**THE GAME** - Sun Devil Football will have two games on the road with a chance to lock up the Pac-12 South title beginning this week at Oregon on Saturday, Nov. 17. The contest against the Ducks will kickoff at 8:30 p.m. Arizona time (7:30 p.m. in Oregon) and will be broadcast live on the Pac-12 Network. Roxy Bernstein will be on the call alongside analyst Anthony Herron and field reporter Lewis Johnson. The game will be broadcast over the airwaves on ESPN 620 AM with the Voice of the Sun Devils, Tim Healey, on the call alongside analyst Jeff Van Raaphorst and sideline reporter Jordan Simone

**ASU VS. OREGON** - Oregon leads the all-time series against ASU, 19-17, due in large part to the Ducks gaining the upper hand in 10 straight games prior to last season's upset win for the Devils at Sun Devil Stadium. The Sun Devils have not defeated Oregon in the last four trips to Eugene.

**PAC-12 SOUTH SCENARIOS** - ASU currently controls its own destiny in the Pac-12 South race. If the Sun Devils win at Oregon Saturday and then defeat Arizona, they will be the Pac-12 South's representative in the conference's title game on Nov. 30 at Levi's Stadium in Santa Clara, Calif. If Colorado beats Utah this weekend, Arizona would control its own destiny as well, meaning that if the Wildcats were to defeat Washington State and then ASU, they would be the Pac-12 South champions. Utah needs to beat Colorado and have ASU fall to either Arizona or Oregon to take the division. USC is 4-4 in the conference with just one conference game remaining (Saturday at UCLA), but can't win the division because of its head-to-head loss to Utah. There is a scenario where Utah, USC, ASU and Arizona could all wrap up Pac-12 play with 5-4 records and end the regular season in a four-way tie in the South. The Sun Devils would earn the Pac-12 Championship Game berth in that situation if they beat Arizona. Utah would be the South champion if the Sun Devils lose to the Wildcats.

### AN ASU VICTORY WOULD...

- Give ASU four straight wins for the first time since opening the 2016 season at 4-0.
- Give ASU two consecutive road wins for the first time since 2014 (at USC and at Washington).
- Guarantee that ASU will at least play for a shot at playing for a spot at the Pac-12 Championship when it takes on Arizona in the finale.
- Give ASU 7 wins in a season for the 5th time in the last 7 seasons.
- Give ASU 2 straight wins over Oregon after losing 10 straight to the Ducks prior.
- Give ASU its first win at Autzen Stadium since a 28-13 victory in Eugene in 2004.

## #BYTHENUMBERS

822

No ASU running back has **lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 822 consecutive carries**, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 29 consecutive games. That includes 247 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only RBs on rushing plays and does not include receptions). The fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back. If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1,161 carries over 42 games (since 2015).

**Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 131 straight games.** The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 74 of those games (56.4 percent). The Sun Devils have scored at least 30 points in each of their victories during the current three-game winning streak. ASU is 5-0 this year when scoring 30 or more points.

**At 1,295 rushing yards this year**, Eno Benjamin has his eyes on the Sun Devil school record of 1,565 yards - set by Woody Green in 1972. In the Pac-12 era, no ASU running back has finished in the Top-10 nationally in single-season rushing yards. Benjamin is currently 3rd nationally with his currently clip and 8th nationally with 12 rushing touchdowns. Eno Benjamin ranks first among Pac-12 running backs with an overall grade of 81.4 according to Pro Football Focus, nearly 5 points high than the next closest tailback. It is the 11th-highest grade among all Pac-12 offensive players, regardless of position.

**N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 35 games of his career at Arizona State**, tied for the 10th-longest active streak among active FBS players. Harry is 3rd place in program history with 202 receptions. Harry is currently 4th in school history with 2,729 career receiving yards. With 22 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is tied for 5th in ASU school history in that category as well. Harry posts an 85.3 overall grade from Pro Football Focus, the 5th-highest graded WR nationally and the third-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 - regardless of position. He ranks in the Top-30 nationally in receiving TDs (9/9th), receiving yards (928/17th), receiving ypg (92.8/17th).

