## BY THE NUMBERS

**21**

This marks the 21st season for head coach Kate Drohan at the helm of Northwestern softball, alongside her twin sister, Caryl Drohan. Last year, the Drohans became the program's all-time wins leaders.

**103**

Rachel Lewis has 103 career stolen bases, the 5th most in program history. This year, Lewis ranked second in the Big Ten with 22 stolen bases, making her the first NU player to hit 20 HR/steal 20 bases in a single season. She is the first Big Ten player ever to steal 100+ bases and hit 60+ homers.

NU's pitcher Danielle Williams has tallied 898 strikeouts in 668.2 innings pitched, good for a career 9.40 K's per seven innings (K/7) rate, the highest in program history.

**6**

Northwestern is advancing to its sixth Super Regional since the tournament format changed in 2005. Each trip has been under the Drohans.

**63**

Rachel Lewis is the 4th player in Big Ten history to hit 60+ career homers. She's now in sole possession of 2nd place all-time in Big Ten history. (Sierra Romero, 82)

## 2022 SEASON NOTES

- » The Wildcats (43-10, 19-4 B1G) clinched the outright Big Ten title this season, their first since 2008 and first outright since 2006. Northwestern has now won eight Big Ten titles in program history, and three under Kate and Caryl Drohan.
- » The Wildcats are the No. 9 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament, their highest ranking since being the No. 2 seed in 2007 en route to a World Series appearance.
- » Northwestern is making its sixth NCAA Super Regional appearance, all under the Drohans, and have made two trips to the Women's College World Series (2006 and 2007).
- » The 'Cats scored 36 runs in their three games in the Evanston Regional. 12 runs per game is the most NU has ever averaged in a NCAA Regional or Super Regional round.
- » The Wildcats' 36 runs scored are the second-most scored by any team in last weekend's regionals, trailing Oklahoma's 37 runs by just one.
- » Northwestern's 17 runs scored against McNeese in the regional last Saturday (May 21) are the most the Wildcats have ever scored in an NCAA Tournament game.
- » The Wildcats are making their 20th overall tournament appearance in program history as well as their 15th tournament appearance in the 21-year Drohan era, including their seventh in the past eight tournaments.
- » Kate and Caryl Drohan earned their 700th career win in Northwestern's regional victory over McNeese on Saturday, the fifth most in Big Ten history.
- » Northwestern is 5-11 all-time against Arizona State. The Wildcats and Sun Devils last squared off at the 2020 Kajikawa Classic, with ASU winning 6-5 ... Northwestern and Arizona State have squared off vs. one another twice in the postseason during the Drohan-era, in 2007 the Wildcats defeated ASU, 2-0, in their opening game of the WCWS. In 2008, Arizona State swept a pair of Super Regional games in Tempe to advance to the WCWS.
- » Northwestern dominated the Big Ten yearly awards this season (info below):
- » Rachel Lewis was named Big Ten Player of the Year, becoming the fifth Wildcat to win the award, joining Lisa Ishikawa (1985), Brooke Siebel (2000), Garland Cooper (2005-07), and Tammy Williams (2008-09). Lewis led the conference in the regular season with 20 home runs, second-most in a season in Northwestern history, 50 RBI, 58 runs scored, an .855 slugging percentage, and 1.355 OPS, while placing second with 36 walks and 22 stolen bases. Lewis tied the Big Ten record with 12 home runs in conference play (excluding the extended 2021 conference season), while leading the conference with an incredible 1.000 slugging percentage, 1.540 OPS, 33 RBI, and 30 runs scored.

