Wrestling to welcome Cal Baptist in penultimate dual

TEMPE – Sun Devil Wrestling is set to welcome Big 12 foe Cal Baptist on Friday, Feb. 13 in a matchup that could mark the final meeting between the programs, after Cal Baptist announced its wrestling program will not continue beyond the current season. First whistle is set for 6:30 p.m. MST at Desert Financial Arena.

The Sun Devils are coming off a 1-1 weekend, highlighted by a come-from-behind 23-16 victory over archrival Oregon State on Feb. 6, before dropping a 31-9 road decision at Oklahoma on Feb. 8. Arizona State erased a 16-4 deficit against the Oregon State by rattling off five consecutive wins from 165 pounds through heavyweight, flipping the dual in dramatic fashion and securing one of its most resilient performances of the season.

The turning point came at 184 pounds, where redshirt junior Shay Addison reversed a 7-4 deficit into a momentum-shifting pin that tied the team score at 16-16 with two bouts remaining. Graduate 197-pounder Colton Hawks followed with one of the weekend's marquee performances, edging then-No. 4 Justin Rademacher in a 6-4 SV-3 win to push ASU ahead. Freshman heavyweight Ben Szuba sealed the comeback with an 11-0 major decision, punctuating the rally and closing out the Sun Devils' statement win.

ASU was unable to carry that momentum into Sunday's matchup at Oklahoma, where the Sooners pulled away for a 31-9 victory. Redshirt sophomore No. 14 Nicco Ruiz earned his second win of the weekend with an 8-2 decision to improve to 18-5 on the season, while redshirt freshman No. 20 Pierson Manville (141) and junior Aníee Vigil (125) also picked up wins in the dual.

The Sun Devils are 1-0 in the all-time series against Cal Baptist after a 34-10 win on Jan. 12, 2025. The Lancers feature former four-year Sun Devil Jesse Vasquez who is expected to compete at 141-lb.

Sun Devil Standard

Sun Devil Wrestling is one of the most decorated programs in the west as the Sun Devils have captured 24 conference titles in their over 50-year history, including 22 Pac-10/12 and two Western Athletic Conference crowns. The Sun Devils have accumulated over 120 individual Pac-10/12 titles and 28 WAC crowns (Over 140 total titles in program history).

-Kaleb Larkin is now 6-1 in the newly reclassified 157-lb. division. After No.7 Meyer Shapiro of Cornell handed Larkin his first loss at 157, he bounced back with a win by fall over Columbia's No. 18 Kai Owen. Larkin has never lost back-to-back matches throughout his career.

- Kyler Larkin ranks No. 1 nationally at 133 lbs. in the RPI, posting a 0.7124 rating through 14 matches.

-Pierson Manville has outscored opponents 189-72 on the season while holding a career-best 15 wins

Additionally, Manville has not given up more than 10 points in a match this season.

SUN DEVIL STORYLINES

The Legend of Larkin

Sun Devil Athletics hall of famer Eric Larkin is widely regarded as one of the greatest wrestlers to ever dawn the Sun Devil singlet. Standing sixth on the all-time wins list at ASU with 123, Larkin accomplished several feats that no other Sun Devil had, including being honored with the 2003 Dan Hodge Award and being selected as the Outstanding Wrestler of the 2003 NCAA meet following a perfect 34-0 record in his senior campaign. Prior to winning the NCAA title, Larkin made an impressive improvement over the course of his career finishing fourth (133) as a freshman, third as a sophomore (141) and second as a junior (141).

He now passes the torch to the next generation of Larkins, with brothers Kaleb and Kyler primed to fill their fathers shoes and bring Sun Devil Wrestling to the next level

Kaleb currently holds a 21-2 record in his NCAA career across limited action due to injuries. To begin the 2025-2026 season, Kaleb is 19-2, with 11 of his wins being bonus point victories (4 TF, 3 MD, 4 F). His signature win came at the National Duals Invitational, defeating then-No.2 Lachlan McNeil (Michigan), by MD 11-1. Kaleb began the season unranked in the 149-lb division, but now holds No.3 in FloWrestling's rankings and No. 3 in Internat's, respectively at 157. Kaleb has since made the jump to 157-lb. and is currently 2-0 with a wins over No. 1 Ty Watters (West Virginia) and No. 3 Vinny Zerban (Iowa State).

