UP NEXT

Coming off a pair of home losses in which it never stopped fighting to overcome deficits of 20 points in each game, the Sun Devil women's basketball team (8-9, 2-3 Big 12) goes on the road for contests at Kansas (11-5, 1-4 Big 12) on Thursday (5:30 p.m. MST) and at No. 11/10 Kansas State (17-1, 5-0 Big 12) on Sunday (12 p.m. MST).

After playing four of its last five games at home, this will be the first time ASU has played consecutive road games since before the holiday break. In fact, between Nov. 26 - Dec. 21, the Sun Devils played seven consecutive games away from home. On the flip side, ASU will not play more than two straight road games the rest of the season.

Thursday's game at Kansas can be seen on ESPN+/Josh Klingler (play-by-play) and Wayne Simien (analyst). It can also be heard on KDUS AM 1060. Veteran broadcaster and the state of Arizona's 2010 & 2019 Broadcaster of the Year Jeff Munn is in his 21st sea-son as the voice of ASU WBB.

SERIES NOTES

- This will be the fourth all-time meeting between the two teams. ASU has won two of the three games.
- The Sun Devils edged No. 17 Kansas, 72-71, in the first meeting at the Florida International Fun in the Sun Tournament (Miami, Fla.) on Jan. 3, 1992.
- One day short of eight years later, #20 Kansas defeated ASU 81-65 on Jan. 2, 2000 in Lawrence.
- ASU won the most recent meeting 73-52 Dec. 5, 2001 in Tempe.

RANKINGS OF NOTE

- Through games played Jan. 14, ASU is ranked among the top 60 teams in the nation in FT pct. (23rd/77.5/1st in Big 12), blocks per game (44th/4.4/5th in Big 12) and defensive rebounds per game (53rd/27.7/7th in Big 12) and.
- ASU is also ranked in the top half of the Big 12 in rebs per game (5th/39.1), FTs made per game (8th/12.5) and scoring (8th/72.6 ppg).
- Individually, **Kennedy Basham** is 16th the in the nation in blocks per game (2.24/2nd in Big 12), **Tyi Skinner** is 46th in minutes per game (34.97/3rd in Big 12) and 53rd in 3-pointers per game (2.47/7th in Big 12) and **Jazion Jackson** is 50th in steals per game (2.54/4th in Big 12)
- ASU also has several players ranked among the Top 20 in the Big 12: **Skinner** is 4th in FT pct. (84.2), 10th in scoring (16.7 ppg/has scored in double figures in all but two games this season) and 7th in 3-pointers per game (2.47), and 12th in 3-point FG pct. (35.6); **Jalyn Brown** is 9th in scoring (16.8 ppg), 11th in FT pct. (79.3) and 14th in blocks per game (1.0); **Nevaeh Parkinson** is 9th in rebounds per game (7.2) and **Kennedy Fauntleroy** is 13th in steals per game (1.88).

NOTES FROM LAST WEEK

- ASU dropped home games to Iowa State (90-83) and Baylor (78-59).
- The Sun Devils came into the game vs. Iowa State looking to extend their season-best three-game winning streak. In the contest they came up short in what would have been the biggest comeback in program history. Down by as many as 20, ASU was within three points with 13 seconds remaining. An ASU win would have eclipsed the record for the biggest comeback in program history: 18 points vs. Utah on Feb. 17, 2019, a game in which the Sun Devils scored the last 20 points of the game to edge the Utes 60-58.
- After Iowa State shot 67 pct in the first quarter, it made just 38 pct of its attempts the rest of the way, while the Sun Devils hit 48 percent of their field goals in the final 20 minutes after making 34 percent in the first half. Jalyn Brown scored 14 of her game high-tying 20 points in the second half to help ASU climb its way back into the game. Also totaling more than half of their points in the second half were Tyi Skinner (9 of 12), Jyah LoVett (8 of 13) and Jazion Jackson (6 of 8).
- ASU's nine turnovers vs. Iowa State represented its fewest total this season.
- The 48 points ASU scored in the second half represented the most points ASU has scored in the second half of a game this season. After shooting 57 percent (12-21) from the line in the first three quarters, Iowa State connected on 82 percent (14-17) of its attempts in the fourth quarter, including a perfect 4-4 in the final 12 seconds to clinch the win.
- Against Baylor, ASU fell behind 38-18 after the Bears scored the first nine points of the second quarter. In the same quarter, the Sun Devils responded a 15-2 run to get within single digits, 40-33, with 3:14 left in the quarter.
- An important sequence came during the scoring run. With 3:24 remaining, each team lost the player who at the time was leading them in scoring – for ASU it was Kennedy Fauntleroy who was tied with Jalyn Brown with nine points at the time – following an altercation. ASU also lost starting guard Jyah Lovett and reserve post Heavenly Greer for coming off the bench. Although Brown capped the 15-2 run by hitting a 3-pointer when play resumed, the previous prolonged sequence had an effect on the momentum ASU had going in its favor. Baylor scored the last four points of the quarter to once again take a double-digit lead, 44-33, at the half. Combined with a 13-4 run to start the third quarter, the Bears once again took a 20-point lead, 57-37, a little more than three minutes into the third quarter.
- After Baylor took its largest lead of the game, 66-45 in the final quarter, the Sun Devils went on a 10-2 run in less than two minutes to get within 13 after Skinner's 3-pointer with 6:37 remaining. Unfortunately for ASU, it was not able to get back within single digits.
- One of the biggest factors in the loss to Baylor was on the boards where the Bears finished plus-18. Baylor had nearly twice as many of-fense rebounds (17-9) as ASU which translated into a 21-7 advantage in second chance points. Nevaeh Parkinson (game-high 12 rebounds, six points) and Jazion Jackson (six rebounds, five points) were the only Sun Devils who had more than four rebounds.
- Brown led ASU in scoring (20.5 ppg) and Nevaekh Parkinson led ASU in rebounding (10.5 rpg) in the two games. LoVett averaged 8.0 points and hit 58 percent (7-12) of her shots.
- The Sun Devils took full advantage of their opportunities at the free throw line where they connected on 87.0 percent of their attempts (20-23). Jackson came off the bench and averaged 6.5 points (5-10 FGs) and 7.0 rebounds.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR

- The Sun Devils come into Thursday's game in a three-way tie for 10th place in the Big 12. With the conference season in its early stages, the difference between 4th place and 10th place is only 1.5 games.
- Tyi Skinner (7x) and Jalyn Brown (7x) have combined to lead or tie for the team lead in scoring 14x this season. Also among the single-game scoring leaders have been Nevaeh Parkinson (2x), Jyah LoVett (1x) and Kennedy Fauntleroy (1x).
- Skinner (15 of 17 games) and Brown (11 of 14 games) have combined to score in double figures 26x this season. The two have also combined to score 20 or more points 11x: Brown 6x and Skinner 5x. Four of Brown's six 20-point games have come in her last six games. Skinner's career-high 30 points in ASU's opening win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4) represents the highest single-game total by a Sun Devil this season.
- In the six games prior to ASU's most recent contests vs. Baylor, LoVett had averaged 14.7 points and connected on 54.5 percent of her shots. Compared to her first 10 games, LoVett had averaged +5.6 more points per game and shot +13.3 percentage points higher.
- In ASU's last six games, Parkinson has averaged 11.3 points and 9.7 rebounds. During that stretch she is shooting 54 percent (29-54). She has also collected her first two double-doubles as a Sun Devil: 22 points, career high-tying 13 rebounds vs. Penn. (Dec. 30) and 10 points, 12 rebounds at Houston (Jan. 4). Four of her five double-digit rebounding efforts have come in ASU's last eight games.
- Kennedy Basham has had multiple blocks 9x this season, including a career-high seven rejections at San Francisco (Dec. 17).

PROGRESS NOT ALWAYS MEASURED IN WINS AND LOSSES

The Sun Devils, who have eight new players on this season's roster, have experienced the ups and downs that can sometimes go with combining the talents of several outstanding players early in the season. That factor alone could account for the Sun Devils' current 8-9 record. Some of the near misses...

- Against Arkansas State, the Sun Devils trailed by 13 with 6:15 remaining. After a 19-5 run, ASU was suddenly up by one with 1:01 remaining. Arkansas State scored the last five points of the game to claim the win.
- After going into the half with a 42-33 win vs. Grand Canyon, the Sun Devils were outscored 37-17 in the second half.
- At Coppin State, ASU was unable to score in the final 53 seconds to break a 61-61 tie. The Eagles would go on to win in OT.
- Despite a stout defensive effort and a plus-12 advantage on the boards, the Sun Devils came up on the short end of a 57-50 decision at UC Davis. For the second straight game the Sun Devils held the opposition to the fewest points they have given up this season and allowed the Aggies to shoot only 37 percent. Unfortunately for ASU, it struggled to put the ball in the basket as it made just 28 percent of its shots and knocked down one of its 14 attempts from long range. Down by eight entering the fourth quarter, the Sun Devils did not show any letup, methodically trimming the Aggies' advantage. Besselink's layup got the Sun Devils within two points, 44-42, with 5:36 remaining. ASU was within one possession three more times but did not come away with points in each instance. After Besselink's earlier field goal got ASU within two, the Sun Devils were only able to connect on three of their 14 shot attempts in the final five

- At San Francisco, the Sun Devils were unable to take advantage of a 27-point performance from Skinner and a career-high and a tremendous all-around performance from Basham, who scored 12 points, grabbed seven rebounds and had a career-high seven blocks. The difference in the game was at the free throw line, not in accuracy – ASU made 82 percent of its attempts and San Francisco made 83 percent – but in the number of opportunities. By game's end, the Dons had more than three times as many attempts (29-35) as the Sun Devils (9-11). Still the Sun Devils were tied at 57-57 with 1:09 remaining. After the Dons took a six-point lead, Skinner knocked down a pair of 3-pointers and missed on a third that would have tied the game and sent it to overtime.

