team with 6 doubles this season tied for 7th in the Pac-12.
 He had 8 doubles in the entirety of his freshman season.
- Williams has been a part of 10 double plays this season, good for 8th in the Pac-12 and playing a key role in ASU currently sitting second in the Pac-12 with 21 double plays turned on the year (11th in the country).
- Last season, his 13 strikeouts were the lowest among players with at least 22 starts.
- As a freshman, Williams teamed up with fellow freshman infielder Drew Swift to execute 30 double plays.

Putting in the Work

- On the year, Gage Workman is batting .329 with 17 runs scored, three home runs, a triple and three doubles for a solid .506 slugging percentage.
- After not having a home run in the first four weeks of the year, Workman
 erupted for three in the Washington State series (two coming as a left-handed
 batter and the other as a right-handed batter).
- The sophomore is just outside the top-10 in the Pac-12 with 39 defensive assists this season.
- Workman has helped turn seven double plays on the season, helping ASU to currently being second in the Pac-12 with 21 double plays turned.
- Collegiate Baseball News Freshman All-American in 2018
- Collected seven triples as a freshman, tied for the fifth highest total in the country and second on the team behind the national leader in the category, teammate Gage Canning.
- Did not ground into a double play all last season, the only ASU regular that can make that claim.
- Posted an OPS of .805, slugging .466 (3rd on team) and reaching base at a .339 clip.

Filling the Boyd

- Boyd Vander Kooi is current 2-0 on the season and second on the team with 27 strikeouts in 27.0 innings pitched.
- Vander Kooi has 14 strikeouts looking on the season, good for 2nd in the Pac-12 Conference while his 27 strikeouts are tied for 11th.
- Vander Kooi and Marsh have combined to lead ASU to three consecutive Friday-night shutouts leading into this weekend.
- Made 10 appearances as a freshman last season, including five starts, finishing the campaign with a 3-3 record.
- His 3.00 ERA tied him for the lowest on the team among those with at least 36 innings pitched as a freshman last season
- Stuck out 35 batters, allowing just 12 earned runs in 36.0 innings pitched.
- Made his final five appearances (8.1 innings) out of the bullpen, preventing an earned run from scoring in four of the five outings.
- Did not allow an earned run in six of his ten outings.

Trev Lightly and Carry a Big Stick

- Perhaps no player on the Sun Devil roster has shown as much improvement this season as sophomore Trevor Hauver.
- The leadoff man has a .485 on-base percentage this season a total good for 10th the Pac-12.

- Hauver has drawn 19 walks on the season currently third in the Pac-12 and 37th nationally.
- Hauver has scored 29 runs this season, third in the league and 9th nationally
- Hauver has also showed plenty of pop in the bat, second on the team with six home runs this season - fourth in the Pac-12 and 30th nationally.
- As a leadoff batter in an inning, Hauver has reached base 14 times this season on 35 chances (.400).
- Hauver has been very productive for his teammates as well, successfully advancing runners 25 times on 45 chances (.556).

Pay the Tolman

- Erik Tolman has been thrust into several crucial spots as a true freshman this season and responded best when the lights were on.
- Tolman is 3-0 with a save this season and third on the team with a 0.92 ERA.
- Tolman has struck out 19 batters and in 19.2 innings pitched.
- The ERA is 0.1 innings pitched away from being fifth in the Pac-12.
- Opponents .136 batting average against this season is the lowest total in the Pac-12.
- Tolman has allowed just one extra-base hit this season the lowest total among Pac-12 pitchers.

Dab On 'Em

- RJ Dabovich has proven to be one of the top offseason additions for the Sun Devils, currently posting a 4-0 record while dominating Sundays for the Sun Devils.
- Dabovich has a 2.57 ERA on the season, currently 11th among Pac-12 pitchers.
- His .219 batting average against is good for 10th in the league and his four wins are third in the league.

All That Chaz

- Chaz Montoya has quickly developed a role as the team's stopper in several crucial scenatios this season.
- Montoya leads the squad with 11 appearances in 20 games, posting a 0.87 ERA in 10.1 innings pitched with 13 strikeouts to 3 walks.
- Montoya has inherited 13 runners this season, allowing just one of them to score
- In his 11 appearances, Montoya has retired the first batter he has seen on 9 occasions.
- Montoya has not allowed an earned run since the second game of the season a streak of nine consecutive appearances.
- Montoya has not walked a batter in his last 8 pitching apperances.
- Montoya is 2-0 on the season with a team-high two saves as well.

A Ferri Tale

- Forced to sit on the bench with injury for the majority of his first two seasons, catcher Sam Ferri has quickly established himself as a gamechanger as a regular in the ASU lineup.
- Ferri is batting .302 on the season with 11 RBIs and six extra-base hits.
- More importantly has been his effect on the game behind the plate, where he is fourth in the Pac-12 with four runners caught stealing this season and just one error on 128 chances.
- Ferri notched his first career home run in walk-off fashion, a solo shot in the bottom of the ninth to help clinch the series over Washington State.

Sam I Am

- Sam Romero has quietly put up impressive numbers this season, giving ASU solid midweek starts while being able to turn it around and eat some quality innings on the weekends as well.
- Romero is 1-0 this year with a 0.95 ERA in 19.0 innings pitched.
- Romero has struck out 15 batters to just four walks while allowing just two total earned runs on the year.

The Brady Bunch

- Brady Corrigan has quickly asserted himself as one of ASU's go-to players out of the pen, appearing in 11 of ASU's 20 games this season.
- Corrigan has inherited a team-high 14 runners this season, allowing just two of them to score.
- Corrigan has a 2.65 ERA in 17.0 innings pitched with a 2-0 record while sitting third on the team with 23 strikeouts.

Chicks Dig The Long Ball

- ASU's power numbers this season have been at another level with ASU already posting 34 home runs through 20 games - a total that is currently third nationally.
- Nine different Sun Devils have gone yard this season.

- ASU's 34 home runs are 10 more than any other team in the Pac-12 (Cal is second with 24).
- The Devils' .566 slugging percentage as a team is nearly 50 points higher than any other program in the conference.
- ASU had 50 home runs last season, a mark that the current roster is well on pace to demonlish as the season goes on.

On The Ground

- The Sun Devil pitching staff has been exceptional at inducing soft contact this season and allowing balls to go into play for the defense to handle, currently leading the Pac-12 with 767 defensive chances this season.
- The frequent groundouts (173) have put the pressure on a Sun Devil defensive infield that had struggled with errors in recent seasons but the group has responded admirably to the extra chances this season.
- ASU has record 203 defensive assists this season, a total that leads the Pac-12
- The roster has turned 21 double plays on the year, second in the Pac-12 and 11th in the country.
- ASU is 40th nationally in fielding percentage (.977) which, while not where the team would like to be, is a far cry from the team that was 230th last season and 184th the season before.

A Tradition Of USA Collegiate Baseball

ASU has had 34 players on the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team with Spencer Torkelson (2018) being the most recent member, which is the third-most among all NCAA schools behind USC (53) and Stanford (40). A Sun Devil has been represented on the Collegiate National Team in 26 different seasons, which is third-most behind Stanford and Cal State Fullerton (27). Sun Devils Ryan Burr, Casey Myers and Dustin Pedroia are the only three Devils to make the team in two seperate seasons.

Alone At The Top

ASU's 11 College Baseball Hall of Famers are the most from any single school in college baseball.