Among all true or redshirt freshmen playing for Power Five teams in the country, **none have more defensive stops (as graded by Pro Football Focus) than Merlin Robertson (30)**, while Darien Butler is right behind him in third among freshmen with 28. The duo ranks 17th and 20th overall in the Pac-12, regardless of year in school. Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have combined for 2,484 play snaps on defense this season with at least three games left to play. Comparatively, freshmen combined for just 918 total snaps played in 2017 and 1,035 in 2016. Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have accounted for 312.6 percent of all of ASU's tackles this season (211 of 647).

Cohl Cabral is one of just 18 Power Five centers **to not allow a sack on the year** and is the 26th-highest graded center as a pass blocker in all of the FBS according to Pro Football Focus (81.1) and 2nd-highest graded center in the Pac-12 (69.8) Quinn Bailey is one of just 17 offensive tackles (that's played at least 50 percent of a team's snaps) on a Power Five team **to not allow a quarterback sack this season**. Bailey's 9 pressures allowed are tied for 4th-fewest among Pac-12 tackles and 14th-fewest among Power Five tackles.

## #10THINGS (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

- Eno Benjamin ranks 7th among Power-Five running backs with that 81.4 score, though he only had 23 career rushes prior to this season. No players in PFF's current Top-10 Power Five running backs had fewer than 100 touches last season.
- N'Keal Harry ranks in the Top-30 nationally in receiving touchdowns (9/9th), receiving yards (928/17th), receiving yards per game (92.8/17th), receptions per game (6.2/25th) and total touchdowns (11/28th).
- Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 131 straight games
- No ASU running back has lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 822 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 29 consecutive games.
- The Devils are 15th nationally if Offensive First Down rate (drives that result in at least a single first down) with 79.4 percent of its drives resulting in at least one first down.
- No true or redshirt freshman on a Power Five Team has more defensive stops (as graded by Pro Football Focus) than Merlin Robertson (30), while Butler is right behind him in third among freshmen with 28.
- The Sun Devil defense causes havoc (tackles for loss, fumbles forced or passed defended/intercepted) 18.6 percent of the time - good for 25th nationally - and 2.5 points over the nation average.
- ASU hasn't finished in Top-100 in fewest sacks allowed per game since 2011 (74th). In fact, since 2003 (as far back as easily accessible team rankings go), ASU has finished in the top-100 just 3 times, and never better than 70th. ASU is currently t-13th in FBS with 1.10 allowed per game.
- The Sun Devils are forcing opponents into the third-best starting field position nationally, with teams starting on average at their own 24.3 yard line.
- ASU is currently 18th nationally and first in the Pac-12 in averaging 7.5 tackles for loss per game this season. ASU was 50th a year ago in the category, averaging just over 6 tackles for loss per game.



## HE'S THE MANNY

- » Manny Wilkins is the 15th-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 (80.0) by Pro Football Focus, regardless of position and the fourth-highest quarterback in the league. His 82.3 score on passing plays is 23rd among all quarterbacks in the FBS.
- » Wilkins currently sits at 8,048 career passing yards, good for fifth in Sun Devil football history. Wilkins will have a chance as moving into the Top 3 in ASU history (8,827 yards by Jake Plummer) before the year is over
- » His 652 career completions are good for fourth in program lore while his 48 career touchdown passes are tied for 6th in program history.
- » Wilkins has 18 rushing touchdowns in his career, good for second among all ASU quarterbacks in school history behind only Mark Malone (21). He had seven touchdowns on the ground last season, becoming one of just 10 quarterbacks in the FBS last season to pass for at least 20 touchdowns with at least 7 rushing touchdowns as well.
- » Wilkins has accounted for 66 career touchdowns (48 passing and 18 rushing).
- » Wilkins holds a 102.8 NFL QB rating this season, according to Pro Football Focus, the 18th-best total in the FBS.
- » The Sun Devil offense has scored a successful play (as graded by Pro Football Focus) on 39.4 percent of Wilkins' passing attempts this season - the 25th-best total among all quarterbacks in the FBS with 350+ snaps.
- » Wilkins has a 123.2 NFL passer rating when facing blitzing plays this season - the 8th-best total in the country.
- » Wilkins has just an 10.2 sack percentage (percentage of time sacked when under pressure) that sits as the 18th-lowest total in the nation.
- » Wilkins is 19th nationally in adjusted completion percentage (74.9 percent), which excludes QB spikes, throwaways, dropped passes and passes thrown while being hit.
- » Wilkins is one of just six quarterbacks in ASU history to win a game at the Los Angeles Coliseum and just the second one since 2000 (joining Mike Bercovici).

## DIRTY HARRY

- » N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 35 games of his career at Arizona State - tied for the 10th-longest active streak among all current FBS players - and is on pace to join school record holder D.J. Foster (53 straight games with a catch) as the only other Sun Devil to log a reception in every game of their career.
- » Harry is third in program history with 202 career receptions and he has moved to fourth in program history with 2,729 career receiving yards. That tally is within 208 yards of second in program history, despite the fact that seven of ASU's 10 all-time leading receivers did so in four seasons while Harry still has at least three games left in his junior campaign.
- » At 5.77 receptions per game in his career, Harry is fourth among the NCAA's active career leaders in the category. His 78.0 career receiving yards per game are seventh among all active players.
- » His 202 career receptions are seventh among all active players but first among players that are not seniors. All six players ahead of him in the category are seniors. Similarly, Harry's 22 career touchdown receptions are 8th among active players but second among players that are not seniors.
- » With 22 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is tied for 5th in ASU school history and needs just two more to move into fourth. Harry has at least one touchdown reception in 10 of last 15 games. He has 14 touchdown receptions in those 15 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career.

## REAL DEAL N'KEAL

- » Harry posts an 85.3 overall grade from Pro Football Focus, the fifth-highest graded wide receiver nationally and the third-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 - regardless of position. The junior ranks in the Top-30 nationally in receiving touchdowns (9/9th), receiving yards (928/17th), receiving yards per game (92.8/17th), receptions per game (6.2/25th) and total touchdowns (11/28th).
- » Harry has a 129.7 Pro Football Focus QB rating when targeted this season, good for fourth nationally among receivers that have logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets. He has forced 16 missed tackles this season, which is good for 12th-most among all FBS receivers.
- » Harry's ability to make plays pivotal situations has been a staple of his career. In 2018, he is third among all FBS receivers in receiving yards in the fourth quarter of games (299) and tied for second with four fourth quarter touchdown receptions. His 11 first down grabs in the fourth quarter of games are fifth nationally.
- » That ability has kept ASU in striking distance of games as well as Harry is sixth in the

nation with 288 receiving yards when the Sun Devils are trailing by a touchdown or less with 13 first-down grabs (tied for second nationally).

- » The junior out of Chandler, Ariz., has demonstrated his versatility throughout the season, scoring touchdowns receiving, rushing and on punt return this season and being responsible for numerous game-changing plays all across the football field. Harry is averaging 109.5 all-purpose yards per game (7th in the Pac-12 and Top 60 nationally) and has played 661 snaps this season - 9th-most among all Power Five receivers - and has at times handled direct snap-taking duties in the team's Sparky formation.
- » In the past three weekends, Harry has been named both the Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week and the Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week and totaled over 100 all-purpose yards in each game during ASU's three-game win streak. Harry has posted 463 all-purpose yards (356 receiving, 4 rushing, 103 punt returns) and a combined six touchdowns (5 receiving, 1 punt return) in that span.

## ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

- » Eno Benjamin is 8th nationally and 2nd in the Pac-12 conference in averaging 150.7 All-Purpose Yards per game.
- » He leads the Pac-12 (8th nationally) with 12 rushing touchdowns this season and is first in the league (7th nationally) in total touchdowns (14). He is 21st (4th in league) in total points scored (84) and 25th (2nd in Pac-12) at 8.2 points scored per game.
- » He is 3rd nationally (leads Pac-12) with 1,295 rushing yards this season and fourth nationally (first in Pac-12) at 129.5 rushing yards per game.
- » He has rushed for 64 first downs this season, third nationally and just one behind the two national leaders (65)
- » At 1,295 rushing yards this year, Eno Benjamin has already eclipsed Ryan Torain's Pac-12-era ASU school record of 1,229 yards for a single season (2006).
- » The Sun Devil school record is 1,565 yards - set by Woody Green in 1972 - a mark that will be worth keeping an eye on through the remainder of the season. With ASU eyeing at least three extra games.
- » Mario Bates (1993) and J.R. Redmond (1999) are the only other running backs since 1978 to average over 100 yards per game in a single season. Benjamin is currently at 129.5 yards per game.
- » In the Pac-12 era, no ASU running back has finished in the Top-10 nationally in single-season rushing yards. Benjamin is currently 3rd nationally at 1,295 yards. Darryl Clack (1984) and Mario Bates (1993) both finished 18th nationally - the highest for a Sun Devil Running back in the Pac-12 era.

