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No. 9 @ASUWrestling Welcomes MMA Stars, 1988 NCAA Title Team to Tempe

TEMPE, Ariz.— This weekend will be a special weekend for No. 9 Arizona State wrestling as two important and significant groups will be welcomed back to Tempe.

On Friday night, the Sun Devils host Stanford (8 pm MT) in their Pac-12 opener, which will serve as the team's annual MMA Night, honoring MMA stars from ASU and beyond.

On Saturday afternoon, the 1988 NCAA Championship team returns home to celebrate the 30th anniversary of the title in a match vs. Oregon State (1:30 pm MT). Following Saturday's match, the ASU Wrestling Legends celebration will take place at Tempe Mission Palms at 4 pm MT with appetizers, raffles, a cash bar, and tributes to the storied Sun Devil team. ARIZONA STATE WINS 38TH ANNUAL VIRGINIA DUALS

After earning their first top-3 finish since 1997 in 2017, the Sun Devils improved further in 2018, winning their first-ever Virginia Duals, the 38th annual version of the tournament.

ASU won the James River Pool with a 35-3 win vs. Virginia and a 25-13 win vs. Iowa State before defeating No. 11 Northern Iowa, 24-16, in the semifinals and reigning champion No. 9 Virginia Tech, 21-15, in the finals.

Zahid Valencia was named Most Outstanding Wrestler for the second straight season at the tournament.

SUN DEVILS HAVE FIVE PLACERS AT MIDLANDS

Zahid Valencia continued his undefeated sophomore campaign with his second consecutive title at Midland's 55th annual Championships. Five placewinners for the team – Z. Valencia (1st), Josh Shields (2nd), Tanner Hall (2nd), Anthony Valencia (4th), Jason Tsirtsis (5th) – was the most for the Sun Devils since 1997 when they had six and third-most all-time. Tsirtsis capped his Midlands career as a six-time placewinner. Z. Valencia earned the third most points for his team amongst the field (28 pts) while Oliver Pierce had the second most pins in the least time (3/7:34). Valencia became the 15th individual title winner at Midlands for ASU and just the third to win multiple titles.

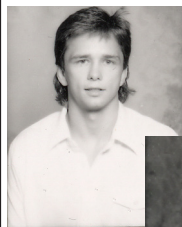

In 1988, Arizona State wrestling, led by legendary head coach Bobby Douglas, did something that no other program west of the Rocky Mountains had done before, or has done since: **brought home the NCAA wrestling trophy.**

With seven All-Americans--including one national runner-up in team captain Mike Davies--the Sun Devils amassed 93 points, beating out the previous year's champion and its runner up, Iowa State and Iowa.

Seven All-Americans for ASU was the second-most in one season of all-time (8 in 1990).

Currently, three members of the championship team, along with its head coach, have been inducted into the Arizona State University Athletics Hall of Fame: Bobby Douglas, Mike Davies, Zeke Jones, and Dan St. John.

Individual secondary to ASU team

AMES, Iowa — Mike Davies was sitting with his fiancée in the upper balcony of Iowa State's Hilton Coliseum on Saturday when Rod Severn stepped on to the mat.

In a few hours, Davies would be wrestling Mark Coleman of Ohio State in the 190-pound final of the NCAA wrestling championships. Davies, a senior, had been waiting four years for the opportunity to win an NCAA title.

"I was nervous and anxious waiting for my match," Davies said. "It's what I've been shooting at for so long. Yet, when I saw Rod walk out there on the mat, all my thoughts drifted toward him."

"He had lost his semifinal match on Friday, and he told me in our hotel room later that night how bad he felt. He said he felt like he let the team down."

"I wanted him to win so bad. Then when he did, and I saw the rest of the (Arizona State team) carry him off that mat in their arms, I almost started crying."

Davies didn't, but later, after he was beaten by Coleman, he did. His nose was caked with dried blood and tears were running down his cheeks. He talked for several minutes with his head lowered. Finally, he looked up.

"I fell short of my one ultimate goal, but the team didn't," Davies said. "We're the national champions, a dream come true for our team. We set this goal for ourselves at the beginning of the season, and when nobody thought we could do it, we did."

The Devils did it with a late flurry in Saturday's consolation matches, which enabled them to surpass Iowa and win their first wrestling title.

Severn's heavyweight match with Mark Sindlinger of Iowa was crucial. Had Severn lost, Iowa would have gone into Saturday night's championship finals down 7½ points instead of 11½.

It didn't matter. The Hawkeyes could only slice four points into the deficit.

However, the ASU wrestlers surround Severn's mat didn't know that.

The only thing they knew was a Severn victory would virtually clinch the title.

"I was confident in Rod because he stays in shape. I knew he would be fit," said Tommy Ortiz, who finished fourth in the 142-pound division. "That's the way it turned out, too. It was (Iowa coach Dan Gable's) guy that quit."

Jim Gressley, who won a third-place medal, said he was confident.

"I was confident in Rod because we wrestle with each other in practice, and I know how good he is," Gressley said. "At the same time, I was nervous. It was kind of scary watching him out there, knowing how much a win by him would mean to the team."

"It was in our hearts to come back like we did. We all wanted to help out as much as we could and win as many points as we could. Every little bit helped, as you could tell."

Severn said he heard the yell from the rest of the Devils standing near his mat. The encouragement, he said, was like a shot of adrenaline.

"I was so tired, but when I heard them screaming, I couldn't help but go on," Severn said. "Besides, they probably would have beaten me anyway, so I would have lost again."

Perhaps the most unusual hero of Saturday was senior Chip Park. Park had lost a second-round match on Thursday. For a third-place finish, he had to win six straight matches.

He did it all with a left leggy damaged that Arizona State coach Bobby Douglas suggested at the beginning of the season that Park never again wrestle.

"(ASU assistant trainer) told me now that the season is over I should have reconstructive surgery on it," Park said. "I guess I will."

"But I couldn't do it until this season was over. We've been trying to win this thing for so long, and I knew we had a chance to do it this year. I couldn't let that opportunity slip by."

"I know people thought our chances didn't look good on Friday, but they didn't know this team. It's like when I lost on Thursday. When I lose, it's like I've defeated the purpose of why I'm out here."

Arizona St. rallies from 4th to claim NCAA mat crown

AMES, Iowa (AP) — Arizona State clinched its first NCAA wrestling title Saturday after a surprising surge from fourth to first place with a string of consolation-round victories.

The team's rally surprised even Sun Devils Coach Bobby Douglas, who said Friday night that the best his team could finish was second or third.

"I wasn't real optimistic about our chances," Douglas said. "I forgot all about the team title last night. I told the kids it was an individual effort now."

Arizona State's victory was the first for a non-Iowa team since 1974. Iowa and Iowa State have won every team title since Oklahoma edged Michigan by 2½ points in 1974. Arizona State's best finish previously was fifth in 1980.

Arizona State qualified seven wrestlers for the meet, seeded all seven, and all seven made all-American by finishing in the top eight.

Iowa had a chance to derail Arizona State by getting victories from the three wrestlers the Hawkeyes placed in the first round, but the Hawkeyes' Brad Penrith lost the first match of the night on a 5-4 riding-time decision to Jim Martin of Penn State.

Arizona State had 66 points to Iowa's 76.5 going into Saturday's consolation round. Iowa State was second with 69.25 points, and Oklahoma State was third with 58 points.

The Sun Devils made their move in

the consolation semifinals, getting four wrestlers into position to go for third place and two in line to go for fifth place, picking up 18.5 points. Iowa got only five in the consolation round.

