## SUN DEVIL REWIND

Following the program's first-ever tournament championship at the Ice Vegas Invitational, the Sun Devils featured a Dr. Jekyl and Mr. Hyde sort of performance against UMass-Lowell last weekend.

After a scoreless opening period, the River Hawks rattled off two goals in the second period and two in the third for a 4-0 victory. As they've done on four other times this season, they flipped the script in game two.

Sophomore goaltender JOEY DACCORD picked up not just his first collegiate shutout between the pipes, but also the program's first-ever shutout over a Division I opponent in a 4-0 win on Saturday.

Freshman forward JOHNNY WALKER netted two goals for his first-ever multi-goal performance in his young collegiate career.

On the back end, sophomore defenseman BRINSON PASICHNUK recorded another multi-point performance -- his third in four games. He's now totaled three goals and four assists in his last four games.

## NO PITY FOR THE KITTY

Despite having one of the program's worst starts in two decades, Quinnipiac is loaded with talent and a goaltender between the pipes that has proven he can steal a game any given night.

The Bobcats are out for revenge, as the Sun Devils' 4-2 victory in Hamden late in January was a dagger to the hopes of Quinnipiac making the 2017 NCAA Tournament - then ranked No. 17.

This season, Q'pac has proven to be better on the road this season at 5-5-2 versus their 3-7-1 record on home ice.

Goaltender Andrew Shortridge ranks second in the NCAA in shutouts with four this season, while freshman phenom Odeen Tufto paces the Bobcats with 20 assists and 25 points so far this season.

2. Goalie @JDac35 recorded his first collegiate shutout against UMass-Lowell and currently leads the NCAA in saves and shots faced.
3. The Devils leading scorer, @Brindogboy (six goals and 10 assists), ties for 25th in scoring amongst defenseman in college hockey.

The Sun Devils penalty killing unit currently ranks 12th in the country with a kill rate of 84.8%. ASU has killed 23 of the last 25 penalties.

In 12 of his last 14 starts, sophomore goaltender JOEY DACCORD has made at least 30 saves between the pipes. He currently has the most saves and shots faced of any goaltender in the NCAA.

The Sun Devils netted four goals against UMass-Lowell and held them scoreless through three frames for the first shutout win at home and against a Division I team in program history.

The Sun Devils rattled off seven goals in the first round of the Ice Vegas Invitational against Northern Michigan, becoming a program record for most scored in a game against a Division I opponent.

# PARTY LIKE IT'S 1997

- This weekend's series features two teams with 1997 birth years pacing the team in points in ASU's BRINSON PASICHNUK and Quinnipiac's Odeen Tufto.
- Both are having great runs over the last four games, with PASICHNUK totaling three goals and four assists and Tufto with two goals and four assists of his own.
- Prior to the two recent goals to start the 2018 calendar year, Tufto hadn't scored since Oct. 20, but as his stat line shows, had been racking up assists with five multi-assist performances during that break.
- PASICHNUK now has six multi-point games this season as a defenseman, including three in the last four games.
- Tufto played with the Sioux City Musketeers and ASU d-man JACOB WILSON last season, who finished as runners-up to the Chicago Steel and Sun Devil JOHNNY WALKER in the USHL Championship.

## MONKEY OFF THE BACK

- Since moving to Division I, ASU hadn't won a tournament through their first three years, and held a 1-3-1-1 record in their prior four tournament appearances.
- Their first NCAA Division I games as a program came in the Kendall Hockey Classic in Alaska, where the Devils captured their first NCAA victory in a 2-1 win over Alaska-Fairbanks in their second game.
- The victory in the Ice Vegas Invitational two weekends ago was the program's first tournament championship.

## SECOND HALF, BEST HALF

- During the 2016-17 season, the Sun Devils finished the 2016 half of the season with a 7-14-1 record. The 2017 half of the season started with three-straight losses to top-10 opponents -- and eventual national champion Denver -- yet won six of the last 11 with two being ties. The two ties came against top-10 opponents Ohio State and Western Michigan, and the Sun Devils ended up winning the second overtime and shootout in those.
- The Devils ended up finishing the 2017 half of the season with a 6-6-2 record.
- After averaging 2.77 goals scored through the 2016 half, the Sun Devil offense exploded at an average of 3.64 goals per game over the last 14 games.

## MULTI DIMENSIONAL

- Sophomore BRINSON PASICHNUK & junior ANTHONY CROSTON are on a heater after departing Las Vegas.
- PASICHNUK totaled five points over the two games, with three goals and two assists. He earned the tournament's Most Valuable Player for his performance.
- It is the first time in his collegiate career that PASICHNUK has tallied back-to-back multi-point games.
- PASICHNUK's 16 points this season break his total output from his freshman season with 10 games still remaining this season.
- CROSTON also had back-to-back multi-point games in Vegas, netting two goals in the first game -- both redirects off shots from PASICHNUK -- and two assists in the second.