## NEVER ENOUGH

- » Eno Benjamin ranks first among Pac-12 running backs with an overall grade of 81.4 according to Pro Football Focus, nearly 5 points high than the next closest tailback. It is the 11th-highest grade among all Pac-12 offensive players, regardless of position.
- » Benjamin ranks 7th among Power-Five running backs with that 81.4 score, though he only had 23 career rushes prior to this season. No players in PFF's current Top-10 Power Five running backs had fewer than 100 touches last season.
- » His 86.5 score from PFF on rushing plays only is 13th among all running backs nationally, first in the Pac-12 (and again nearly five points higher than any other back).
- » Benjamin has forced 67 missed tackles this season (56 rushing, 11 receiving) - second among all FBS players in the category.
- » Benjamin does not have a fumble on 230 carries this season - one of just 31 running backs that have played 300+ snaps without a fumble and the most carries without a fumble among any running back in the FBS.
- » 37.8 percent of Benjamin's rushes this season have resulted in a "win" for the Sun Devil offense according to Pro Football Focus, the 22nd-highest total among FBS running backs with at least 100 carries. 31.7 percent of his rushes have resulted in a first down or touchdown, the 16th-highest percentage in the FBS.
- » Benjamin's 25 explosive runs this season (runs for over 15 yards) are second nationally and his explosive run percentage of 10.9 percent is 13th in the FBS.
- » Benjamin's 31 receptions this season are 6th among FBS running backs and his 109.4 QB rating when targeted is 6th among FBS running backs with at least 20 receptions this year.
- » Since Pac-12 play started for ASU in Week 4, no running back in the country has rushed for more yards than Eno Benjamin's 1,116 yards.
- » Benjamin set a single-game school rushing record with 312 yards against Oregon





State, placing him eighth all-time on the Pac-12 conference single-game rushing list and the highest single-game performance in the FBS this season.

### THE CHASE IS ON

- » Chase Lucas has made his presence felt all over the field and has been especially efficient in run defense, where he has made 18 solo tackles this season - tied for 15th among all FBS corners.
- » Lucas is the 30th-highest graded pass rushing corner in the FBS, scoring a 63.5 score as a pass rusher this year. He has five quarterback pressures this season, 3rd among FBS cornerbacks and his push-rush productivity score of 25.0 from PFF is tied for first nationally.
- » Among 31 Pac-12 corners that play at least 50 percent of the time, Chase Lucas has the 11th-lowest NFL passer rating when targeted this season at 86.6.
- » Lucas was named a freshman first-team all-American last season by the FWAA and second-team by USA Today.
- » Lucas earned Pac-12 Second Team honors at defensive back and was the only freshman to be named to either the Pac-12 First or Second teams last season and became the first freshman to earn First or Second team honors on offense or defense since Oregon running back Royce Freeman earned Second Team offense honors in 2014. He was the first Pac-12 freshman defensive back to make the First or Second teams since Brandon Browner did so for Oregon State back in 2003.
- » Despite being targeted more than any of the 23 Pac-12 corners that played at least 60 percent of snaps in the regular season (once every 4.6 passing plays), Lucas allowed the fifth-lowest completion percentage of any corner in the conference - regardless of year.

