ASU MEN'S BASKETBALL HOSTS NO. 19 GONZAGA

Arizona State faces their first Top-25 opponent with Gonzaga coming to Tempe on Friday.

Arizona State Men's Basketball hosts No. 19 Gonzaga at Desert Financial Arena on Friday at 9 PM MST. Head Coach Bobby Hurley's team has their first Top-25 matchup of the season, welcoming the highly-touted Bulldogs to Tempe on Homecoming weekend. The Sun Devils will look to capture their 14th win over a ranked opponent in the Hurley era.

THE MATCHUP

Arizona State looks to avenge their loss from last season when they matched up with Gonzaga for the first time in program history. The Sun Devils went toe-to-toe with a Top-10 Bulldogs team last season on the road in one of college basketball's toughest environment. ASU battled to a 88-80 loss. ASU had quality games from Alston Mason (19 points on 8-of-13 shooting) and Basheer Jihad (22 points including perfect in seven free throws and 10 boards). ASU led 69-67 with under eight to go and had an 11-0 run in the outing.

SEEKING A 2-0 START

Arizona State is off to their sixth 2-0 start to the season under Bobby Hurley. It is the second consecutive year they have won their first two games. ASU also started 2-0 in the 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, and 2022-23 seasons, three of which resulted in NCAA Tournament appearances.

KEEPING IT 100

Senior point guard Moe Odum played in his 100th career game at the Division I level in the win over Utah Tech. He made the most of the milestone, stuffing the stat sheet with 14 points, six rebounds, and six assists. Odum's 7.0 assist/game is tied for 16th and second in the Big 12 Conference. No active Sun Devil has played in more games at the Division I level.

MO(R)E ASSISTS, LESS GAMES

Odum is putting together one of the most productive passing careers in recent memory. Among active NCAA players at the Division I level, Odum's 532 assists are the **THIRD** most. He is the only active NCAA Division I player to have been credited with 500+ assists and have played in 100 games or less (100 career games).

Odum ranks near the top nationally in several significant career passing statistics, an indication of what a successful career he has had. Here is a closer look at where he stands nationally in several important categories:

BENCH BOOST

Arizona State has received tremendous contributions from their bench in both their wins to open the season. After claiming a 25-8 edge in bench points over Utah Tech, the Sun Devils now have a 60-22 (+38) advantage in the category this season.

PUSHING THE PACE

Through two games, the Sun Devils have been one of the nation's best teams in transition. They boasted a 20-11 advantage in fast break points in the win over Utah Tech and have 20 or more fast break points in each of their first two games. ASU is averaging 22 fast break points, the 29th-best total in the nation.

DEFENDING FROM DEEP

ASU has held their first two foes to a combined 13-of-55 from behind the arc. Teams are shooting a miniscule 23.6% from 3 PT range against the Sun Devils so far, the 38th-best mark in college basketball this season.

T-ALLEN-TED

Graduate transfer forward Allen Mukeba has made a big splash during his short time as a Sun Devil. He has always been a double-double threat throughout his career, posting big scoring and rebounding numbers typically in a starting role. Mukeba has made a seamless transition to the bench, reaching double figures in a reserve role in both games so far this season. He is shooting a team-high 69.2% (9-of-13) from the field while adding nine rebounds, four blocks, and three assists.

RANKED WINS IN HURLEY ERA

Arizona State has won a total of 13 games against ranked teams since Bobby Hurley took over in 2015-16. Eight of those ranked wins have come in front of the home crowd in Tempe, including historic triumphs over No. 1 Kansas in 2018 and No. 3 UCLA in 2022.

GET TO KNOW THE NAME

Center Massamba Diop has been one of the most impressive freshman in the country so far this season. In his first collegiate game, he became just the ninth freshman in the Bobby Hurley era to earn the opening night start. He delivered with 14 points on 6-of-8 shooting, five rebounds, and three blocks in only 27 minutes of action in the win over Southern Utah. Diop elevated his game even more in the second game of the season, scoring a game-high 18 points in the victory over Utah Tech. He added six rebounds and two steals while converting both of his three point attempts. Diop leads the Sun Devils in scoring after two games averaging 16 points a game.

