## Gabi Rennie - 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup

Sun Devil Soccer's Gabi Rennie did not have an ordinary summer. On June 29, New Zealand women's soccer head coach Jitka Klimková named her 23-person squad for the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup which included Rennie.

The New Zealander is the second Sun Devil Soccer player in history to be named to her country's FIFA World Cup roster. Amy LePeilbet (2000-2003) won a silver medal at the 2011 Women's World Cup in Germany with the United States Women's National Team.

"This is a home World Cup, which is never going to happen again in my lifetime, so to be a part of it as a player is pretty surreal. I'm definitely letting myself enjoy that and letting that pressure come in because I think it is a privilege to have that good kind of pressure," says Rennie.

The Ferns opened up their Group Stage against Norway on July 20 with a 1-0 victory. It was the first time in the country's history that they have won a FIFA World Cup game (men's or women's). Rennie was a part of the one in a life time experience as she subbed in at the 93' for her first ever appearance at the World Cup.

In the final group stage game, Rennie played for approximately 17 minutes against Switzerland before the Ferns were eliminated from the 2023 World Cup.

"It is an incredible achievement to play for your country, but to represent them in a World Cup that is hosted in your home must feel like nothing else on Earth," Sun Devil head coach Graham Winkworth said. "'I am so proud of Gabi. We were cheering her on like crazy during the tournament, and I know all of Arizona State was, too."



## Men's Swim and Dive Place Second at NCAA Championships For Highest Finish Ever

The Sun Devil Men put a stamp on their incredible 2022-23 season by finishing second at the NCAA Swimming & Diving Championships at the Jean K. Freeman Aquatic Center to secure the best national finish in school history. The Sun Devils had never finished better than sixth at the national championships. Their two best showings, both sixth-place efforts, came in 1982 and 2022. They scored just 236 points at last year's championship, a number they cleared after the 10th event in 2023. The Sun Devils were brilliant all week from the jump, beginning with a pair of second-place relays in the opening night and closing it with 10 top-15 finishes on the final night, including the third individual title from Léon Marchand.



## Bob Bowman Earns Frank Kush Award for 2022-23

In the middle of June, every Sun Devil head coach casts their vote for the Sun Devil Coach of the Year in honor of Frank Kush.

The award – presented around the anniversary of Coach Kush's passing (June 22, 2017) – is one way for each coach to recognize a peer that impressed them the most. There are no true guidelines for this honor; coaches can nominate someone who earned any honors, a coach who made an impression in their first year, or simply the nicest coach in the building. Once the nominations are in, one Sun Devil coach earns what one can consider the ultimate show of respect: an award from their peers in the 26-sport department.

This year's winner is a head coach of a sport that led his men's team to the program's first Pac-12 Championship and a second-place finish at the NCAA Swimming and Dive Championships in Minneapolis.

Swim head coach Bob Bowman will enter his eighth season with Arizona State in 2023-24 as the Frank Kush award winner. In addition to guiding the men's team to their finishes in the postseason, the Sun Devil men earned the No. 1 ranking in the nation by the CSCAA for the first time in program history back in mid-December. The Sun Devil women were terrific down the stretch to close out the '22-23 regular season as they won three of their final four dual meets and placed fifth at the Pac-12 Championships.

## Get to Know Coach Dillingham

Sun Devil head coach Kenny Dillingham at age 33 is the youngest head coach in FBS. He's also the first Arizona State alum to be named head coach of the football program.

Throughout his coaching tenure the Scottsdale native has coached four NFL draft picks, an All-American and 11 All-Conference Selections prior to joining ASU. He has been a part of six bowl games, two with the Sun Devils as an offensive assistant.

Coach Dillingham served as an offensive assistant in 2014-15, which in 2014 the Sun Devils ranked 13th in the nation with 34 touchdowns and 5,750 total yards.

Under Dillingham's offensive mind, it has brought success wherever he's been, with his first stint with Memphis, he coordinated the Tigers offense in 2018 with 7,324 total yards of total offense and 3,919 rushing yards, ranking 4th in the nation.

At Auburn in 2019, he helped the Tigers to a 9-3 record and an Outback Bowl appearance, including scoring 48-points in a win over arch-rival No. 5 Alabama.

For two seasons at Florida State, he coordinated multiple offensive schemes to fit many different quarterbacks due to injuries. In 2021, the Seminole offense finished 18th nationally in plays for 60-plus yards (6) and converted their final 32 trips in the red zone into points, making it the second longest streak in the nation in 2021.