### DON'T CROSS THAT LINE

- » ASU is currently 18th nationally and first in the Pac-12 in averaging 7.5 tackles for loss per game this season. ASU was 50th a year ago in the category, averaging just over 6 tackles for loss per game.
- » The Sun Devils are 30th in the nation and second in the Pac-12 in sacks per game, averaging 2.60 per game thus far.
- » 21 players have logged a tackle for loss this season for ASU, making the Sun Devils one of just one of 14 teams nationally to lay such a claim. 12 different players have scored a sack.
- » ASU entered the season ranked fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU was sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.
- » ASU recorded nine sacks against UTSA, the most since the Sun Devils sacked the UCLA Bruins the same amount of times on Nov. 23, 2013. ASU recorded 15 tackles for a loss, the most since the Sun Devils recorded that same amount against Washington State on Oct. 30, 2010.

### DON'T CROSS THAT ONE, EITHER

- » The Sun Devils have allowed just 23.0 points per game this season, good for 40th nationally. A year ago, ASU was 103rd nationally at 32.8 points per game and had finished 99th or worse in three consecutive seasons prior to the marked improvement this year.
- » ASU did not allow more than 30 points in the first 7 games of the season, one of just 11 teams in the nation to do so in 2018. ASU has held opponents to 30 or less points in 9 of 10 games this season. This was just the fifth season in the Pac-12 era that ASU has opened the year with seven consecutive games not allowing 30 points, joining the 1982, 1986, 1991 and 1997 campaigns.
- » ASU is one of just 24 teams nationally to hold opponents to less than 30 points in at least 9 games this season.
- » This was just the fifth season in the Pac-12 era that ASU has opened the year with seven consecutive games not allowing 30 points, joining the 1982, 1986, 1991 and 1997 campaigns.
- » The Sun Devils defense did not allow a single point in the first quarter of games against non-conference opponents and haven't allowed one in six of 10 games this year. ASU has allowed just 4.2 points per first quarter this season, good for 33rd nationally. Last season, ASU allowed 6.7 first quarter points per game - the 82nd worst tally nationally.
- » The tough scoring defense has kept ASU in every game this season, with seven games this year being decide by one possession - tied for the second-most in the FBS this year. Unfortunately, ASU has been on the wrong end of four of those games - tied with 8 teams in the nation for to most to losses of 7 points or fewer.

### HOLD ON TO THAT BALL

- » No ASU running back has lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 822 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 29 consecutive games. That includes 247 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only running backs on rushing plays and does not include running backs on receptions).
- » Of note on the above stat, the fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back (Kalen Ballage against UCLA in 2016). If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1,161 carries over 42 games, dating back to Utah in 2015.
- » ASU ranks tied for seventh nationally with only 8 turnovers this season. ASU is outscoring opponents 42-20 in points off turnovers this season.
- » The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers.

### MAKE 'EM PAY

- » ASU has outscored opponents 629-348 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 67.3 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (105 of 156) while finding the end zone 80 times in that span (51.3 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 52.2 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (59 of 113) with 45 touchdowns (39.8 percent).

### A HAND IN THE COOKIE JAR

- » ASU has 17 interception returns for touchdowns in the last seven seasons, good for third in the nation behind only Alabama (20) and Ohio State (17) in that time.
- » The Sun Devils have 94 interceptions in the last six seasons, ranked in the Top 10 nationally.
- » ASU has added four fumble return touchdowns as well for 21 defensive touchdowns since the 2012 season, good for fourth in the country in that time span behind Ohio State (28), Alabama (26) and Boise State (25).

### KEEP THEM IN FRONT OF YOU

- » Renell Wren has scored a positive grade on 17.8 percent of his plays on running snaps, the 7th-highest percentage of all Pac-12 front-seven players this season. He is 36th nationally among all defensive interior linemen in the category.
- » Wren has the 9th-highest run defense score among Pac-12 interior defenders with a 76.1 grade from PFF.
- » Jalen Harvey has made 40 tackles within 8 yards of the line of scrimmage as a safety - the second-highest total among all safeties nationally.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, there are just 20 3-4 outside linebackers to not miss a tackle on a running play this season that play at least 100 snaps on rushing plays - with Merlin Robertson being one of those.