Arizona State won three of the third-place matches with Chip Park posting a 7-2 decision over Craig Walters of Wyoming at 126 pounds, Jim Gressley getting a 19-10 major decision over Eric Osborne of Cal-Poly at 167 and Dan St. John winning at 158.

The Sun Devils came out with 93 points to Iowa's 81.5, Iowa State's 79.75, Oklahoma State's 76.5, Penn State's 67.5 and Michigan's 62.5.

St. John, third-seeded at 158 pounds, won a key 3-2 decision over fourth-seeded John Heffernan of Iowa in a third-place match.

"We're both very hard to score on," St. John said. "It came down to conditioning."

St. John said he was out to solidify his team's lead. "All the way," St. John said. "Them down. Us up."

Iowa was hurt by having only two wrestlers in the consolation round.

Arizona State heavyweight Rod Severn also scored an important 1-0 consolation-round victory over Mark Sindlinger of Iowa.

Severn said his teammates' cheering put him over the top. "The only reason I held on was those guys screaming at me on the edge," he said.

Head Coach Zeke Jones



The seventh coach in ASU wrestling history, Zeke Jones was hired in April 2014 and had his contract renewed in October 2016.

Jones led his alma mater to its 17th Pac-10/12 championship (19th conference title including two Western Athletic Conference titles) in 2017 behind five individual champions in Josh Maruca (149), Josh Shields (157), Anthony Valencia (165), Zahid Valencia (174), and Tanner Hall (HWT).

In his first season with the Sun Devils, Jones led ASU to a second-place finish at the Pac-12 Championships, the highest finish since 2006, and coached six wrestlers to the 2015 NCAA Wrestling Championships including All-American Blake Stauffer (184). In 2016, the Sun Devils again finished second as a team at Pac-12's and returned six individuals to the NCAA championships.

An Olympic silver medalist for the United States, Jones was the 1991 World Champion at 52kg, a four-time World Cup Champion, and coached the United States' Olympians in the 1996, 2000, 2004, and 2012 Olympic Games.

A member of ASU's 1988 NCAA Wrestling Championship team, Jones was a three-time All-American and Pac-10 Champion for the Sun Devils. A national runner-up at 118, Jones sits at No. 4 in ASU's career record book in both overall victories (134) and dual victories (59). He also holds the school record for dual match victories in a season with 22 during the 1989-90 campaign.

As Olympic head coach, Jones' athletes earned two gold medal and one bronze at the London games in 2012. His athletes in the 2004 Athens games, where he was the freestyle coach, earned a gold and two silvers.

In the four World Championships during Jones' tenure, the USA placed third in 2011, fifth in 2013, and seventh in 2009. He also led the USA to five individual World Champion medals, including two-time world champion Jordan Burroughs.

The United States also competed in three Freestyle World Cups during the Jones era, placing third in 2012 and 2013, and sixth in 2010. During the Jones era, the USA won eight Junior World medals, five University World medals, and four Cadet World medals.

Jones came to USA Wrestling after coaching at the University of Pennsylvania from 2005-07, where he amassed a record of 33-17-1. Following the 2006 campaign that saw an NCAA champion, two All-Americans, two Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association (EIWA) champions, and a third-place finish at the EIWA Championships, Amateur Wrestling News named Jones the Rookie Head Coach of the Year.

Prior to coaching at Penn, he served on the coaching staffs at West Virginia, ASU, and Bloomsburg University. Jones coached teams that have finished in the NCAA Final Four twice, in the top-10 four times, and won six conference team championships. Individually, his wrestlers have won six NCAA titles, eight NCAA finalists, 36 individual conference champions, 29 All-Americans, 74 NCAA Qualifiers, and 11 wrestlers have competed in the NWCA All-Star Meet.

Originally from Ann Arbor, Mich., Jones is a Distinguished Member of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame, member of the Arizona State University Hall of Fame, and the Michigan Wrestling Hall of Fame.

