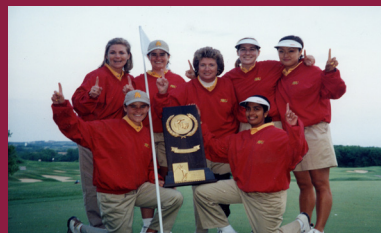
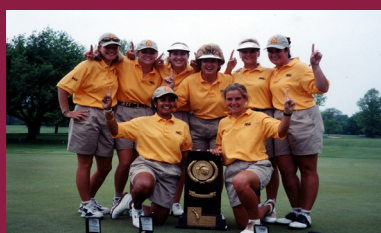

Arizona State Women's Golf has done something unmatched by any other NCAA Division I women's golf team - the Sun Devils have won eight National Championships, including three straight, five in six years, and six within nine years (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1998, 2009, 2017).

The Sun Devils advanced to NCAA Regionals for the 27th consecutive year this season (one of 9 teams to appear each of the 27 years). By virtue of their 5th-place finish, ASU earned a berth in their 35th NCAA Championships at Blessings Golf Club.

Arizona State Notes

- For the third consecutive year and 35th time overall, the Sun Devil Women's Golf team advances to the NCAA Championship thanks to their fifth-place finish at the Norman Regional.
- The Sun Devils have enjoyed their share of success on the sports' biggest stage, capturing a nation-leading eight National Championships.
- Head Coach Missy Farr-Kaye lead her team to the 2017 National Title in just her second season in charge, with Monica Vaughn earning Individual Medalist honors.
- Pac-12 Champion Olivia Mehaffey is playing some of her best golf of her career, as two of her three victories this season have come in the past two tournaments.
- Mehaffey became the eighth Sun Devil to win at least a share of Individual Medalist honors at a Regional, tying Oklahoma's Kaitlin Milligan for the top spot (-8) at the Norman Regional.
- For the second consecutive season, Mehaffey was named to the ANNIKA Award Watch List, presented to the Most Outstanding Collegiate Female Golfer.
- Head coach Missy Farr-Kaye has had success in any role that she has filled as part of the Sun Devil Women's Golf program, winning a national championship at ASU as a player (1990), assistant coach (2009), and head coach (2017).
- A testament to the strength of the Pac-12 Conference, 9 of 11 Pac-12 teams earned a spot in NCAA Regionals this season with six advancing to Fayetteville.

Head coach Missy Farr-Kaye and assistant coach Michelle Estill, both former Sun Devils, played under legendary head coach Linda Vollstedt at Arizona State. The five-time National Coach of the Year retired from ASU in June 2001 after leading the Sun Devils to six NCAA championships in the 1990's.

- Missy Farr-Kaye was named the 10th head coach of the Arizona State Women's Golf team on June 26, 2015
- Led the Sun Devils to their nation-leading eighth NCAA Championship in 2017 behind individual medalist Monica Vaughn
- 2017 National Coach of the Year, Regional COY, and Pac-12 COY
- Spent 13 seasons as an assistant coach then associate head coach of the ASU women's golf program under Melissa Luellen before the promotion
- Farr-Kaye returned the Sun Devils to the NCAA Regionals for the third straight year, their 27th consecutive appearance, while ASU makes their 35th appearance at Nationals
- A Phoenix-area native, she was a member of ASU's first NCAA Title team as a senior in 1990 under legendary head coach Linda Vollstedt
- Farr-Kaye graduated from ASU in 1990 with a degree in Organizational Communications

- Returned to her alma mater in November 2016, joining former teammate Farr-Kaye's staff as an assistant coach
- Served as an Assistant Coach in 2017 during the Sun Devils run to their eighth National Championship
- Also played under legendary head coach Linda Vollstedt during her ASU career (86-89)
- Was the NCAA Championship runner-up in 1986
- Graduated from ASU with a B.S. in Business Management in 1989
- 1991 LPGA Rolex Rookie of the Year and had four top-20 finishes the following year after ASU
- LPGA playing member from 1991-2006, also serving on the LPGA Board of Directors and Executive Committee (1996-98) as President (1998)
- Received Budget Service Award for the LPGA Urban Youth Pen Pal Program in 1994