### LOCKING IT DOWN

- » ASU is tied for 7th nationally in allowing just 5 plays over 40 yards this season, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively). ASU is also tied for 3rd nationally in allowing just 1 play of over 50 yards on the year.
- » The Devils have given up just 15 plays over 30 yards, tied for 23rd-fewest nationally. In the past four years ASU had given up 38, 44, 40, 40 such plays, ranked 116th, 124th, 117th and 119th.
- » ASU is tied for 7th nationally for fewest passing plays over 40 yards allowed this season, allowing just three. ASU was 90th in the category a year ago with 12 such plays allowed and 127th in 2016 with 22 passing plays over 40 yards allowed.
- » The Sun Devils are 54th in allowing 5.51 yards per play this year, an improvement of nearly 60 positions from the team's 111th place finish in the category last year (6.33 yards per play). ASU had finished 109th or worse in the category in three consecutive seasons prior to the current campaign.

### ON THE DEFENSE

- » The Sun Devils are forcing opponents into the third-best starting field position nationally, with teams starting on average at their own 24.3 yard line.
- » ASU is 22nd nationally in average opponent third-down distance (8.0 yards).
- » On those passing downs, opponents are averaging a marginal explosive tally of -0.16, according to Bill Connelly's advanced metrics, the 9th-best score nationally.



- » A testament to ASU's ability to crack down on the big play, the Sun Devils are 21st nationally with a -0.06 defensive marginal explosiveness rating.
- » The defense has been exceptional in limiting scoring, logging in a 1.05 IsoPPP (points per play) score based on Connelly's metrics, the 19th-best total among FBS defenses. A year ago, ASU was 111th (1.17).
- » The Sun Devil defense causes havoc (tackles for loss, fumbles forced or passed defended/intercepted) 18.6 percent of the time - good for 25th nationally - and 2.5 points over the nation average. ASU had just a 14.1% havoc rate last season (94th nationally).
- » ASU's defense has held opponents to just 2.50 points per possession on "short" field drives (drives that start with 60 or fewer yards to go to the end zone). That's the 12th-lowest total nationally. ASU was 64th a year ago in the category (3.35).
- » The Sun Devil defense has surrendered a touchdown on just 24.5 percent of opponent drives, the 47th-best total nationally after being ranked 90th (31.3 percent) a year ago.
- » The Sun Devil defense has bent but not broke this year, allowing an opponent touchdown on drives where a first down was allowed only 32.1 percent of the time this season (35th nationally) after sitting 91st (42.4 percent) in the country last season.

### TAKING OFFENSE

- » ASU is 7th nationally in Offensive Ball Control Rate (drives that last 4 plays or more) - doing so 76.5 percent of the time.
- » The Devils are 15th nationally in Offensive First Down rate (drives that result in at least a single first down) with 79.4 percent of its drives resulting in at least one first down.
- » ASU has capitalized on short field position, scoring 4.08 points per drive when the possession STARTS within 60 yards of the opponent end zone - 30th nationally.
- » ASU is also 30th nationally in total points per drive, sitting at 2.59.
- » ASU's offense has been fairly successful when backed up against their own goal line, scoring a successful play 46.7 percent of the time - the 30th-best total nationally.
- » ASU gets itself into manageable third-and-short situations 17.3 percent of the time (5th nationally).
- » ASU only finds itself in third-and-long situations 40.6 percent of the time this season, good for the 10th-lowest total national. Its average third-down distance is 6.5 yards - the 15th best total in the country.

### THE YOUTH MOVEMENT

- » Only three Pac-12 TRUE freshmen have played at least 500 defensive snaps this season and all of them play for Arizona State (Merlin Robertson/630, Darien Butler/540, Aashari Crosswell/557).
- » Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have combined for 2,484 play snaps this season with at least three games left to play. Comparatively, freshmen combined for just 918 total snaps played in 2017 and 1,035 in 2016.
- » Robertson's 630 snaps are 73 more than any other true freshman in the league and the third-most among any Power Five true freshman in the country.
- » Robertson was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week for his performance against #16 Utah, becoming the first freshman offensive or defensive player to accomplish the task since 2010.
- » Among all true or redshirt freshmen playing for Power Five teams in the country, none have more defensive stops (as graded by Pro Football Focus) than Robertson (30), while Butler is right behind him in third among freshmen with 28. The duo ranks 17th and 20th overall in the Pac-12, regardless of year in school.
- » Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have accounted for 312.6 percent of all of ASU's tackles this season (211 of 647) and 44.7 percent of the team's total tackles for loss (33.5 of 75).

