

Stellar Start

The Sand Devils are off to their best start through 10 games in program history at 8-2. They started 6-0, which was the best start in team history and was tied for the longest winning streak.

LBSU Tournament

No. 11 Sun Devil Beach Volleyball is heading to California this weekend as the team takes on the LBSU Tournament from March 15-16, facing Pepperdine and No. 7 Long Beach State on Friday before finishing the weekend against Cal State Northridge and Texas.

ASU looks to get its first wins over Pepperdine and Long Beach, whom the Sun Devils have yet to beat in the all-time series. It will also be the first meeting in proram history with Texas, a team in its second season as a program.

Pair of the Week

Following two ranked team wins and three wins as a pair, the No. 1 duo of sophomore Daniella Kensinger and junior Anya Pemberton are the Pac-12 Pair of the Week, the first for Sun Devil Beach Volleyball since 2019.

This is the second pair of the week award in team history and first since 2019 when Ashley Wenz and Oluoma Okaro won on March 19.

As a pair, Kensinger and Pemberton had an incredibly strong weekend hosting the Pac-12 South Tournament, going 3-1 all against ranked opponents (No. 2 Stanford, No. 7 Cal, No. 19 Arizona). Not only did they get those three wins, but all three wins were in straight sets. Against the Wildcats, they won an intense 30-28 second set to get the sweep, which was the third-longest set in program history and was the longest set that the Sun Devils won.

In the Rankings

The Sand Devils are ranked No. 11 in the AVCA Coaches Poll. The highest ranking this season was No. 10 in week 2, which was tied for the highest rank ASU has received in program history. It tied a No. 10 ranking in 2017.

Familiar Faces

There are 11 Sand Devils returning to the team for the 2024 season. There are three seniors in Kate Fitzgerald, Ivey Weber and Taryn Ames, in addition to graduate Lexi Sweeney. Sweeney was named to the All-Pac-12 Second Team, making her the first Sand Devil to earn a conference honor since 2021. All of them played the majority of last season, with Ames leading the team in wins in 2023 with a 14-9 record.

Other returners who were key starters last season are sophomores Adriana Nieves Papaleo and Carys Thomas and juniors Anya Pemberton and Rylie Kael. Sophomore Kendall Whitmarsh played in five duals her freshman season. The other returning players on the roster are sophomore Ava Lewison-German and junior Lillie Seymour.

New Faces

Five transfers and five freshmen are on the 2024 roster. The transfers are junior Samaya Morin (GCU), sophomore Arden Besecker (FSU), sophomore Daniella Kensinger (Saint Mary's), junior Ava Kirunchyk (USC) and redshirt-freshman Hayden Huber (TCU).

Annalyse Askew, Ava Haughy, Elsa Snipes, Ava Williamson and Deanie Woodruff all join the team in their first year of college beach volleyball. Williamson played at the AVCA Fall Pairs Championships with Kensinger.

New Coach, New Era

After eight seasons at Grand Canyon, Kristen Rohr made the switch across the Valley to ASU, replacing former head coach Brad Keenan. After the opening weekend this season, she surpassed 150 career wins. She led the Lopes to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2022 and 2023 and holds a 148-71 (.676) record as a head coach, all with the Lopes. Rohr was picked by the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) as the 2022 Collegiate Beach Coach of the Year after leading GCU to its first-ever NCAA Championship appearance in 2022.

2024 Schedule Outlook

This season, the Sand Devils will be home more than ever before with three tournaments and seven days that the team will be playing at the Sun Devil Beach Volleyball Facility. Additionally, the Maroon and Gold Scrimmage is on February 17 at the facility, free to the public to get the first chance to see the 2024 squad.

The schedule is packed with some of the top teams around the country, including defending national champion USC. There are 11 opponents on the slate that made the 2023 NCAA Tournament and 15 teams finished ranked in the AVCA Coaches Poll. In the preseason poll, there are 14 teams of the top 20 on the schedule.

Last Season

In 2023, the Sand Devils earned an 11-13 record, 6-5 in Pac-12 play. During the year, Arizona State had two win streaks of three. Of the six Pac-12 wins, which are the most ASU has had, two came against Utah, two against Oregon and two against Arizona.

The highlight of the season was the team sweeping the regular season series against Arizona for the first time since 2014. Not only did the Sun Devils win both teams while the Wildcats were ranked, but ASU came back down 2-0 in both duals to win 3-2.

- Kristen Rohr was hired as the third head coach in program history on June 2, 2023.
- Rohr spent eight seasons at Grand Canyon University, leading the team to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2022 and 2023.
- Rohr was picked by the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) as the 2022 Collegiate Beach Coach of the Year after leading GCU to its first-ever NCAA Championship appearance in 2022.
- The GCU beach volleyball program went from being unranked in 2015 to a top-15 team in Rohr's second season as head coach in 2017. She led the Lopes to three-straight top-10 rankings to finish the seasons from 2021-23. In her eight seasons, she led the team to three top-10 finishes, two top 15 and one top 20.
- Rohr has coached six AVCA All-Americans and four AVCA Top Flight pairs (two in 2022, 2021, 2019). She led the Lopes to 41 wins over ranked opponents in her tenure. Additionally, from 2020-23, GCU was 50-0 against unranked opponents. In 2022 and 2023, the Lopes finished with a program-best 26 wins each season.
- From 2007-2015, Rohr competed professionally in beach volleyball, ranking as high as
 fifth in the country. She began her career with the Association of Volleyball Professionals (AVP) and spent years on the National Volleyball League tour.
- Additionally, Rohr was head coach of Cardinal Mooney High School in Sarasota, Fla., for five seasons. She co-founded the Coastline Volleyball Club team for high school athletes and served as its director and coach.
- Rohr graduated from Kentucky in 2005 with a degree in family consumer science. During her collegiate career, she was a four-year starter for the Wildcats and was named All-SEC and team MVP. She received her master's degree in counselor education from Capella University in 2011.
- Prior to college, Rohr competed at Venice (Fla.) High School, leading the team to a state championship and being selected as MVP during her junior and senior years.
- Rohr and her husband Daniel reside in the Valley.

- He also won a state title in his first season with Point Loma High School's indoor women's team.
- Competed on the AVP Tour from 2005-18, recording three top-10 finishes in his career. His best finish was seventh place in 2016 at the Seattle Open.
- He played on San Diego State's club team, where he was selected to the all-tournament team in both 2004 and 2005.
- He graduated with a degree in psychology. He played at Grossmont College for two years before transferring to SDSU.

- Abbie Hughes joined Sun Devil Beach Volleyball in July 2023.
- In the coaching sphere, Hughes had coached for Rob Long at Ohio Valley Beach/P1440. She also ran the developmental summer program for the club that consisted of over 100 players.
- Hughes has experience playing beach volleyball in college. She played the 2022-23 seasons at Grand Canyon, where Rohr was the head coach.
- In 2023, she played on the top court all year, earning a 16-4 record. She earned AVCA All-America honors for her first time. For the pair's efforts, they won the AVCA Top Flight award, one of 12 in the nation.
- With strong work in the classroom as well, she was a CSC Academic All-American.
- Prior to GCU, Hughes played at Florida International for three years, both indoor and beach volleyball.
- Hughes has a bachelor's degree in psychology and is currently pursuing a master's degree. Her parents are John and Christie and she has one younger brother, Jake.
