Peak Vista Community Health Centers Moves Administrative Services to North Academy Campus

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo. – Peak Vista Community Health Centers completes its Administrative Services personnel move from the Printers Parkway campus to the North Academy campus, located at 3207 and 3205 N. Academy Blvd., this month.

Since 2012, the 225,000-sq.-ft. property has housed Peak Vista’s Pharmacy, Enrollment Services, Well Child Waiting, Convenient Care Center, two Family Health Centers and the Developmental Disabilities Health Center. The North Academy campus is located on a public transit route, providing convenient access for patients.

Peak Vista’s Administrative Services will now be on the north side of the campus in Suite 130. Administrative Services includes the executive leadership team as well as several departments such as: Business Intelligence, Communications, Compliance, Credentialing & Recruitment, Customer Service Center, Facilities, Finance, Foundation, Human Resources, Information Technology, Logistics, Materials Management and Patient Accounts.

With the need for community healthcare increasing, Peak Vista plans to further expand patient services at the Printers Parkway campus with the extra space gained by moving Administrative Services.

“We are pleased with the possibilities this move presents,” said Pam McManus, president and CEO of Peak Vista. “It allows us to consolidate administrative services, creating a more efficient program, and it opens up more space for expanded services at Printers Parkway.”
