The Role

KHFC are looking to recruit part time coaches to work within our Foundation Phase (U9s – 11s). The individual will be required to deliver 2 x 1-hour training sessions or one 2-hour training session (evenings) and manage a match day (total 4-6 hours). Hourly rate will be dependant on qualifications and experience.

You will report to the Football Development Officer and your duties will be –

- To prepare, coach, manage and debrief the age group for their games programme.
- To plan, prepare, organise, manage and evaluate all training sessions for the age group.
- To liaise with the Female Football Development Officer in the recruitment of trialists.
- To deliver player / parent reviews and information meetings where applicable.
- To liaise with the Sports Therapists in the management of injuries.
- To carry out and manage administration for game days
- To attend coaches meeting and CPD training as and when required.