- » Danielle Williams was named the unanimous Big Ten Pitcher of the Year. Williams is the third Wildcat to be crowned Big Ten Pitcher of the Year, alongside Eileen Canney (2006-07) and Lauren Delaney (2008). She is the first unanimous Big Ten Pitcher of the Year in program history. Williams won the pitching triple crown in the Big Ten, leading the conference in ERA (1.49), strikeouts (270), and wins (25), in 187.2 innings pitched in the regular season. Lewis and Williams were also both unanimous First-Team All-Big Ten members, the only two players in the Big Ten to be unanimous selections.
- » Kate Drohan won Big Ten Coach of the Year for the 4th time (2nd-most ever in conference history behind Michigan's Carol Hutchins) in her 21-year career. She also won the award in 2005, 2006 and 2019.
- » Northwestern tied a program record set in 2006 with five first team All-Big Ten honorees (Hannah Cady, Nikki Cuchran, Rachel Lewis, Jordyn Rudd, Danielle Williams). Skyler Shellmyer and Maeve Nelson each earned 2nd team honors.
- » In conference play this season, the 'Cats led the Big Ten with 6.7 runs per game, a .408 on-base percentage, .569 slugging percentage, and 39 home runs. The Wildcats' .315 average and 191 hits trailed only Nebraska in the conference.
- » Danielle Williams and Jordyn Rudd are the first battery (pitcher/catcher combo) in conference history to earn three-straight All-Big Ten selections together.
- » Rudd is the fourth catcher in Big Ten history to earn three First Team honors, joining Diane Pohl (Iowa, 1990-91-92), Monica Schock (Michigan, 2003-04-05), and Samantha Marder (Ohio State, 2007-08-10). She is the only catcher to be named First Team All-Big Ten in her first three full seasons.
- » The Wildcats are 8-5 vs. ranked opponents this season and ranked 11th in RPI.

## 2021 SEASON RECAP

- » Finished 2021 season 30-17, played an all-conference regular season schedule and went 29-15 against Big Ten competition. Head Coach Kate Drohan and Associate Head Coach Caryl Drohan became the program's all-time wins leaders, passing their predecessor Sharon J. Drysdale (who coached at Northwestern for 23 years). The Wildcats qualified for their 14th NCAA Tournament under the Drohans, also marked their sixth NCAA Regional over the past seven NCAA tournaments.

## PLAYER SPOTLIGHTS

### 24 | DANIELLE WILLIAMS | P | SR.

Unanimous Big Ten Pitcher of the Year ... Top-10 finalist this season for USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year, one of 6 pitchers on the list and the only Big Ten player ... 4-0 vs. Pac-12 opponents this season (UCLA, Oregon, Washington, Stanford) ... Tossed a no-hitter vs. Stanford on March 20 (was also her 22nd birthday), marked the second no-hitter of her career ... Has earned a win against seven ranked opponents this season, including complete-game shutouts against #5 Washington, #9 Oregon, and #15 Clemson ... 10 games with 10+ strikeouts already this season ... Set a new career high with 17 strikeouts against Michigan State on March 25, struck out 16 against Michigan in a nine-inning win the following week (April 1) ... Four time Big Ten Pitcher of the Week (3/1, 3/22, 3/28, 4/25) ... Also named NFCA National Pitcher of the Week twice in March (3/1, 3/23) ... Struck out 26 batters in 16.1 innings over the opening weekend, going 2-0 with a save ... Opened last year's 2021 season with a 30.0 inning scoreless streak ... Threw a perfect game against Iowa on April 16, the fifth perfect game in program history ... Named 2019 NFCA Freshman of the Year winner (first-ever Big Ten recipient of the award) ... She has 81 wins, 898 strikeouts, 28 shutouts and a 1.93 ERA in her career ... Her 304 strikeouts this season are the seventh most in a season in program history, closing in on her career-high of 317 (2019) ... One win shy of 30 on the season, would make her the first player in program history to ever earn 30+ wins in multiple seasons (she also had 31 wins as a first-year in 2019) ... Williams has posted a 2.72 ERA and 71 strikeouts in 61.2 career innings pitched in the NCAA Tournament.

### 22 | GRACE NIETO | 2B | FY.

Started every game at second base during her rookie season on her way to being named as one of 11 conference newcomers on the Big Ten All-Freshman team ... Nieto finished the season red hot to elevate her batting average to .336, making her the first NU first-year to hit over .300 in a single season since Jordyn Rudd and Nikki Cuchran did so in 2019 ... Her .336 average is the highest by a Northwestern first-year since Rachel Lewis hit .351 as an All-American in 2018 ... Nieto led the team with a .714 batting average (5-for-7) in the Evanston Regional and has hit .579 (22-for-38) with six stolen bases in the 15 games leading up to the NCAA Super Regional.