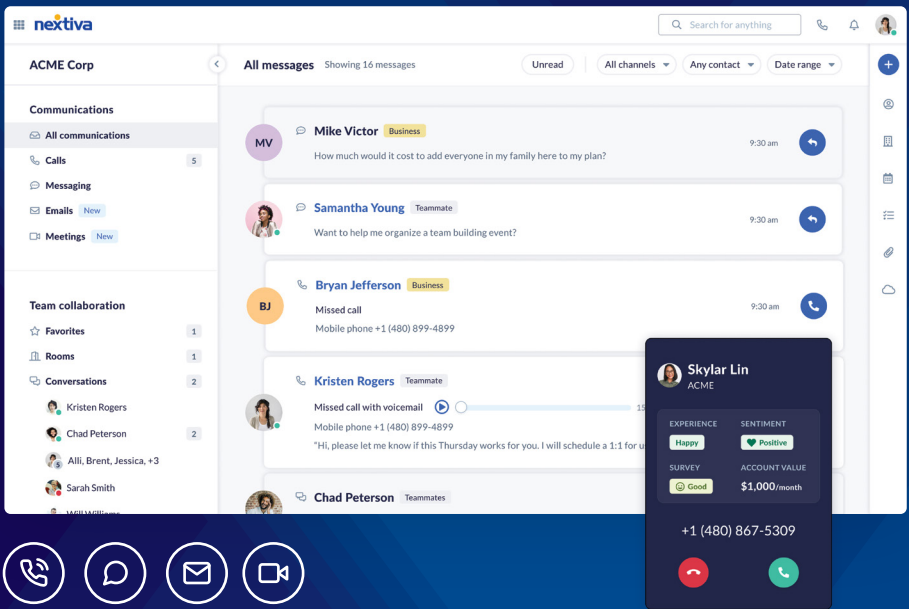
## ASU's Model for the New American University

# Gameday Information

## Mountain America Stadium

### **Banners/Signs**

Banners and signs cannot be hung over any existing signage, block the view of another guest, or contain any advertisements or profanities. Poles of any kind or size are not allowed in Mountain America Stadium.

### **Cameras/Photography**

Fans are welcome to bring personal cameras less than 6" and do not have a detachable lens into Mountain America Stadium. However, flash photography, monopods, tripods, and selfie sticks are not permitted in the stadium. Professional photography/cameras are not allowed in the stadium without a media credential.

### **Concessions**

Multiple concession stands are located on all levels throughout Mountain America Stadium. All stands offer a variety of food and beverage items. Some of the specialty concessions offered for the 2023 season include Chick-fil-A, Cold Beers & Cheeseburgers, Kona Ice, Someburros, 505 Southwestern Nacho Cantina and Venezia's Pizza.

### **Elevators**

Elevator access is limited throughout Mountain America Stadium. Individuals with specific needs for elevator access to seating areas should contact Guest Relations for more information at (480) 965-3933.

### **First Aid**

The AMR First Aid Stations are staffed by registered nurses and physicians and are located behind the south end zone, the northwest corner of the main concourse (behind section 12), the southwest end of the upper deck (behind section 201), and on the east side. Paramedics are available during all football games and regularly patrol the stadium.

### **Guest Assistance Center**

There are Guest Assistance Centers located inside Mountain America Stadium. They are located just inside the Southwest Gate and on the main concourse level and upper deck on the west and east sides. Guest relations representatives are available to assist with directions, seating issues, and any other questions or comments you may have.

### **Lost Children**

Parents of lost children should contact the nearest game management staff member, including ushers and security, regarding their lost child. They may also go to the Mountain America Stadium Police Station located behind Section 12 on the concourse level for assistance or text SPARKY 69050. Please include your location (seat/section number) and issue (lost child).

### **Lost and Found**

Mountain America Stadium

provides lost and found services for its guests located at the Police Station behind Section 12 on the concourse. Found items should be taken to this location or given to a game day staff member. Lost and found items will be logged and kept for two weeks. Unclaimed items will be donated to charity after the two-week holding period. To check on or claim a lost and found item following football games, please call (480) 965-3933.

### **Police**

The Mountain America Stadium Police Station is located on the concourse behind Section 12.

### **Prohibited Items**

For the safety and security of our guests, all prohibited items must be returned to the owner's vehicle or discarded prior to entry. The following items are prohibited inside Mountain America Stadium and are causes for removal. No refunds:

- Soft or hard sided coolers, ice chests
- Glass or metal containers
- Outside beverages
- Tortillas

- Use of tobacco products, including e-cigarettes and smokeless cigarettes/tobacco

There are restrooms located throughout Mountain America Stadium. Baby changing tables are available in men's and women's restrooms throughout the stadium. There are family restrooms located throughout the stadium on the main concourse and behind sections 5, 9, and 17.

On August 1, 2013, ASU joined more than 800 universities and colleges nationwide in becoming a tobacco-free campus. Tobacco products are not permitted in Mountain America Stadium, including e-cigarettes and smokeless cigarettes/tobacco. ## Super Bowl Sun Devils

The Sun Devils have had some great history with the Super Bowl.

Arizona State All-American Terrell Suggs was a part of the Kansas City Chiefs Super Bowl LIV in February of 2020, giving him a pair of NFL titles after previously earning a Super Bowl ring with the Baltimore Ravens back in 2013.

