SCOUTING THE SERIES

Arizona State Sun Devils

After a month-long hiatus, the No. 19 Arizona State hockey team returns to NCAA competition as hosts of the sixth Desert Hockey Classic on Jan. 3-4. The Sun Devils welcome participating schools No. 16 Cornell, Massachusetts (RV), and Robert Morris to Mullett Arena for non-conference play to start the New Year.

The Sun Devils rang in the New Year in ideal fashion: hot on a five-game winning streak, a home sweep of conference foe Minnesota Duluth before the holiday break, and a road sweep of then-No. 1 Denver under their belt. With the break in NCHC play, ASU looks to gain key PairWise points against historically strong East Coast collegiate hockey programs.

Four NCAA conferences are represented in the Desert Hockey Classic. ASU is tied for the lead in the NCHC, Robert Morris is tied for fifth in the Atlantic Hockey America, Cornell is tied fifth in the ECAC, and UMass tied ninth in the Hockey East.

All games of the Desert Hockey Classic will be streamed on NCHC.tv (subscription required). The ASU games will play on the airwaves of FoxSports910 with Tyler Paley and Alex Coil.

SUN DEVIL NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

- -- In Friday night's 5-3 victory, the ASU offense was bolstered by goals from five different skaters who helped nab three conference points from Minnesota Duluth. Dylan Jackson scored the game-winning goal, his second of the season.
- -- Saturday's showdown extended into overtime after goals from Dylan Jackson and Ryan Kirwan couldn't topple UMD's two. Kyle Smolen broke a scoring spell that spanned 13 games with the game-winner in three-on-three overtime. As a rookie last year, he tallied seven goals including two clutch game-winners.
- -- Luke Pavicich made his sixth and seventh consecutive starts as the No. 1 goaltender on the ASU roster against the Bulldogs.
- -- The twins, Ty and Dylan Jackson, let the twin telepathy fly against the Bulldogs. Together, they combined for seven points in the series. Both scored a goal and tallied an assist on Friday before continuing to cook on Saturday as Dylan put up another one goal, one assist night and Ty tallied an assist.

SERIES HISTORY VS. RMU (4-0-0)

The two programs first met in 2019-20, the season that was ultimately cut short due to COVID-19. ASU swept RMU at Oceanside Ice Arena in what became part of a seven-game winning streak for the Sun Devils who contended for an NCAA Tournament bid for the second-straight year. Three years later, the Sun Devils returned the travel favor with a trip to Pittsburgh to meet the Colonials on their home ice. Between those two meetings, RMU had its program cut (due to COVID) and reinstated and ASU had its new facility, Mullett Arena, built, opened, and played-in for two seasons. At RMU, the Sun Devils extended their winning record with 4-1 and 8-3 victories.

LAST MEETING VS. COLONIALS In Saturday night's 4-1 victory, Matthew Kopperud shined on the power play, scoring two goals. Kopperud's performance boasted him to the title of the nation's leading power play goal scorer with eight at that point in the 2023-24 season. ASU's victory was supported by Jackson Niedermayer and Ty Murchison's first goals of the season. The Sun Devils put up 43 shots on goal while holding the Colonials to less than 10 shots in each of the first two periods.

In game two of the series in Pittsburgh, the offense was firing on cylinders as ASU collected a dominant 8-3 win over RMU. Team

captain Tyler Gratton tallied his first career hat trick while alternate captain Lukas Sillinger issued a five-point night to reach 100 career points. His 26 points this season ranks third among all NCAA skaters at that point in the 2023-24 season. The road sweep was ASU's first since the 2021-22 season. ASU's 56 shots on goal is a new single game program record. The previous record was held at 53 shots on goal. ASU's eight goals ties the program record for most goals scored in a game.

THIRD LINE MAGIC

The line centered by Shlaine and flanked by Ryan Alexander and Kyle Smolen controls 67 percent of ASU chances this season. The line combines for 30 points.

PAVICICH PUTS UP HOT MONTH Luke Pavicich has made seven consecutive starts for the Sun Devils and boasts a 5-2-0 record in that span. His overall record in 2024-25 is 6-4-0. He made 111 saves in the month of November, including against two top-20 ranked teams. The netminder

boasts a 2.29 goals against average and .919 save percentage.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Twins Ty and Dylan Jackson signed off of 2024 with a venegance. The pair combined for seven points in the series against Minnesota Duluth to close out the first half of the season. Dylan earned a four-point weekend with one goal and one assist in each game. Ty nearly carbon copied his brother with a goal on Friday night and assists in each game. Dylan's goal on Friday night was credited as the game-winner. Dylan and Ty are the team's fifth and sixth top point scorers.

NHL DEVILS

Joey Daccord signed a five-year, \$25 million contract with the Seattle Kraken on Wednesday. It has an average annual value of \$5 million and begins next season. The 28-year-old goalie could have been an unrestricted free agent after this season. He's in his second full season in the NHL after going 19-18-11 with a 2.46 goalsagainst average, .916 save percentage and three shutouts in 50 games (46 starts) for Seattle in 2023-24.

HEAD COACH GREG POWERS

Coach Powers enters his tenth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2024-25, and his 17th overall at the helm at ASU. He was a finalist for the 2019 and 2020 Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the Division I Coach of the Year. Coach Powers was also named the 2018-19 Frank Kush Sun Devil Coach of the Year, as voted on by the 26 head coaches at Arizona State. On July 7, 2022, Arizona State University and Greg Powers agreed to a five-year contract extension through the 2026-27 season. In 2023-24, Powers led the Sun Devils to a program record 24 wins on the season. Matthew Kopperud finished as an NCAA statistical leader with 17 power play goals. A true Sun Devil coached by Powers all four years of his NCAA career, Kopperud completed his time at ASU as the fourth-best career power play scorer in NCAA history with 41 through his four years in college. Lukas Sillinger also topped the charts in 2023-24 as he set the ASU program record in single season points (48). In the final year of Oceanside Arena, Powers coached ASU to five-straight wins versus USCHO.com Top-20 opponents for the first time in program history (the previous record for consecutive wins against ranked opponents was three-straight games). In 2021-22, the team boasted three of the top-10 scorers in the nation in Colin Theisen, Matthew Kopperud and Josh Doan. ASU scored 116 goals in 35 games for a 3.31 goals per game average, ranked No. 10 in the country. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their first-ever ACHA Division I National Championship. Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter

Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.

A HOME IN THE DESERT

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, 2020, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received for the
 commencement of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve as the future home for Sun
 Devil men's ice hockey and wrestling. This project continues the development of the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado
 Parkway on the east side of Packard Drive, immediately north of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction began in January 2021 and recieved its certificate of occupancy on Friday, September 30, 2022.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the north side of the arena.
 Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
- On February 14, 2022, ASU and the NHL's Arizona Coyotes formed the first agreement of its kind between a college and NHL team in 100 years. The last time an NCAA college team and an NHL team shared an arena was the Boston Bruins and Boston University from 1924-28 at Boston Arena, now known as Matthews Arena. Other improvements will now be made, at the Coyotes' expense, to prepare the arena to temporarily house Coyotes home games. These improvements include constructing coaches' rooms, equipment rooms, technology and other aspects of the new ASU arena according to NHL standards. The added cost is up to \$30 million, which will be paid in advance by the Coyotes.
- The 5,000-seat venue is managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for Mullett Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- · A 942-seat student section occupies the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.