### 11 | RACHEL LEWIS | RF | GR.

Big Ten Player of the Year ... Returned for a fifth season ... In each season of her career, Lewis has never struck out more than she has walked (currently 39 BB/25 SO in 2022) ... Leads the Big Ten with 21 home runs, 58 RBI, 64 runs scored, an .855 slugging percentage and a 1.360 OPS ... Lewis became Northwestern's all-time home run leader earlier this season and now sits at 63 career homers (2nd most in Big Ten history) ... In 2021, led the Big Ten in stolen bases (30), finished 3rd in on-base percentage (.492) and 3rd in runs scored (39) on her way to unanimous First-Team All-Big Ten and All-Big Ten Defensive Team honors last season ... She dominated Big Ten opponents in her final season, tying the Big Ten record with 12 home runs in conference play (excluding the extended 2021 conference season), while leading the conference with an incredible 1.000 slugging percentage, 1.540 OPS, 33 RBI, and 30 runs scored ... Homered in four of her last five at-bats during the Purdue series, the sixth and seventh multi-home run games of her career, and the first back-to-back multi-homer games of her career ... Has a career-high 21 home runs this season, 2nd most in a single season in program history-Garland Cooper's program record is 23 (2007) and the Big Ten single-season record is 24 homers (Angela Mexicano, 2008, Illinois) ... 2nd place in program history with 162 walks (Adrienne Monka, 2009-12 in 1st with 190) ... This is Lewis's fourth NCAA Tournament appearance, where she holds a .409 on-base percentage in 65 plate appearances. ... With four hits in the Evanston Regional, Lewis moved into sole possession of sixth place in the Northwestern record book with 217 career hits ... Lewis has played 239 games for the Wildcats, third most in program history. She is eight games from tying Garland Cooper's record of 244 games played ... Her 227 runs scored is second-most in program history. She is 8 runs scored from tying Tammy Williams's program record of 235 runs ... Lewis's 227 runs scored are fourth in B1G history.

### 4 | MAEVE NELSON | SS | SR.

Second-Team All-Big Ten Honoree for the second time in her career (also 2019) ... Started every game of her career (183 games) at shortstop ... Hit six homers in conference play, trailing only her teammate Hannah Cady among Big Ten infielders. Her 1.126 OPS against conference opponents was fifth best among infielders. 28 walks and 12 homers on the year trailed only Lewis for the team lead ... Nelson launched two home runs in the regional opener against Oakland on May 20, her fourth-career multi-homer game.

### 36 | JORDYN RUDD | C | SR.

Leads all Big Ten catchers with 48 RBI this season while hitting .351 (54-for-154) with a 1.001 OPS. She also threw out 14 base stealers this season, most in the Big Ten, on her way to landing on the All-Big Ten defensive team for a second-straight season ... Has struck out only nine times in 154 at bats this season ... Became the fourth catcher in Big Ten history to earn three First Team honors, joining Diane Pohl (Iowa, 1990-91-92), Monica Schock (Michigan, 2003-04-05), and Samantha Marder (Ohio State, 2007-08-10) ... She is the first catcher to be named First Team All-Big Ten in her first three full seasons ... Rudd went 5-for-9 with a double, home run, and seven RBI in the Evanston Regional.

### 8 | SKYLER SHELLMYER | CF | SR.

Collected her second-consecutive All-Big Ten honors, hitting .359 with 21 stolen bases and her first-career home run this year ... Leading the Wildcats in hits for a second straight season, notching 66 in 184 at-bats while scoring 55 runs which ranks second-most on the team behind Rachel Lewis ... Leads the team with 19 multi-hit games this season ... Hit her first-career home run at Ohio State on April 8 after 461 career at-bats.... Started every game of her career, 183 games in the outfield ... Last year, raised her batting average a team-high .132 points (.228 to .360) from 2020 to 2021 ... In the final two games of the Evanston Regional, Shellmyer went 7-for-7 with four stolen bases ... She set career highs with four hits (tied), four runs scored, and three stolen bases in Saturday's game win over McNeese ... Shellmyer has two four-hit games this season, the only Wildcat with a four-hit game this season.

### 31 | NIKKI CUCHRAN | 1B | SR.

Earned her First Team All-Big Ten honors (first all-conference accolades of her career) after posting career-highs with a .363 average (58-for-160), .418 on-base percentage, .581 slugging percentage, eight home runs, and 50 RBI ... Cuchran is a career .419 (18-for-43) hitter in the NCAA Tournament with two home runs.

### 16 | HANNAH CADY | 3B | SO.

Named First Team All-Big Ten in her first full season in the starting lineup ... Hit .378 (37-for-98) over team's last 33 regular season games. Led all Big Ten infielders with seven homers in conference play, ranked 3rd with a 1.162 OPS and posted a .382 batting average (26-for-68) ... Cady went 3-for-7 with a double, three RBI, and three runs scored in the Evanston Regional.