DYNAMIC DUO DEBUT

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were dealt a serious blow when it was announced before the season that superstar guard Tyi Skinner would miss the entire season due to a knee injury.

Skinner, who played her first two seasons at Delaware, joined Natasha Adair in Tempe after Adair was named ASU's head coach. In 2022-23, Skinner (2023 All-Pac-12 honorable mention) scored 20 or more points 15 times, including 29 points twice. A starter in all 28 games, Skinner averaged 19.3 ppg, (most by a Sun Devil since the 1988-89). She concluded her first campaign as a Sun Devil among the leaders in the Pac-12 in points per game (19.3/2nd/27th in the nation), 3-pointers per game (2.43 per game/2nd), minutes per game (36.59/3rd/29th in the nation), FTs made (79/3rd) and attempted (91/4th), steals per game (1.71/5th), 3-point FG pct (34.7/6th) and FT percentage (78.1/8th).

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were left pondering, 'what might have been,' had Skinner been able to share the court with Louisville transfer Jalyn Brown. Much like Skinner did in 2022-23, Brown would emerge as one of the top performers in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. In league games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56). She scored in double figures 26 times (12 20-point games) including a pair of outings in which she had the two highest-scoring games by a Sun Devil since 2000: 35 vs. Colorado (Jan. 7, 2024) and 34 points at Washington (Jan. 21).

Brown, who earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention honors from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 recognition from media who cover the league, went on to lead the team in scoring (17.3 ppg) and 3-pointers per game (1.4), was 2nd in FT pct. (76.9), 3-pointers (1.3 per game), minutes (35.54 mpg) and FTs made (103) and attempted (134), 3rd in assists (1.6 apg), tied for 3rd in steals (0.9 spg) and 4th in O-rebounds (1.1 rpg).

In her first game since the end of the 2022-23 season, Skinner scored a career-high 30 points – the 17th time she scored 20 or more points in a Sun Devil uniform – in ASU's 74-66 win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4). Brown led ASU in scoring (24 points) vs. Arkansas State (Nov. 8). Combined with Skinner's 16 points, the duo combined for 40 points in the game.

In ASU's 80-73 win over SMU (Nov. 16), Skinner (26 points) and Brown (25 points) combined for 51 points. In addition both Skinner (8-16 FGs, 5-10 3FGs) and Brown (10-18 FGs, 3-7 3FGs) were efficient with their opportunities as they teamed up to shoot 53 percent (18-34 FGs) from the field, including 47 percent (8-17) from long range.

Skinner (7x) and Brown (7x) have combined to lead or tie for the team lead in scoring 14x this season. Skinner (15 of 17 games) and Brown (11 of 14 games) have combined to score in double figures 26x this season. The two have also combined to score 20 or more points 11x: Brown 6x and Skinner 5x. Four of Brown's 20-point games have come in her last six games. Skinner's career-high 30 points in ASU's opening win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4) represents the highest single-game total by a Sun Devil this season.

NOTES ON ASU'S FIRST SEASON IN THE BIG 12

Big 12 Transfers: Three Sun Devil newcomers were on a Big 12 campus in the past year. Heavenly Greer played the past two years at Kansas State, Dallas native Jazion Jackson was at Texas Tech last year and Kennedy Fauntleroy was at Oklahoma State last year after earning 2022-23 Big East Freshman of the Year at Georgetown.

The Big 12 format: Teams will play three opponents home and away while facing six teams only at home and six opponents only on the road for a total of 18 Conference games. Opponents were selected based on a combination of geography, historical results and a poll of the coaches to best balance the schedule in terms of travel and competitiveness.

ASU's Big 12 opponent breakdown: Home: Baylor (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Cincinnati (2024 WNIT Team), Iowa State (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), TCU (2024 WBIT Team), Texas Tech, West Virginia (2024 NCAA Tournament Team). Away: Central Florida, Colorado (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Houston, Kansas (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Kansas State (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Oklahoma State. Home and Away: Arizona (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), BYU (2024 WBIT Team), Utah (2024 NCAA Tournament Team).

When it starts/ends: League play begins Saturday, Dec. 21 with six games and concludes Sunday, March 2. The regular season will be followed by the 2025 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship, which will take place in Kansas City's T-Mobile Center for the second consecutive season.

About the league: The current league members combined to go 8-0 in their first game of the 2024 NCAA Tournament while 15 of the 16 teams finished the 2023-24 season in the top 101 of the NET rankings. Four Big 12 teams are ranked in the top 16 of ESPN's Women's Basketball Way-Too-Early Top 25, tied for the most of any league.

HEAD COACH NATASHA ADAIR



- On March 27, 2022, Natasha Adair was introduced as the new head coach of Sun Devil Women's Basketball.
- Adair, who brought 10 seasons of head coaching experience to ASU, came to Tempe after five seasons at Delaware where she compiled a 95-58 record, including a 48-13 record in her final two seasons.
- In 2021-22, Adair's final season at Delaware, the Blue Hens captured the program's third Colonial Athletic Association tournament title and earned their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in nearly a decade.
- In 2021, Adair was named the CAA's Coach of the Year for a season in which she guided Delaware to its first regular season conference championship since 2013.
- Prior to her five seasons at Delaware, Adair also had successful head coaching stints at College of Charleston (two seasons) and Georgetown (three seasons).
- Despite a spate of unlucky injuries to key personnel, the Sun Devils had several noteworthy accomplishments during Adair's inaugural season in Tempe, including: Starting 5-0 for the first time since 2002-03; Finishing the season No. 2 in the Pac-12 and 10th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (12.3/only ASU's 2017-18 squad averaged fewer turnovers per game (11.7) in a season; Even with all its injuries, ASU nearly pulled off three Top 25 upsets in the season's final five games: vs. No. 21 Colorado (62-70), vs. No. 4 Utah (69-74) and vs. No. 19 UCLA (70-81-OT) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. In their 75-73 win at Oregon State, the Sun Devils

overcame their second-largest deficit in school history (17 points).

- ASU was once again hampered by injuries in 2023-24 as it lost leading scorer Tyi Skinner before the season started. Despite the injury issues, the Sun Devils still increased their overall win total and conference win total from the season before. Individually, Jalyn Brown flourished in her first season as a Sun Devil. The transfer from Louisville earned All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention recognition from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 notice from media who covered the league. In conference games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56).
- In addition to the 2021-22 team (NCAA Tournament), Adair's leadership while at Delaware was instrumental in the 2017-18 (WNIT) and 2020-21 (WNIT) squads earning postseason appearances. Playing a big role in Delaware's success in Adair's final two seasons as head coach was the Blue Hens' resiliency on the offensive glass as they finished among the top three teams in the nation in offensive rebounding in 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- Under Adair's tutelage, three Delaware student-athletes earned Player of the Year honors, two were named Rookie of the Year and multiple players collected All-Conference honors.
- In recent years, Adair has taken on an increasingly prominent role within USA Basketball. In 2017, she was appointed as the U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach. In 2018, Adair was a speaker at USA Basketball's Las Vegas Coach Academy. In 2018 and 2019, Adair earned gold medals while serving as an assistant coach for the USA teams that won the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.
- Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned a four-win program into a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, Georgetown finished 2016-17 with 17 wins, the most for the Hoyas since 2011-12 and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.
- In only her second season at Georgetown, Adair helped the Hoyas experience a 180-degree turnaround as they finished 16-14 – the third-best NCAA DI turnaround in 2015-16 – and made the program's first postseason appearance since 2012.
- While at Georgetown, Adair coached a Big EAST Rookie of the Year, two players who were named to the league's All-Rookie team and pair of All-Conference standouts.
- Adair's first head coaching job was at College of Charleston, where (35-31 overall in two seasons). She was the first coach to lead the

program to consecutive postseason appearances.

- In 2013-14, Adair's second season and the Cougars' first in the Colonial Athletic Association, Adair guided College of Charleston to a record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

- In her first season at College of Charleston, Adair led the Cougars to 16 wins and a WBI postseason bid. Her first squad broke 22 school records along the way.

- While leading the College of Charleston, Adair coached two all-conference players and an all-rookie team performer who would go on to be named a three-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year.

- Adair previously spent 14 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with eight years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor five WNBA draft picks and several players who went on to play professionally overseas.

- A founding member of the Black Coaches United, Adair has been recognized by the organization, as well as Advancement of Blacks in Sports (ABIS), as one of the top women's basketball coaches in the country. Adair prides herself on being known as a game-changer as it

relates to social justice and creating a safe space for athletes to find and use their voice; where she was a guest on ESPNW's "Around the Rim" with LaChina Robinson and Delaware's UD Winning Women in Athletics: Trailblazers and Changemakers Webinar Series.

- Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990- 92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994.

- Coach Adair has two children, a son Aaron M. Adair (27), graduated magna cum laude from Johnson C. Smith University. A four-year member of the university's President's Council for his academic achievement, he also earned four letters playing for the men's basketball team. Daughter Allyssa M. Adair (19) is a sophomore at Texas State University and a middle blocker on the volleyball team.