Notably, Kaleb earned his way to the US Olympic trials in the summer of 2024, going toe-to-toe with four-time national champion Yianni Diakomihalis in a highly competitive match.

As for Kyler, his freshman year is among one of the most anticipated in the entire country. He currently stands at 15-1 in the 133-lb division with his lone loss coming in the Cliff Keen Las Vegas 133-lb championship due to a medical forfeit. He has knocked off four ranked opponents, with the highest win coming over No. 6 Tyler Knox (Stanford). Kyler's big moment came center stage against former Sun Devil National Champion, Richard Figueroa II (Oklahoma State). Kyler dethroned Figueroa with a 10-5 Dec. to put him in headlines all over the wrestling world. Kyler has began to emerge in the 133-lb rankings, now all the way up to No. 5 in Flo's Dec.15 rankings. Over the summer, Kyler notched a dominant gold medal performance at the U20 Pan-Am Championships in the 61 kg freestyle division in Lima, Peru. He is also a 2023 Fargo champion while winning the college division at the Reno Tournament of Champions at 133 lbs in 2023.

Ruiz The Roof

Headlining the Sun Devils returning class is none other than 165-lb standout Nicco Ruiz. Ruiz is the lone Sun Devil to have qualified for the NCAA Championships a season ago, as he turned in a 1-2 outing at the national meet in Philadelphia. The meet was highlighted by a take down of No. 31 Cody Goebel (Wisconsin) by a 16-3 MD for his first career win at the national meet. He also placed sixth in the 165-lb bracket at the 2025 Big 12 Championships

As for 2025-26, Ruiz is currently at 18-5 in his second season as a starter at 165-lbs. that includes a 10-4 dual record while coming in at 7-1 in Big 12 bouts.

Of Ruiz's five losses, he has lost by just 10 combined points in the five matches. Four of the five opponents happened to be ranked, including a narrow 4-2 to defending 165-lb. NCAA championships runner-up Joey Blaze.

Manville Mania

Pierson Manville's first full season as a Sun Devil has gotten off to a solid start. After being sidelined for most of the 2024-25 campaign due to illness and injuries, Manville has stepped into a starting role at 141 lbs and has provided ASU with steady consistency. Manville is 15-5 with a team lead of six tech fall wins, the fastest coming in 2:23.

Manville has only allowed 72 points across 21 bouts this season. The redshirt-freshman has added the aforementioned six tech fall wins, in addition to picking up his first career major decision over Lehigh's Carter Bailey (11-1).

Over the summer, Manville became the U20 Greco-Roman national champion with a 10-0 tech fall victory in the 67 KG division on April 24, 2024. He also added

a gold medal at the U20 Pan-American Championships on July 10, 2024. Manville was named most outstanding wrestler in his efforts to secure first in the 65 KG Greco-Roman division.

Notably, he defeated Oklahoma State's No. 2 Sergio Vega by decision, 8-6, in the quarterfinals

No Schultz? No Problem.

Sun Devil heavyweight legend Cohlton Schultz graduated after the 2024-2025 season compiling a 109-18 record over a five-year career that saw him become the first ever 5x All-American in program history. The Sun Devils then turned to the brotherly duo of David & Ben Szuba to fill arguably the biggest pair of shoes in program history.

The Szubas have picked up right where Schultz has left off, combining for a 30-11 record in the heavyweight position with 20 bonus points to add to it. Younger brother Ben's nine bonus point wins are the most by any Sun Devil freshman since at least the 2020-21 season, as he sits at 13-2 with two tournament wins under his belt (Reno TOC, Edinboro Open).

As for David, the graduate student comes in at 17-9 with a team-leading 11 bonus point wins that include another team-best five wins by major decision

Fives are wild

The Sun Devils turned in a solid showing at the annual Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational with five different wrestlers placing within the top-five of their respective weight classes. The five individual placements were the most individual placements at the CKLV in program history dating back to 2010.

