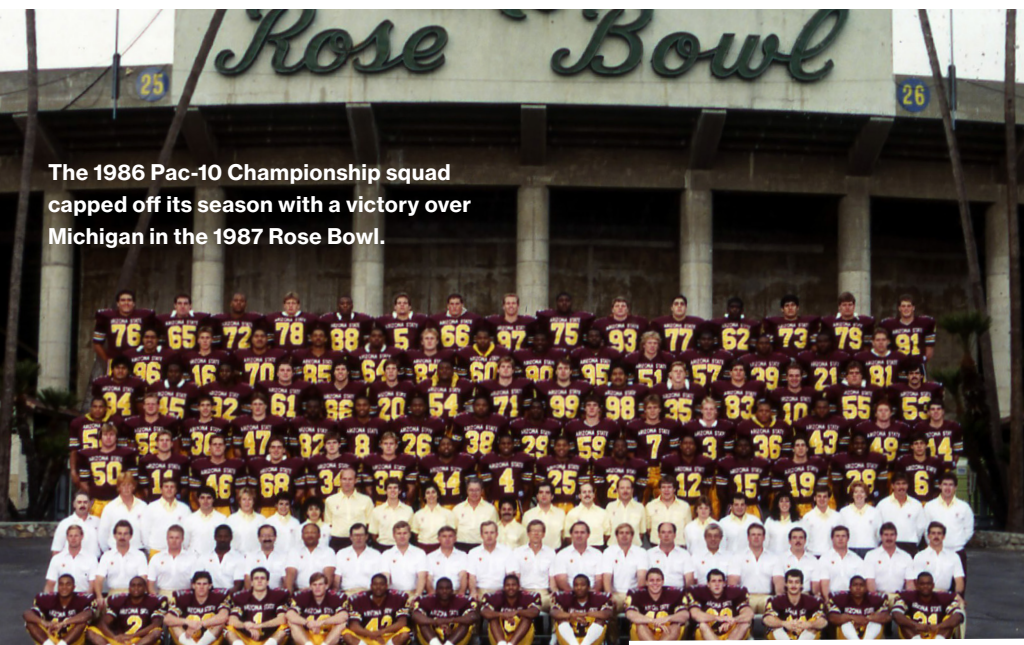

Rest in peace to a great Sun Devil, Bill Riddle.



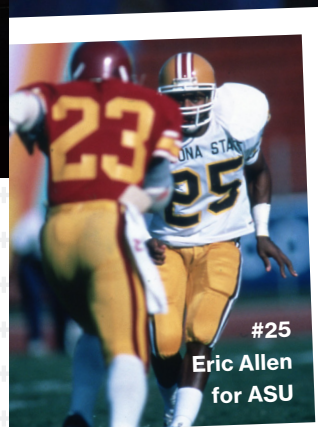

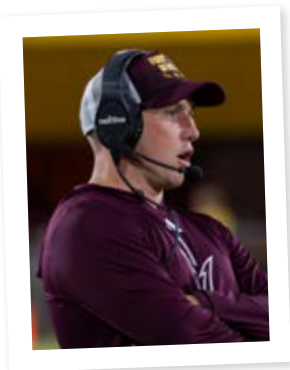


Eric Allen: NFL 2025 Hall of Fame inductee

ASU Hall of Famer (2008) Eric Allen was named to the NFL's 2025 Hall of Fame Class. Taken as the 30th overall pick in the 1988 NFL Draft, his career spanned 14 seasons and included 217 games, 214 of which he started for the Philadelphia Eagles, New Orleans Saints and Oakland Raiders.

Allen was a six-time Pro Bowler and earned second-team All-Pro honors twice. In nine playoff games, Allen recorded four interceptions — one of them a pick-six — and solidified himself in history as his eight career pick-sixes were tied for third most in history at the time of his retirement.

Arizona State ushered in a new era of Sun Devil Football with alumnus Kenny Dillingham named as the 26th head coach of the program on Nov. 27, 2022.

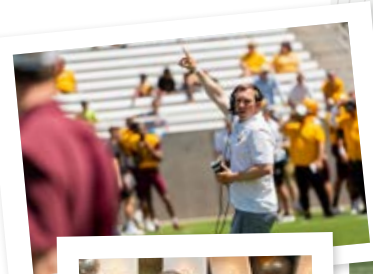
Two seasons after he was hired, Sun Devil Football has become a championship team.

In 2024, the team had an undefeated home season for the first time since 2004, a Big 12 Championship and a bevy of players who took to ASU's coaching and delivered, with several back for the 2025 season.

Kenny and his wife, Bri, also a Sun Devil graduate, have a son, Kent.

History and traditions

A rich culture of unique traditions has grown around Sun Devil Athletics since 1899. Here are some of the most popular.

The Territorial Cup

The ASU and U of A rivalry culminates in the Territorial Cup, the oldest rivalry trophy in college football.

The cup was first awarded in 1899, 13 years before Arizona became a state. After disappearing for decades, the original trophy was found at the ASU Alumni Association in 1980.

The series now encompasses the 22 Division I sports in which both schools compete; the university with the most points at year's end earns the trophy.