With Suggs helping lead Kansas City to a victory on the biggest stage in professional sports, the Chiefs became the 32nd Super Bowl-winning team to feature a Sun Devil. An incredible 34 Super Bowl rings have been earned by Sun Devils, two of them on the hand of Terrell Suggs. Suggs becomes just the sixth Sun Devil in history to win two or more Super Bowls, joining elite company: Darren Woodson (1993, 1994, & 1995 Cowboys), Mike Richardson (1986 Bears, 1990 49ers), Jim Jeffcoat (1993 & 1994 Cowboys), Grey Ruggamer (2002 Patriots, 2008 Giants), and Marvel Smith (2006 & 2009 Steelers).

# HISTORY and TRADITIONS



## This is Sun Devil Football

### Territorial Cup

Thanks to a historic find in a church basement several years ago, Arizona State University and the University of Arizona can now claim the oldest intercollegiate rivalry trophy in the nation. The Territorial Championship Cup®, which has been registered with the NCAA, was first presented to Tempe Normal School (now ASU) on Nov. 30, 1899, following an 11-2 victory over the University of Arizona at Tucson's Carillo Gardens Field. The Territorial Cup® was lost for a time and was discovered years ago in the basement of a church that was being demolished. According to the NCAA, the previous oldest trophy was the Michigan/Minnesota Little Brown Jug which dates back to 1909.

### The Mascot

On Nov. 8, 1946, the students of Arizona State College voted 816 to 196 in favor of changing the school's nickname from the Bulldogs

to the Sun Devils. Phoenix attorney Walter E. Craig contacted a former classmate, Berk Anthony, who was an artist employed by Walt Disney Studios. Anthony designed the Sun Devil free of charge.

### The Gear

Since July 2015, Sun Devil Athletics has partnered with adidas with a goal of advancing the brand, including the use of iconic logos like the Pitchfork as well as historic logos like Sparky and the interlocking AS. The partnership with adidas set the standard for apparel contracts by creating provisions to adapt for the addition of sports and dollars allocated towards marketing and facility upgrades. The company has also shown its investment in Sun Devil student-athletes, giving them the opportunity to test and provide feedback on its latest performance gear prior to release.

Mountain America Stadium – the only college football stadium located between two mountains. Just to the west of Mountain America Stadium is "A" Mountain. Originally installed on Tempe Butte in 1918, the letter has been changed from a "T" to an "N" to the "A" of today as the name



of the school has changed. In 1952, a bomb destroyed the letter, but in 1955, the present "A", which stands 60 feet tall, was built using reinforced steel and poured concrete.

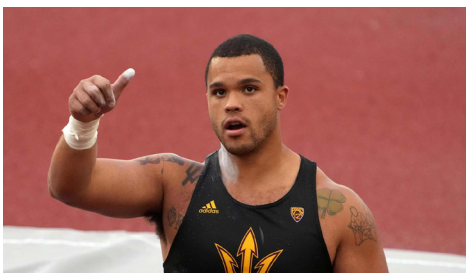

### Follow the Sun Devils on the Radio

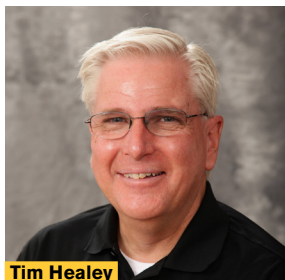

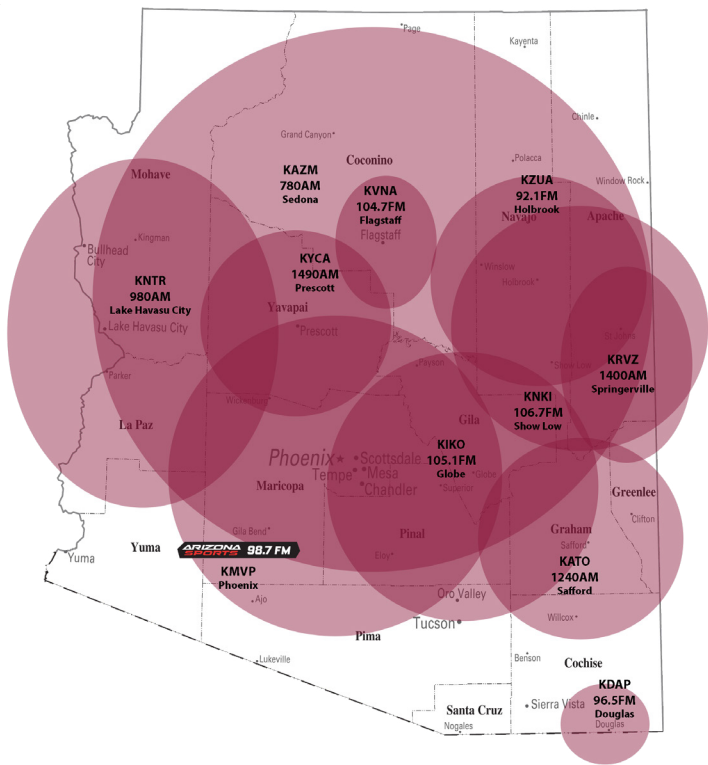
