VISION: Peak Vista is focused on enhancing the health of people and the

community-at-large through a professional, caring staff who are motivated, enthusiastic, respectful, energetic, and committed to

strategic partnerships.

ORIGIN: Peak Vista Community Health Centers has proudly served Colorado

communities since 1971 when a few local community advocates alongside a handful of volunteer doctors and nurses not only identified a need to health care services to those who could not otherwise afford it, they took action. Within two years, the teams saw

nearly 7,000 patients.

Through the generous support of the El Pomar Foundation and the philanthropic community, Peak Vista has continued to grow and expand services for over 50 years. What started as a clinic open two nights a week has become a pillar in the community providing high-quality medical, dental, psychiatric and behavioral health care. Our history is a story of community support, strong partnerships, and

dedicated staff.

NETWORK: Peak Vista has an integrated health care model with over 350

medical, dental and behavioral health providers and clinical support staff to provide health care to patients with nearly 90% at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. Peak Vista offers additional special programs like First Visitor, Well-Child Waiting and Care Coordinators that increase patient access to quality health care.

SERVICE AREA: Serving patients in Colorado Springs, Divide, Fountain, Limon and

Strasburg.

PATIENTS: As of January 2023, Peak Vista Community Health Centers serves

over 74,000 patients within our local community.
