

practical tips for parents for each theme

Numbers

- Count from 1-10 out loud.
- Count from 10 back to 0 out loud.
- Look for numbers in a magazine.
- Look at a number and copy it with a pencil.
- Write numbers in the sand with your finger.

Numbers 11-100

- Count out loud from 0-10, 0-20, 0-30, etc.
- Use clay to make numbers.
- Look for house numbers in your street.
- Ask your parents how old they are and write down their age.

Alphabet

- Say A-Z out loud.
- Write down your name. What letters are in your name?
- Find a word for every letter in the alphabet and write them down.

Farm

- Visit a farm.
- Look for all the words you've learned at the farm. Take a picture of everything you find!
- Read a (picture)book about the farm.

Clothing

- What clothes are you wearing today?
- Look for all garment in your closet untill you find them.
- Find all sorts of garment in the clothingshop.
- Let's play dress-up!

Colors


- Use all your colorpencils to create a beautiful drawing!
- Find all colors in your house.
- Mix all colors with paint to create new colors.

Shapes

- Find all shapes at your house!
- Draw shapes and cut them out.
- Explore outdoors: find all shapes in nature!
- Paint shapes with your fingers on paper.

Playground

- Go to a nice playground in your neighbourhood.
- Test all kinds of playground equipment: swings, seesaw and the slide.
- Go to a playground you've not been before.

Food & Drinks

- Explore your own kitchen! What products and tools can you find?
- Visit a supermarket and buy a few products you've learned about.
- Make a nice meal for your family.

Zoo

- Visit a zoo or farm and look for all the animals you've learned about!
- Go to a library and look for a (picture)book about the zoo. Find all the animals!
- Watch a nature documentary with your parents.

Body

- · Sing 'head, shoulders, knees en toes'.
- Close your eyes. Can you point at all your bodyparts correctly?
- Let one of your parents or friends say a word you've learned. Can you show where that's at?

Music

- Watch a movie about an orchestra.
 Do you recognize the instruments?
- Listen to classical music. Can you tell what instruments you hear playing?
- Let's make music yourself!

Sports

- Find a picture of every kind of sport and make a collage. Write down the sports.
- What sport do you do? And your friends?
- Choose a new sports and take a lesson!

School


- Look around at your school. Do you recognize the words you've learned?
- Do you have some schoolequipment at home? What are they called?
- Play hide-and-seek at school with your friends!"

Seasons and weather

- Find a song about the seasons. Do you know them all already?
- Every morning when you wake-up go outside and see what the weather is like.
- Check the weather forecast. Let's see if it's correct!

Emotions

- Show all kinds of emotions with your face.
- Let someone pick an emotion and show it to you. Can you guess what emotion he's showing?
- Draw circles (face) on a paper and give each one of them a different emotion.

Washing & Peeing

- Can you already dress yourself? Pratice dressing yourself in the morning.
- Draw two clean things and two dirty things.
 Write 'clean' and 'dirty' at the right drawings.

People

- Make a pedigree of your family. Call everyone by name, like an uncle, an aunt, a grandmother etcetera..
- Add photo's to your pedigree.
- Write a card and sent it to a familymember you love!

Fruit

- Buy some kinds of fruit to make a nice smoothie.
- Visit a supermarket and look for fruits you don't know yet.
- Taste and guess the fruits!

Beach

- Go to the beach. Did you take all the things you've learned about?
- Make a beautiful sandcastle and write 'sandcastle' with your finger in the sand.
- Can you find all animals of the sea at the beach?

Traffic

- Go to the shop. Show someone how you can go there safely.
- Look for all the words around you.
- Read a picturebook about traffic.
- Go cycling on your own bike. Can you ride your bike safely in traffic?

Forest


- Time for a walk in the forest! Can you find all the words you've learned?
- Make a picture of every animal you see in the forest.
- Make a drawing of the forest and write down three words you've learned.

Party

- · Craft your own party invitation.
- Craft your own garlands.
- Decorate your room with garlands and halloons!
- Celebrate your birthday with your friend and sing some songs!

Be-ill

- Everybody gets sick sometimes. How do you feel when you are sick? Tell about it.
- Read a picturebook about a hospital. Can you find the words you've learned?
- Roleplay: someone plays the doctor and the other plays the patient.

Where am I

- Let's play hide-and-seek! Once you have been found, tell them where you were hidden using the prepositions you have learned.
- Grab a chair and let someone tell you where to be. Can you find the right place?

Professions

- What would you like to become when you grow up? Draw your profession!
- Go outside and look around. What kind of professions do you see? You can ask them what they do for a living.
- Time for role-play: act your dream job!

Fairy Tales

- Read a Fairy Tale book together. Find all the words you've learned.
- Dress up like your favourite Fairy Tales figure.
- Write your own Fairy Tale and make a drawing to illustrate it.

Animals

- Let's go outside and look for some animals you've learned about.
- Watch a clip about different kinds of animals. Can you tell their name?
- Paint your favourite animals in one painting

Christmas

 Read the Christmas story together. Can you repeat the story by yourself? Go to a Christmas store. Can you find all the words you've learned about in the app? Sing a Christmas song together!
