LAST TIME OUT

Arizona State finished third at the Valspar Collegiate Invitational in Palm City, FL with freshmen Wenyi Ding (-8/4th) and Connor Williams (-3/T8th) leading the way for the Sun Devils.

Ding made 17 birdies on the week, the second most of any competitor, while junior Preston Summerhays finished with 39 pars, also second most in the field.

Graduate student Ryggs Johnston had an impressive third round, shooting a 5-under 66. His six birdies helped him tie for sixth place while competing as an individual.

Sun Devil Men's Golf returns home to wrap up the regular season and host the 51st playing of the Thunderbird Collegiate at Papago Golf Club in Phoenix, Ariz.

Arizona State will defend its team title while junior Preston Summerhays defends the individual honors.

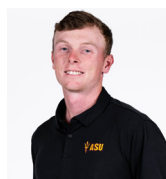

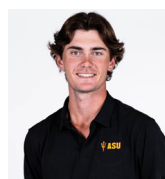

THE COURSE

- Papago Golf Club, the home of the Sun Devils, will play host to the Thunderbird Collegiate
- Papago will host the event for the fifth time after becoming the host site for the Thunderbird in 2019.
- The course measures 7,503 yards and plays as a par-71.

THE FORMAT

- Teams will play 36 holes on Friday and the final 18 on Saturday in the 54-hole event.

- Six teams in the field are ranked inside the top 20 of the Scoreboard rankings powered by clipd:

No. 4 Arizona State
No. 8 Washington
No. 9 Arizona
No. 10 Texas Tech
No. 14 Oklahoma
No. 19 New Mexico

- Baylor (33), Colorado (68), Houston (62), Oklahoma State (32), Oregon State (62), SMU (40), San Francisco (71), UCLA (27), Utah (60), USC (102), and Washington State (60) round out the 2024 field.

THUNDERBIRD HISTORY

- Arizona State has captured the Thunderbird on 21 different occasions and has produced 13 individual champions.
- 16 winners of the Thunderbird have gone on to win on the PGA Tour.
- Six winners have won major championships: John Rahm (ASU), Collin Morikawa (Cal), Phil Mickelson (ASU), Steve Jones (Colorado), Corey Pavin (UCLA), and Scott Simpson (USC).

LAST TIME HERE

- Down by as many as seven strokes on the back nine, Arizona State made a charge down the stretch to defeat Arizona by one shot at the 2023 Thunderbird Collegiate.
- Preston Summerhays made birdies on the 17th and 18th

holes to put the Sun Devils on top of the leaderboard while shooting a final round 66 to finish 13-under for the event.

THE VALSPAR

- ASU finished third at the Valspar Collegiate during the last week of March with Freshmen Wenyi Ding and Connor Williams leading the way.
- Wenyi Ding continued his instant success as a Sun Devil with rounds of 72, 65, and 68 to finish in solo fourth in the event.
- Connor Williams' hot spring continued with his first top-10 finish of the year. Since the new year, he has a stroke average of 69.8.
- While competing as an individual, graduate student Ryggs Johnston fired a season best 66 during the final round to post his best result of the season at T6.

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK

- After Arizona State's 14th place finish at the Southern Highlands Collegiate in Las Vegas, Coach Thurmond called it, "The worst tournament I have ever had as a coach."
- A week later at the Cabo Collegiate, the Sun Devils claimed the team title by nine strokes, thanks to an 11-under 273 in the final round.
- In Cabo, ASU was the only team that was in the top three in par-3 (+2), 4 (+5), and 5 (-16) scoring, birdies (56), and eagles (2).
- Preston Summerhays (-8/3), Wenyi Ding (-3/T10), and Josele Ballester (-3/T10) all posted top-10 finishes in the event.

WELCOME WENYI

- In his second collegiate event, the Amer Ari Invitational in Hawaii, freshman Wenyi Ding set what is believed to be a collegiate golf record by becoming the first player to break 190 in a 54-hole event, with his 189/-27 total (Jon Rahm had the previous record at 192).
- Ding won the event by a nine stroke margin at 27-under par. He topped it off by shooting 10-under 62 in the final round.
- In his first stroke play event as a Sun Devil, Ding finished in second place at the N.I.T. with a 17-under total. He led the tournament after 36 holes of play by shooting rounds of 65 and 67.
- The native of China is the only Pac-12 golfer who has earned Golfer of the Week honors twice this season, doing so in back-to-back weeks, Feb. 6 and Feb. 18.
- His impressive amateur career prior to his enrollment at ASU includes a victory in the 2022 U.S. Junior Amateur Championship and a runner-up finish at the 2023 Asia-Pacific Amateur Championship, narrowly missing out on an invite to this week's Masters Tournament.