ASU's National College Baseball Hall of Famers

Today's Devils Are Tomorrow's Major Leaguers

- Most players taken in the MLB Draft since 2010 (57)
- ASU's 110 Major Leaguers since 1959 are the most in the nation
- The first-ever player drafted by the MLB was Sun Devil alum Rick Monday
- ASU is the only school at any level to have multiple No. 1 overall picks in June MLB Draft history
- Most unique first round players taken in the June MLB Draft with 20 - (excludes compensation picks and re-draftees)
- Most players drafted in a single year (15 in 2008)
- 437 MLB Draft Picks, more than any other school in the country.

Movin' On Up

 As has become commonplace at Arizona State, five Sun Devils heard their names called in the MLB Draft following the 2018 season. The Sun Devils have had five or more players drafted in 47 of MLB Drafts held since 1956 and five or more players have gotten the call in 14 of the last 16 seasons.

Keeping the Tradition Alive

- Two Sun Devils made their debuts in the MLB during the 2018 season, bringing ASU's total to 110 all-time the most among all NCAA schools since 1959. Ryan Burr (White Sox) and Adam McCreery (Braves) each saw their first Big League action when the rosters explanded this past season.
- The Sun Devils have now had at least one major league player on their varsity roster each year from 1961 through 2015, which is the longest current streak in the nation.
- Thirty-five ASU baseball players have made their MLB debuts since 2002.

Making an Impact

- Since 1999, Sun Devils in the major league have the second-highest WAR among all colleges in the country with a Sun Devil WAR of 152 coming in behind only Long Beach State (214), according to Baseball America.
- The 2008 Sun Devils boasted a trio of eventual first-round picks in 1B lke Davis (2008, 1st round), 3B Brett Wallace (2008, 1st round) and RHP Mike Leake (2009, 8th overall), plus also OF Jason Kipnis (2009, 2nd round). Davis, Leake and Kipnis all had moments in the sun in the big leagues.
- The program's brightest light is 2B Dustin Pedroia (2004, 2nd round). He and OF Andre Ethier (2003, 2nd round) teamed up in 2002 and 2003.
- Pirates RHP Trevor Williams (2013, 2nd round) is the most prominent ASU alum in his peak years.





TRACY SMITH - HEAD COACH - FIFTH SEASON (23rd OVERALL)

Tracy Smith, the 2013 National Coach of the Year, was hired as the fifth head baseball coach in program history on June 24, 2014, and enters his fifth season at the helm of the Sun Devil baseball program.

Smith has established a reputation of evaluating and developing talent as more than 50 student-athletes since 2000 improved their stock in the Major League Baseball Draft under Smith's tutelage, including four who became first-round draft picks after going undrafted out of high school.

In 22 total years as a head coach, Smith has seen 80 of his players selected in the MLB Draft, including 73 draftees since 2000 and 33 in the first 10 rounds. He has mentored 48 Major League Baseball draft picks over the past eight seasons, including the fourth overall pick in the 2014 Major League Baseball June Amateur Draft (Kyle Schwarber) and three first-round selections in the 2009 MLB June Draft (Eric Arnett, Josh Phegley, Matt Bashore).

In 2018, Smith eclipsed 700 career wins as an NCAA head coach while also overseeing one of the most prolific freshman campaigns in collegiate baseball history as Spencer Torkelson became the first freshman to ever lead the nation in home runs, finishing with 25 on the season.

Torkelson knocked two more home runs than any other player and just one shy of the NCAA freshman record. Torkelson was just the sixth player to reach 25 home runs since the BBCOR batting technology changes took effect in 2011 and the only freshman in the NCAA to reach the milestone in that time.

Against Washington State, he surpassed the previous Sun Devil freshman record of 11 home runs set by Barry Bonds in 1983. Torkelson finished tied with Bob Horner (1978) for second in ASU single-season history, just two shy of Mitch Jones' school record 27 in 2000.

Torkelson slugged .743 on the season (25 homers, 12 doubles), the third-highest total for any freshman in the NCAA in the past two decades and the highest for a freshman in the BBCOR era (since 2011). Only Rickie Weeks (.849 in 2001) and Jeremy Baltz (.771, 2010) have posted higher freshman slugging percentages in the past 20 years.