The fight song

"Maroon and Gold" was composed in 1948 by Felix E. McKernan, director of the Sun Devil Marching Band. Here are the lyrics:

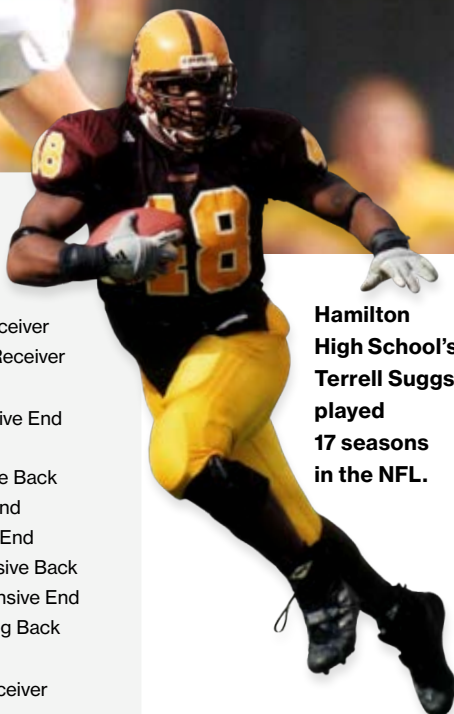

- **Appropriate behavior is expected.** Inappropriate conduct may result in ejection or arrest. Report suspicious activity to staff, police or text Sparky at **602-962-4962** with details.
- **Banners and signs** must be game-related and not block views, cover signage, display ads or profanity.
- **Guest assistance centers** are outside the southwest gate and behind sections 6, 24, 34,

Football fashion: 1896 to now

When Coach “Cap” Irish first took the field with the unnamed team he founded at the Arizona Territorial Normal School in 1896, ASU football was born. The next 13 decades brought new team names – Owls, Bulldogs, Sun Devils – and uniforms that evolved from utilitarian to spectacular.

Here’s a look back at designs over the years.

1902



The 1902 team wore pads inside the uniforms, leather helmets, a knit jersey against the skin and a turtleneck sweater with “N” for Normal School.

1930s



1975

1999



Todd Heap, who set an ASU tight ends’ record with 115 receptions, wears a maroon jersey and gold pants.

2025



All 2025 jerseys feature a Big 12 patch and, on some, a Tillman Leadership Council patch.

Timeline: major milestones in college football fashion

1890s

Stretchy materials

Early teams wore turtlenecks, then changed to jersey fabric, a tightly woven natural material (silk or wool) that stretched, allowing players more movement. Jerseys also fit the body better, leaving less for opponents to grab.

1900s

Small pads over

Pads became essential. “Light padding and padding like a chest plate would be applied on top of the jersey around this time,” said Kevin Jones, curator at ASU FIDM, specializing in sports fashion.

1940s

Synthetics

Synthetic materials developed during World War II could wick away perspiration and stretch in any direction, fitting perfectly over pads “without any extra fabric that could get caught during tackling,” Jones said.

2000s

2000–10 Multiple uniforms

Teams adopted more than just home and away uniforms, rolling out three or four total themes and even more combinations when paired with various helmet designs.

The future

What’s next?

More technology, such as uniform additions that can keep certain parts of the body cooler.

Volleyball secured the program's first-ever conference title with a 28-2 record, earning an NCAA Tournament bid.

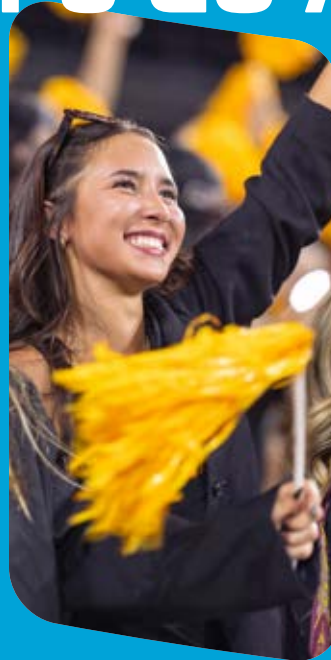
ASU football won the Big 12 Championship in its first season in the conference.

Commissioner's Cup

In its inaugural year in the Big 12, Arizona State University's athletic department won the Commissioner's Cup, awarded to the conference program that best combines athletic and academic excellence as well as community service efforts.

Four Sun Devil teams – football, men's and women's swimming and diving, and volleyball – won conference championships in 2024–25.

On the academic side, the average cumulative GPA for all of ASU's student-athletes in the spring of 2025 was 3.37, and 48% of ASU's student-athletes made the Dean's List. In addition, 82% of student-athletes had a semester or cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, and 135 student-athletes earned a 4.0 semester or cumulative GPA.

"I'm just incredibly proud of our department," said ASU Athletics Director Graham Rossini. "Most importantly, I think it's a good validation that we're on our way."

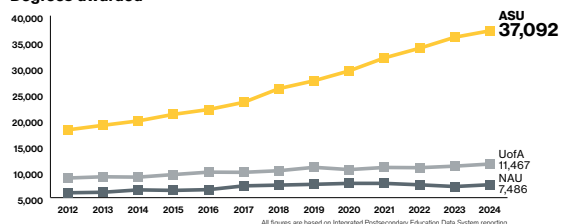

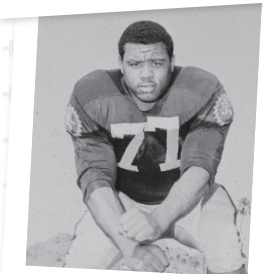

Territorial Cup blowout in Tucson, Dec. 11, 2020

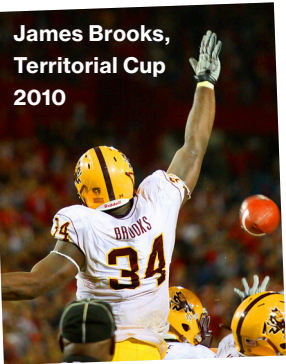