INDIVIDUAL MEDALISTS

- Preston Summerhays' victory at the Sahalee Players Championship in September marked his second collegiate victory, after winning the Thunderbird Collegiate last April.

His rounds of 72-67-72 and win in a playoff earned him a spot in the PGA Tour's Fortinet Championship.

• Freshman Nick Prieto was one of two freshman to medal in the fall when he did so at the Oregon State Invitational by shooting rounds of 68-70-71 to finish 4-under. The Sun Devils sent three freshman to the event in Corvallis to compete as individuals, the same week as The Williams Cup.

• Freshman Fifi Laopakdee won his collegiate debut in September at the Maui Jim Individual by finishing 15-under to win by three shots. The Thai native shot 70 in his first round as a Sun Devil and followed it with rounds of 64 and 67.

• Graduate student Gabe Salvanera won the Papago Individual in September at ASU's home course. The veteran opened with a 64 and followed it with rounds of 66 and 71 to finish at 12-under and win by six shots.

• Wenyi Ding became the fifth individual on the Arizona State roster to capture an individual championship when he broke the record book with rounds of 63, 64, and 62 for a 189 total at the Amer Ari Invitational.

HOGAN AWARD

• Freshman Wenyi Ding and junior Preston Summerhays were both named to the Ben Hogan Award watch list. The watch list of 40 players will be narrowed down to 10 semifinalists on April 19.

• Jon Rahm (2015 & 2016) is one of only two players who have earned Hogan Award recognition in back to back years.

NEWCOMERS

• After carrying a roster of seven last season, Coach Thurmond added five freshmen to the squad this season.

• Wenyi Ding from Beijing, China was the winner of the 2022 U.S. Junior Amateur Championship and is ranked No. 13 in the World Amateur Golf Ranking (WAGR). He enrolled in the Spring 2024 semester after a runner-up finish in the Asia-Pacific Amateur Championship.

• Fifi Laopakdee won his first collegiate start during the Maui Jim Intercollegiate when she shot 15-under. He is a two-time Thailand Amateur Open Champion and has played in the Junior Presidents Cup and World Amateur Championship.

• Anawin Pikulthong is a two-time AJGA Champion and a two-time Rolex All-American. He won his local qualifier for the 2022 U.S. Amateur Championship.

• Nick Prieto advanced to the Round of 32 at the U.S. Junior Amateur and was named a Rolex All-American. He won the Oregon State Invitational at 4-under.

• Connor Williams is also a two-time Rolex All-American and former winner of the Southern California Junior Amateur Championship. He was ranked No. 16 on the Junior Golf Scoreboard for the 2023 class.

THURMOND TO LEAD USA

- Head coach Matt Thurmond was selected to lead Team USA at the 2024 Arnold Palmer Cup in July at Lahinch Golf Club in Ireland.
- The event is a Ryder-Cup style competition that features the best men's and women's collegiate golfers from the U.S. and abroad. The USA leads at all-time series against the International Team 14-12-1.
- Since the Palmer Cup's start in 1997, Arizona State has had 12 players represent their home countries.

HELLO FRIENDS

- While ASU defends its title at the Thunderbird, #SunDevil4Life John Rahm will defend his Green Jacket at the 88th playing of the Masters at Augusta National Golf Club.
- Last year, Rahm carded rounds of 65, 69, 73, and 69 after beginning the tournament with a double bogey on the first hole. The victory earned him his second career major championship (2021 U.S. Open).
- Right below Rahm (-12) on the leaderboard, finishing in second, was another #SunDevil4Life and two-time Green Jacket winner Phil Mickelson (-8).
- Rahm (11) and Mickelson (16) combined to win 27 times as Sun Devils, making them the winningest players in program history.

