- FACILITY: The GAC is an 8 lanes, 50m pool. Competition will be run in 8 lanes with turns on the bulkhead. Starting block wedges and backstrokes wedges available, relay judging pads for relays, Colorado Timing. An additional 12 lanes will be available for continuous warm-up/warm-down. The GAC also has a separate 25 yard wide, 17ft deep diving well for the diving competition.

PRACTICE TIMES: The GAC will have lanes available Wednesday 12:00pm-8:00pm. We will work with each team to assign a time that works best with your travel schedules. There are 12 lanes in the main pool (under the scoreboard, not the competition lanes) 12:00pm-4:00pm. There are also 10 lanes in their new training pool 12:00-4:00pm. The competition pool will have all 8 lanes available 4:00-8:00pm. Please work with Kevin Happ to arrange pool time for Wednesday. - MEET FORMAT: Finals will run 5 heats (A-E) for the 50 Free, 4 heats (A-D) for the 100/200 events, 3 heats (A-C) for the 400/500 events. Relays will be contested timed finals during the finals sessions.
- Finals will be swum in the following order- E Final, D Final, C Final, B Final, A Final

- SCORING:** The meet will be scored to 32 places (relays double points)  
Championship A Final: 32, 28, 27, 26, 25, 24, 23, 22  
Consolation B Final: 20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11  
Bonus C Final: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1  
D/E Final: Non-Scoring
- ENTRIES:** Must be submitted via Team Manager by November 18th. Please submit entries to Kate McIntosh, [Katherine.mcintosh@greensboro-nc.gov](mailto:Katherine.mcintosh@greensboro-nc.gov). An entry file will be sent to each team before November 4<sup>th</sup>.
- Participants are limited to a maximum of nine (9) events of which there may be no more than four (4) individual events. Team may each enter unlimited relays per event, but only 2 scoring (A & B). All relays will be swum as timed finals. The 400 IM will be limited to the fastest 48 individuals and the 1650 freestyle limited to the fastest 40, if needed based on the timeline. Please enter the 1650 freestyle with individual's season best 1000 time.

- ENTRY FEE:** There will be an entry fee of \$250 per team (\$500 per institution bringing both men and women) with a check payable to NC STATE Athletics.
- MEET TIMES:** Prelims- 9:30am  
Finals- 5:30pm  
Diving will be announced after entries are received
- PROCEDURE:** A scratch box will be provided and all scratches are due by 5:00pm the previous evening. Anyone wishing to scratch from the evening finals must adhere to the 30 minute scratch rule.
- TEAM SEATING:** *Option A:* Teams will pick seating location based on combined order of finish from 2019 NCAA Championships.
- Option B:* We will assign each team a number, write that number on a ping-pong ball and have an Instagram Live drawing from a bowl. Order drawn will be seat selection order. Host team will have first pick.
- TEAM PARKING:** The GAC will work with each team to help provide appropriate parking for each team's needs. Please let Kevin Happ know what type of vehicles you will have and how many of each. ***Please let Kevin know before November 18.***
