- 1. How advanced is my case of "diagnosis"?
- 2. How does it typically progress? Am I at risk of going blind?
- 3. Will controlling my blood sugar levels slow the progression?
- 4. Would it be helpful to see a specialist?
- 5. How will you monitor my diagnosis to protect my eyesight?
- 6. What is the best treatment for my case?

Additional Things to Discuss

Medications:

Your doctor may ask how well the medications are working and if you're experiencing any side effects.

If you need a prescription refill, be sure to ask for it.

Symptoms:

Your doctor may ask any symptoms you may be experiencing or have experienced since your last visit.

Concerns:
