#### **Sun Devil Update**

The Sun Devils are coming off two home wins to wrap up the regular season, as well as the first season in the new facility. The team has accumulated 15 wins, which is the third-highest season total in program history.

#### Win Leaders

Two Sand Devils have a team-high 16 wins this season: senior Maddy Salazar and sophomore Kate Fitzgerald. Right behind them with 15 wins are sophomore Taryn Ames and freshman Kylie Wickley.

#### Pairs To Watch

The No. 1 pair of Cierra Flood and Lexi Sweeney are the only duo to play in every dual together this season, earning 12 wins together. In the latter half of the seasaon, a few pairs have been put together and have seen a lot of success. Maddy Salazar and Taryn Ames have a 5-1 record in the No. 5 spot. Kate Fitzgerald and Kylie Wickley also have a 5-1 record, playing in the No. 4 spot.

#### Flood Watch

Sand Devils graduate student and fifth-year player Cierra Flood moved up to rank second overall in program history in career wins with 63 total. Flood has become one of the most consistent players this season in the No. 1 spot alongside Lexi Sweeney, the only duo to be paired together all season and play in the same spot.

#### Debuts

Several Sand Devils have made their collegiate debuts this season. Freshmen Rylie Kael, Anya Pemberton and Kylie Wickley have played in the majority of the duals so far. Others made their debuts as well throughout the sesaon: freshman Kaitlyn Winkelman, sophomores Cambria Hall, Maia Nichols and Ivey Weber and juniors Maria Kowal and Shane Burleson.

#### **New Home**

Arizona State has a brand new facility for the 2022 season. The Sun Devil Beach Volleyball Facility opened in February 2022 and features four championship courts. With flexible seating, fans can bring their beach chairs to watch the action. The courts will also be available to host open tournaments, intramural sports and other events and activities.

#### Returners

The 2022 roster sees fifteen athletes returning with the combo of Flood and junior Sarah Waters among them. The two teamed up in the No. 3 spot for nearly all duals in the 2021 season. They had a record of 12-9 for the season, capturing wins over three pairs from ranked teams.

Half of the No. 1 duo will return with Lexi Sweeney as she enters her junior season. Teamed with former Sun Devil student-athlete Katelyn Carballo, the two clinched a record of 11-11 for the 2021 season. Taryn Ames also returns after recording an 11-9 record playing at the No. 5 spot with Kate Fitzgerald, Weintraub, or Maddy Salazar, all who are returning this season.

#### **New Faces**

Six freshmen join the 2022 roster, all of whom have worked their way to success in the sport. The Sand Devils have the dual winners of the p1440 Southwest Championship both on the roster in that of Anya Pemberton and Rylie Kael.

Success does not run short in the talent coming onto the roster with Katie Blomberg fresh off a win at the 2021 TAPPS Beach State Championship and Kylie Wickley with a Gold Metal at the 2021 AVP Arizona State Championships (AVP 4 Star 18U).

#### **Last Season**

The Sand Devils ended the 2021 season with a 10-12 record, collecting four sweeps. In head coach Brad Keenan's fifth season at the helm, the Sand Devils went 4-7 in the Pac-12, earning wins over Washington, Utah and No. 11 Cal. They pushed forward into the Pac-12 Championships where they picked up a win over Washington before bowing out.

#### 2022 Schedule Outlook

The schedule is packed with competitive teams to strengthen the Sand Devils. Six teams on the schedule made it to the 2021 NCAA Championships: Cal Poly, Loyola Marymount, Stanford, TCU, UCLA and USC. The Bruins and Trojans advanced to the championship match and USC won the title. Ten opponents are ranked in the AVCA Preseason Coaches Poll, including USC at No. 1 and UCLA at No. 2.

- Hired as the eighth head coach on May 13, 2016
- Has three wins over ranked opponents (3 in 2019)
- Led ASU to its winningest season in program history in 2019, finishing the season ranked No. 20. The team did not lose to a single unranked team in 2019.
- Previously coached at Concordia University with the men's volleyball team in 2015.
- Also served as a volunteer assistant coach with the USA Women's National Team, Balboa Bay Volleyball Club, Surf City Volleyball Club and with the Fountain Valley High School Varsity Volleyball program.
- Made his professional beach volleyball debut in 2006, and has since earned 25 top-three finishes on the Association of Volleyball Professionals (AVP) tour. He was named the 2006 Rookie of the Year, and earned Most Improved Player accolades in 2007. In 2014 he was recognized as the AVP's Best Server. He also spent seven years with the Fédération Internationale de Volleyball (FIVB), from 2009-15.
- Keenan was a four-time AVCA All-American and two-time National Player of the Year at Pepperdine, where he was a middle blocker from 2000-03. He finished his career as the record holder in blocks and service aces and earned his Bachelor of Science in Accounting. In 2014, Keenan was inducted into the Pepperdine Hall of Fame.



- He came to ASU after a season with Cal's beach volleyball team as the volunteer assistant coach.
- Prior to his time with the Bears, he was part of the UC Berkeley beach volleyball coaching staff and spent time working with various top beach volleyball clubs in California.
- He also coached indoor volleyball teams at the high school level, winning three state championships in four years at Cathedral Catholic High School with the women's team and then moved to the men's indoor team to win two CIF titles.
- He also won a state title in his first season with Point Loma High School's indoor women's team.
- Competed on the AVP Tour from 2005-18, recording three top-10 finishes in his career. His best finish was seventh place in 2016 at the Seattle Open.
- He played on San Diego State's club team, where he was selected to the all-tournament team in both 2004 and 2005.
- He graduated with a degree in psychology. He played at Grossmont College for two years before transferring to SDSU.