ASU President Michael Crow on Zeke Jones: "I said to Ray [Anderson], either we're going to have a wrestling team that's going to compete for national championships or we're not going to have a wrestling team. So you need to find the best person in the world to be our coach. Zeke Jones is our coach: Multi-time world champion in wrestling, NCAA champion, ASU graduate, and at the time Ray hired him, sitting Olympic coach for the United States Olympic Team in wrestling, former coach at the University of Pennsylvania. That is the person, the personage, the kind of character that we are looking for."

ASU Vice President for University Athletics/Athletics Director Ray Anderson on Zeke Jones: "It is important we retain our high-caliber coaching hires and, without a doubt, Coach Jones has made a huge impact in his three years at Arizona State. He consistently demands high academic commitment and athletic dedication from our student-athletes and he and his staff worked tirelessly to recruit one of the top-rated recruiting classes in college wrestling history."

As a team, Arizona State had the second most pins in the least time (9/25:39) and the second most pins/tech falls combined in the least time (11/35:00). ASU's fourth-place finish marks their second top-10 finish since 2001 (also in 2016) and eighth all-time top-five finish (also: 1984, 1987, 1988, 1989, 1996, 1997, 2016) as well as the fourth time in history the Sun Devils have had back-to-back top-5 finishes.

ZAHID VALENCIA WINS SECOND STRAIGHT CKLV

Zahid Valencia was named Most Outstanding Wrestler of the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational (Dec. 1-2) for going 6-0 to win the 174 lbs title for the second consecutive year. Last season, he became the second Sun Devil freshman to win a CKLV title after Eric Larkin. As a team, ASU finished third (113.5 pts) behind Ohio State and Michigan, their best finish in over 17 years and first top-five finish since finishing fifth in 2005. The Sun Devils have had title winners at CKLV in three of the last four seasons, with Blake Stauffer also winning (184) in 2014. Tanner Hall (2nd), Josh Shields (3rd), Josh Maruca (5th), and Anthony Valencia (7th) also placed for ASU.

TSIRTSIS WINS RENO TOC

With a 5-0 streak, Jason Tsirtsis moved down a weight class (149) to win the Reno Tournament of Champions title (Dec. 17). The tournament, founded in 1994, now includes junior, high school, and college portions and the college version has grown from a four-way dual to a 16-team invitational. Tsirtsis defeated Stanford's Jake Berry, Wyoming's Jaron Jensen, North Dakota State's Kyle Gliva, Oklahoma State's Boo Lewallen, and NC State's Beau Donahue.

SHIELDS AND VALENCIA EARN WEEKLY HONORS

Josh Shields (157) and Zahid Valencia (174), both undefeated on the season, were honored for their performances Nov. 10/12 as Shields was named National College Wrestler of the Week by The Open Mat and Valencia received the same honor from FloWrestling.

Valencia was also named NCAA Wrestler of the Week.

Within a week, Valencia defeated the previous No. 1 Mark Hall (Nov. 5) at the NWCA All-Star Classic as well as No. 4 Myles Amine (Michigan) and No. 3 Bo Jordan (Ohio State). Shields defeated No. 7 Alec Pantaleo (Michigan) and No. 5 Micah Jordan (Ohio State).

VALENCIA MOVES BACK TO NO. 1

After defeating reigning national champion Mark Hall (Penn State), 3-2, at the NWCA All-Star Classic on Nov. 5, Zahid Valencia moved back to No. 1 at 174 lbs. in several polls including Internat, FloWrestling, and TrackWrestling.

GRAPPLING AT GAMMAGE

In a first of its kind event, Arizona State took their home opener to a different venue, hosting Pitt on Sunday, Nov. 19 at ASU Gammage Theatre on the ASU Tempe campus.

"Wrestling has performed on the biggest stages in the world - the Coliseum in Rome, Times Square, the U.S.S. Intrepid on the Hudson River, and even NYC's Grand Central Station. Now we will make our own small part of history when we wrestle Pitt in one of Arizona's iconic buildings. It will be an excellent venue for wrestling and a historical event in ASU history and we're proud to be a part of it."