Redshirt sophomore Nicco Ruiz (165-lb) and freshman Kyler Larkin (133-lb) each landed in second place, with Larkin's championship hopes sidelined due to a medical forfeit. Redshirt sophomore Kaleb Larkin (149-lb) claimed third, while graduate students David Szuba (HWT) and Chance McLane (157-lb) earned fourth and fifth place in their respective brackets.

In team scoring, ASU took fifth place with 92 points. It was the highest finish for the Sun Devils since taking third in 2019 with 103 points. ASU has now placed within the top-five of team scoring at the CKLV five times under head coach Zeke Jones since 2014.

Reppin' in Reno

Sun Devil Wrestling sent a total of six student-athletes to the annual Reno Tournament of Champions hosted at the Reno Events Center on Sunday, Dec. 21. Of the participants, Arizona State had three wrestlers stand atop the podium with individual titles to round out a well-represented showing over the weekend.

While team scores were not kept, junior An'ee Vigil (125 lb), redshirt senior Cael Valencia (174 lb) and freshman Ben Szuba (HWT) each went perfect on the mat in their respective weight divisions to secure a trio of first-place finishes.

Valencia (5-0) recorded four technical fall victories, while Szuba (5-0) knocked off the number one, two and three seeds in the HWT division en route to championships.

Additionally, redshirt freshman Joseph Manfredi (165 lb) turned in a runner-up effort, while redshirt senior Tristan Mascarenas (125 lb) and freshman Gabriel Delgado (157 lb) each reached match limits over the course of the action.

A dozen years of Zeke Jones

Zeke Jones has redefined success and cemented the Sun Devils into the national spotlight since his hiring in April 2014. Now heading into year 12, Jones has a new sense of energy around the program and the team.

"This is a big year for our program. We're pretty excited about where we're heading, I think all people would consider we've hit the reset button. We're bringing in 14 new wrestlers on our new roster that caps at 30. It's a really exciting time for us and I can't wait to see what this team can achieve," said Jones.

SUN DEVIL STORYLINES

Under Jones' leadership, the Sun Devils have won six conference titles, as Jones trails just Bobby Douglas (8) for most in team history. Jones sits behind just Douglas and Men's Golf's Randy Lein (8) for the most conference titles among any coach in Sun Devil history.

Dominance at the MSU Open

The Sun Devils began their 2025-26 campaign with a bang, seeing nine of 20 competing wrestlers reach the championship round in each of their respective brackets. Of the nine wrestlers competing in the finals, ASU had six individual winners:

Welcome to Tempe

The Sun Devils welcome 14 newcomers to the team, making it the largest signing class in Sun Devil Wrestling history. Kyler Larkin is one of the class headliners as he joins his older brother, Kaleb Larkin, to continue the Larkin pipeline at ASU. Larkin is considered one of the top 132-pounders and recently captured the U20 Pan-American title in the 61 kg freestyle division, representing the United States.

Coming from the transfer portal is former Oklahoma standout Jude Randall. Randall put a stamp on his freshman campaign by going 9-3 last season as a freshman in Norman. He also joined Ky. Larkin at the U20 Pan-American event, as he captured his own title at 72 kg in the Greco-Roman division.

The new heavyweight on campus David Szuba will slide into the 285 weight class for ASU. Hailing from Rider university, Szuba is ranked No. 21 on FloWrestling's preseason list in the heavyweight division. He compiled a career 68-37 record and qualified for the NCAA Championships last season including a victory in the first round. He secured the MAC Championship and went 12-1 as a senior last season. His younger brother, Ben Szuba joins the team entering his freshman year.

The Sun Devils also made a late splash, bringing in Mizzou transfer and three-time NCAA qualifier Colton Hawks to round out an almost brand new roster set to compete in 2025-26.

Champions made here

Former Sun Devil Wrestling standout Zahid Valencia etched his name into the history books by taking gold at the Senior World Wrestling Championships in Zagreb, Croatia.

The 28-year-old scored a perfect 49-0 across five total matches against international opponents en route to a gold medal. The dominant run was capped off by securing a 12-0 tech fall victory over Hayato Ishiguro (JPN) in the finals, his fourth tech fall victory of the championships.