THE HURLEY ERA

Bobby Hurley has won 170 games at ASU and is only the third coach in program history to reach the mark. He is now the second-winningest coach in program history.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Does any team in the nation have a tougher road schedule on paper in the preseason than Arizona State? It would be tough to argue.
- They have five road games scheduled against teams ranked in the top-16 of the AP Preseason Poll.
- That includes trips to No. 1 Houston and No. 5 Arizona in addition to a non-conference battle with No. 15 UCLA in Los Angeles.

HEAD COACH BOBBY HURLEY



One of the most recognizable names in college basketball history became the 14th men's head coach of the Sun Devil Men's Basketball program, as Arizona State named 1992 NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player Bobby Hurley as the head coach on April 9, 2015. What has followed is aggressive scheduling, lots of fast-paced hoops, playing hard, several big-time wins both home and away and back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for Arizona State for the first time since Byron Scott, Fat Lever and Alton Lister were starring in Tempe (1980-81 to be exact). In his 11 seasons as head coach, Sun Devil Men's Basketball has matched its highest ranking in school history (third in the Associated Press Poll in December of 2017), notched its best two average attendances in history (10,603 in 2017-18 is the ASU record), reached the NCAA Tournament three times, notched its best two non-conference wins in school history (vs. No. 1 Kansas on Dec. 22, 2018 and at No. 2 Kansas on Dec. 10, 2017) and defeated two eventual 2018 No. 1 seeds in a span of a few weeks (Kansas and Xavier).

Following a three-year drought without a First or Second Team Pac-12 All-Conference selection, ASU had at least one in six straight seasons under Hurley (2018-23) and Frankie Collins received Honorable Mention distinction in 2024. Hurley has coached two Pac-12 Sixth Man of the Year winners in addition to the 2019 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year (Lu Dort).

Three Sun Devils have been selected to the Pac-12 All-Tournament team and three received All-Defensive Team distinction

during Hurley's tenure. During the 2024-25, he reached a couple significant career milestones. Hurley moved into second place in program history with his 160th win as the ASU head coach over Cal Poly. His 168 career wins heading into the 2025-26 season trail only legendary Sun Devil head coach Ned Wulk. He also captured his 200th career win when the Sun Devils defeated Grand Canyon at the Jerry Colangelo Classic. Arizona State captured their fourth non-conference tournament championship in the Bobby Hurley era when they won the 2024 Acrisure Classic Championship. ASU defeated New Mexico and Saint Mary's in back-to-back days to win the title in Palm Springs. ASU also won the 2022 Legends Classic, 2018 MGM Resorts Title, and the 2017 Continental Tire Invitational under Hurley.

CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- The Big 12 remains tied for the national lead with six teams inside the AP Top-25, three within the poll's top ten and is the only league with multiple top-five teams. Houston is ranked No. 1 for the first time since 2024, followed by No. 5 Arizona, No. 7 BYU, No. 11 Texas Tech, No. 16 Iowa State and No. 25 Kansas.

- Four of the last six national championship games have featured a Big 12 school, including Houston's appearance in the game last season. The run is highlighted by back-to-back national championships by Baylor in 2021 and Kansas in 2022. Texas Tech reached the title game in 2019.

-The Big 12 led the nation with a 66.7 winning percentage in the 2025 NCAA Tournament. It was the 11th consecutive tournament to feature at least six Big 12 schools, with the league getting at least seven bids in eight of those seasons.

- The Big 12 has been the top-ranked Conference in NET/RPI (prior to 2019) in nine of the past 12 seasons.

- The league is a combined 40-4 so far this season and still has 12 undefeated teams remaining.

DESERT FINANCIAL ARENA



Desert Financial Arena is the home for Sun Devil men's and women's basketball as well as volleyball, gymnastics and wrestling. Constructed in the spring of 1974, the 14,198-seat facility also plays host to graduation ceremonies and a variety of concerts and shows. The arena contains offices and locker rooms for ASU basketball, along with space for weight training, a training room and an equipment room. Over the years, the arena has seen several upgrades, including the installation of a multimillion-dollar center-court video scoreboard featuring four 8-by-12-foot display screens, enhancing the experience for attendees. Throughout its history, Desert Financial Arena has been more than just a sports venue; it has been a gathering place for the ASU community and the broader Tempe area, reflecting the university's growth and commitment to providing quality facilities for its students and the public.

The arena was renamed to Desert Financial Arena after a multi-year agreement was announced on October 14, 2019 with Desert Financial Credit Union.