## RISE OF THE ROOKIES

- Two of the new freshman rank in the top-10 in scoring among the Devils, including JOHNNY WALKER in 4th with seven goals and five assists, and JACOB WILSON in a tie for 8th with a goal and six assists.
- WALKER is on a tear as of late with three goals and an assist in his last four games.
- The 2017 incoming Sun Devil class ranked No. 9 in the country according to NeutralZone.net.
- The ranking is fitting, as ASU welcomes nine new freshmen, including JOHNNY WALKER, JACOB WILSON, GVIDO JANSONS, FILIPS BUNCIS, DOMINIC GARCIA, AUSTIN LEMIEUX, GAGE MACKIE, MAX BALINSON and MIKE DePHILLIPS.
- WILSON and JANSONS are listed as top-25 recruits among 1997-born players, according to Neutral Zone. WALKER comes in at No. 45 in the field of 1996-born players, with GARCIA at No. 48.
- LEMIEUX, who is the son of Hockey Hall of Famer and Pittsburgh Penguins' owner Mario Lemieux, will redshirt the 2017-18 season.

## NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP

- While the freshman class arrives in style, the rising freshmen that are now sophomores continue to thrive in their second season. Four of the top-10 scorers from a season ago were all returning sophomores, including BUSCH, JAKOB STRIDSBERG, BRINSON PASICHNUK and BRETT GRUBER. STRIDSBERG is a junior by eligibility, and a sophomore by NCAA seasons.
- Through 24 games this season, PASICHNUK, GRUBER and BUSCH lead the team in points so far this season.
- Goaltender JOEY DACCORD continues to give the Sun Devils a winning chance each and every night, boasting a 7-11-4 record, 3.20 goals against average and .913 save percentage -- the latter which ranks 7th among goaltenders in the NCAA with at least 20 starts.
- So far, defensemen BRINSON PASICHNUK and JAKOB STRIDSBERG continue to thrive from the blue line with 11 goals and 14 assists between the two.

## LATVIAN LOVE

- The Sun Devils welcome their second and third Europeans to the roster, as Latvian defenseman GVIDO JANSONS and forward FILIPS BUNCIS come to Tempe and join Swedish junior JAKOB STRIDSBERG.
- Along with their hard-and-heavy style of play, the two both stand at 6-foot-4 and 210 pounds and arrive at ASU from the NAHL. BUNCIS played with the Johnstown Tomahawks, where he wore the 'C' as the first European captain in Johnstown history. He netted 11 goals and 25 assists last season.
- JANSONS spent last season with fellow freshman DOMINIC GARCIA with the Aston Rebels, where he led all NAHL defensemen in goals scored with 19 -- 11 of them on the power-play.

## THE GEASERS

- Redshirt senior DAVID NORRIS and graduate transfer GAGE HOUGH reside as the only two seniors on this year's Sun Devil roster.
- NORRIS is the final Sun Devil who once played for the ACHA program before it transitioned into NCAA Division I.
- At the end of 2014, NORRIS transferred from American International College in the NCAA for a change of scenery and to join his brother, LIAM, on the Devils' roster. Never knowing whether he would play NCAA hockey, NORRIS scored nine goals and nine assists in nine games in that final season of ACHA -- the same time when ASU found out they would move to the NCAA.
- Due to NCAA rules, NORRIS redshirted the inaugural NCAA season at ASU and returned last year for his first year back in Division I hockey. He scored three goals and nine assists before suffering an injury in the second game against Denver on Jan. 7.
- HOUGH once played with current assistant captain LOUIE ROWE before going to UMass-Lowell for his first three seasons, totaling six goals and four assists in 40 games. He is currently pursuing his master's in Sports Law & Business.

## DRAFTED DEVIL

- Sophomore JOEY DACCORD is now the only Sun Devil to have been drafted in the NHL after the departure of Robbie Baillargeon and Wade Murphy.
- DACCORD was drafted prior to wearing the Maroon & Gold, but is officially the first drafted player in Sun Devil Division I history as he was committed to ASU. DACCORD went 199th overall in the 7th round of the 2015 NHL Draft to the Ottawa Senators.
- Over the summer, sophomores BRINSON PASICHNUK, TYLER BUSCH and JAKOB STRIDSBERG attended NHL Development Camps, including the Montreal Canadiens, Calgary Flames and Toronto Maple Leafs, respectively.

## POWERING UP

Coach Powers enters the 2017-18 season wrapping up a decade on the Sun Devil Coaching Staff and his third as Head Coach of ASU's NCAA Division I Hockey program. During the 2016-17 campaign, Powers led the Devils to double-digit victories at 10-19-3, doubling his victories year-to-year. In the inaugural NCAA season, ASU finished 10-23-5 in 2015 and 5-22-2 in NCAA play under Powers. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their first-ever ACHA Division I National Championship. He holds a 191-85-20 career record at ASU.

Along with assistant coaches Alex Hicks and Mike Field, the Sun Devils welcomed their first top-10 recruiting class in just their third season as an NCAA program. According to NeutralZone.net, ASU's 2017 recruiting class ranked 9th in Division I, ahead of historic programs like Boston College, Minnesota-Duluth, Harvard, Notre Dame and UMass-Lowell.

Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammert. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.
