QUICK HITS

Winning Streak

The Sun Devils are coming off three wins in a row with two of those victories coming against ranked conference opponents, No. 16 UCLA on Oct. 14 and No. 19 Utah on Friday. ASU also defeated Colorado, who was receiving votes in the AVCA Coaches Poll, on Sunday in Boulder, which led to Sun Devil volleyball's first road sweep of the mountain schools in program history.

Block Party

The Sun Devils now have three matches in a row reaching double figures in blocks. In the win over Utah, the team had 17 blocks in the upset, which was the most for ASU since 2016. Claire Jeter had a career-high nine blocks and Iman Isanovic had six blocks (matching her personal best) on Friday night. Claudia Stahlke matched her season high in blocks with seven in the win over Colorado on Sunday, as well.

Weekly Awards

Junior outside hitter Iman Isanovic racked up the awards for leading the Sun Devils offensively on this win streak. She was named Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week on Monday, and on Tuesday she was the Sports Imports/AVCA Player of the Week. It was the first offensive player of the week nod for ASU since 2018 and the first national weekly award since 2015. She continues to lead the conference in kills this season with 335. On Friday in Salt Lake City, Isanovic had a game-high 24 kills in the upset over Utah, which was her fifth match this season reaching 20+ kills. She also had 18 kills in the win over Colorado on Sunday to lead the team.

Balanced Offense

Sophomore pin hitter Marta Levinska, freshman outside hitter Geli Cyr and Jeter have also been additional factors for ASU's offense. Levinska is currently on a five-match streak of reaching double figures in kills and also has nine double-doubles this season. Jeter has reached double figures in kills nine times this season. Cyr had her career-high in kills with 13 and had her second double-double of her career on Sunday.

No Sophomore Slump Here

Sophomore setter Ella Snyder has 10 double-doubles this season and has reached 50 or more assists in two matches this season, where she reached 51 assists on Sunday. Additionally, Snyder has reached 40 or more assists in the last five matches.

She Can Dig It

Junior libero Annika Larson is now in sole possession of first for total digs for the Pac-12 with 328. Larson had 24 digs for ASU's defense on Sunday in Colorado and 13 digs against Utah and now has 15 matches reaching double figures in digs and six matches notching 20 or more digs.

Scouting the Opposition

California (7-14, 0-10 Pac-12)

- Cal is coming off of another tough weekend where they traveled to face No. 10 Washington and No. 22 Washington State. The Bears took the Huskies to four sets in the matchup in Seattle and were swept by the Cougars on Sunday in Pullman.
- Last season, the Bears finished with a 1-21 record with a win in the 2021 season facing Pac-12 competition only over then-No. 15 Stanford on Feb. 12 in Palo Alto. Cal finished in 12th place in the conference.
- Friday's matchup with Cal will be the second time the Sun Devils will face the Bears during the regular season. On Oct. 3 when ASU was in Berkeley, the Sun Devils took down the Bears in four sets, which was ASU's first Pac-12 win of the season and ended a four-match skid. ASU has won the last three matchups with Cal.

No. 15 Stanford (12-6, 7-3 Pac-12)

- The Cardinal traveled to the Washington schools last weekend where they split the two matches. In Pullman on Friday night, Stanford defeated No. 22 Washington State in a five-set match and were swept by No. 10 Washington on Sunday in Seattle. Stanford has four ranked wins this season.
- In the spring 2020-21 season, Stanford only played in ten matches due to various match cancellations because of COVID-19 related issues and additional injuries within the program. The Cardinal finished with a 2-8 record in an abbreviated season and were 11th in the conference.
- Arizona State last played Stanford on Oct. 1 in Palo Alto where they came up short in four sets to the Cardinal. In the match, ASU had seven service aces and Isanovic and Levinska both reached double figures in kills.
- Redshirt sophomore outside hitter Caitie Baird leads her team in kills with 285 and is fourth in the Pac-12 in kills. She was named Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 18. The leader in assists is freshman setter Kami Miner who has 794 assists on the season, and leads the Pac-12 in assists per set with 11.27. Miner was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Week three times on Aug. 30, Sept. 13 and Oct. 4

Weekly Awards

Junior outside hitter Iman Isanovic was named Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 25, and on Oct. 26 she was the Sports Imports/AVCA Player of the Week. It was the first offensive player of the week nod for ASU since 2018 and the first national weekly award since 2015.

New Kids On The Block

There are eight new faces on the roster: five freshmen and three transfers. Of the five freshmen, one is a libero, two are outside hitters, one is a setter and one is a middle blockers. The transfers include two middle blockers and one libero.

National Team Experience

Over the summer, Sun Devil Volleyball pin hitters Iman Isanovic and Marta Levinska played for their national teams in their home countries of Bosnia-Herzegovina and Latvia, respectively. Isanovic helped her team earn a bid for the European Women's Volleyball Championship for the first time ever.

Worldwide Sun Devils

The Sun Devils continued to be represented by countries all around the world. On the coaching staff, head coach Sanja Tomasevic is from Serbia and associate head coach Carlos Moreno is from Brazil.

On the roster, there are six international student-athletes. Jinna Zeng is from Canada, Ayyuce Altintas is from Turkey, Iman Isanovic is from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Marta Levinska is from Latvia, Roberta Rabelo is from Brazil and Beatrice Badini is from Italy.

2020-21 Recap

In the fourth season under head coach Sanja Tomasevic, the Sun Devils competed in 20 matches, all against Pac-12 opponents. The team went 6-14 on the year and finished in ninth place in the conference. The roster was made up of primarily underclassmen (82 percent), eight student-athletes making their Division I NCAA volleyball debut.

Arizona State earned two wins over ranked opponents in the 2020-21 season, beating Sweet Sixteen teams Washington and Oregon. The Sun Devils made history at Stanford this season, winning there for the first time since 1982.

Pac-12 Honors in 2020-21

A few Sun Devils made a splash in conference play in the spring. Iman Isanovic was named to the All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention list last season. Marta Levinska made the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team after being named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week twice.

Career Leaders

On this young squad, junior Iman Isanovic has the highest career numbers in multiple categories. She has 481 kills and 35 aces. Junior Annika Larson has 387 career digs and junior Shannon Shields has 558 career assists.

Tried and True

The roster features 12 returning letterwinners, including the kill leaders (Isanovic and Levinska), digs leader (Annika Larson) and assists leader (Ella Snyder). Seven Sun Devils who started in a match last season are returning.

Pac-12 Preseason Poll

The Sun Devils were picked to finish 11th in the Pac-12 preseason poll. ASU finished the 2020-21 season in 9th place. Washington was picked to win the conference.

- She was named to the 2016 Husky Hall of Fame Class for her efforts at UW, just the second individual volleyball player to be inducted

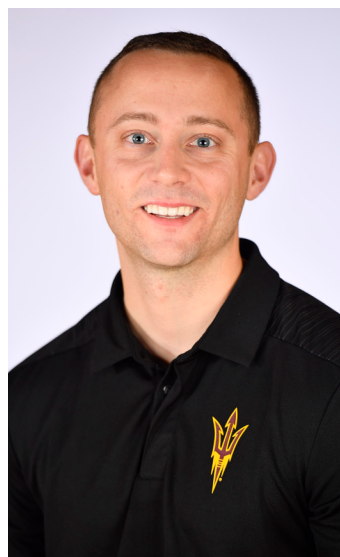

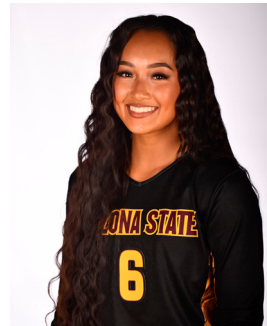