Valencia now joins Zeke Jones as the only former Sun Devil wrestlers to win gold at the world championships, as Jones took gold in 1991

During his tenure at ASU, Valencia was a two-time NCAA Division I national champion (2018-19), a three-time All-American, a three-time Pac-12 champion, and a three-time Pac-12 Wrestler of the Year

The Big Man on Campus

Graduate transfer David Szuba has made a name for himself amongst the heavyweights nationwide after 70+ wins at Rider and an NCAA tournament appearance. While his success on the mats are widely known, Szuba's story off the mats write headlines themselves.

Szuba hails from Brick, New Jersey, where he was born and raised alongside eight siblings. David is the son of Shanna and Benjamin Szuba and has two older brothers, Justin and Nathan, three younger brothers – Benjamin, Caleb and Seth, and two younger sisters, Abigail and Shanna Rose.

Szuba is married to his wife Kaylee, where they have two children of their own, Rose and Luke Szuba. David recalls his favorite wrestling memory being his daughter, Rose, cheering him on from the stands yelling, "Come on Daddy! You got this!"

JUCO bandits

Among the deep transfer class, coach Jones and his staff dove into the junior college waters and reeled in three high-impact wrestlers. The trio Gavin Bauder, Leo Tukhlynovych and An'ee Vigil are primed to make the jump from junior college to division 1 after each of which spent two years in the NJCAA.

In two seasons at Clackamas CC for Vigil, he cemented himself as one of the best all-around 125 lb wrestlers in the NJCAA. Vigil claimed two individual NJCAA National Championships and was a part of the 2025 national runner-up squad. He was recognized as a 2025 NJCAA All-American and named The Open Mat's 2024 NJCAA Freshman of the Year.

Bauder, a teammate of Vigil's at Clackamas, secured an NJCAA national championship of his own at 133 lbs. His stellar season helped propel the team into the second place finish nationally before putting pen to paper with the Maroon and Gold.

Tukhlynovych earned back-to-back years of All-American honors and finished third nationally at the 174 lb mark in 2024-25 after seasons at Rochester Community and Technical College Minnesota.

Brotherly love

The Sun Devils active roster features three different sets of brothers. Ben and David Szuba, Kaleb and Kyler Larkin, and Aidan and Emilio Ysaguirre. Notably, the Aguirre and Larkin brothers are local products born and raised in Arizona.

Back to the Bok

SUN DEVIL COACHING STAFF

Head Coach: Zeke Jones, Year 12

Three-time Pac-12 Coach of the Year and 1988 Sun Devil national champion Zeke Jones was hired to lead his alma mater in April 2014 and immediately turned the program into a national powerhouse while continuing the Sun Devils' tradition of success in the conference. Jones is directly responsible for bringing six Pac-12 Championships to Tempe since his arrival - bringing ASU's total conference title count to 24. He developed national champions Zahid Valencia ('18, '19) and Richard Figueroa ('24), the first five-time All-American in Cohlton Schultz, a 125 national runner-up in Brandon Courtney (2021), and in 2022 led the heavyweight Schultz to national runner-up honors, too. ASU has celebrated more than 30 All-America honors since Jones' hiring. The team placed within the top-seven at the national tournament in from 2021-24, placing sixth overall in 2024. The 2022 season marked the second-consecutive season ASU finished fourth at the NCAA Championships - that's the first time the Sun Devils have earned back-to-back team trophies since the 1989 and 1990 seasons when ASU earned back-to-back silver medals. Jones is directly responsible for 40 individual Pac-12 titles, five NCAA top-10 finishes, four Pac-12 Most Outstanding Wrestlers, seven Pac-12 Wrestlers of the Year and three Pac-12 Freshmen/Newcomers of the year.