### IN THE TRENCHES

- » ASU has now twice gone consecutive games without allowing a sack (Washington/Oregon State and USC/Utah) The last time ASU had consecutive games doing so even once in a season was 2005 (LSU and Northwestern).
- » The Devils now have 5 such games this year (UTSA, UW, OSU, USC and Utah). Since AT LEAST 2000, ASU had never had more than 2 games in a SEASON where it didn't allow a sack.
- » ASU's 11 sacks allowed this season are 12th nationally. A year ago, ASU finished 124th in the nation with 41 sacks allowed and 119th in 2016 with 41 sacks allowed as well.
- » ASU hasn't finished in Top-100 in fewest sacks allowed per game since 2011 (74th). In fact, since 2003 (as far back as easily accessible team rankings go), ASU has finished in

the top-100 just 3 times, and never better than 70th. ASU is currently t-13th in FBS with 1.10 allowed per game.

- » Cohl Cabral is one of just 18 Power Five centers to not allow a sack on the year and is the 26th-highest graded center as a pass blocker in all of the FBS according to Pro Football Focus (81.1) and 2nd-highest graded center in the Pac-12 (69.8) and 35th-highest graded center in the FBS.
- » Cabral has scored a positive run-blocking grade on 10.4 percent of his rushing snaps this season - the 18th-best percentage among FBS centers in the country and 3rd in the Pac-12.
- » Quinn Bailey is one of just 17 offensive tackles (that's played at least 50 percent of a team's snaps) on a Power Five team to not allow a quarterback sack this season.
- » Bailey's 9 pressures allowed are tied for 4th-fewest among Pac-12 tackles and 14th-fewest among Power Five tackles. He is Pro Football Focus' 38th-highest graded pass-blocking tackle among all tackles in the FBS this season (83.1).
- » Getting it done on the outside has been important also, as wide receiver Kyle Williams is the 16th-highest graded receiver in the FBS this season as a run-blocker (78.1).
- » Following the non-conference slate, ASU's run game efficiency from PFF was ranked 85th nationally (8th in Pac-12) with a play success rate of 32.9. During the Pac-12 slate, ASU is ranked 25th nationally (3rd in Pac-12) with a success rate of 38.3 (4 points above national avg).

### GOLD RUSH

- » ASU has had a 100-yard rusher in 11 of its last 15 games dating back to last year (Demario Richard with 4 and Eno Benjamin with 7).
- » Benjamin's 7 100+ yard performances this season put him in rare company. He is now one of just five Sun Devils have had 7 or more in a season: Freddie Williams and Art Malone (8), Woody Green (7, twice), Demario Richard (7).
- » The last time that occurred was across the 1997 and 1998 campaigns, where ASU had 10 such performances over a 13-game span (last 6 of '97, 4 of 7 to open '98).
- » ASU had 27 rushing TDs last year as it reached 25 rushing touchdowns for the fourth time in the last six seasons. Those four times are notable as the Devils had just three previous seasons with at least 25 rushing touchdowns from 1980-2011 (1985, 1986 and 1996).
- » The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards five times in the last six seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011 and only eight times total over 30 years from 1981-2011.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, the Sun Devils had the 27th-highest graded rushing attack last season after having the 41st worst-graded attack in 2016.
- » ASU currently has the 10th-highest graded rushing attack of 2018, according to Pro Football Focus.

### KEEPING MOMENTUM

- » Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 131 straight games. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 74 of those games (56.5 percent).
- » The Sun Devils have won at least seven games in four of the last six seasons, marking the first time ASU has done so in a six-year gap since doing it four straight times from 2004-07.
- » Prior to that, the last time ASU accomplished the feat was 1978-82, winning at least seven games four times in that five-year spread.
- » The Sun Devils are 31-8 at home since 2013 and are one of just 17 teams in the FBS to win 30 home games in that time frame.
