SUN DEVIL MEN'S HOOPS WELCOMES ST. THOMAS

Arizona State and St. Thomas meet for the first time as ASU returns to Desert Financial Arena

Sun Devil Men's Basketball takes on St. Thomas at Desert Financial Arena on Sunday, Nov. 16 at 6 PM MST. Arizona State (3-1) will face the Tommies for the first time in program history. It is the second part of a double-header with the Sun Devil Women's Basketball team also competing at Desert Financial Arena in the Briann January Classic against SMU. Head Coach Bobby Hurley's team looks to build off their 3-1 start which includes wins over Grand Canyon and Santa Clara away from home.

THE MATCHUP

The Sun Devils remain in the Valley when they return to Desert Financial Arena for the second time to face St. Thomas. This will be the first meeting between the two sides, as St. Thomas joined the Division I ranks prior to the 2021-22 season. The Tommies won 20 games a year ago as members of the Summit League.

HOW TO FOLLOW

Arizona State is back on ESPN+ when they take on St. Thomas, scheduled for a 6 PM MST tip-off with Cronkite alums Braiden Bell and Eliav Gabay on the call. Make sure to listen to Tim Healey and Kyle Dodd on Arizona Sports 98.7 FM (KMVP).

LAST TIME OUT

Arizona State controlled the second half and emerged with a 87-76 win over GCU in a neutral-site matchup on Thursday night at Footprint Center. Behind 21 points from freshman guard Joson Sanon off the bench

along with 18 from senior forward Basheer Jihad, Bobby Hurley secured the 200th career win of his head coaching career.

Three Sun Devils players reached double figures, led by Joson Sanon, who came off the bench and had 21 points while connecting 5-of-7 shots beyond the arc. Basheer Jihad found his rhythm at the free throw line, shooting 9-11 at the line and finishing with 15 points and five rebounds. Alston Mason operated the offense effectively throughout the contest, adding 19 points while dishing out five assists.

DIALED IN FROM DEEP

ASU made 15 three-point field goals in the win over Santa Clara earlier in the year, tied for the third-most three pointers made in a single-game in the Bobby Hurley era. The last time they made 15 three-pointers was at the Pac-12 Tournament against Stanford back on March 9, 2022).

THE GRAND CANYON ARIZONA STATE

Grand Canyon now falls to 131-47 in the state of Arizona since becoming a Division I program (2013-14). Arizona State is responsible for three of those losses. GCU is now 0-3 against the Sun Devils and boast a 131-44 (75%) in other games played in Arizona.

THE JAYDEN QUAINANCE EFFECT

Jayden Quaintance came into tonight's game leading the nation in blocks per game thus far in the season. He added two blocks to his total tonight and had an impact on GCU shooting at the rim. The Lopes finished a putrid 13-for-28 (46%) on layups and 19-for-42 (45%) on shots inside the arc in large part due to Jayden Quaintance's presence down low.

FINDING OUR RHYTHM

The Sun Devils started off the game against Grand Canyon shooting 1-7 from the field and had just four points four minutes into the game, but settled in after that. Arizona State shot 13-for-21 from the field and scored 37 points the rest of the half to take the lead into the break.

BA-SHEER FORCE

In his first two games, Basheer Jihad combined for five points on 1-of-10 shooting. Over his past two games, Jihad has accumulated 40 points on 11-of-19 shooting. He is also 16-for-18 (88.9%) from the free throw line during that span.

JO CAN GO

Freshman Joson Sanon put on a clinic in the win over Grand Canyon. He came off the bench to score a game-high 21 points, making five three-point field goals. His five three-pointers were the most by an ASU true freshman since December 28, 2019, when Jaelen House hit five against Texas Southern. The 21 points are the most by an ASU freshman since Josh Christopher put up 22 against UCLA on January 7, 2021.

HIT THE MARK

The Sun Devils shot 53.7% (29/54) from the field tonight. ASU is 48-4 (.923) when it shoots 50 percent or better from the field under Bobby Hurley.

FAMILY TIES

The Sun Devil Men's Basketball roster features several connections through bloodline. Head Coach Bobby Hurley's son, Bobby Hurley, is a senior guard on the team. Senior guard Alston Mason's father, Alton Mason, played at Arizona State from 1998-2001. Senior guard Jordan Williams cousin is legendary Sun Devil guard James Harden.

THE HURLEY ERA

Bobby Hurley has won 158 games at ASU and is only the third coach in program history to reach the mark.

MILESTONE COMPLETE

Hurley earned the 200th win in his head coaching career between Arizona State and Buffalo in his 12th season at the Division I level. 158 of those wins have come with Sun Devil Men's Basketball. Hurley also earned his 150th career win over Grand Canyon back in 2021.

Arizona State is one of three schools at the NCAA Division I level to have its head men's basketball coach play in the NBA and its head baseball coach play in the MLB.

- So far in 2024, Arizona State has wins over Santa Clara and Grand Canyon away from home and nearly took down No. 4 Gonzaga at their place
- ASU is 23rd in ESPN's Strength of Record metric
- The Sun Devils will eventually play seven of the Top-10 teams in the AP Preseason Top-25 at some point during the 2024-25 campaign
- Big 12 play features single contests against No. 1 Kansas, No. 4 Houston, No. 5 Iowa State, and No. 8 Baylor as well as two showdowns with No. 10 Arizona.
- 2024 NCAA Tournament participants New Mexico and Florida with a possible showdown against St. Mary's or old Pac-12 rival USC at neutral sites also represent significant future challenges

HEAD COACH BOBBY HURLEY



One of the most recognizable names in college basketball history became the 14th men's head coach of the Sun Devil Men's Basketball program, as Arizona State named 1992 NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player Bobby Hurley as the head coach on April 9, 2015. What has followed is aggressive scheduling, lots of fast-paced hoops, playing hard, several big-time wins both home and away and back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for Arizona State for the first time since Byron Scott, Fat Lever and Alton Lister were starring in Tempe (1980-81 to be exact).

In his ten seasons as head coach, Sun Devil Men's Basketball has matched its highest ranking in school history (third in the Associated Press Poll in December of 2017), notched its best two average attendances in history (10,603 in 2017-18 is the ASU record), reached the NCAA Tournament three times, notched its best two non-conference wins in school history (vs. No. 1 Kansas on Dec. 22, 2018 and at No. 2 Kansas on Dec. 10, 2017) and defeated two eventual 2018 No. 1 seeds in a span of a few weeks (Kansas and Xavier).

Following a three-year drought without a First or Second Team Pac-12 All-Conference selection, ASU had at least one in six straight seasons under Hurley (2018-23) and Frankie Collins received Honorable Mention distinction in 2024. Hurley has coached two Pac-12 Sixth Man of the Year winners in addition to the 2019 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year (Lu Dort). Three Sun Devils have been selected to the Pac-12 All-Tournament team and three received All-Defensive Team distinction during Hurley's tenure.

A signature of Hurley's teams have been their successs in close games and ability to erase deficits. Arizona State is 40-20 (.666) in close games (two possessions or less) over the past five seasons. The 40 wins are a Top-10 total in the nation during that span. To take it a step further, ASU is 25-17 in two point or less games under Bobby Hurley. Arizona State has come back to win a game when trailing at halftime 44 times during the Bobby Hurley era. The 44 comeback wins place Arizona State in the Top-15 nationally since 2015-16.
