- Enterprise Zone donations must be made by check only – cannot accept credit cards

Colorado Tax Savings at 4.63%	\$46.30	\$46.30
Enterprise Zone Tax Credit	\$250.00	\$0.00
Tax Savings	\$646.30	\$396.30
Net Cost of \$1,000 GIFT to Donor	\$353.70	\$603.70
