

Services

Peak Vista's care team approach works with patients to reach optimal wellness – whether by delivering quality **medical, dental,** and **behavioral health care**, or by arranging for transportation, housing, or financial assistance. Together, the care team helps the patients set, achieve, and maintain their health goals.

To provide exceptional whole-person, whole-family care, Peak Vista can also coordinate referrals to a network of local specialists, and in some cases, at little to no cost to the patient.*

Peak Vista accepts Medicaid, Medicare, Medicare Supplements (including TriCare for Life and AARP), and PacifiCare Secure Horizons in addition to private insurance such as Aetna, Cigna, or United Healthcare. **We accept all patients, regardless of ability to pay or insurance coverage.** We have income-based options for payment and a Sliding Fee Scale available.

Care Coordination

Peak Vista has an entire team dedicated to assisting patients with their needs. The Care Coordination team can assist Peak Vista patients with housing resources, transportation to and from appointments, access to healthy food, and more.



First Visitor Program

The First Visitor program provides free education, resources, and home-visit support to families with children ages zero to five within our community.



Pharmacy & Lab Services

Peak Vista has two in-house pharmacy locations and offers lab services at several locations. We allow patients to request prescription refills using our telephone prescription refilling system and the Patient Portal 24 hours a day, seven days a week.



Well-Child Waiting Areas

Well-Child Waiting Areas offer complimentary childcare in a space where parents can drop off their healthy children while they attend their appointments with Peak Vista providers. Peak Vista's staff watch over the children at no cost to the parents, removing a significant barrier to care. Well-Child Waiting Areas are available at three Peak Vista locations.

What is a Medical Home?

A medical home is a model of primary care that is **patient-centered**, **comprehensive**, **team-based**, **coordinated**, **accessible**, and **focused on quality and safety**. It has become a widely accepted model for how primary care should be organized and delivered throughout the health care system.

Features of the Medical Home

- Patient-centered: A partnership among providers, patients, and their families ensures that decisions respect patients' wants, needs, and preferences and that patients have the education and support they need to make decisions and participate in their own care.
- **Comprehensive:** A team of care providers is wholly accountable for a patient's physical and mental health care needs, including prevention and wellness, acute care, and chronic care.
- **Coordinated:** Care is organized across all elements of the broader health care system, including specialty care, local hospitals, and both community and support services.
- Accessible: Patients are able to access services with shorter waiting times, after hours care, electronic or telephone access, and strong communication through online and mobile technology.
- **Committed to quality and safety:** Providers and staff enhance quality improvement to ensure that patients and families make informed decisions about their health.