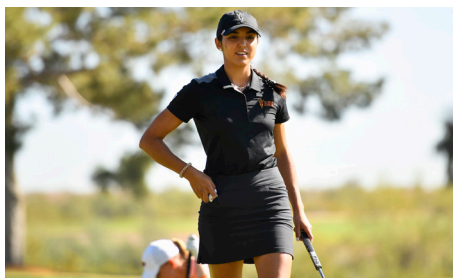

Olivia Mehaffey (Jr./Belfast, Ireland)

- Currently ranked No. 7 in Golfstat's NCAA Individual Rankings; sits at No. 16 in the Women's World Amateur Golf Rankings as of May 8th
- 2019 Pac-12 Individual Champion; 2019 Norman Regional Co-Medalist
- Named one of ten finalists for the 2019 ANNIKA Award
- Two-time Pac-12 First Team All-Conference (2017, 2018)
- Took home three individual titles this season (two in a row), placing in the Top-10 six times this season



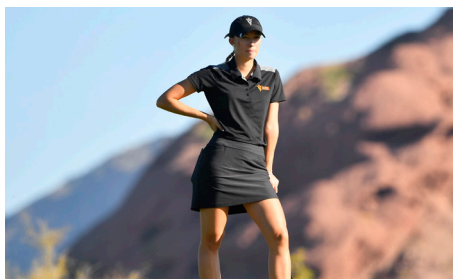
Raquel Olmos (So./Torre-Pacheco, Murcia, Spain)

- Played brilliant golf at the Windy City Collegiate Classic (Oct. 1-2), earning a second-place finish by shooting a 207 (-9)
- Competed in 22 of 23 tournaments during her two-year career
- Seven Top-20 finishes this season, giving her 11 as a Sun Devil
- Shot a hole-in-one on the 13th hole in round 2 of the Windy City Collegiate Classic
- Three rounds in the 60s to her name in 2018-19



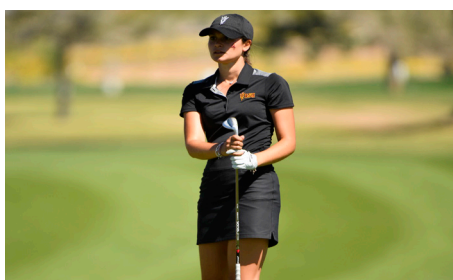
Madison Kerley (Sr./Phoenix, Ariz.)

- Adds plenty of experience to the Sun Devil lineup, competing in 38 tournaments during her four-year career
- A pair of Top-20 and five Top-30 finishes to her name in 2018-19
- Recorded her best finish of the season at the Wildcat Invitational, helping lead the Sun Devils to the team title by finishing seventh individually
- Ten career Top-20 finishes to go with seven career rounds in the 60s
- Enjoyed her best round of the season (69) at the Stanford Intercollegiate



Alexandra Forsterling (Fr./Berlin, Germany)

- A consistent part of the Sun Devils lineup, playing in all 11 events to this point of the season
- Shown flashes of improvement throughout her first season in Tempe, finishing in the Top-20 in three of her last five tournaments
- Put together three rounds in the 60's this season
- Finished tied for 16th in her first Pac-12 Championships
- Rose 16 spots on the final day of the Norman Regional to finish T-27th



Alessandra Fanali (Fr./Fiuggi, Italy)

- Appeared in seven tournaments this season, continuing to show improvement as the year goes on
- Set the tone for an eventual Sun Devil victory with a career-best 67 (-5) during the opening round at the Wildcat Invitational (Mar. 11-12)
- A major factor in Arizona State's move into third place on the final day of the 2019 Pac-12 Championships, posting a 69 (-2) in her final round
- No. 49 in the Women's World Amateur Golf Rankings as of May 8th