Smith saw five of his student-athletes taken in the 2018 MLB Draft, including fifth-round selection Gage Canning to the Washington Nationals. Canning wrapped the season as one of the elite five-tool players in the country, finishing with a .369 average and a Pac-12 leading 87 hits on the season. Canning was the national leader in triples with 11, and now has 25 in his career at ASU – good for third in school history and the most since Ed Irvine tied the school record of 26 between 1977-79.

Canning reached base in 54 of 55 games for the Sun Devils this season and logged a hit in 47 of those. He led the team with multiple hits in 26 games and had 11 games with three or more hits, becoming the first Sun Devil player to have at least 10 games with 3+ hits since Brett Wallace did so from 2007-08.

With one more home run, Canning would have become the first player in the BBCOR batting era (since 2011) to record double digit numbers in doubles, triples AND home runs. He finished the season with nine homers, 17 doubles and 11 triples, slugging .648 for the season – good for third in the Pac-12 and 38th nationally.

Defensively, Canning was flawless after shifting to center field and logged just one error on the season on 144 chances for a .993 fielding percentage.

The 2017 campaign saw Canning emerge as one of the elite players in the Pac-12. The California-native led the team in virtually every hitting category, including batting average (.332), runs (37), doubles (12), triples (8), home runs (6) and slugging percentage (.538). He was the only player in the Pac-12 to finish with a double-digit number of doubles while also posting at least six home runs and six triples.

On top of dominating the leader boards at ASU, Canning's eight triples were the most by a player in the conference and second-most in the NCAA. Canning also recorded 120 total bases on the season, good for third in the conference. The outfielder really hit his stride in the middle of the season, as he went on a 12-game tear in which he hit at a .538 clip, including five three-hit nights and a four-hit performance.

Smith also helped oversee the emergence of Hunter Bishop as one of the exciting young freshmen in the country on the year. The freshman finished his 2017 campaign with an impressive .301 batting average, five doubles, four triples and five home runs. He ranked second on the team – behind only Canning – in batting average, runs scored (27), triples, home runs and slugging percentage (.484). Bishop started 31 games in the outfield season to become just the sixth ASU freshman in the past 15 years to start over 50 percent of the season in the outfield, most recently done by Canning last season. His 10 multi-RBI games were also a team-best.

In 2016, Smith piloted the Sun Devils to a regional final for the first time since 2013. The Sun Devils' 36 wins were the most in the previous three years and they finished tied for third in the Pac-12. Five players were selected in the 2016 Major League Baseball Draft, marking 14 total players who have been taken in the draft during Smith's tenure.

Eight Devils earned All-Pac-12 honors on the season, including first team selections David Greer, Seth Martinez, Brian Serven and Colby Woodmansee. All four players would go on to be selected in the MLB draft with Greer (third team), Martinez (second team) and Woodmansee (third team) earning Louisville Slugger All-America accolades.

HEAD COACH

In his first season at ASU, Smith led the Sun Devils to a postseason berth, a third-place finish in the Pac-12 and 30-plus wins.

He became one of five active coaches, and one of eight all-time, to bring three different Div. I schools to NCAA Regional play as he guided the Sun Devils to a No. 2 seed in the Fullerton Regional in 2015.

A exceptional recruiter, Smith was instrumental in Sun Devil Baseball's signing of the nation's top recruiting class in 2016, which included eight players who had been drafted by the Major League out of high school. His 2017 class was also rated in the Top-5 nationally and was the No. 1 class in the West.

He has amassed a 698-535-1 career record in 21 seasons as a head coach at three different schools, including nine seasons at both Miami (Ohio) and Indiana, and one year at Arizona State. His 698 victories rank in the top 50 among active coaches in the NCAA, and his 21 seasons represent the sixth-fewest number of years on that list.

Smith instituted a change in culture at Arizona State and his demand for excellence both on and off the field was represented as the Devils led the Pac-12 in both all-conference and all-academic honorees in 2014.

Nineteen players have earned Pac-12 All-Academic honors in Smith's first two seasons, tied for the most in Sun Devil history for a two-year span. ASU's 10 selections in Smith's first season led the Pac-12.

His emphasis on defense became evident right away as ASU vastly improved its fielding percentage and lowered its number of errors committed in Smith's first season. The Devils finished fourth in the Pac-12 in both categories in 2015 after ranking near the bottom of the conference from 2010-14.

An accomplished fundraiser, Smith played a huge role in helping transition the Sun Devil Baseball program into Phoenix Municipal Stadium. His vision saw a renovated clubhouse, complete with an alumni locker room and an academics center, as well as an increased prominence on the program's historical accomplishments. Capital improvements included a state-of-the art video board, batting tunnel, a weight room and training room, creation of a grass berm and patio installations, and premium seating options. Smith also played a huge role in facility upgrades at both Indiana University and Miami (Ohio) and was instrumental in the approval and design of both Miami's Stanley G. McKie Field at Joseph P. Hayden Jr. Park and Indiana's Bart Kaufman Field.

Smith earned National Coach of the Year honors and was a unanimous choice for Big Ten Coach of the Year after he led IU to the school's only College World Series appearance in 2013. The following season in 2014, Smith led the Hoosiers to the No. 4 national seed in the NCAA Tournament, the first national seed in Big Ten baseball history.

Smith came to Tempe with 18 years of experience as a collegiate head coach, including nine at Miami University (Ohio) and nine at IU, where he was two-time Big Ten Coach of the Year. He led both programs to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances and more than 600 combined career victories.

He tallied more than 40 wins in his final two seasons at IU and led the Hoosiers to consecutive Big Ten Conference Championships for the first time in school history. IU won the Big Ten regular season and B1G Tournament title in 2013, marking the school's first regular season conference championship since 1949 and the first outright crown since 1932, and advanced to the 2013 College World Series, which ended the Big Ten's 29-year CWS absence.

Smith took an IU program that had finished 10th in the Big Ten six times in an eight-year stretch between 2000 and 2007, and led the Hoosiers to an NCAA Regional in 2009 and to the College World Series in 2013. IU notched a program-best 21 conference wins in 2014 and secured eight first team All-Big Ten selections to tie a conference mark for most first team honorees from one school.

Smith's Academic Progress Rate as a head coach increased each season until it reached a perfect 1000 in two-year stretch between 2008-10.

IU saw eight players on 12 occasions be named All-Americans under Smith, including four in 2014, which was the highest total in program history and the second straight season that IU produced three or more All-Americans.

Smith mentored two Big Ten Players of the Year, three Big Ten Pitchers of the Year and a pair of Big Ten Freshman of the Year in nine seasons at IU, and at least one Hoosier earned Freshman All-America honors in six of the past seven seasons in Bloomington.

He has landed three players on the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team and mentored numerous players at all positions, including outfielder Alex Dickerson, who was named Big Ten Player of the Year and won the Big Ten Triple Crown in 2010, right-handed pitcher Aaron Slegers, who was named 2013 Big Ten Pitcher of the Year, and catcher Kyle Schwarber, who was named an All-American by five major college baseball groups in 2014.


In nine years at the helm of the RedHawks baseball program, Smith compiled eight straight 30-win seasons, two NCAA Regional appearances and advanced to the Mid-American Conference Tournament finals six times.

He began his coaching career as head coach at Miami University-Middletown in 1990, served as an assistant coach at Miami (Ohio) from 1993-94 and was the pitching coach at IU from 1995-96.



Born Feb. 14, 1966, Smith graduated with a bachelor's degree in Education from Miami (Ohio) in 1989 and completed a master's degree in Sport Organization from Miami (Ohio) in 1992.