Jones took the helm with a resume that features accomplishments at the collegiate and international level. The Ann Arbor, Michigan, native was a three-time All-American, three-time Pac-10 champion, and national runner-up at 118 lbs with the Sun Devils from 1987-1990 before going on to earn the 1991 52kg World Champion title. He followed his world title with a silver medal-finish (52kg freestyle) while representing the U.S at Barcelona 1992. He finished his professional career with four World Cup titles before shifting over to coaching, guiding U.S. Olympians at the 1996, 2000, 2004 and 2012 Games. His accomplishments earned him an induction into the Arizona State Athletics Hall of Fame in 2004.

The 2020-21 season was one for the record books, despite the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic. No. 6 ASU earned five titles at the conference championships to post 138 total points en route to earning its 20th title in the Pac-10/12 era. Brandon Courtney (125), Jacori Teemer (157), Anthony Valencia (165), Kordell Norfleet (197) and Cohlton Schultz (HWT) brought home gold, and nine total trophies were earned in Corvallis, Oregon. Jones' athletes went on to collect five All-America nods at the NCAA Championships, with No. 3 Courtney taking silver in 125. The year was capped off with Cohlton Schultz earning a spot on Team USA with his second-place finish at the Olympic Trials, Anthony Valencia earning CoSIDA Academic All-America status, and Cade Belshay earning a Pac-12 Postgraduate Scholarship.

Jones earned his third Pac-12 Coach of the Year honor in four years in 2020 after leading the Sun Devils to their highest conference tournament point total (141.5) since 1993 while winning the program's 19th Pac-10/12 title. He became the first ASU wrestling head coach to win the conference award three times since Thom Ortiz did so in 2003, 2005 and 2006.

As an Olympic head coach, Jones' athletes earned two gold medals and one bronze at the London Games in 2012. His athletes in the 2004 Athens Games, where he was the freestyle coach, earned a gold and two silvers.

Lee Pritts, Assistant Coach

Year: 13

Lee Pritts was named assistant coach on September 4, 2012. Pritts, considered one of the top recruiters in the country, previously worked at North Carolina State, Old Dominion, and Missouri. He was a two-time team captain and made three appearances in the NCAA Championships, earning All-America honors in 1996 for Eastern Michigan and qualified for the 2000 Olympic trials. In 2017 and 2018, he was a coach for USA Wrestling at the Cadet Freestyle World Championships. Pritts mainly works with the lighter weights and also helps oversee the academics of Sun Devil Wrestling student-athletes.



Frank Molinaro, Assistant Coach

Year: 6

Frank Molinaro was named assistant coach on April 9, 2020. Molinaro was training to prepare himself for Team USA's roster for the Olympics before the Olympic Committee announced postponement of the games to 2021. Previously he won the 2016 Pan American games (70kg) and placed second at the 2017 World Team Trials. Molinaro comes to ASU after previously working as an assistant coach with Virginia Tech in 2017-2018. Before coaching at Virginia Tech, Molinaro was also an assistant coach with Rutgers and Penn State, where he helped win the National Championship in 2016. During Molinaro's collegiate career he was named NCAA champion with Penn State, a four-time NCAA All-American, and a two-time Big Ten champion. Molinaro primarily works with the middle weights and focuses heavily on the mental health and readiness of the team.



Eric Thompson, Assistant Coach

Year: 7

Thompson joined the Sun Devil Wrestling staff in August 2021 as a volunteer assistant coach, and was elevated to the full-time staff prior to this season. Thompson coached at the Nittany Lion Wrestling Club prior to coming to Tempe where he trained Kyle Snyder and David Taylor, five world-team members, and four Olympians. Before joining the coaching staff, Thompson wrestled at NLWC, where he trained to make the 2016 Olympic Team. He took fifth place in the 2016 Olympic trials. During his collegiate career at Grand View University, Thompson was a three-time NAIA National Champion at 285 pounds and was named NAIA Wrestler of the Year in 2012. Other stops for Thompson include a three-year stint with M2 Training Center where he worked with over 100 athletes and a one-year position with Lock Haven University as an assistant coach. Thompson focuses on the upper weights.

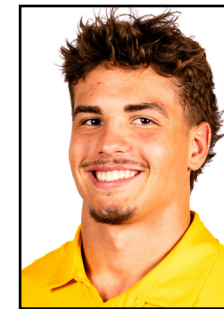