ASU Gammage was designed in partnership with then-President Grady Gammage and famed architect Frank Lloyd Wright in the mid-1950's. Though neither lived to see the blueprints take life, the building was completed in Sept. 1964 and is the only public building in Arizona designed by Wright.

The Gammage stage has welcomed a vast number of musical, artistic, and cultural talents over the years including B.B. King, Johnny Cash, and Elton John, a 2004 presidential debate, and numerous Broadway touring plays including The Phantom of the Opera, Wicked, the Lion King, and more.

SUN DEVIL REPRESENTATION ON WORLD TEAMS

Two Sun Devil coaches served on USA Wrestling World Freestyle Teams, with assistant coach Chris Pendleton on the Junior World Team staff and assistant coach Lee Pritts on the Cadet World Team staff.

All-American Zahid Valencia also won a silver medal for the US, helping the team to its first title since 1984. Valencia significantly improved upon his 10th place finish in 2015 and seventh place finish in 2016.

Valencia followed in his head coach's footsteps as Zeke Jones earned a Junior World Freestyle silver in 1986 while Sun Devil teammate Mike Davies won silver in 1984.

It was the seventh consecutive year ASU has had representation on the Junior World Team, with Zahid Valencia from 2015-17, his brother Anthony Valencia in 2014, and Tanner Hall in 2011-12. Now current Sun Devil Jason Tsirtsis was on the 2013 team while Bubba Jenkins won gold in 2007 prior to his time in Tempe.

ANTHONY ROBLES INDUCTED INTO ARIZONA SPORTS HOF

Anthony Robles, 2011 NCAA champion and ASU graduate, was inducted into the Arizona Sports Hall of Fame on Wednesday, Nov. 1.

The 3-time All-American and 4-time NCAA qualifier at 125 lbs. also finished his ASU career ranked eighth in wins (122) and 10th in dual wins (53), setting ASU career records for bonus-point victories (92) and technical falls (47).

In 2011, Robles capped a perfect 36-0 season and won a national championship by defeating the reigning champion, Iowa's Matt McDonough, 7-1, in the finals. That year, he was named the NCAA Tournament's Most Outstanding Wrestler.

Since graduating from ASU, Robles has become a motivational speaker, receiving the Jimmy V Award for Perseverance in 2011, and recently had the opportunity to narrate an ESPN E:60 episode on Wisconsin high school wrestler Zack Anglin, who was born with no hands or feet. Robles also returns to ASU on the Pac-12 Network broadcast team for wrestling matches, also part of ESPN's team for the NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships.

Robles is the third representative of Sun Devil wrestling to be named to the prestigious Hall of Fame after 1967 NCAA wrestling champion and Pro Football Hall of Famer Curley Culp (2002) and 1965 WAC champion, former president of USA Wrestling, and longtime supporter of ASU wrestling Art Martori (2014).

Joining Robles in the five-member class of 2017 are Arizona Cardinals owner Bill Bidwill, longtime sportswriter and current Cronkite School professor Paola Boivin, former Coyotes captain Shane Doan, and former NBA great and GCU head men's basketball coach Dan Majerle.

2016-17 IN REVIEW

The Sun Devils reached and surpassed many significant milestones in 2016-17, including the following:

- First Pac-10/12 championship since 2006 (11 years)
- Third-place finish at Midlands was best team finish at prestigious tournament since 1989, first top-10 finish since 2001, first top-5 finish since 1997, and best finish since winning the tournament in 1989
- Seventh time in Midlands' 54-year history that ASU finished top-5 as a team (1984, 1987, 1988, 1989, 1996, 1997)
- At Midlands, Tanner Hall and Zahid Valencia became ASU's 13th and 14th individual title winners, first individual winners for the program since 2001
- Most Pac-10/12 individual champions (5) since 2003 (6)
- First time ASU had 3 or more individual Pac-12 champions in back-to-back years since 2006/07
- Zahid Valencia was ranked No. 1 at 174 lbs. and went as high as No. 5 on NCAA's Most Dominant List (undefeated going into NCAA semis)
- With a 10-4 dual record, Sun Devils earned back-to-back 10-win seasons for first time since 2004-05 and 2005-06
- Finished 4-1 in the Pac-12 for the first time since 2013-14
- Posted best finish at Virginia Duals since 1997 (3rd). It was the sixth time ASU had finished in top-4 (also 1988, 1989, 1990, 1997), including 3-straight second place finishes (1988-1990). Zahid Valencia was named Most Outstanding Wrestler.
- Won first Pac-12 opener of Zeke Jones era, defeating Cal Poly 30-15 (Jan. 8)
- Earned 25-14 win at Iowa State (Jan. 6), first win in Ames since 1989
- Zeke Jones named Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Zahid Valencia named Pac-12 Wrestler and Freshman/Newcomer of the Year, first time in conference history a wrestler has earned both titles in the same season

NEW KIDS IN TOWN

Two transfers who redshirted and trained with the team last season will now be eligible to compete for the Sun Devils in 2017-18: Jason Tsirtsis and Ryan Millhof.

Tsirtsis (149) transferred from Northwestern where he was the 2014 NCAA Champion as well as a two-time Big Ten champion and 2015 All-American.

Millhof moved to Tempe from the University of Oklahoma where he earned All-American honors in 2015-16 and was one of just four true freshmen to compete in OU's starting lineup in 2014-15.

ASU adds 12 other freshmen and transfers, highlighted by freshmen Cade Belshay, Kordell Norfleet, Navonte Demison and Brandon Courtney.

OREGON STATE TO HOST 2018 PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIPS

Hosting responsibilities for the 2018 Pac-12 Championships shifts to Oregon State as the Beavers host the conference championships on Sunday, Feb. 25. Last season, the Sun Devils won their first Pac-12 title in 11 years (since 2006). In 2019, the hosting duties will return to Tempe after ASU hosted in 2016.

In 2017, Josh Maruca (149), Josh Shields (157), Anthony Valencia (165), Zahid Valencia (174), and Tanner Hall (HWT) won Pac-12 individual titles.

2018 NCAA WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2018 NCAA Wrestling Championships are set for March 15-17 at Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio.

In 2017, ASU qualified five wrestlers in the form of five Pac-12 champions - Josh Maruca (149), Josh Shields (157), Anthony Valencia (165), Zahid Valencia (174), and Tanner Hall (HWT) while Z. Valencia and Hall became All-Americans.

THE STAFF

Joining head coach Zeke Jones on the 2017-18 coaching staff are sixth-year assistant coach Lee Pritts, fourth-year assistant coach Chris Pendleton, and second-year volunteer assistant Haislan Garcia.

Pritts, considered one of the top recruiters in the country, previously worked at North Carolina State, Old Dominion, and Missouri. He was an All-American at Eastern Michigan and qualified for the 2000 Olympic trials. This summer, he was a coach for USA Wrestling at the Cadet Freestyle World Championships.

Pendleton previously served as an assistant coach at Wyoming for four seasons, and specialized in training the team's upper weight classes. Pendleton was a two-time NCAA Champion and three-time All-American at Oklahoma State. In summer 2017, he served as an assistant coach for the USA Wrestling Junior World Freestyle Team in Finland where Zahid Valencia won a silver medal.

Garcia, a three-time Canadian Olympian, joined the staff as volunteer assistant coach last season and brings a wealth of experience as a nine-time Canadian National Champion and multiple-time Pan-American championship medalist.

Maddie Schossow (Iowa '15) enters her second season as Director of Operations while Alex Reyes and Matt Kramer join the staff as Student Video Coordinators.