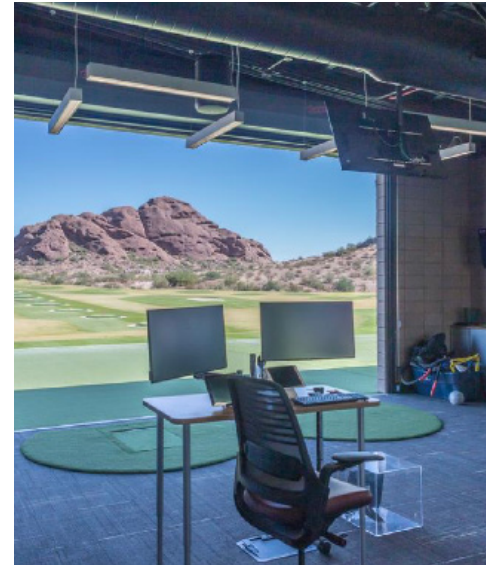

THE THUNDERBIRDS GOLF COMPLEX



The Thunderbirds Golf Complex, designed by Douglas Fredrickson Architects and built by Rummel Construction Inc., is a 7,000-square foot facility featuring a grand entry lobby, national championship displays, a team gym and locker rooms for both men's and women's teams, a fueling station, study and team lounge, indoor hitting bays & more.

Designed by Sun Devil alumnus and five-time PGA Major Championships winner Phil Mickelson, who is known for his short-game expertise, the four-acre practice area consists of five practice greens, four practice bunkers and a three-acre fairway and rough designed to practice every possible golf shot.

On Nov. 1, 2018, Papago Golf Course became the new home for Sun Devil Men's & Women's Golf with the unveiling of their new state-of-the-art practice facility -- The Thunderbirds Golf Complex -- through the generous commitment by The Thunderbirds organization.

HEAD COACH MATT THURMOND

Head coach Matt Thurmond was hired to lead the men's golf program on July 25, 2016, by Ray Anderson and in his first six seasons has led ASU to 17 team titles, earned 2019 Pac-12 Coach of the Year and hired the nation's top assistant coach who is now the UCLA head coach. Entering 2022-23 he has led ASU to its best NCAA finishes since 1996 with a tie for third in 2021 and a runner-up finish to Texas in 2022.

Last season, Thurmond led Arizona State to the NCAA Championship for an eighth consecutive season, the fourth longest active streak in college golf. The season featured the first team victory at the Thunderbird Collegiate since 2019 and the entire NCAA Championship lineup being awarded with Pac-12 postseason honors.

The 2021-22 season saw the Sun Devils make a fantastic run to the finals of the NCAA Championship, have another Sun Devil (Preston Summerhays) win Pac-12 Newcomer of the Year and watch four Sun Devils earn All-America honors for the second straight year while also racking up three team tournament wins, including the NCAA Stockton Regional.

The 2020-21 season saw two tournament titles in a condensed season with the squad earning a NCAA match play win for the first time, as well as its best finish (tied for third) since it won the 1996 NCAA title. ASU had four GCAA All-Americans, with three of returning in 2021-22 and the other (Chun An Yu) earning a spot on the Korn Ferry Tour through the PGA Tour University program. The spring of 2021 was the busiest five months in the history of Sun Devil men's golf with the cancellation of fall golf in the Pac-12, as the Sun Devils played 41 rounds of golf in 136 days, starting on Jan. 17 with a win at the inaugural Copper Cup and finishing with a tough NCAA match play semifinal loss to top-ranked Oklahoma on June 1. In between much happened as ASU competed in Arizona, California, Hawaii, Texas, Florida and Georgia. The team notched four All-Americans for the first time since 2009, and its NCAA finish (tied for third) was its best since it won the 1996 title.

His Sun Devils were hot and ready to make a run at postseason trophies in 2020 with three titles, including the highly competitive Cabo Collegiate, but when the Corona Virus canceled the NCAA spring season and the chance to win the NCAA title at Grayhawk Golf right up the road, reality hit and goals were changed.

"I'm just still so humbled every day to be able to represent Sun Devil Golf, coach these amazing players, and build this program," says Thurmond. "I love doing it and I love seeing and feeling the growth in momentum in any and all areas of our program and especially in our players. I'm more confident than ever in the brightness of the Sun Devil Golf future. Talking about it with our players, recruits, and supporters gives me a rush because it is real and they can all feel it."

Thurmond, who spent the previous 15 seasons at Washington, created a perennial national championship contending program for the Huskies. With 12 total NCAA Championship appearances, Thurmond's teams averaged a ninth-place national finish, including seven top-10 finishes. The 2009 Golfweek National Coach of the Year and two-time Pac-12 Coach of the Year ('05, '09), Thurmond coached Washington to three conference titles in 2005, 2009, and 2010.

He also knows how to hire. Currently five former assistant coaches are leading Division I men's golf programs: Armen Kirakossian (UCLA), Van Williams (Wofford), Jon Reehoorn (Oregon State), Garrett Clegg (Utah) and Michael Wilson (Long Beach State) while Dan Potter led Boise State to impressive wins before stepping away after the 2021-22 season.
